MAUI INVITATIONAL ON HAWAII'S 'NINTH ISLAND'

■ Wisconsin will spend Thanksgiving week competing at the 2021 Maui Jim Maui Invitational, held this season in Las Vegas, Nevada. This marks the 4th time the Badgers have participated in the Maui Invitational (more pg 3).



Wisconsin faces Texas A&M on Monday, Nov. 22 in the opening game. The Badgers will then play either Butler or Houston in round two.

FAST BREAK FACTS

- Wisconsin travels to Las Vegas looking to bounce back from a rare home loss to Providence. Playing without leading scorer Johnny Davis, the Badgers held the Friars to 63 points on 66 possessions, but couldn't quite overcome 32.8% FG shooting.
- The Badgers have played in a non-conference November tournament in 14 of the last 16 years, going 23-12 (.657) in those games. (page 3)
- Wisconsin claimed runner-up honors in its last trip to the Maui Invitational in 2016.
- Through 3 games, UW is shooting 80.4% at the free throw line and has made more FTs (45) than its opponents have attempted (38). Wisconsin is also out-rebounding foes 44.3 to 35.3, while averaging just 8.7 turnovers/game.
- UW ranks 14th in defensive efficiency according to KenPom.com, limiting foes to 51.7 ppg and just 35.1% shooting (27.1% 3FG). (page 3)
- In his 7th season as head coach, **Greg Gard** has guided the Badgers to a 121-71 (.630) record --74-21 (.779) at the Kohl Center. (page 2)
- Gard has led Wisconsin to appearances in 4 of the last 5 NCAA tournaments.
- Sophomore Johnny Davis is poised for a breaout season for UW and off to a solid start, averaging 15.0 points per game. He also leads the team with 7 assists and zero turnovers.
- Wisconsin returns 2 starters from last year in 5th-yr senior Brad Davison + junior Tyler Wahl.
- Wisconsin's top returning scorer, Brad Davison is pacing the Badgers through 3 games this year averaging 16.0 ppg (shooting 45.5% FG).

- Davison has played in all 131 games he's been eligible (127 straight), ranking 3rd alltime at Wisconsin in games started (127), 6th in minutes played (4,098),
 - 16th in scoring (1,411), 4th in 3FGs (228), 10th in steals (138) and 5th in FT% (.831). (page 5)

- Having played 65 career games (24 starts), Tyler Wahl is coming off a career-high game scoring 16 pts vs. Providence (11/15).
- This season's Wisconsin roster features 12 underclassmen, including 5 true freshmen.
- Wisconsin is tied with Nebraska (2 So., 10 Fr.) for the most underclassmen in the Big Ten.
- With 12 underclassmen (7 soph. and 5 fresh.), it marks UW's largest group of underclassmen in at least 20 years (going back to 2001-02).
- The average age of UW's starting lineup this season is 19.8 years old. In comparison, last year's lineup had an average age 22.6 yrs old.
- Freshman PG Chucky Hepburn became the first true freshman to start a season opener for Wisconsin since Devin Harris in 2001-02. He also became just the 5th UW freshman to score double digits (13 pts) in a season opener since 2000. On the season, Hepburn ranks 5th on the team averaging 7.0 points per contest.
- Wisconsin is 1 of just 5 teams in the country that has played in 21 of the last 22 NCAA tournaments, joined by Gonzaga (22), Kansas (22), Michigan State (22) and Duke (21).

LAST TIME OUT

WISCONSIN 63, PROVIDENCE 58 Nov. 15 | Kohl Center | Madison, Wis.

- Trailing by 11 at the half, Wisconsin pulled within 3 late, but couldn't overcome cold outside shooting in a 63-58 loss.
- UW turned it over just 7 times and held Providence to 63 points on 66 possessions and 40.7% shooting. However, the Badgers only shot 5-for-27 (18.5%) from 3-point range and 32.8% overall themselves.
- The Friars also boasted a 19-6 edge in 2ndchance points.
- Senior G Brad Davison poured in a game-high 25 points (8-10 FTs), adding 7 boards and 3 steals.
- Junior F Tyler Wahl scored a career-high 16 points on 7-for-12 shooting with 5 rebounds and 2 blocked shots.
- UW's leading scorer, sophomore G Johnny Davis (15.0 ppg) missed the game with a lower body injury.

GARD AMONG THE BEST

In his 7th season as head coach, **Greg Gard** has put together one of the most successful careers in Wisconsin history and is quickly placing himself among the greatest Big Ten coaches of the last 40 years.

 Gard has guided the Badgers to a record of 121-71 (.630), owning the 5th-best win total and 3rd-highest win percentage in UW annals.

Among Wisconsin coaches, Gard ranks 4th in Big Ten wins (69) and 3rd in Big Ten win pct., trailing only Hall of Famers Bo Ryan (.717) Walter Meanwell (.660).

NEW FACES. NEW PLACES

Wisconsin has plenty of new faces, plus familiar ones in new places, that are making their mark:

- UW's roster features 12 underclassmen, tied with Nebraska for most in the Big Ten. It marks UW's largest group of underclassmen in at least 20 years (going back to 2001-02).
- Freshman G Chucky Hepburn became the first true freshman to start in a season opener for Wisconsin since Devin Harris in 2001-02.
- He also became just the 5th UW freshman to score in double figures (13 points) in the season opener since 2000.
- Four different Badgers have made their first career start this season: Chucky Hepburn,
 Ben Carlson, Steven Crowl and Johnny Davis.
- In total, six Badgers made their UW debuts in UW's opener (11/9): Lorne Bowman II, Chucky Hepburn, Markus Ilver, Isaac Lindsey, Jahcobi Neath and Chris Vogt.
- Sophomore G Johnny Davis made his first 2 career starts this season and is averaging 15.0 ppg, 4.0 rpg, 3.5 apg with 0 turnovers.
- Sophomore F **Steven Crowl** is averaging 11.0 points and 6.3 rebounds per game this season.

SERIES VS. TEXAS A&M

Wisconsin and Texas A&M meet for just the 2nd time in series history. The only other meeting came back in 1984, when the Badgers earned a 71-69 win over the Aggies in Madison.

- Texas A&M head coach Buzz Williams is no stranger to Wisconsin, as he formerly coached UW's in-state rival Marquette (2008-14).
- Wisconsin is 4-3 all-time vs. Buzz Williamscoached teams (3-3 Marquette, 1-0 Va. Tech).
- Greg Gard is 1-0 as a head coach against Buzz Williams, claiming an 84-74 win vs. William and Va. Tech in the 2017 NCAA Tournament.

- Starting the first two games of his career,
 Davis is averaging 15.0 points, 4.0 rebounds
 and 3.5 assists per game (with 0 turnovers) so
 far this season for Wisconsin.
- Davis was inactive for Wisconsin's game vs.
 Providence (11/15) with a lower-body injury.
- An athletic guard with slashing ability, Davis is averaging a team-high 5 drawn fouls per game for the Badgers. He's 6-for-8 at the FT line.
- As a true freshman last season, Davis ranked
 5th on the team in minutes played (24.0 mpg).

Wisconsin has stiffled its first 3 opponents, holding the opposition to an average of 51.7 points per game, 35.1 FG% and 27.1% 3FG.

- The Badgers lead the Big Ten and rank 11th in the NCAA in scoring defense, allowing opponents just 51.7 ppg.
- UW has led the B1G in scoring defense 4 of 6 seasons under Greg Gard (2 straight seasons).
- UW ranks 14th in the nation in Ken Pomeroy's Adjusted Defensive Eficiency (15th last year), allowing 88.6 points per 100 possessions.
- In a 72-34 win over Green Bay (11/12), the Badgers surrendered the fewest points of the Greg Gard era and fewest overall since a 62-31 win vs Northern Kentucky (11/14/14).
- Wisconsin limited Green Bay to 23.5% FG, the lowest opponent FG% since UW held Virginia to 23.4% FG back on Dec. 4, 2013.
- GB's 23.5% FG marked the 4th-lowest mark ever by a UW opponent in the Kohl Center.
- Providence averaged 89.0 ppg through its first 3 contests, but was held to 63 pts by UW.

WHAT'S TRENDING THIS SEASON

Wisconsin's 2-1 start is already revealing a handful of familiar trends. Consider...

- **Defense:** Wisconsin leads the Big Ten and ranks 11th in the NCAA in scoring defense. Under Gard, UW has led the B1G in scoring defense 4 of the last 6 years.
- Free Throw Shooting: UW ranks 2nd in the Big Ten shooting 80.4% (45-56) at the foul line. The Badgers have *made* more FTs (45) than their opponents have *attempted* (38).
- **Turnovers:** The Badgers are averaging just 9.5 turnovers per game, which ranks 3rd best in the Big Ten and 12th overall in the NCAA.
- **Rebounding:** UW ranks 5th in the Big Ten averaging 44.3 rebounds per game; also 3rd in offensive rebounding (14.7 off reb/game).

WISCONSIN'S IRONMAN DAVISON

Senior **Brad Davison** has been an ironman during his Wisconsin career, appearing in all 131 games he has been eligible (127 straight).

Davison's durability included a reoccurring shoulder injury as a freshman in 2018-19 when he dislocated his shoulder during a game against Baylor on Nov. 20, 2018. He was back in the lineup the next night against UCLA, the first of 29 consecutive starts to end the year despite the fact he re-injured his shoulder on 5 other occassions during that season.

During one game vs. Michigan State on Feb. 25, 2018, Davison separated his shoulder during the second half and returned to score 10 of his career-high 30 points after the injury.

- UW's returning leading scorer, Davison leads the Badgers this season averaging 16.0 ppg, shooting 45.5% FG (80% FT, 12-15).

reg Gard, a coaching veteran of 30-plus years enters his seventh season leading the Wisconsin men's basketball program in 2021-22 after proving himself as one of the best head coaches in the Big Ten. Gard earned 2020 Big Ten Coach of the Year honors after leading the Badgers to the regular season conference championship in 2019-20.

Wisconsin's incredible postseason success hasn't wavered on Gard's watch either, participating in the NCAA tournament in five of his first six seasons (Big Ten automatic qualifier status in canceled 2020 Big Dance, due to COVID pandemic). Most recently in 2020-21, Gard led the Badgers to an NCAA tournament first-round win over North Carolina, advancing UW to the second round of the NCAA tournament for the fifth time in its last six trips to The Big Dance.

Gard's postseason ledger includes a pair of Sweet 16 appearances in each of his first two seasons at the helm. In fact, Gard is just the third coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons, joining UCLA's Steve Lavin (1996-97) and Gonzaga's Mark Few (2000-01).

In his first six seasons as head coach, Gard posted a record of 119-70, the second-fastest (157 games) Wisconsin coach to 100 overall wins in the NCAA tournament era. He also guided UW to a conference record of 69-45. His .605 conference win percentage ranked eighth among Big Ten coaches the last 40 years.

After initially taking over on an interim basis midway through the 2015-16 season, Gard would go on to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year Award that season and was officially named head coach of the Badgers on March 7, 2016. Through six seasons, Gard has already risen to fifth on the school's all-time wins list and owns the third-best win percentage in Wisconsin program history.

The 2020-21 season brought unprecedented challenges due to the global COVID-19 pandemic, but the leadership of Gard and his staff helped navigate the Badgers to an NCAA tournament appearance. The Badgers finished the season 18-13 overall (10-10 Big Ten), highlighted with an 85-62 win over North Carolina in the first round of the NCAA tournament.

Gard's leadership during the 2019-20 season might have been his best. After opening 5-5 overall and 5-5 in the Big Ten, Wisconsin won nine of its last 10 games, including its final eight games of the season

to win a share of the 2020 conference championship and claim the No. 1 seed for the later canceled Big Ten tournament. During that run, UW knocked off No. 14 Michigan State, won at No. 19 Michigan and closed the season with a win at Indiana to clinch the title.

In his inaugural season as head coach, Gard led the Badgers to the 2016 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, becoming just the second-ever first-year coach to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. He followed that up by leading UW to the fifth-highest single-season win total in school history (27-10) and making a second-consecutive visit to the Sweet 16.

Gard's Badgers would follow that up with another 12-6 conference campaign in 2017, finishing second in both the regular season and the Big Ten tourney. UW capped off its 27-win season with a signature win in the NCAA tournament, knocking off the nation's No. 1 team Villanova, 65-62, to advance to the Sweet 16.

In 2018-19, Gard piloted the Badgers back to the Big Dance, posting a 23-11 overall record. Wisconsin also boasted a mark of 14-6 in Big Ten play, winning 14 conference games for just the 3rd time in school history, joining 16-win seasons in 2008 and 2015.

During his tenure as head coach, Gard has helped a pair of players reach first-team All-Big Ten status: Nigel Hayes in 2016 and third-team All-American Ethan Happ received the distinction in both 2017, 2018 and 2019.

Gard served as an assistant at Wisconsin for 14-plus seasons, including the final seven as the associate head coach. Gard served as the Badgers' recruiting coordinator in addition to constructing future game schedules. He was also the director of the Badger Boys Basketball Summer Camps.

Gard helped guide the Badgers to back-to-back Final Fours in 2014 and 2015, and in 2015 UW reached its first national championship game since 1941.

In fact, Gard has been on the bench for each of the top 13 winningest seasons at Wisconsin.

Prior to coming to Wisconsin in 2001, Gard spent the previous two seasons as Ryan's assistant at UW-Milwaukee. Previously, Gard served as an assistant coach to Ryan at UW-Platteville from 1993-99. During Gard's years on the Pioneer staff, UW-Platteville compiled a 161-13 (.925) record and won three NCAA Division III titles, five straight Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) championships and appeared in six consecutive NCAA tournaments.

GET TO KNOW JAHCOBI

Jahcobi Neath begins his first season with the Badgers after transferring from Wake Forest. The Toronto, Ontario native played the last two seasons for the Demon Deacons and had an immediate impact as a true freshman in 2019-20. Neath played in 30 games and started five, averaging 5.3 points and 2.2 assists per game his first season, shooting 42.2 percent from the floor, including 48 percent from 3-point range. Last season as a sophomore, Neath played in 20 games for Wake Forest and made four starts. He averaged 3.8 points and 1.7 assists in 15.8 minutes per game.
