TEXAS A&M QUICK HITS

- Texas A&M hits the road for the first time this season as it takes part in the Maui Jim Maui Invitational in Las Vegas.
- The Maroon & White are coming off a dominant 34-point victory over Houston Baptist on Wednesday, 73-39.
- Texas A&M is 4-0 to begin the season for the first time since the 2017-18.
- **Henry Coleman III** leads the team in scoring through the first four games at 12.5 points per game. The sophomore scored a career-high 27 points in the season-opener against North Florida. Additionally, he ranks second on the team in rebounding at 5.8 per game.
- **Marcus Williams**, the only Aggie to score in double figures in every game this season, ranks tied for third on the team in scoring at 10.8 points per game and second in assists with 13.
- **Tyrece Radford** leads the team in rebounding at 6.8 per game while also averaging 11.3 points, which ranks second on the team.
- Texas A&M's defense is one of the best in the nation in forcing turnovers as the Aggies rank second in the SEC and 10th nationally in turnover percentage at 28.6-percent.
- The Maroon & White have shared the ball effectively as they lead the SEC and rank 26th nationally in total assists with 68.
- A&M is led by third-year head coach **Buzz Williams**. The 2019 Associated Press SEC Coach of the Year has made eight NCAA Tournament appearances and has advanced to the Sweet Sixteen four times and the Elite Eight once.

WILLIAMS NOTABLES

- Named the Associated Press SEC Coach of the Year in 2019-20
- Eight NCAA Tournament appearances in 13 postseason opportunities as a head coach
- Four career Sweet 16 appearances (3 Marquette, 1 Virginia Tech) and one Elite Eight appearance (2013 Marquette)
- Guided Virginia Tech to the NCAA Tournament in each of the last three seasons
- Has won 20-or-more games in nine of his 14 seasons as a head coach
- Won 100 games in five seasons as he reinvigorated the Virginia Tech program
- Has coached over 20 all-conference honorees
- Previously served as an assistant coach at Texas A&M under Billy Gillispie (2004-06) and coached Aggie greats such as Acie Law IV and Antoine Wright

LAST TIME OUT

- Texas A&M defeated Houston Baptist, 73-39, to close out its four-game home stand to open the season.
- The 34-point victory marks A&M's largest margin of victory since the Aggies defeated Savannah State, 113-66, on Dec. 13, 2017.
- Texas A&M limited Houston Baptist to 39 points, the fewest since allowing 38 against Texas Tech on Feb. 14, 2012.
- The Maroon and White went on a 22-0 point run to open up the second half. Houston Baptist scored their first points of the second stanza with 11:01 remaining in the game.
- Four Aggies scored in double digits for the third time this season.
- **Aaron Cash** recorded his first career double-double as the junior registered 12 points and 10 rebounds.

HISTORY AT MAUI INVITATIONAL

- Texas A&M is making its second appearance at the Maui Invitational.
- The Aggies competed in the illustrious event in 1994, where they compiled a 1-2 record.
- A&M fell in its first two games, 103-73, to No. 12 Arizona State and 76-74 to Tulane, before topping Chaminade, 73-52.
- **Buzz Williams** has participated in the Maui Invitational once as a head coach, participating in the 2012 edition while at Marquette.
- Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 2-1 record, falling to Butler in the opening round, 72-71, before defeating Mississippi State, 89-62, and Southern California, 72-64.

4-0 STARTS

- Texas A&M is off to a 4-0 start for the first time since the 2017-18 season, a campaign that began with a seven-game winning streak.
- Only two other times since 2010 have the Aggies opened the season with a 4-0 record (2013-14; 2015-16).
- No stranger to fast starts, the 4-0 record marks the seventh unblemished record after four games in **Buzz Williams'** head coaching career.
- In the six previous 4-0 starts, Williams' teams have gone on to advance to the NCAA Tournament, four with Marquette (2008-12) and twice at Virginia Tech (2016-17; 2018-19).
- In both seasons as an assistant at Texas A&M from 2004-06, the Aggies began the season with an 11-game winning streak and a 10-game winning streak.

NEW GUYS MAKING THEIR PRESENCE KNOWN

- **Henry Coleman III, Tyrece Radford** and **Marcus Williams** have made their presence in Aggieland known early on as the trio of transfers lead the team in scoring and rebounding through the first four games of the season.
- Coleman III leads the team in scoring at 12.5 points per game, while Radford is second at 11.3 and Williams is tied for third at 10.8.
- Radford is the team's leading rebounder at 6.8 per game, while Coleman III is second at 5.8.
- Williams, who is the only Aggie to score in double figures in every game this season, is second on the team in assists with 13.
- All three are tied for second on the team in steals with four.

JACKSON BACK FOR HIS FIFTH SEASON

- Texas A&M fifth-year **Quenton Jackson** is the lone Aggie to utilize the extra year of eligibility given out by the NCAA due to the COVID-19 pandemic and does not count towards the scholarship limit.
- Through the first four games, Jackson is tied for third on the team in scoring at 10.8 points per game, leads the team lead in steals (5) and ties for the team lead in blocks (3).
- Last season, Q averaged 10.4 points per game and improved his field goal percentage from 36.6% his junior year to 47.4% last season.
- The Los Angeles native has appeared in 51 games for the Aggies, averaging 9.5 points per game. Additionally, Jackson has recorded 83 assists and 63 steals.
- Jackson graduated from Texas A&M with a bachelor's degree, becoming the first person in his family to earn a college degree. He continues to embark on his academic journey as he is enrolled in post-graduate classes.

BOOTS REJOINS BUZZ

- Junior **Tyrece Radford**, who signed with Buzz Williams while he was at Virginia Tech, transferred to Texas A&M in the offseason.
- Radford is more commonly referred to as Boots, a nickname given to him by Coach Williams because Radford's toughness reminded Williams of the tough material used to make boots.
- Radford has immediately made an impact as he is second on the team in scoring at 11.3 points per game and is the team's leading rebounder at 6.8 a contest.
- Boots was a standout for the Hokies, where he averaged 10.9 points and 6.1 rebounds while appearing in 50 games.
- During his redshirt freshman season, Radford became the third Hokie freshman since 2004-05 to lead the team in rebounding at 6.2 per game.
- The Baton Rouge, Louisiana, native graduated from Virginia Tech in three years, and is currently pursuing his master's in recreation youth development.

- Freshman guard **Wade Taylor IV** has settled in quickly and leads the team in assists with 15.
- Taylor IV has led the team in assists on three occasions, including his first career game where he tallied five.
- Against A&M-Corpus Christi, Taylor IV scored a season-high 14 points with four assists and matched his season high in assists with five against Houston Baptist.

CASH MONEY

- JUCO transfer Aaron Cash has been a key cog off the bench the last two games for the Aggies as he has averaged 8.5 points and 7.5 rebounds while shooting 7-of-10 from the floor.
- He recorded his first-career double-double in the win over Houston Baptist, tallying 12 points and 10 rebounds on 5-of-8 shooting to go along with two steals.
- In just nine minutes of play against A&M-Corpus Christi, Cash scored five points on 2-of-2 shooting while recording a team-high three blocks.
