ON TO THE MAUI SEMIFINALS

- Wisconsin used a 69-58 win over Texas A&M to advance to the semifinals of the 2021 Maui Invitational. The Badgers have reached the semis in each of their last 3 visits to the Maui Invite.



- Wisconsin is now 6-4 all-time in the Maui Invitational.
- UW has now started the season with a record of 3-1 or better in each of the last 4 seasons.
- In his 7th season as head coach, **Greg Gard** has guided the Badgers to a 122-71 (.632) record -- 74-21 (.779) at the Kohl Center.
- UW has played in a non-conference November tournament in 14 of the last 16 years, going 24-12 (.667) in those games.

LAST TIME OUT

WISCONSIN 69, TEXAS A&M 58

Nov. 22 | Michelob Ultra Arena | Las Vegas, Nev.

- Trailing by as many as 16 in the first half, Wisconsin ended the first half on a 15-1 run to take the lead and never looked back.
- Texas A&M started the game 8-for-10 from the field to build a 26-10 lead in the first 8:00. The Badgers would hold the Aggies to 11-for-39 (28.2%) shooting and 32 points over the remaining 32:00.
- Sophomore **Johnny Davis** led UW, setting career highs with 21 points and 9 rebounds. He also added 2 assists and 2 steals.
 - Davis' 21 points equal the second-best scoring output for a Badger in the Maui Invitational, trailing only the 24 points scored by Trevon Hughes against Arizona in 2009.
 - Davis has scored at least 15 points in all 3 games he has played this season and is averaging a team-best 17.0 ppg on the year. His 5.7 rpg rank third on the team.
- Senior **Brad Davison** scored 19 points (6-6 FTs) and added 7 rebounds and 3 assists.
 - Davison is second on the team averaging 16.8 ppg and is tied for the team high at 5.8 rpg.
 - Davison is tied with D'Mitrik Trice for 14th on UW's all-time scoring ledger with 1,430 career points. He needs 25 to pass Kirk Penney (1,454) for 13th place.

- Freshman **Steven Crowl** rounded out UW's double-figure scorers with 10 points.
 - Crowl ranks third on the Badgers in scoring (10.8 ppg) and is tied with a team-high 5.8 rpg.
- UW owned a 26-16 scoring edge in the paint and 15-5 on second chance points.
- Wisconsin out-rebounded the Aggies 36-29, including 11-5 on the offensive glass.
- The Aggies ended up shooting just 38.8% overall. The Badgers forced 16 turnovers and had just 11 themselves.
- UW went 15-for-17 at the free throw line, making more FTs than TAMU attempted.

ON THE SEASON

- **Defense:** Wisconsin is allowing just 53.8 points per game, which leads the Big Ten and ranks 14th in the NCAA in scoring defense. Under Gard, UW has led the B1G in scoring defense 4 of the last 6 years.
 - Wisconsin is 10th in the nation defensive efficiency according to KenPom.com.
 - UW opponents are shooting just 35.9% from the field, which ranks 3rd in the Big Ten. Opponents are shooting only 30.6% from 3-point range.
 - The Badgers are 67-7 under Greg Gard when holding opponents below 60 points.
- **Free Throw Shooting:** UW is tied with Iowa atop the Big Ten and ranks 10th nationally shooting 82.2% (60-73) at the foul line. The Badgers have *made* more FTs (60) than their opponents have *attempted* (52).
- **Turnovers:** The Badgers are averaging just 9.3 turnovers per game, which ranks 3rd best in the Big Ten and 9th overall in the NCAA.
- **Rebounding:** UW ranks 4th in the Big Ten averaging 13.8 offensive rebounds per game.

SERIES VS. HOUSTON

- Wisconsin and Houston have met twice, playing a home and home series in 1964 and 1965 with each team winning on its home floor. The Badgers claimed a 76-65 win in Madison before the Cougars answered with a 82-57 win in Houston. UW went 2-1 against Kelvin Sampson-led Indiana in 2007 and 2008.
 - In facing No. 12 Houston, the Badgers are looking for their 22nd win over a ranked opponent under Greg Gard.
 - UW's last win over a top-12 foe was an 85-76 win at No. 12 Michigan State last season (Dec. 25, 2020).

TEXAS A&M AGGIES

All-Time Series: UW, 1-0

Last Meeting: Wisconsin 71, Texas A&M 69 (Dec. 28, 1984 – Albuquerque, N.M.)

The Badgers and Aggies have met just once with Wisconsin edging out a 71-69 win in the Lobo Invitational in Albuquerque, New Mexico in 1984. The Badgers are 4-3 all-time against Texas A&M head coach Buzz Williams, splitting 6 meetings when Williams was with Marquette (2009-14) and knocking off Williams' Virginia Tech team, 84-74, in the 2017 NCAA Tournament in Buffalo, N.Y.



HOUSTON COUGARS

All-Time Series: Tied, 1-1

Last Meeting: Houston 82, Wisconsin 57 (Dec. 11, 1965 – Houston, Texas)

Wisconsin and Houston have met twice, playing a home and home series in 1964 and 1965 with each team winning on its home floor. The Badgers claimed a 76-65 win in Madison before the Cougars answered with a 82-57 win in Houston. UW when 2-1 against Kelvin Sampson-led Indiana in 2007 and 2008.



BUTLER BULLDOGS

All-Time Series: UW leads, 17-14

Last Meeting: Butler 61, Wisconsin 54 (March 24, 2011 – New Orleans, La.)

UW and Butler have met 31 times in a series dating back to 1921, but just twice since 1990. In the most recent meeting, the Bulldogs pulled out a 61-54 win in the 2011 Sweet 16 in New Orleans, La. Butler head coach Lavall Jordan was a player for the Bulldogs when the teams met in 2001. Jordan had 7 points and 5 rebounds in Butler's 58-44 win in Madison.



NOTRE DAME FIGHTING IRISH

All-Time Series: UND leads, 19-10

Last Meeting: Notre Dame 61, Wisconsin 56 (March 25, 2016 – Philadelphia, Pa.)

In a series that began in 1927, the Badgers and Irish have met 19 times, with 17 of the match-ups coming before 1969. Notre Dame has taken the two most recent meetings, posting a 58-51 win in the championship game of the 2010 Old Spice Classic in Orlando, Fla. and stealing a comeback 61-56 win in the Sweet 16 of the 2016 NCAA Tournament in Philadelphia, Pa.



OREGON DUCKS

All-Time Series: UW leads 5-3

Last Meeting: Oregon 72, Wisconsin 54 (March 22, 2019 – San Jose, Calif.)

Wisconsin owns a 5-3 edge in a series that began in 1951, including a 2-1 mark in the NCAA tournament. The Badgers knocked off the Ducks, 85-77, in the 2nd round of the 2014 Big Dance and 72-65 in the 2nd round of the 2015 NCAA Tournament. Oregon got payback with a 72-54 win in the 1st round of the 2019 NCAA Tournament. Brad Davison had 4 pts and 3 reb in that game.



SAINT MARY'S GAELS

All-Time Series: SMC leads, 2-1

Last Meeting: Saint Mary's 65-63 (OT) (Nov. 5, 2019 - Sioux Falls, S.D.)

Saint Mary's has taken 2 of 3 all-time meetings against UW. The Badgers split a pair of match-ups at the UW Field House, falling 62-60 in 1974 before claiming an 82-76 win in 1976. The teams also met in the 2019-20 season-opener as SMC pulled out a 65-63 OT win at the Sanford Pentagon in Sioux Falls, S.D. Brad Davison had 16 pts and 4 reb, while Tyler Wahl scored 2 pts.



CHAMINADE SILVERSWORDS

All-Time Series: UW leads, 1-0

Last Meeting: Wisconsin 104, Chaminade 66 (Nov. 22, 1995 – Maui Invitational)

The Badgers faced Chaminade in their 1995 trip to the Maui Invitational, scoring a 104-66 win over the Silverswords in game three. In the first three games under head coach Dick Bennett, Wisconsin fell to No. 3 Villanova and No. 4 UCLA in their first two games of the tournament before taking on Chaminade.

BADGERS IN HAWAII

Dating back to 1964, Wisconsin has made eight trips to Hawaii for tournaments, owning a 14-11 (.560) all-time record on the island.
