## TERRIERS BRING IN FIVE TRANSFERS

**Tedrick Wilcox Jr. (Dominican College) - 15.4 ppg | 5.6 rpg | 2.6 apg ('20-'21)**  
 • Started all eight games for Division II Dominican College in the 2020-2021 season, finishing his final season there as the team's second leading scorer, and averaging the second-most minutes per game of his teammates. Wilcox was named to CACC All-Conference Team after his sophomore season. He was CACC Rookie of the Year in 2020 in his first season at Dominican.

**Patrick Emilien (Western Michigan) - 5.2 ppg, 3.5 rpg, 1.3 apg ('20-'21)**  
 • Comes to St. Francis Brooklyn after three seasons at Western Michigan. Emilien ended his time with the Broncos on a high note averaging a career high in points per game, including a single-game career high of 18 points on 7-10 shooting against Buffalo on 1/12/21. He averaged a career high 19.6 minutes per game as a junior for the Broncos. During his first season at WMU, he was one of five players to play in all 32 games, starting 12 of them.

**Michael Cabbage (Marist) - 11.0 ppg, 5.3 rpg, 4 games, 4 starts ('20-'21)**  
 • The Marist transfer joins the Terriers looking to rebound from an injury-shortened red-shirt senior season in which he played just four games. In his single full season at Marist (2018-2019), Cabbage led Red Foxes in scoring (9.3 ppg), rebounds (6.1 rpg), assists (3.4 apg) and double-doubles (two). He started his collegiate career at Paris Junior College in Texas.

**Bahaïde Haïdara (George Mason) - 2.3 ppg, 2.9 rpg, 21 games ('20-'21)**  
 • Appeared in a total of 23 games at George Mason before transferring to Brooklyn Heights. Haïdara averaged 8.7 minutes per game in 2020-2021. He appeared in two games during his freshman season, before a wrist injury. Entered his college career as the No. 11 Canadian prospect, per North Pole Hoops.

**Jack Hemphill (Boston University) - 6.4 ppg, 3.4 rpg, 1.2 apg ('20-'21)**  
 • Hemphill comes south to Brooklyn Heights from BU off the best statistical season of his college career. He scored in double figures four times during his junior season, recording a career-high 16 points against Holy Cross (1/5/21). He appeared in all 34 games in the '19-'20 season, helping BU to its first Patriot League title, and NCAA tournament since 2011.

## TERRIERS SIGN SEVEN FRESHMAN TO 2021-22 ROSTER

### G Di'Andre Howell-South (Paterson, NJ/Immaculate Conception)

Attended Immaculate Conception High School in Montclair, NJ. He averaged 14.6 points, 10 rebounds, and 1.2 assists per game for the Lions. He led the team in rebounds in his senior season, helping them go undefeated in the SEC-American Conference.

### G Nick Folk (Coney Island, NY/Xaverian)

Attended Xaverian High School in Bay Ridge, Brooklyn. He was a member of the Clippers' varsity boys' basketball team, helping them to the Catholic High School Athletic Association this spring. He was named to the All-CHSAA team for his efforts. Folk turned down a number of other offers to stay home and play in his native Brooklyn.

### F Max Egner (Woodside, NY/Brewster Academy)

Joins the Terriers after a prep year at the highly respected Brewster Academy in Wolfeboro, NH; a program that has produced 19 NBA players and won 7 national championships since 2010. Prior to his time at Brewster, the Queens native was the all-time leading scorer at Mas-peth High School, averaging 29.9 ppg, and would become the first DT commit from the school. Egner has also played internationally with the U20 Polish National Team.

### G Cameron Jones (Hudson, NH/IMG Academy)

Arrives at St. Francis after a prep season at IMG Academy in Bradenton, FL. Prior to his time in Florida, Jones graduated from Alvirne High School in Hudson, NH, where he average 15 points per game. The guard found success on the travel circuit, finishing out with NEXT, averaging 21.3 points per game.

### F Michael Parrotta (Armonk, NY/St. Thomas More)

Joins the Terriers program after a detour to St. Thomas More for a prep season in Oakdale, CT. He graduated from Byram Hills High School, where he was a Class A all-state standout, earning numerous Player of the Week awards from The Journal News in the Lower Hudson Valley. Michael is the son of former Canisius head coach, and current Hofstra assistant coach, Tom Parrotta.

### G Michael Gonzalez (Brooklyn, NY/Xaverian)

One of three Xaverian alumni on the 2021-22 roster for the Terriers, competed alongside fellow freshman Nick Folk for the Clippers last season.

### G Kasper Suurorg (Tallinn, Harjumaa, Estonia/Audentese e-gymnasium)

Comes to Brooklyn Heights with a wealth of experience in European competition. Suurorg most recently competed for Pärnu Sadam in his home country of Estonia, averaging 5.1 points per game in 21 games during the 2020-2021 EMKL season. He also competed for the U18 Estonian national team during the 2019 FIBA U18 European Championships, averaging 3.6 points per game.

## 2021-22 NEC PRESEASON POLL & HONORS

The Northeast Conference released its preseason coaches poll on October 26, 2021, with St. Francis Brooklyn selected to finish seventh in the conference. Wagner was tabbed as the preseason conference favorite by the NEC coaches, with Bryant and Mount St. Mary's being selected second and third, respectively, also receiving first place votes. LIU was selected fourth, Merrimack was selected fifth, Sacred Heart was selected sixth, with Saint Francis U (PA), Fairleigh Dickinson, and Central Connecticut State rounding out the rankings.

## TERRIERS COACHING RECORDS

St. Francis Brooklyn men's basketball head coach Glenn Braica passed Rody Cooney for third place on the program all-time wins list for victories by a head coach on November 18, 2018, vs. Lafayette. Braica eclipsed the 150-win mark with St. Francis Brooklyn on February 11, 2021, with a 70-67 win over Saint Francis (PA). He is just one of four Terriers' head coaches to win over 150 games in their career. Braica currently holds a 154-180 all time record with the Terriers.

## NEC COACHING VETERANS

Head Coach Glenn Braica is the longest-tenured current Head Coach in the NEC as he took over the Terriers' men's basketball program before the 2010-11 season. Braica is the active leader for overall wins at an NEC institution with 154. LIU's Derek Kellogg has the most career wins of any coach in the NEC with 213 (nine years at UMass, three years at LIU). Braica has an 8-3 all-time record in NEC openers. Braica leads all current NEC Head Coaches with 102 league wins, Wagner's Bashir Mason is second with 93, followed by Saint Francis (PA)'s Rob Krimmel with 83.

## 150 WIN CLUB

Coach Braica collected his 150th career win at Saint Francis (PA) on February 11. Braica became just the third coach in program history to win 150 or more games joining Daniel Lynch (283 wins) and Ron Ganulin (187 wins). Braica has the most overall wins of any NEC Coach at its current institution. LIU's Derrick Kellogg is the career leader with 213 wins (nine years at UMass, three years at LIU).

## 100 NEC WINS

On February 17, at FDU, Coach Braica earned his 100th career win in NEC play, which are the most by an active Head Coach in the league. He became just the 10th coach in conference history to reach the 100-win plateau in league play and just the second coach in program history to do so. Braica joined former Terriers' Head Coach Ron Ganulin who picked up 129 wins in NEC play, which are the third-most in conference history. With 101 NEC wins, Braica sits in 10th-place on the all-time regular season NEC wins list.

## COACHING TENURE IN MET AREA

Terriers' Head Coach Glenn Braica and Seton Hall's Head Coach Kevin Willard are the two longest tenured Division I Head Coaches in the Metropolitan area. Both Braica and Willard were hired to take over the helm of their respective programs prior to the 2010-11 season.

## NEW LOOK ST. FRANCIS

The Terriers return just five of their fifteen letter winners from a season ago, which accounted for just over 34 percent of their scoring. St. Francis looks to replace three of its top five scorers from the 2019-20 season in Chauncey Hawkins (15.1 ppg), Unique McLean (11.4 ppg), and Stevan Krtnic (6.0 ppg). Hawkins led the Terriers in points, assists, steals, field goals made, field goals attempted, free-throws made, and free-throws attempted in 2019-20. Last season, McLean led the Terriers in rebounding (8.0 rpg). Rob Higgins is the top returning scorer from last season (11.2 ppg). He also led the team in minutes during the 2020-21 season.

## TRANSFER PORTAL GIVETH AND TAKETH AWAY

St. Francis welcomes five transfers this season: Tedrick Wilcox Jr. (Dominican College), Patrick Emilien (Western Michigan), Michael Cabbage (Marist), Bahaïde Haïdara (George Mason), and Jack Hemphill (Boston University). Four of the transfers come in from Division I institutions, one comes from a Division II institution (Wilcox Jr.) Four of those five led their previous teams in at least one statistical category during their careers.

## METROPOLITAN AREA ROOTS

62.5 percent of the Terriers' roster is comprised of student-athletes from the Metropolitan area. 43.8 percent of the St. Francis' roster hails from the state of New York. Five of the seven native New Yorkers hail from the borough of Brooklyn. The Terriers' Brooklynites include Larry Moreno, Nick Folk, Elijah Hardison, Matthew Gonzalez, and Angel Lopez. Folk and Gonzalez both featured for a high-powered Xaverian Clippers team during the 2020-21 season. Rob Higgins, Michael Cabbage, and Di'Andre Howell South are from New Jersey.

## LIGHT CHEESE LARRY

Following the 2019-20 season, Larry Moreno became a viral social media sensation for his trick shots that he posts to his personal Instagram page (@lcf\_larry). Has been featured on ESPN.com, ESPN SportsCenter, Overtime, House of Highlights, Complex, FIBA, SLAM, Reuters, ABC News, NBC Access Hollywood, NBC 4 New York, FOX 5 New York, PIX 11 New York, 1010 WINS, New York Post, News 12 Brooklyn. Since he first went viral on March 25, 2020, his Instagram following has grown to over 79K followers.

## SERBIAN TIES

The Terriers have had at least one student-athlete on their roster who has hailed from Serbia in 13 out of the last 14 seasons (2014-15 they did not have a Serbian on the roster). Stefan Perunicic (2008-12), Milos Trivic (2010-13), Aleksandar Isailovic (2012-14), Jagos Lasic (2015-18), Milija Cosic (2017-20), Stevan Krtnic (2019-Present), and Vuk Stevanic (2020-Present).

## HAWKINS RECORD BOOK WATCH

Chauncey Hawkins became the 33rd member of the Terriers' 1,000 Point Club against Robert Morris on March 4, 2020, in the NEC Quarterfinals. He became the first Terrier to reach the 1,000-point plateau since former teammate Glenn Sanabria did so during the 2018-19 season. With 1,231 career points, he is currently in 17th-place on the all-time scoring list. He is just 12 points away from tying Robert Jackson for 16th-place with 1,243 career points. Hawkins currently sits in second-place on the Terriers' all-time made free-throws list with 351 made free-throws. Jalen Cannon is the Terriers' all-time leader in made free-throws with 416.

## 19 GAME SCHEDULE

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic the Terriers played 19 games during the 2020-21 season. 18 of the 19 games were NEC contests, with the one lone non-conference game being against Tri-state area foe Saint Peter's on December 23. The 19-game schedule marks the fewest games that the Terriers have played in a single-season since the 1945-46 season when they played 18 games and posted an overall record of 12-6.

## CB RANKED AS A TOP FIVE ASSISTANT IN NEC

Associate Head Coach Clive Bentick was ranked as one of the top five Assistants in the NEC by Stadium this past Summer. Bentick enters his 14th season on staff at St. Francis and his second as Associate Head Coach. He has helped guide the Terriers to 11 NEC Tournament appearances during his tenure.

## 2020-21 NCAA NET RANKINGS

The NET rankings are a sorting tool the NCAA will use to evaluate teams in contention for at-large bids into the NCAA Tournament. The rankings will rely on five factors — team value index, net efficiency, winning percentage, adjusted win percentage, and scoring margin.

The 2021 NEC Men's Basketball Tournament field was reduced from eight teams to four teams with games being contested at the home of the higher seed. The 2022 version of the post-season conference tournament has not been announced so far.

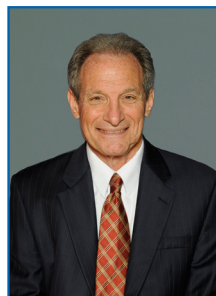

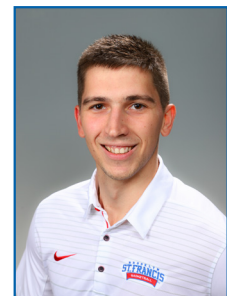

Glenn Braica was named the 17th head coach of the St. Francis Brooklyn men's basketball program on May 20, 2010. In 10 seasons at the helm of the Terriers, Braica has recorded the third-most wins by a head coach in program history.

Braica has a stellar 102-94 (.520) mark in Northeast Conference (NEC) action and has guided the Terriers to the NEC Tournament nine times. His 2020-21 team finished with an even 9-9 record in an abbreviated NEC slate.

In 2018-19, the Terriers won 17 games, their most since the historic 2014-15 season and earned a bid to the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT). St. Francis collected eight non-conference victories in 2018-19, which were one shy of tying the NEC non-conference wins record which the Terriers set back in 2013-14.

Through his 10 seasons as head coach, Braica has had at least one player from his team receive NEC accolades in each season. In 2010-11, Akeem Bennett was named the Defensive Player of the Year and selected to the Second Team. Bennett's teammate Ricky Cadell also earned a spot on the Second Team that season. In 2011-12, Jalen Cannon was picked to the Rookie Team, and the following season he was tabbed to the Second Team.

In 2013-14, Cannon earned First Team honors, while Wayne Martin was picked to the Rookie Team. In 2014-15, one of the most historic seasons in program history, Cannon won the Player of the Year honor and was a member of the First Team. Amby Fall picked up the Defensive Player of the Year honor, and Brent Jones was selected to the First Team alongside Cannon.

The following season, Fall took home his second-straight Defensive Player of the Year award. That year, the Terriers had a trio on the Third Team (Chris Hooper, Yunus Hopkinson, and Tyreek Jewell). In 2016-17, Rasheem Dunn made the All-NEC Rookie Team. In 2017-18, Dunn was rewarded with Second Team honors, while Jalen Jordan was named to the Rookie Team. In 2018-19, Jordan earned Second Team honors, while Glenn Sanabria was named to the Third Team. Last season, Chauncey Hawkins and Deniz Celen were named to the All-NEC Third Team, while Rob Higgins was selected to the NEC All-Rookie Team.

In total, Braica has coached one NEC Player of the Year (Cannon), two NEC Defensive Players of the Year (Bennett & Fall, twice), and 14 All-Conference players.

In 2014-15 St. Francis Brooklyn tied a school record with 23 victories and won its first NEC Regular Season Championship since the 2003-04 campaign. The Terriers earned a berth in the NIT, which marked the program's first national postseason appearance since 1963.

One of Braica's first recruits, Cannon was named the NEC Player of the Year and was a First Team All-Metropolitan Sports Writers Association selection. Cannon had a record-breaking year in 2014-15, as he became the Terriers' all-time leading scorer (1,720 points) and rebounder (1,159 rebounds). His 1,159 rebounds made him the All-Time leader in the NEC. Cannon became the first St. Francis Brooklyn player to be named to the All-Met Division I First Team and also the first Terrier to become an AP Honorable Mention All-American. Before his graduation in May 2015, Cannon was the NCAA Division I active rebound leader.

In addition, Jones earned First Team All-Conference accolades and Fall was named the Defensive Player of the Year. Braica earned the NEC Coach of the Year honor for the second time in his career and was the Metropolitan Sports Writers Association's Co-Coach of the Year. He also was named the District 18 NABC Coach of the Year.
