- Ohio State jumps back into Big Ten play this weekend when it hosts Wisconsin on Saturday at Noon.
- The Buckeyes are looking to start 2-0 in the Big Ten for the first time since the 2018-19 season as they beat Penn State on the road last Sunday in the conference opener.
- Ohio State leads the all-time series with Wisconsin 89-73 and 54-25 in Columbus. But the Badgers had the upper hand in the last meeting at Value City Arena, winning 61-57 on Jan. 3, 2020.
- The Buckeyes have won the last three games since returning home from Florida and are 7-2 overall on the season. They re-entered the rankings this week at No. 21 in the AP poll and No. 22 in the coaches poll.
- Wisconsin comes to town on a high, riding a six-game winning streak and having comeback from a 22-point deficit to beat Indiana last Wednesday. The Badgers won the Maui Invitational last month and are 8-1 on the year.
- Kyle Young has led the team in scoring each of the last two games. That includes a career-high tying 18-point effort in the win over Towson on Wednesday. Young has made the last six three-pointers he has attempted.
- Justin Ahrens is coming off a 16-point game against Towson where he was 5-of-10 from long range. That was his fourth career game with five or more three-pointers and he has done it twice this season. He is shooting 44 percent on the year from long range and leads the team with 24 makes.
- E.J. Liddell has been in double-figures in every game and has posted four 20-point games this season. He leads the team and is third in the conference in scoring at 19.8 points per game. Liddell is also in the Top 10 in the country in free throws attempted with 68 (7.5 attempts per game).
- The Buckeyes have hit 10 or more three-pointers in back-to-back games and are third in the conference at 8.9 makes per game.
- As a team, the Buckeyes are shooting 49.0 percent from the floor which is second-best in the conference. They are also second in three-point percentage at 39.2.

## KYLE YOUNG LEADING SCORER?

- Graduate forward Kyle Young led the team in scoring in back-to-back games at Penn State on Dec. 5 and at home vs. Towson on Dec. 8
- He scored 16 points at PSU and followed that with a career-high tying 18 points vs. Towson
- He has now led the team in scoring in a game eight times in his career
- This was just the second time he has done it in back-to-back games as he also scored 16 points at Iowa (2/4/21) and 18 points at Maryland (2/8/21) last season.
- In those games, he was tied for the leading scorer. He was the sole leader in the two games this season.
- The two instances of 34 combined points in back-to-back games are the most in a two-game stretch in his career.

## E.J. LIDDELL OFF TO A GOOD START

- E.J. Liddell has been one of the best players in the country so far this season.
- He is averaging 19.8 points, 7.0 rebounds, 3.1 blocks and 2.6 assists per game.
- He has been in double-figures in every game and has posted four 20-point games.
- He has blocked multiple shots in a game six times.
- He is second in the Big Ten in blocked shots per game (3.1) and is 15th nationally.
- Liddell has shot 68 free throws on the season which is tops in the conference and fourth nationally.

## BUCKEYES OPEN 110<sup>TH</sup> SEASON OF BIG TEN WITH A WIN

- With the 76-64 victory at Penn State on Dec. 5, the Buckeyes are now 60-47 in league openers
- They are 73-33 in the first conference home game of the season and 40-67 in league road openers.
- Ohio State is 41-20 when the first conference game of the year is at home and 20-27 when opening conference play on the road.
- The Buckeyes also beat Penn State 106-74 in the first conference game of the 2019-20 season in Columbus.

## LIDDELL SWATTED HIS WAY INTO THE RECORD BOOKS

- In the game at Xavier on Nov. 18, E.J. Liddell did his best to pull the Buckeyes out of an 11-point first-half hole.
- He finished the night with a game-high 17 points to go along with seven rebounds and a career-high eight blocked shots.
- He is just the third Ohio State player in program history with at least 17 points and eight or more blocks in a game.
- Herb Williams had 20 points, 17 rebounds and eight blocks vs. Iowa on Jan. 7, 1978.
- Brad Sellers did it in an NCAA Tournament game as he had 23 points, 13 rebounds and nine blocks vs. Louisiana Tech on March 24, 1986.

## AHRENS HUNTS HIS SHOT, AND USUALLY MAKES IT

- Senior captain Justin Ahrens is the team's three-point specialist. He is constantly hunting his shot and when he gets it, he usually hits it.
- Ahrens is shooting 44 percent from long range this season and is shooting over 41 percent from distance in his career.
- He has made 120 career three-pointers and just 13 shots from inside the arc.
- This season, he has only attempted two shots from two-point range.
- Ahrens and the Buckeyes are 21-3 when he makes three or more three-pointers in a game.

## AHRENS CLOSING IN ON OSU TOP-10

- Justin Ahrens has made 120 career three-pointers and is nearing the Top-10 in program history.
- He trails Sean Connolly (2001-03) and Ne-shaun Coleman (1996-99) for the tenth spot. They both made 147 three-pointers in their careers.
- Ahrens' career three-point percentage of .418 is currently second in school history behind Doug Etzler's career mark of .446 (107-of-240)

### RECAPING THE TOWSON GAME

- Ohio State forward Kyle Young led the team in scoring, as his career-high 18 points paced four Buckeyes in double figures in an 85-74 victory over Towson on Wednesday night.
- Young was 6-of-7 from the floor, including 2-of-2 from long range.
- Senior Justin Ahrens made four of his season-high tying five three-pointers in the second half to help the Buckeyes keep Towson at bay. Ahrens finished with 16 points.
- E.J. Liddell scored 15 points, had seven rebounds, dished-out three assists and was 8-of-8 from the foul line.
- Sophomore Zed Key came up one rebound shy of a double-double, finishing with 13 points and a game-high nine rebounds.
- The Buckeyes shot a season-best 57.4 percent (27-of-47) from the floor and made 10 three-pointers.
- Despite forcing a season-high 20 turnovers, Ohio State couldn't fully pull away from Towson. The Tigers made 12 three-pointers and were 14-of-17 from the line to remain within striking distance the whole way.
- The teams started the game by trading runs. The Buckeyes opened with a 10-0 run to take a 12-3 lead and Towson responded with a 13-2 run to retake a 21-17 edge. The game settled down after that and a fade-away jumper at the end of the shot clock by Key put the Buckeyes in front 33-32 at the break.
- With the scored tied 43-43, Malaki Branham drove and helped create on back-to-back scoring possessions to start a 12-2 Buckeye run. The freshman putback his own miss on the first drive and then he found Young for his second three-ball. The run gave the Buckeyes a 55-45 lead at the under-12 timeout and Towson wouldn't get closer than nine the rest of the way.

### DECIDED AT THE BUZZER

- The Buckeyes have played three games this season that have been decided by a shot in the final seconds.
- OSU beat Akron with a lay-in at the horn by Zed Key.
- Meechie Johnson Jr. lifted the Buckeyes past No. 21 Seton Hall on a three-pointer with two seconds left in the first game of the Rocket Mortgage Fort Myers Tip-off.
- Two nights later, Florida turned the tables with a running, pull-up three-pointer at the buzzer

to steal a 71-68 victory in the championship game.

- This doesn't include the games against Xavier (11/18) and then No. 1 Duke (11/30) that were both one-possession games with less than 20 seconds to play.

### ONE-POINT GAMES

- The Buckeyes scored with less than a second remaining to beat Akron 67-66 on opening night.
- That was the 135th one-point game in program history and the Buckeyes are now 73-62 in those games.
- OSU has had just a single one-point game each of the last two seasons and then opened this year with a one-point game.
- Under Holtmann, the Buckeyes are 2-3 in one-point contests.
- OSU has won its last two one-point games. In addition to the win over Akron, the Buckeyes beat No. 4 Michigan 68-67 in the semifinals of the Big Ten Tournament last season.

### KEY WAS THE KEY TO BEATING NO. 1 DUKE

- Sophomore Zed Key got his body into better shape during the offseason to prepare himself for being ready in the big moments.
- Against No. 1 Duke on Nov. 30, he certainly stepped up and the Buckeyes rode him to the win.
- Key found himself one-on-one in the post most of the night and delivered, to the tune of 8-of-15 shooting for a career-high 20 points.
- His previous high before that night was 14 points.

### BIG COMEBACK TO BEAT NO. 1 DUKE

- Ohio State was down 15 points early in the second half against No. 1 Duke on Nov. 30.
- The Buckeyes held Duke to just 7-of-31 shooting (22.6 percent) in the second half and the Blue Devils didn't make a field goal in the final five minutes.
- That allowed the Buckeyes to comeback and take the lead with less than a minute to play and held on for a 71-66 victory.
- That was the first time in 185 games in which Duke lost after leading by 10 or more at half-time (*ESPN Stats and Info*)
- The Blue Devils also don't give up 15-point leads very often.

### BUCKEYES WIN AGAIN IN THE BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE

- Ohio State's win over No. 1 Duke on Nov. 30 bumped the Buckeyes' all-time record in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge to 9-11 in it's 20 appearances.
- The Buckeyes have won their matchup each of the last three seasons.
- OSU trounced another ACC blue-blood North Carolina 74-49 in Chapel Hill in 2019 and then took down Notre Dame 90-85 in South Bend last season.
- This year's meeting was the fourth meeting between Ohio State and Duke in the Big Ten/ACC Men's Basketball Challenge.
- Duke won the first meeting in 2002 in Greensboro, N.C., which was the Buckeyes' first appearance in the annual event. The teams then split the meetings in 2011 and 2012, with each team winning on its home court.
- Chris Holtmann's teams are 3-2 with the wins over Duke, Notre Dame and UNC and losses to Clemson and Syracuse.

### BUCKEYES VS. NO. 1

- Following it's win over No. 1 Duke on Nov. 30, Ohio State is now 10-11 all time vs. the No. 1 ranked team in the AP poll.
- The Buckeyes are 7-5 at home vs. the No. 1 team. In fact, the last six times OSU has played No. 1, it has been played at Value City Arena.
- Overall, the Buckeyes have won eight of the last 11 meetings with the No. 1 ranked team.
- That streak dates back to a 90-84 overtime victory over No. 1 Duke in the ECAC Holiday Classic in New York on Dec. 29, 1978.
- In the win over Duke, Zed Key led the Buckeyes with a career-high 20 points. E.J. Liddell had a double-double with 14 points and 14 rebounds to go along with a career-high six assists. The Buckeyes erased a 15-point second-half deficit and finished the game on a 14-1 run over the final five minutes.

### OHIO STATE VS. THE AP TOP-10 AND TOP-5

- Ohio State is 78-139 (.359) all-time vs. teams in the AP Top-10
- The Buckeyes have won seven of the last 11 meetings vs. Top-10 ranked teams dating back to the start of the 2019-20 season
- Against just Top-5 teams, Ohio State is 42-73 (.365) all-time.
- The last win was a 71-66 victory over No. 1 ranked Duke on Nov. 30 of this season.
- The Buckeyes also split a pair of meetings with Top-5 Duke in 2011 and 2012

### SUEING OUT WITH ABDOMINAL INJURY

- Ohio State forward Justice Sueing will be out for an extended period of time after having an abdominal injury evaluated earlier this week. The Honolulu, Hawaii, native will rehab the injury and is expected to return sometime this season.
- "We look forward to getting Justice back when he is healthy," said head coach Chris Holtmann. "I'm disappointed for him because I know how much he is looking forward to his senior year. I know he will rest, rehab and be ready to go when he is healthy."
- The fifth-year senior is in his third year with the program. He played and started all 31 games last season and was third on the team in scoring at 10.7 ppg.

### LIDDELL OPENS WITH TWO BIG NIGHTS

- Junior E.J. Liddell opened the season with two big games, scoring 25 points in game one vs. Akron and then a career-high 29 points vs. Niagara.
- He also grabbed 11 rebounds vs. Akron to post his fifth-career double-double.
- Liddell made was 3-of-6 from long range vs. Niagara and was 9-of-16 (.600) overall from the floor.
- He had three assists in each game and swatted a total of seven shots.
- For the two games, he averaged 27 points and shot 55.9 percent from the floor.

### BUCKEYES SOLID ON OPENING NIGHT

- With the win over Akron in the season-opener, Ohio State improved to 101-21 in season-openers and 104-17 in the home opener
- Head coach Chris Holtmann is 5-0 in season-openers at Ohio State and 9-2 all-time in his career.

### 20-WIN SEASONS

- The Buckeyes are one of just three Power 5 programs to win 20 games the last four years, joining Kansas and Oregon.
- Broadening it out to three other conferences, Houston and Memphis from the AAC, Creighton from the Big East and Gonzaga from the WCC have also won 20 games in each of the last four seasons
- Any way you look at it, the Buckeyes are in rare 20-win company

### OHIO STATE 72, WISCONSIN 64 -- JAN. 23, 2021 IN MADISON, WISC.

Ohio State claimed its third consecutive road win over a ranked team as it knocked-off No. 10 Wisconsin 72-64.

Sophomore E.J. Liddell has been the team's most consistent scorer all season and on Saturday, he led the Buckeyes with 20 points and a team-high seven rebounds. He was 7-of-12 from the floor and 5-of-7 from the line.

Seth Towns added 10 points in 17 minutes of action. Five other Buckeyes chipped-in with either eight or nine points.

As a team, Ohio State shot 50.9 from the floor and made its final 11 free throws in the last five minutes.

The Buckeye defence held Wisconsin to just 33 percent shooting in the first half which helped them take control and they never let up. The Badgers were also just 7-of-28 from long range.

Ohio State entered the locker room at the half with a 32-25 lead behind eight points from Towns, who came off the bench to pace the Buckeyes on 4-of-5 shooting.

The Buckeyes never trailed over the first 20 minutes with seven scoring at least a bucket. The Ohio State defence held the Badgers in check from the field, allowing just 9-of-27 shooting and 3-of-15 makes from 3-point range.

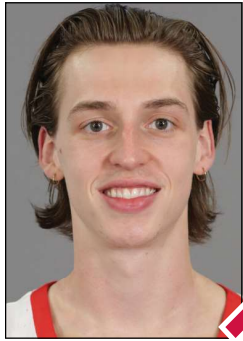

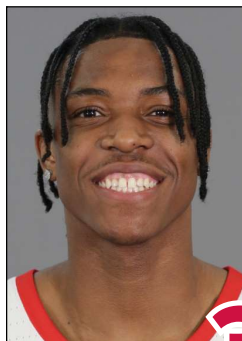
