OPENING TIP: This is the 187th meeting between Northwestern and Wisconsin ... the Badgers own a 121-65 series lead and are currently riding a six-game winning streak vs. the Wildcats.

- This marks the second-consecutive AP Top-10 opponent the Wildcats have faced ... The last time NU played two Top-10 opponents in a row was last season (Jan. 17 vs. #5 Iowa, then at #10 Wisconsin on Jan. 20) ... Northwestern will face #4-ranked Purdue next on Sunday Jan. 23, marking the first time in program history the Wildcats play three AP Top-10 opponents in a row.
- The last time the 'Cats knocked off ranked opponents in back-to-back games was in 2009, when they defeated #18 Minnesota, 74-65, on Jan. 18, followed by a 70-63 win at #7 Michigan State on Jan. 21 (was also the Wildcats' last win at the Breslin Center prior to this past Sunday, when they snapped an eight-game skid in East Lansing).
- Northwestern's last win over a ranked Wisconsin team was on Feb. 12, 2017, when the Wildcats took down the 7th-ranked Badgers, 66-59, at the Kohl Center amid their historic 2016-17 campaign.

MISSING PIECE AT HOME RETURNS: Tuesday's game will mark the first time in 682 days in which Northwestern students will be in Welsh-Ryan Arena for a Big Ten matchup (March 7, 2020, an 80-69 Senior Day win vs. #20 Penn State).

Due to a two-week quarantine mandate for all NU students returning back to campus after Winter Break ('Wildcat Wellness' period), the 'Cats did not have students in attendance at Welsh-Rvan Arena for their first three home conference games of 2022.

DYNAMIC DUO: Northwestern has two players that rank in the Top-20 in the conference in points per game ... Pete Nance leads the team with 17.1 ppg (7th in conference), while Boo Buie ranks behind him in 17th at 14.6 ppg.

LAST TIME OUT: Northwestern defeated #10 Michigan State, 64-62, at the Breslin Center for its first ranked win of the season.

- Marks the second-straight season in which NU knocked off a Top-10 ranked Michigan State team ... Also marks the 'Cats' third win over an AP Top-10 opponent under Chris Collins (vs. #4 MSU on Dec. 20, 2020 and at #7 Wisconsin on Feb. 12, 2017).
- Marked Northwestern's fifth win in program history on the road vs. a Top-10 opponent (h/t @collegebb_ref).
- Northwestern forced 17 Spartan turnovers (including 12 in the first half), which led to 16 Wildcat points.
- Ryan Young made his first start of the season and led the team with 18 points, eight rebounds, and two steals.
- Chase Audige (14 points, season-high 4 made threes) and Boo Buie (12 points) also finished in double figures.

LAST MEETINGS: Wisconsin took both meetings over Northwestern last season, with a 68-52 win in Madison on Jan. 20 followed by a 68-51 win in Evanston on Feb. 21.

- Chase Audige led all players with 16 points in the first matchup on Jan. 20, shooting 4-of-5 from behind the arc.
- Boo Buie led the team with 19 points on 8-of-15 shooting in the Feb. 21 game in Evanston.

BOARD MEN: Northwestern grabbed 17 offensive rebounds, including 10 in the second half on Jan. 15 at Michigan State. The 'Cats have now combined for 36 offensive rebounds in their last two games, the most in a two-game stretch under Chris Collins and since at least 2010.

BOO!: Boo Buie currently leads the Big Ten and ranks 21st in the nation averaging 5.7 assists per game ... Buie ranks fourth in the conference with a 2.58 assist-to-turnover-ratio.

At 244 career assists, Buie is just nine dimes away from passing Elyjah Williams (252) as the Wildcats' active career assists leader (more on pg. 11)



MORE NOTES...

D-D-DEFENSE: The 'Cats are holding opponents to a .394 shooting percentage this season, the fourth-lowest mark in the conference and 32nd-lowest in the nation.

- Northwestern held Michigan State to a 38.5% shooting clip on Jan. 2, the Spartans' second lowest mark this season.
- The 'Cats are holding opponents to a .444 shooting percentage from inside the arc, the third-lowest mark in the Big Ten, 21st-lowest in the nation ... so far this season 41.6% of all points scored by Wildcat opponents have come from 2-pointers, the seventh-lowest mark in the nation.
- In December, Northwestern held two-straight opponents to under 30% shooting (Dec. 5, Maryland shot 17-of-59; 28% + Dec. 12 NJTT shot 16-of-55; 29%) ... The last time Northwestern held an opponent to under 30% shooting twice in the same season was in 2015-16, when NU also did so in back-to-back games vs. Chicago State and Mississippi Valley State on Dec. 13 and 15, respectively.

HE'S COMING HOME: Evanston native **Elyjah Williams** returns to his hometown this year as a graduate transfer from Fairleigh Dickinson. Williams averaged 13.9 points, 7.6 rebounds, and 1.5 blocks per game last season, shooting 55.6% from the field and 42.0% 3PT. In total, Williams played in 116 games and made 74 starts across four seasons with the Knights.

 Williams finished with a season-high 11 points while grabbing four rebounds at Wake Forest on Nov. 30.

YOUNG, THE GIANT: Ryan Young is fourth on the team in scoring this season, currently averaging 10.0 points per game coming off the bench.

- Young has been consistently getting to the free-throw line for the Wildcats, ranking 16th in the nation with 6.8 fouls drawn per 40 minutes, per KenPom.
- Young ranks sixth in the conference averaging 2.8 offensive rebounds per game in Big Ten play this season.
- During his career, Northwestern is 5-0 in games in which Young has scored 18+ points.
- Young scored 20 points on a perfect 8-of-8 shooting and four rebounds in the Wildcats' win over High Point (Nov. 12) ... The last Wildcat to finish perfect from the field on at least eight FG attempts was Dererk Pardon on Feb 1, 2018 at Wisconsin (8-of-8, 17 points)
- Young led the team with 41 offensive rebounds last season, finishing in the Top 15 in the Big Ten in the category ... He also finished second on the team with 10 blocks, 114 rebounds, and 45 made free throws.

20/20 EXPERIENCE: Ty Berry led the way with a career-high 23 points at Ohio State, while **Pete Nance** and **Chase Audige** added 20 points apiece. They are first Wildcat trio with 20+ points each in the same game since Vic Law, Ryan Taylor, and AJ Turner did so against La Salle on Nov. 23, 2018 ... They are also the first to do so in a conference game in the Chris Collins era (2013-present).

The Wildcats have had multiple players finish with 20+ points in the same game three times already this season ... Pete Nance (22) and Ryan Young (20) did so in the win over High Point on Nov. 12, while Nance (20) and Boo Buie (23) also did so in the setback vs. Providence on Nov. 22.

TY BERRY = INSTANT ENERGY: Ty Berry led the Wildcats with a career-high 23 points (8-of-12, 4-of-6 3PT) and six rebounds on Jan. 9 at #13 Ohio State.

NANCE BREAKOUT: Pete Nance leads the Wildcats at 17.1 points and 7.7 rebounds per game. Nance is one of just two players in the nation to be averaging 17+ points per game, seven rebounds per game while shooting at least 45% from three-point range (also Justin Bean, Utah State).

- Nance missed the Wildcats' game at Michigan State on Jan. 15, but has scored in double figures in every game he's played this season, including a career-high 28 points vs. Maryland on Jan. 12 ... In that game, he also set career highs in field goals (10) and minutes (40), while tying career highs in made 3-pointers (3) and free throws (3).
- Nance has recorded a team-high four double-doubles this season (7th in Big Ten), including two with 20+ points and has led the team in scoring seven times.
- Nance scored 10+ points and pulled down at least five rebounds in each of the Wildcats' first 10 games, becoming the first NU player in the Collins era to do so in the Wildcats' first 10 games of the season.

AUDIGE SIEGE: Chase Audige scored 20 points on 7-of-14 shooting on Jan. 9 vs. #13 Ohio State, his fourth 20-point game in an NU uniform ... Audige led the Wildcats in scoring (12.3 points per game) in his first year with the program in 2020-21.

 The last Wildcat to average over 12 points per game in their first season of action for Northwestern was Kevin Coble in the 2006-07 season (13.4 ppg).

DECEMBER PAUSES: Northwestern played just three games in the month of December. The Wildcats' game against Prairie View A&M on Dec. 28 was canceled by mutual agreement between the two programs, NU's game against DePaul on Dec. 18 was canceled due to positive COVID-19 results in the DePaul program

B1G START: Northwestern opened Big Ten play with a 67-61 win at Maryland on Dec. 5 ... It marked NU's first win at Maryland in program history ... The Wildcats held Maryland to 28.8% shooting (17-of-59) from the field, Maryland's lowest shooting percentage since joining the Big Ten.

STOLE THE SHOW: Northwestern generated 19 turnovers in its season opener vs. Eastern Illinois. The Wildcats finished with 16 steals, the most since Dec. 20, 2007 against Howard (18 steals).

 Robbie Beran and Boo Buie both set career highs with five steals apiece ... It marked the first time two Wildcats had five steals in the same game since at least 2010.

RETURN OF THE 'CATS: Chris Collins' squad is among the most experienced in the Big Ten heading into this season. The Wildcats returned four starters for the second-consecutive season, tied for second-most in the conference. The 'Cats return:

- 78.1% of scoring from last season, second in the conference behind Purdue.
- 73.7% of minutes, third most in the Big Ten
- 69.1% of rebounds, third in conference.
- 84.1% of assists, second in Big Ten behind Purdue, led by team assist-leader Boo Buie (4.0 APG). Buie's 4.0 APG ranked seventh-best in the Big Ten last season.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE: Northwestern finished last year ranked second in the nation in strength of schedule, behind only Penn State. Dating back to the 2001-02 season, Northwestern's 2020-21 schedule (+19.18 adjusted efficiency margin) ranked as the second-most difficult schedule in KenPom history.

CHRIS COLLINS

BULLIVAN-UBBEN HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



Chris Collins is in his ninth season at Northwestern. He was named the University's 24th head men's basketball coach on March 27, 2013.

Collins guided the Wildcats to heights never before reached during the 2016-17 season. The unforgettable campaign saw Northwestern accumulate a school-record 24 wins while earning the program's first NCAA tournament berth and victory in school history.

NU captured the nation's attention with its outstanding start to the season. An 18-4 start, including a six-game winning streak in Big Ten Conference play – the program's first since 1933 – saw the team crack the top 25 of the AP poll on Jan. 30, the team's first national ranking in seven years. NU went on to record 10 wins in league play, its most since the 1932-33 campaign.

NU was rewarded with an NCAA tournament berth on Selection Sunday and the Wildcats earned a 68-66 victory over Vanderbilt in an opening-round contest in Salt Lake City. Northwestern pushed second-ranked and eventual national runner-up Gonzaga to the limits in the second round before eventually suffering a narrow loss.

Collins' contributions to the program were rewarded by being named one of four national finalists for the Naismith Men's Coach of the Year award. Following the season, Collins agreed to a contract extension that runs through the 2024-25 campaign.

Collins came to Evanston after serving on the coaching staff at Duke since July 22, 2000. He was promoted to Associate Head Coach in the summer of 2008. During Collins' 13 seasons on the Blue Devils' staff, Duke posted an overall record of 385-77 while recording eight ACC tournament championships, four ACC regular season titles, eight in-season tournament titles and national championships in 2001 and 2010.

Before returning to his alma mater, Collins served as an assistant coach at Seton Hall for two years with Tommy Amaker. Collins spent the 1997-98 season as an assistant with the WNBA's Detroit Shock.

While attending Duke, Collins was a team captain as a senior and fouryear letterman from 1993-96. He ranks 11th among Duke's all-time leaders in three-point field goals (209) and 10th in three-point field goal attempts (539). Collins averaged 9.1 points, 2.0 rebounds and 2.4 assists as a collegian. He earned second-team All-ACC honors as a senior.

Collins is the son of former NBA All-Star, Doug Collins, who is currently a senior advisor for the Chicago Bulls. A native of nearby Northbrook, Illinois, Collins is a 1996 graduate of Duke with a bachelor's degree in sociology.

Led the team with seven assists while scoring 19 points against High Point (11/12) ... Dished out a career-high nine assists along with 13 points in a win over New Orleans (11/16) ... Scored a game-high 23 points on 8-of-15 shooting against Providence (11/22) ... Scored a game-high 22 points and tallied six assists to help defeat Georgia (11/23) ... Recorded 16 points, five rebounds, and four assists in a win over Maryland (12/5) ... Scored 11 points in 20 minutes against Ill. Springfield (12/20) ... Chipped in 12 points and four assists against Michigan State (1/2) ... Recorded team highs with 22 points and eight assists against Penn State (1/5) ... Tallied eight assists against Ohio State (1/9).

2020-21: Led the team with 41 made threes and 96 assists ... Finished in the Top 10 in assists per game in the Big Ten ... Was one of four Wildcats to average double figures in scoring (10.3 ppg) ... Named the Big Ten Player of the Week for the first time in his career after scoring a career-high 30 points in a win over #4 Michigan State (12/20).

COLLINS on BUIE...

"We all know what Boo needs to be for us to be successful. He's our catalyst, he's the guy with the ball-our point guard/our quarterback. We expect him to be a top-half point guard in this league, and to be the guy who runs the show for us.

2021-22: Contributed 14 points, four rebounds, and three assists in his season-debut against Maryland (12/5) ... Scored 11 points and grabbed six rebounds in a win over NJIT (12/12) ... Tallied 12 points, seven rebounds, and four steals against Michigan State (1/2) ... Led the team with seven rebounds against Penn State (1/5) ... Finished with 20 points on 50% shooting (7-of-14) against Ohio State (1/9).
