NOTABLES

OPENING TIP

• Indiana University continues its 123rd season of competition in men's basketball with a home matchup against No. 18/18 Wisconsin at 1 p.m. ET on Jan. 14 at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. The game will be broadcast on CBS.

• The Badgers, led by eighth-year head coach Greg Gard, sport an 11-4 record and a 3-2 mark in B1G play. The game will mark the fourth ranked opponent for IU this season.

SERIES HISTORY

• Indiana holds a 96-80 lead over Wisconsin. The Badgers have claimed the win in 24 of the last 27 games in the series dating back to the start of the 2007-08 season.

• The Hoosiers fell in a pair of five-point losses to the Badgers a season ago. Indiana held the lead for 63 total minutes in the two games. Senior forward **Trayce Jackson-Davis** averaged 19.5 points, 9.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists, and 2.0 blocks in the two games.

• Indiana holds a record of 3-16 record all time against a ranked Wisconsin squad when playing as an unranked team. All three victories came in Bloomington with the most recent coming in a 75-73 result on Feb. 26, 2019.

LAST TIME OUT

• Indiana lost for the third-straight outing in an 85-66 result at Penn State on Jan. 11. The Nittany Lions drilled 18 3-point field goals in the game, the most by a Hoosier opponent in the last 25 seasons.

• Senior forward **Trayce Jackson-Davis** posted a 14-point, 11-rebound double-double with four assists and two blocks in the loss.

• Freshman guard **Jalen Hood-Schifino** (11), sophomore guard **Tamar Bates** (11), and junior guard **Trey Galloway** (10) all scored in double figures.

FINO ON THE RISE

• After hitting double figures in the scoring column just twice in his first six collegiate games, freshman guard **Jalen Hood-Schifino** has scored 10-plus points in seven-straight games.

• During the seven-game run, Hood-Schifino is averaging 17.9 points on 51.2% shooting from the floor and 56.3% shooting from the 3-point line. The Montverde Academy product has made 2.7 3-pointers since returning to the lineup at Kansas on Dec. 17.

• Hood-Schifino scored a career-best 33 points on 12-of-17 shooting from the floor and 5-of-7 shooting from the 3-point line against Northwestern on Jan. 8.

• JHS ranks third among all freshmen in the Big Ten in scoring (13.2 points per game), first in assists (4.5), fifth in rebounds (4.4), and fifth in made 3-pointers per game (1.7).

SHUFFLING THE DECK

• Indiana has utilized seven starting lineup combinations through the first 16 games of the season, compared to just four different starting units a season ago.

• Junior forward **Jordan Geronimo** (Jan. 8) and sophomore guard **Tamar Bates** (Jan. 5) have each earned their first collegiate starts this season.

SCOOP, THERE IT IS

• Sophomore guard **Tamar Bates**, nicknamed "Scoop", has taken a second-year leap for the Hoosiers. He has upped his minutes per game from 14.3 to 23.0, points per game from 3.9 to 9.3, and 3-point percentage from 29.8% to 40.7% from his debut collegiate season.

• The IMG Academy product scored 32 points off the bench on 6-of-11 (54.5%) shooting from the 3-point line against Nebraska (Dec. 7) and Arizona (Dec. 10).

• Bates became a father to his daughter, Leilani, on March 20, 2022, two days after his freshman season concluded.

NOTABLE STATISTICAL PERFORMANCES

• Senior forward **Trayce Jackson-Davis** pulled down a career-best 24 rebounds against Northwestern on Jan. 8. The tally marked the most by a Hoosier in a single game since **Steve Downing** had 25 against Kentucky on December 11, 1971 and the most rebounds by a Big Ten player since Aaron Johnson had 24 for Penn State on Nov. 15, 2004.

• **Jackson-Davis** recorded the third triple-double in Indiana basketball history with 12 points, 11 rebounds, and a career-high 10 assists against Nebraska on Dec. 7.

• The Center Grove product blocked a career-high nine shots at No. 8/6 Kansas on Dec. 17, the second most by an IU player. **Steve Downing** blocked a school-record 10 shots against Michigan on Feb. 23, 1971.

• Freshman guard **Jalen Hood-Schifino** netted a career-high 33 points for Indiana on Jan. 8 against Northwestern, the highest point total by a Hoosier freshman since **Eric Gordon** scored 33 against Chattanooga on Nov. 12, 2007.

• Junior forward **Jordan Geronimo** blocked a combined 10 shots against Miami (Ohio) on Nov. 20 and Little Rock on Nov. 23. The tally marked the most by a Hoosier off the bench since 1996-97.

CHASING HISTORY

• Senior forward **Trayce Jackson-Davis** currently sits eighth all-time at IU in scoring (1,814), fourth in rebounds (923), and second in blocked shots (214). He joins Alan Henderson as the only Hoosiers to be top-10 all-time in career scoring, rebounding, and blocks.

He was inducted into the IU Athletic Hall of Fame in the fall of 2022.

• The Hoosiers are 23-1 in the program's last 24 season openers after defeating Morehead State 88-53 on Nov. 7.

• True freshman forward **Malik Reneau** scored 15 points in his first-career game against Morehead State, the most points from a freshman debut for IU since Romeo Langford scored 19 against Chicago State on Nov. 6, 2018.

• Indiana made 21-of-22 free throws (95.5%) in the win over Bethune-Cookman on Nov. 10, the seventh-best shooting performance from the charity stripe with a minimum of 10 makes since the start of 1996-97 season.

• Senior forward **Trayce Jackson-Davis** recorded the third triple-double in Indiana basketball history with 12 points, 11 rebounds, and a career-high 10 assists against Nebraska on Dec. 7. He added three blocks and three steals in the win.

• Jackson-Davis joined historic company of triple-doubles in IU history. Juwan Morgan notched a 10-point, 10-rebound, and 10-assist triple-double against Jacksonville on Dec. 22, 2018. Steve Downing tallied 28 points, 17 rebounds, and 10 blocks against Michigan on Feb. 23, 1971.

• TJD is the first player to compile a triple-double with at least three blocks and three steals since Luke Walton accomplished the feat with 27 points, 11 rebounds, 10 assists, four blocks, and four steals against USC on Jan. 17, 2002.

• Junior guard **Trey Galloway** scored a career-best 20 points on a career-high 4-of-6 shooting from the 3-point line in the win over the Huskers on Dec. 7.

• Sophomore guard **Tamar Bates** scored 19 points on a career-high five 3-point baskets on Dec. 7 against Nebraska.

• Sixth-year senior forward **Race Thompson** scored a team-high 16 points to go along with nine rebounds against No. 10/9 Arizona on Dec. 10.

• Thompson hit a career-high 4-of-7 shots from the 3-point line, his fourth career game with multiple made 3-pointers.

• Freshman guard **Jalen Hood-Schifino** had a career-high 33 points on 12-of-17 from the field and 5-of-7 from the 3-point line against Northwestern on Jan. 8.

• The 33-point outburst were the highest output by an IU freshman since **Eric Gordon** also scored 33 on Nov. 12, 2007 against Chattanooga.

• Senior forward **Trayce Jackson-Davis** had 18 points, a career-high 24 rebounds, eight assists, and four blocks against the Wildcats.

• His 24 rebounds were the most by a Hoosier in a single game since **Steve Downing** had 25 against Kentucky on December 11, 1971 and the most rebounds by a Big Ten player since Aaron Johnson had 24 for Penn State on Nov. 15, 2004.

• Senior forward **Trayce Jackson-Davis** had 14 points, 11 rebounds, four assists and two blocks at Penn State on Jan. 11. The game marked his 38th career double-double.

MIKE WOODSON

Second Year at Indiana • Second Year as College Head Coach

Record at Indiana: 31-20 Overall, Second Year

• Indiana University Vice President and Director of Athletics Scott Dolson has named former Hoosier All-American and Indianapolis native Mike Woodson as the 30th head coach in the men's basketball program's history.

• Woodson returns to the Bloomington campus with vast experiences and knowledge after playing in the NBA for 11 seasons beginning in 1980 and serving as a coach in the league beginning in 1996 for seven NBA franchises, including nine years combined as a head coach with the Atlanta Hawks and New York Knicks. He was currently serving as an assistant coach with the Knicks.

• "This is a great day and a great fit for Indiana Basketball," said IU Vice President and Director of Intercollegiate Athletics Scott Dolson. "Throughout this process, I was looking for someone I could partner with to return Indiana Basketball to a level of success that Hoosier fans have come to know and expect, and Mike is that person."

• "During the last two weeks, I have spoken with numerous individuals at the college and NBA levels, and they were unanimous in their support of and respect for Mike. From his ability in terms of X's and O's to his skill at building relationships and developing players, his reputation is outstanding. As a coach, he's succeeded at the highest levels of the NBA, and he's mentored some of the game's all-time great players. On top of all of that, as one of our program's legendary players, Mike certainly gives us a bridge to our past. But more important than what he did as a former Hoosier player, he's someone who shares my vision for what Indiana Basketball is about, and I'm thrilled about what this day means for our program."

• Woodson was the 1980 Big Ten Player of the Year and NABC All-American as a senior in leading the Hoosiers to a conference title and a berth in the NCAA Tournament's Sweet Sixteen. Despite undergoing back surgery in December and missing seven weeks, he was honored as the Chicago Tribune's Silver Basketball Award Winner following the season.

• As head coach of the Knicks, Woodson guided his 2012-13 Atlantic Division Champions to their first appearance in the Eastern Conference semifinals since 2000 and finished his tenure as New York's coach with a record of 109-79 (.680). As an NBA head coach with Atlanta (2004-2010) and New York (2011-2014), Woodson saw his teams compile two 50-plus win seasons including a personal high of 54 victories during the 2012-13 season with the Knicks. Woodson joined the Knicks staff following six seasons as head coach of the Hawks, where he guided the Hawks to the NBA Playoffs in each of his last three seasons (including 2007-08, ending Atlanta's eight-year Playoff drought), and into the Eastern Conference Semifinals in his last two seasons. In the Playoffs, he piloted the Hawks to back-to-back Game 7 wins in the first round over Miami in 2009 and Milwaukee in 2010.

• Before joining the Hawks, Woodson served for one season (2003-04) as an assistant coach with the Detroit Pistons, where he earned an NBA Championship ring as one of the chief architects behind Detroit's suffocating defense that helped lift the Pistons to the 2004 NBA title. Prior to his six years at the helm of the Hawks, Woodson logged eight seasons as an assistant coach with Milwaukee (1996-97 through 1998-99), Cleveland (1999-2000 through 2000-01), Philadelphia (2001-02 through 2002-03) and Detroit (2003-04).

• Among the All-Stars he's mentored are Ray Allen (Milwaukee Bucks), Kenny Anderson (Atlanta Hawks), Carmelo Anthony (New York Knicks), Chauncey Billups (Detroit Pistons), Sam Cassell (Milwaukee Bucks), Derrick Coleman (Philadelphia 76ers), Baron Davis (New York Knicks), Blake Griffin (Los Angeles Clippers), Richard Hamilton (Detroit Pistons), Al Horford (Atlanta Hawks), Allen Iverson (Philadelphia 76ers), Joe Johnson (Atlanta Hawks), DeAndre Jordan (Los Angeles Clippers), Shawn Kemp (Cleveland Cavaliers), Jason Kidd (New York Knicks), Kenyon Martin (New York Knicks), Dikembe Mutombo (Philadelphia 76ers), Chris Paul (Los Angeles Clippers), Paul Pierce (Los Angeles Clippers), Julius Randle (New York Knicks), Glenn Robinson (Milwaukee Bucks), Derrick Rose (New York Knicks), Amar'e Stoudemire (New York Knicks), Antoine Walker (Atlanta Hawks), Ben Wallace (Detroit Pistons) and Rasheed Wallace (Detroit Pistons, New York Knicks).

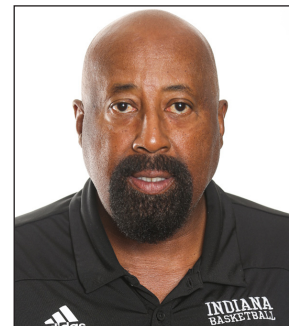
• As an assistant, he has worked for greats such as Chris Ford (Bucks), George Karl (Bucks), Larry Brown (76ers and Pistons), Mike D'Antoni (Knicks), Doc Rivers (Clippers), and Tom Thibodeau (Knicks).

• The Knicks selected Woodson with the 12th pick of the 1980 NBA Draft and he enjoyed an 11-year NBA playing career, averaging 14.0 points over 786 games for the Knicks (1980-81), New Jersey (1981-82), Kansas City/Sacramento (1981-82 through 1985-86), the LA Clippers (1986-87 through 1987-88), Houston (1988-89 through 1990-91) and Cleveland (1990-91). He scored a career-high 18.2 ppg with Kansas City in 1982-83. He also averaged 12.2 points in 13 career Playoff games over five post-seasons. Woodson's NBA playing career began in 1980-81, when he averaged 4.7 points over 11.7 minutes in 81 contests with the Knicks.

• He had the honor of playing for some of the most decorated coaches in league history including Red Holzman (Knicks) Larry Brown (Nets) Cotton Fitzsimmons (Kings); Gene Shue (Clippers), Don Chaney (Clippers and Rockets).

• Woodson played 104 games for the Hoosiers after graduating in 1976 from Broad Ripple High School and is the fifth all-time leading scorer with 2,061 points and his 19.8 points per game average is tied (Calbert Cheaney) for the second highest by a Hoosier who played four seasons in college. He averaged 21.0 points during his junior season and helped lead Indiana to an NIT Championship. Woodson captained the USA's Pan American Games team to a gold medal during the summer prior to his senior year and was all set to have a perfect season with the Hoosiers who were ranked No. 1 in the preseason of the 1979-80 campaign. After five games, Woodson suffered a herniated disc in his back and had to undergo surgery. Upon losing Woodson, the Hoosiers went 7-5 in the Big Ten until he returned to spark Indiana back into action. IU finished the conference season with six straight victories and won the Big Ten title. Woodson was the MVP after playing in only six league games that season.

• The 63-year old was born on Mar. 24, 1958 in Indianapolis. At Broad Ripple High School in Indianapolis, he averaged 28.6 points as a senior, scored 1,154 points in his career, and earned All-State honors while being a member of the Indiana All-Stars. He was inducted into the IU Athletics Hall of Fame in 1992 and the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame in 2010. Mike and his wife, Terri, have two daughters, Alexis and Mariah, who were volleyball players at Georgia Tech. Alexis also played one season at IU.
