

ABOUT THE BRAVES

- Bradley won its first MVC regular season championship in 27 years earlier this season in a clinching game at home vs Drake in front of 10,548 Bradley fans.
- Bradley would then meet Drake in the MVCT championship game, with both schools being in the top 70 of the NET. Drake won, claiming the MVC's auto bid to the NCAAT. Bradley will now look to claim its first NIT championship since 1982.

NATIONAL AWARD FINALISTS

- Brian Wardle and Malevy Leons are finalists for the CollegeInsider.com Skip Prosser Man of the Year award (Brian Wardle) and the Lefty Driesell Defensive Player of the Year (Malevy Leons).
- Wardle previously won the Skip Prosser Man of the Year award in 2014 when at Green Bay.
- Leons is fomerly the National JC player of the year prior to coming to Bradley and has already annouced he will be returning to Bradley next season.

NOTHING BUT NET

- The Bradley Braves are 72nd in the latest NET rankings. Bradley is 25-3 against quad-2 or lower and is 0-5 against quad-1 teams. Bradley's highest win is against Drake, who is currently 55th.
- BU's side of the NIT bracket presents the chance for brand name wins against Liberty, Villanova, Wisconsin, Florida and Oregon.

COACH PROFILE

- Brian Wardle is the head man for Bradley.
 Coach Wardle took over the Bradley program during the 2015-16 season and is in his 8th year at the helm with a 117 wins over the last 6 seasons.
- Coach Wardle previously was the HC at UW-Green Bay where he averaged 19 wins per season in his 5 years in Green Bay.

BRAVES TO WATCH

- Ja'Shon Henry, the fifth year senior has made his presence felt this MVCT. Henry is avergaing 14.5 PPG, 7.5 RPG, and 1 BPG in the MVCT this season. Henry is the 2023 MVC 6th Man of the Year
- Malevy Leons comes into today's contest in the after of one of the best defensive seasons the MVC has ever seen. Leons became the first MVC player to reach 50+ steals and 50+ blocks in the same season. He is the only player in the NCAA with 50+ blocks, 50+ steals, and 200 rebounds.

BUILDING DEPTH BY FIRE

- Depth is something that Bradley is blessed to have as they enter the NIT but it wasn't that way to begin the season.
- In the first month of the season Bradley was out four of their eight man rotation with Mast (MCL Sprain), Montgomery (Broken Wrist), Henry (Neck), and Weathers (Head/Illness) all being sidelined with injuries.
- As a result Darius Hannah, Christain Davis, and Ville Tahvanainen all were forced to play big minutes into conference play. Now all three consistantly find minues off the bench for Bradley.

EYE-OPENING PERFORMENCES

- Darius Hannah, mainly known for his highlight reel dunks, Hannah showed off his low post skills collecting 10 of BU's 30 bench points against Indiana State in the MVCT Semifinals
- Connor Hickman, BU wouldn't be in this postion without their 2nd year combo guard. Hickman has been known to be a 3pt sniper in his young career with

BATTLE TESTED

- For casual fans on the outside, many may look at Bradley vs Wisconsin and say Bradley won't be ready to play a brand name like Wisconsin but that couldn't be further from the truth.
- Bradley played as hard of a schedule that a mid-major can get this season with five NCAA tournament teams on the calandar this season in Utah State, Drake, Auburn, Arkansas, and SEMO.
- Bradley also had a game against Liberty in Cancun, Mexico. Bradley despite being down four of their top eight in their rotation held Liberty to 55 points.

BRADLEY'S RUN THROUGH THE MVC

- Bradley needed to run off 10 straight wins following their home loss to Belmont in late January to win the MVC regular season for the first time since 1995.
- BU ended the regular season with the MVC's best conf record (16-4), road record (8-4), home record (15-1), and second most overall wins (23).

HENRY'S LAST RIDE

- Ja'Shon Henry comes into this season as the oldest and most exprienced player on BU's roster.
- · He is currently the only remaning player of BU's back-to-back championship teams in 19' & 20' and is one of three players on the roster from the 2020 MVCT title team
- Henry recently recorded his 1,000th career point in late February and will go down as one of the toughest Bradley players ever after suffering back to back season ending injuries in his 3rd and 4th seasons.

SEPERATED BY 12 YRS AND 3 HRS

- Its been 12 years since Bradley and Wisconsin met on the hardwood with the last meeting coming in 2011 in the Chicago Inviational Challenge.
- It's just a 3 hour and 16 minute drive to Madison from Peoria which makes it a closer trip than Drake, Murray St, Belmont, Missouri St, Southern IL, Evansville, Indiana St, and Northern Iowa. All of which are MVC foes for Bradley.

BRADLEY'S LENGTH HAS YOU COVERED

- The Bradley Braves feature the longest front court in the MVC with an average wingspan of 85 inches or roughly 7 feet and 1 inch.
- Individual lengths of Mast 6ft-11.5in. Hannah 7ft, Jonovic 7ft-6in, and Leons 7ft-1in.
- In NBA perspective that is like putting three Jonathan Issacs on the floor and James Wiseman at the same time with room still for a 5th player on the floor.

BALANCED ATTACK

- The Braves have had eight different players hit a 3pt shot this season. BU struggled to shoot from three last year (32%), they are 36% so far this season.
- The Braves have two players averaging double figure scoring another four players close behind at 9.8, 9.6, 8.7, and 7.9 (Duke Deen, Ja'Shon Henry, Connor Hickman, Zek Montgomery).

BRADLEY FROM THREE

- · Malevy Leons, Duke Deen, and Zek Montgomery setting the tone from long range this season.
- · All three are making their mark from behind the arch with each shooting 36% or better from three.
- Bradley currently has seven different players that have made 10+ threes BU is shooting 40% from three at home and 34% on the road.

REWRITTING THE "SCRIPT"

- New this season for BU will be their script retro uniforms. BU has both red and white versions of the uniform which is inspired from BU uniforms of the 80s, which were worn by Hersey Hawkins.
- Bradley's players loved them so much that they decided to make them the permanant jerseys of choice for the remainder of the season.
- Looking good must mean playing good as BU has just one loss in these unforms coming in the MVCT title game. (10-1 in the white & 2-0 in the Red).

THE DUTCH ARMY KNIFE

- Bradley's Malevy Leons was awarded the MVC Defensive player of the Year honor.
- Leons currently ranks 1st in the MVC blocks (52), 2nd in steals (51), and 10th in total rebounds and is usually tasked with guarding the other teams best player, so far Leons leads BU in minutes played and has yet to foul out this season.
- Leons is the 1st Brave to win the award since Adebayo Akinkunle (Ah-Kink-O-lay) in 1998. Leons currently stands 6' 9" with a 7-1 foot wing span.
- Only 3 other MVC players since 1991-92 has recorded 40+ steals and 40+ blocks in the same season (last Jake Koch, UNI 2012) Leons is the only MVC player that has ever recorded 50+ blocks and 50+ steals.
- Leons is the only player in the NCAA with 50+ blocks, 50+ steals and 200 rebounds this season.

THE BEST ONE BID CONFERENCE?

- This MVC season has been as enterainting as any in the last guarter century. The MVC had five teams finish with 20+ wins and currently has two teams in the top 75 of the NET and 4 teams within a 1.5 games of 1st place with one week left in the season.
- BU and DU are both widley considerd to be two of the best mid-majors in america and could win a game or two in the NCAAT as projected 12-seeds. Despite both teams impressive metric only one team from the MVC was picked to the NCAA Tourney in Drake.

OPTIONS OFF THE BENCH

- So far this season Bradley's bench has recorded 711 true bench points (points added up from all 34 single game box scores) of the teams total points at 2411 (29%).
- Ja'Shon Henry, Ville Tahvanainen, and Dairus Hannah make up the three headed monster off the bench. This trio is combining for 22 PPG and 11 RPG.

HEAD COACH BRIAN WARDLE

- Named the 14th head coach in Bradley men's basketball history on March 28, 2015.
- Led a complete rebuild of the BU program that resulted in taking the team from a last place finish the year before he arrived to back-to-back conference championships in his fourth and fifth seasons.
- Helped Bradley end a 31-year drought as MVC Tournament Champions in 2019.
- Became the ninth team in MVC history to repeat as champions in 2020 as the Braves qualified for the NCAA Tournament in backto-back seasons for the first time since 1954 and 1955.
- Prior to joining the Braves, Wardle compiled a 95-65 (.594) overall record in his five seasons at Green Bay, which culminated with back-to-back 24-win seasons and the 2013-14 Horizon League regular-season title.
- Wardle was the youngest head coach in NCAA Division I basketball when he took over at Green Bay program in 2010 at age 30.
- Prior to taking over as head coach at Green Bay, spent the previous five seasons (2005-10) as a Phoenix assistant and two years (2003-05) as Director of Ops at Marquette.
- As a player, Wardle scored 1,690 career points at Marquette, currently eighth on the school's career scoring list.

- It should be no surprise that Ville Tavahanainen's hot stretch from three coincided with BU's strong play.
- The senior has been at his best in BU victories, shooting nearly 20% percent higher in BU wins.

3-POINT VICTORIES

 Bradley in the last two seasons when shooting better than 33.3% holds a record of 28-4 and 13-18 when under or equal to 33.3% from three.

MAST ON A MISSION

- Rienk Mast has been on a mission for BU this season. The Bradley big man has posted double digit scoring in 25/27 games so far this season and ranks 12th in PPG, 2nd in RPG, 2nd in FG%. Mast owns eight double-doubles this season.
- Mast is just 13 points away from 1,000 for his career. BU has already celebrated one 1K-point scorer this season in Ja'Shon Henry when he became the 51st 1K-point scorer in BU history against Valpo on Feb 22nd.

THE FLYING DUTCHMEN

Batman & Robin, Tom & Jerry, and Peanut
Butter & Jelly are all examples of great dynamic
dous but none may be better than "The Flying
Dutchmen" aka Rienk Mast and Malevy Leons.
The Netherlands natives currently own 32% of
BU's points, 35% of BU's rebounds, and 50%
of BU's blocks.

WINNING EVERY WAY POSSIBLE

- BU's game in the MVCT vs Indiana State was a microcosm of BU's season to this point.
- Their best player in Mast was held to just 2pts and they shot under 25% from 3-point land. However, BU found a way to win.
- This season BU has won games, scoring in the 50s, 60s, 70s, 80s, and 90s. This includes being involved in track meets with Indiana State and 15-round boxing matches with Southern Illinois.

"ONE MORE"

- Every year Bradley MBB comes up with a slogan to descibe their season, this year's couldn't be more fitting with it being "One More"
- BU has been playing with a single elimination mindset since February 1st, needing to go 7-0 to win the MVC regular season title.

FIRST-HALF IMPORTANCE

- A big key for the Braves during this season has been getting off to a hot start
- This season, BU is 21-2 when leading at the break (both losses to Belmont) and 4-6 when trailing.
- However, in its eight losses during the 34-games, Bradley was 6 points or closer in only three of its contests heading into the second stanza. Facing an average 8-point halftime deficit when trailing. Bradley has three losses this year when scoring 70 or more.

ROAD WARRIORS

- Since the year 2000 BU has struggled to win on the road but this year is different. Excluding BU's 3 neutral site games, the Braves have collected 8 true road wins and are riding a 6-game road win streak in the MVC.
- That streak ties the 6th longest MVC road win streak in school history and BU's 8 true road wins to this point tie the most since 1987-88 when BU won 10 road games that season.






