### ZACH BODEAU OF ROCKHURST, AMANDA KAUTZER OF MICHIGAN TECH HEADLINES CoSIDA ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICA® DIVISION II AT-LARGE TEAMS

**AUSTIN, Texas** | Rockhurst University senior lacrosse midfielder **Zach Bodeau** and Michigan Tech senior Nordic skier **Amanda Kautzer** (Plymouth, Minn.) headline the 2020 Academic All-America® Division II Men's and Women's At-Large teams as selected by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA). Bodeau and Kautzer are the CoSIDA Academic All-America® Team Member of the Year for their respective teams.

The Academic All-America® program is being financially supported by the NCAA Division II national governance structure to assist CoSIDA with handling the awards fulfillment aspects for the 2019-20 Division II Academic All-America® teams program.

The at-large program for the CoSIDA Academic All-America® program includes the sports of fencing, golf, gymnastics, ice hockey, lacrosse, rifle, skiing, swimming and diving, tennis, water polo for both men and women; bowling, crew and field hockey for women; and volleyball and wrestling for men.

Bodeau, who is from Centennial, Colorado, helped the Rockhurst Hawks win 44 games during his four-year career. He holds a perfect 4.00 grade-point average with a double major in criminal justice and psychology. Bodeau is a three-time CoSIDA Academic All-America® selection, garnering first team honors in 2019 and 2020 after a second team nod in 2018. Bodeau was the 2019 GLVC Specialty Player of the Year and a first team All-GLVC midfielder the same season. He received first team All-RMAC honors in 2017 and 2018.

On the NCAA Division II career statistical charts, Bodeau ranks second in faceoff winning percentage (.749) and fourth in ground balls (381) among active players. He led the GLVC in faceoff winning percentage and ground balls in 2019.

Kautzer, who is from Plymouth, Minnesota, earns first team CoSIDA Academic All-America® laurels for the second consecutive season. She possesses a spotless 4.00 GPA with her biomedical engineering major. Kautzer won the Elite 90 award as a senior, given to the student-athlete with the highest GPA at the NCAA skiing championships. She is also an NCAA Postgraduate Scholarship recipient.

A three-time NCAA skiing championships qualifier, Kautzer was the 2019 Central Regional champion in the classic and placed 17th in the same discipline at the 2019 NCAA championships. She is a three-time All-CCSA selection and a three-time All-Central Region finisher.

Kautzer has also performed on the world stage at the 2020 U23 World Ski Championships in Germany. She competed at the Junior World Championships three times (2015-17) as a biathlete.

Kautzer also ran cross country for the Huskies. She raced at the 2019 NCAA championships. She finished one spot outside of All-GLIAC honors at the 2019 league XC meet. Kautzer was a captain on both teams. She is only the third Michigan Tech female student-athlete to compete at the NCAA championships in both cross country and Nordic skiing.

Sixteen men and 16 women are repeat performers on this year's at-large teams. Thirty-four (20 women, 14 men) student-athletes on the CoSIDA Academic All-America® Division II At-Large Teams have a 4.00 GPA. The CoSIDA Academic All-America® Division II Women's At-Large First Team had an overall 3.94 GPA, while the CoSIDA Academic All-America® Division II Men's At-Large First Team had an overall 3.93 GPA.

Six student-athletes earn CoSIDA Academic All-America® Division II At-Large recognition for the third time in their respective careers. Wingate University senior swimmer **Giacomo Viazzo** and Carson-Newman University senior swimmer **Paden Duke** join Rockhurst's Bodeau as three-time selections. Viazzo is the only member of this trio to earn first team honors three times. Duke has two first team trophies after his third team recognition in 2018.

On the women's side, Cal State San Marcos senior golfer **Jaime Jacob** has back-to-back first team honors after a third-team nod in 2018. Carson-Newman senior swimmer **Mary Northcutt** jumped to the first team this year after consecutive third team laurels. Colorado Mesa University senior tennis standout **Kristen Kirby** was third team in 2018, first team in 2019 and second team in 2020.
