ABOUT LAST WEEK

West Florida started off the conference schedule with a sweep over West Georgia at the UWF Softball Complex. It turned out to be a breakout week in every facet of the game -- the offense hit a collective .403 and averaged more than 8 runs per game, and the pitching staff combined for a 1.24 ERA against the Wolves.

The series started with a pair of run-rule victories for UWF on Saturday before Montana Young, Jeya Prasad, and Kelsey Sweatt threw a combined shutout on Sunday. UWF is one of just two GSC teams that is undefeated in conference play through the first week.

ABOUT SHORTER

Even after going 1-2 against Delta State to start the conference schedule, Shorter brings in one of the top offenses in the Gulf South Conference.

The Hawks are second in the conference in batting average (.303) and on-base percentage (.379) so far, and Kaylee Georgia is in the top 10 in the GSC in batting (.417). Paytn Cripps is second in the GSC with 5 doubles.

UWF has a 7-3 record against Shorter in the last 10 matchups, dating back to the 2016 GSC Tournament. The teams have not matched up since 2019, when UWF won the series in Pensacola, 2-1.

NEWS AND NOTES

JESSICA FORD'S OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION

Junior outfielder Jessica Ford was on a tear last weekend, hitting .700 (7-10) with four doubles, five RBIs, and three runs scored against West Georgia. Ford had multiple hits in each of the Argonauts' three games, including a perfect 3-for-3 day on Sunday.

She has the third-most doubles in the GSC, and she leads UWF in runs (9), doubles (4), and RBIs (8) this year.

PITCHING AND DEFENSE

As usual, the UWF pitching staff and defense have been near the top of the conference. West Florida has led the GSC in fielding percentage twice in the last three years, and the Argonauts top the conference again, with a .975 team fielding percentage and the fewest errors in the league, with 7.

The pitching staff has also been outstanding, with a 2.33 ERA and a league-best .199 opponent batting average. The team ERA is good for 34th in the country, and UWF's WHIP (walks + hits per innings pitched) is 17th in Division II.

And UWF's pitching staff ranks third in the GSC in strikeouts (65), despite ranking 10th in innings pitched. Jeya Prasad and Kelsey Sweatt each rank in the top 10 in the conference in ERA, opponent batting average, innings pitched, and strikeouts, and Prasad leads the conference in WHIP and opponent batting average.

TEALA AND THE RECORD BOOKS

With another strong weekend at the plate against West Georgia, Teala Howard has continued her climb in the UWF record book. The senior utility player holds the GSC and UWF all-time batting average record, at .457, and she ranks among the top 10 in UWF history in several other categories.

Howard is also fifth in career slugging percentage at UWF (.584) and tied for second in career stolen bases (107). Her 15 triples and 107 stolen bases also rank inside the top 10 in GSC history. A little farther down the list, Howard ranks ninth in program history in hits (234), tenth in runs (161), and 12th in total bases (299).

And keep in mind – Howard has done this in a little over two-and-a-half years, having lost half of her sophomore season due to the COVID-19 outbreak.

A MADELYN VASQUEZ BREAKOUT

Sophomore Madelyn Vasquez broke out at the Florida Tech Invitational, hitting .385 over the weekend. She led the team in slugging at .769, doubles (2), hits (5), runs (3), and total bases (10).

The Milton, Florida, native had at least one hit in each of the team's four

games at the FTI, and she kept it up last weekend against West Georgia. She hit .500 in the series to open GSC play, leading the team in runs (4), walks (4), and on-base percentage (.778).

She doubled in each game against Bentley and No. 8 Saint Anselm and hit her first career home run -- a first-inning, two-run shot to center field -- against Barry on Sunday of the Florida Tech Invitational.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK JEYA PRASAD

Jeya Prasad was named the Gulf South Conference Softball Freshman of the Week on February 15, and she followed up with another pair of strong outings against West Georgia last weekend.

She pitched 3.2 innings of relief to start GSC play, allowing just one hit and striking out 5, while earning the win in Game 2 against UWG.

The Pensacola native posted a 1.68 ERA over 16.2 innings of work, with 13 strikeouts at the Florida Tech Invitational. She held opponents to a .123 batting average and went 2-0 over the weekend, with a dominant start against Bentley, and a near-perfect relief outing against Florida Tech.

Prasad has gotten off to an impressive start, leading the GSC in opponent batting average (.150), ranking third in ERA (1.87), and ranking fifth in strikeouts (29).

THE CLASS OF THE GSC

With a 57-16 conference record since 2019, West Florida holds the best winning percentage (.781) in league play among all Gulf South Conference teams. The team's 57 conference wins -- as well as their 112 total wins -- since 2019 are the most in the GSC.

Teala Howard is a .449 career hitter in GSC play, and Kelsey Sweatt holds a 26-3 career record with a 2.48 ERA against the conference.

ARGOS AT HOME

Put simply, UWF likes playing at home. The Argonauts are 95-18 (.841 winning percentage) at the UWF Softball Complex since 2017.

Teala Howard is a career .500 hitter at The Fork, with 118 hits at home, and Kelsey Sweatt and Montana Young have been excellent in their home circle. Young posted a 1.32 ERA over 53.0 innings at home last season, striking out 54 batters against just 5 walks, and Sweatt has a 23-4 all-time record at the UWF Softball Complex, with a 2.11 ERA and 173 strikeouts.

NEWS AND NOTES

WE'RE RANKED

UWF was ranked No. 22 in the country in the latest National Fastpitch Coaches Association poll, released on Tuesday.

West Florida stands at 8-3 on the year and is on a five-game winning streak, including a sweep over West Georgia last weekend to start Gulf South Conference play. The Argonauts are one of two teams that are undefeated in the GSC after the first weekend of action.

UWF is one of three GSC teams ranked in the poll, along with No. 2 Valdosta State and No. 15 Auburn Montgomery. South Region opponent Tampa is also ranked, at No. 13.

WHO'S BACK?

West Florida brings back 13 letterwinners from the 2021 squad, including All-American Teala Howard and All-Region pitcher Kelsey Sweatt. While just six starters remain from last year's team, plenty of role players from last season are primed to contribute this year.

Pitcher Montana Young returns for her sophomore season after throwing to a 2.37 ERA as a freshman, while starting position players Angela Agurkis, Kayanna Perez, and Mallory Vining are also back in the blue and green this year.

Fellow returners include catcher Brett Leiva, infielders Chelsea Dumas, Kayla Mayo, and Madilynne Webb, and outfielders Kelsey Hodges, Morgan Zettle, and Laurynn Boggs.

CLIMBING THE CAREER LEADERBOARD

Seniors Teala Howard and Kelsey Sweatt have turned in outstanding careers with UWF. They each rank among or close to the top 10 in West Florida history in several categories.

Howard is the all-time leading hitter (.457) in UWF and Gulf South Conference history and she ranks in the top five in the program record book in stolen bases (107; t-2nd) and slugging percentage (.584; 5th). The lefty is just outside the top 10 in UWF history in hits, runs, total bases, and triples.

Similarly, Sweatt ranks second in program history in hits allowed per seven innings (4.63) and is fourth in strikeouts per seven innings (6.65). She is also eighth in strikeouts (376) and winning percentage (.754), while standing just outside the top 10 in wins, with 46.
