Camp Information

Register early! Camp enrollment is limited.
Grade level indicates grade student will be entering in the fall of 2013.

Youth Camp (Grades 3-7) Dates: July 1-3 (\$130), July 8-11 (\$160), and July 22-25 (\$160)

This is a camp for kids who want to have fun while learning the basic skills of volleyball. The athlete will be introduced and trained in all areas of the game including passing, serving, hitting, blocking, and setting. Participants will be divided into teams by age and skill level to create a positive experience for all campers.

Setting & Hitting Camp (Grades 8-12) Date: July 5 (\$85)

Setting & Hitting Camp is designed for athletes to further develop offensive skills in the areas of setting and attacking. This camp is ideal for players who have identified themselves as a setter. The position-specific camp also invites all hitters to learn the fundamentals of attacking and connection with the setter.

All Skills Camp (Grades 8-12) Date: July 6 (\$85)

The All Skills Camp invites athletes who are looking to advance individual skills including passing, serving, hitting, blocking, and setting in a challenging and fun environment. This camp will also focus on developing offensive and defensive systems for game play. Players will be divided based on skill level and experience.

Libero Camp: Grades 8-12 Date: July 15 (\$85)

This camp will focus on the techniques used for backrow players with an emphasis on first contact passing. Skills that will be trained include forearm passing, overhead passing, and digging. Defense and serve receive drills will be featured.

Elite Camp (Grades 9-12) Dates: July 19-21 (\$275 resident, \$215 commuter)

This camp is designed to instruct and train advanced techniques for taking your game to the next level. Players will be trained in their selected positions for a total of seven sessions. All meals from dinner on July 19 to lunch on July 21 are included.

Location

All camps will be held at the Kress Events Center.

Meals

Meals will be provided for the campers attending the **Elite Camp only**. Campers attending the Youth, Libero, Setting & Hitting, and All Skills Camps will need to provide their own meals.

Insurance/Medical Information

Health and medical authorization forms will be emailed to you with your confirmation packet. A physical is not required for these camps.

These camps are open to any and all entrants (limited only by number, age, grade level, and/or gender).

Refunds

A full refund will be given to applicant if your application is received **after the camp has reached the enrollment limit**. Cancellation due to a medical excuse will receive a full refund minus a \$25 cancellation fee if the cancellation is made prior to the start of camp and the request is accompanied by a physician's statement. A camper departing camp due to an injury received at camp will receive a prorated refund. All other cancellations will receive payment back minus a \$50 cancellation fee if notification is made **at least one week prior to the start of camp**.

Refund policy **refers** to each camp session separately. No refunds will be given for no-shows or campers sent home for disciplinary reasons.

Overnight Check Out Procedure

When you depart campus, your room will be evaluated for its condition. If property was damaged in your room, your parents/guardians will be billed.

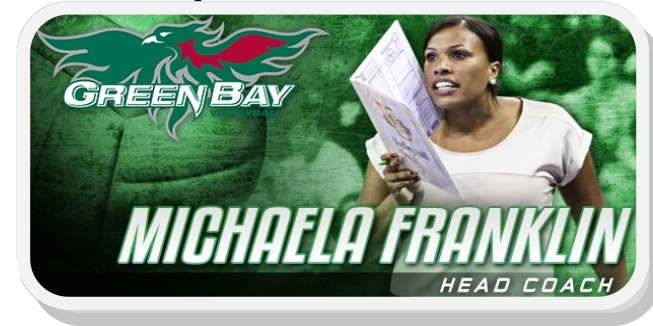
