WHAT TO WATCH FOR

- West Georgia rebounded from their week five loss with a 40-21 GSC road victory over Mississippi College, and are rewarded with another 300-plus mile road trip to take on the top team in Division II and defending National Champion, West Florida.
- The Wolves are now 5-1 with a 3-1 mark in Gulf South Conference play, and moved up one spot to number 12 in this week's AFCA Division II Coaches Poll.
- Harrison Frost is just 44 yards away from becoming the 13th quarterback in school history with 2,000 yards passing, and the Kennesaw native is on pace to become the Wolves' first 3,000 yard passer in program history.
- Mechane Sade has had three consecutive 100-yard receiving games, and leads the league in receiving yards (567) and receptions (39). Slade is looking to become just the second 1,000 yard receiver in school history, joining Andre Heard who had 1,095 in the 2000 season.
- This game features the top two receivers in the conference in Slade and UWF's David Durden. Between the two, they have 11 touchdowns and are one and two in receiving yards in the GSC.
- The home team has never won a game in the short series history between the Wolves and Argos. It's just the third meeting in Pensacola, and the second time it's two ranked teams squaring off on the diamond at Blue Wahoos Stadium.
- West Florida has won 11 straight games dating back to the 2019 season and their run to the NCAA Division II National Championship. The Argonauts have not lost at home since November 3, 2018, winning six straight home games.

November 2, 2019 • Uniersity Stadium • Carrollton, GA - The weather was horrendous, the homecoming crowd didn't show up, and the Argonauts ran away with a 30-2 victory in the "Wild West Mud Bowl" of 2019. The weather and the UWF defense made it tough for the Wolves to get anything going, with UWG having just 147 yards of total offense. UWG's only points came on a first quarter safety, and they never led again after UWF scored with 4:06 left in the first half.

BACK ON TRACK

West Georgia got the taste of a week five loss out of their mouth last Saturday, defeating Mississippi College 40-21 on the road in Gulf South Conference action. And the reward for that is a road trip to the number one team in the country, West Florida. The Wolves are now 5-1 on the year and 3-1 in GSC play as the calendar rolls into week seven.

HISTORICAL PASSING PERFORMANCE

Junior quarterback Harrison Frost was 34-for-47 with 415 yards against the Choctaws, recording the first 400-yard passing game in over 20 years, and the third most passing yards in a single game in school history. Prior to Saturday, Jeremy Clements had the last 400-yard passing game which came way back at the turn of the century in 2000. Back to Frost, he is now 44 yards from becoming the 13th quarterback to throw for 2,000 yards in a single season, and is on pace to become UWG's first ever 3,000 yard passer. Frost ranks inside the top-10 in the nation in multiple passing categories.

HUNDRED-PLUS DUO

For the first time since 2015, West Georgia had a pair of receivers with 100 yards receiving last Saturday at Mississippi College. Quan Harrison led the way with 118 yards on eight catches with Mechane Slade catching seven passes for 108 yards. The last duo to accomplish this feat was Shaq Hall (141) and Qa Walker (153) in the 2015 playoffs against Tuskegee. In both games, each receiver had a touchdown as well.

SLADE'S STREAK

Mechane Slade is on a bit of a roll, as the Roswell native has three consecutive games with at least 100 receiving yards. Slade started the streak with 146 yards on five catches against Shorter and then had 119 on 10 catches against West Alabama. Last week against MC, Slade had 108 yards on seven catches and a touchdown. Slade leads with league in receiving yards with 567 and in receptions with 39. Slade's receiving yards total is currently good for 22nd in the country.

THIRD DOWN TO FIRST DOWN

The West Georgia offense is one of the best on third down conversions this season, ranking seventh in the country in that category. The Wolves successfully convert 53.7 percent of their third downs, which leads to a lot of first downs. UWG ranks second in Division II in total offensive first downs with 165. This week's game features the top two offenses on third down conversions, as West Florida leads the league with a 57.1 percent third down success rate.

WOLVES IN OCTOBER

Two weeks into October, the Wolves continue conference play in one of the toughest, if not the toughest leagues in all of Division II. All-time in October, West Georgia is 85-81 and under David Dean the Wolves are 11-3 in the month of October, including this year's results.

OMAR ADDS TWO MORE

Junior kicker Omar Cervantes added two more field goals against Mississippi College, giving him eight on the year. He's only missed three field goals, giving him a .727 field goal percentage, a number that ranks him third in the GSC and 27th in the country. His 53 points scored are tops in the Gulf South Conference and ranks 22nd in all of Division II.

PIVOTAL PROTECTION

The UWG offensive line has done a good job protecting Harrison Frost, allowing less than a sack per game. The Wolves have allowed 0.5 sacks per game, which ranks second in the country and third in the nation. That protection is of utmost importance this week as the Argonaut defense ranks first in the GSC and fourth in the country in sacks, averaging 4.6 per game. The Argos have 23 sacks total on the season, for 151 yards of loss.

DEFENSE STILL SOLID

After the loss and giving up 300-plus yards of offense to Mississippi College, people may be sleeping on the UWG defense, but it's still a unit that ranks second in the GSC and 16th in the NCAA in total defense. The Wolves pass defense ranks sixth in the country, allowing just 118.5 yards through the air per game.

INSIDE THE SERIES

It's only the sixth meeting between West Georgia and West Florida as the Argonauts began playing football in 2016. The Wolves have won both previous meetings in Pensacola, including a top-10 matchup in 2018 and a 69-0 blowout in the final game of the 2016 season.

WOLVES-ARGOS CONNECTIONS

- West Florida's David Durden was teammates with Harrison Frost and Tyray Devezin at Mercer. In 2019, Devezin was Mercer's leading rusher and Durden the top receiver while Frost played in 11 games and took some snaps at QB that season.

WEST FLORIDA SCOUTING REPORT

The #1 team in America and the defending National Champion West Florida enters week seven undefeated and on the heels of a 52-10 win on the road at North Greenville. The Argos have a win over FCS opponent McNeese State as well as a win over ranked-opponent Texas A&M Commerce on the road. Two weeks ago at Delta State, the Statesmen were up 20 at the break, but West Florida came back to earn the big road conference win. At quarterback, Austin Reed brings a wealth of experience to the offense. The St. Augustine Beach, Florida native threw for over 4,000 yards on UWF's National Championship team in 2019 and has thrown for 1,485 yards this season. Rodney Coates is his top target with 22 catches for 382 yards, but David Durden leads UWF in receiving yards with 441 and seven touchdowns. In the backfield, Shomari Mason leads the Argos with 41 rushing yards and five touchdowns. On defense, TJ Limehouse leads with 32 tackles including 2.5 for loss. Three other Argos have eclipsed the 30 tackles mark so far this season: Shea Campbell (31), Trent Archie (30), and D'Anthony Bell (30.)

HEAD COACH DAVID DEAN

David Dean became the 11th head coach in the history of UWG football in 2017, returning to a program where he was part of two Gulf South Conference championships and three trips to the NCAA Playoffs as an assistant in the 1990s.

Dean arrived in Carrollton in January 2017, on the eve of signing day, and led the Wolves to nine victories and a return to the NCAA Division II Playoffs in his first season.

In his second season in 2018, West Georgia won 10 games and reached the playoffs for the fourth time in the past five seasons.

In the second week of the season in 2019, Dean stepped even more into history, becoming the third coach in Gulf South Conference history with 100 wins in his career as the Wolves defeated Limestone on the road.

Since returning, Dean and his team has produced 27 All-Gulf South Conference selections and 12 All-Americans. Two players from his 2019 squad, John Hurst and Azouyah Alufohai signed undrafted free agent contracts in the National Football League.

Dean was no stranger to the Carrollton campus when he returned to UWG last season. He brought with him a resume that would rival any coach in the nation. As an assistant or as a head coach, David Dean and his football teams are winners.

A former wide receiver at Georgia Tech, Dean got his introduction to the wars of Gulf South Conference football in 1988 when he began a four-year run on the staff at Valdosta State. In 1992 Dean moved to Carrollton for an eight-year run on the staff at West Georgia. That stint included the first winning season at the Division II level, the first NCAA D-II Playoff berth, and the program's first two Gulf South Conference titles.

Dean departed UWG following the 1999 season, joining the staff of Chris Hatcher at Valdosta State. He spent seven seasons as the Blazers' offensive coordinator, a run that included the 2004 NCAA Division II Championship.

In 2007 Dean ascended to the head coaching post at VSU. He had to assemble a coaching staff almost from the ground up as all but one fellow staff member moved on. The results were positive as Valdosta State posted a 13-1 record and won the program's second national championship.

Five years later, Dean was back in the winner's circle again. This time the Blazers lost twice in the regular season, but they were untouchable in the playoffs, averaging 42 points a game during a postseason march to a second national title.

That second national title with the Blazers put Dean in rare company. College football has been played in the state of Georgia since the 1890s, and during that time only three football coaches in this state have won multiple national titles.

Erskine Russell won three FCS crowns at Georgia Southern, while Paul Johnson followed him in Statesboro with a pair of championships of his own, and now it is also David Dean.

Dean's run as head coach at Valdosta State covered nine seasons. Beyond the two national crowns, his Blazer teams posted an impressive record of 79-27, including a mark of 42-19 in games played with the nation's best Division II conference, the Gulf South. His teams advanced to the NCAA Playoffs six times, and Dean's postseason head coaching record is 13-6.

The success of Dean's Valdosta State program resulted in numerous individual plaudits. He captured American Football Coaches Association Division II Coach of the Year honors following both national titles. He was also named 2007 Coach of the Year by Schutt Sports, AFCA Regional Coach of the Year, and GSC Coach of the Year in 2010.

Beyond his individual success, Dean's VSU players captured the highest of honors. His VSU teams had 18 Division II All-America selections, while 10 players signed National Football League contracts. Dean also coached three players who earned GSC Freshman of the Year honors, two league players of the year, and a national defensive player of the year.

Clearly, David Dean has been linked to success throughout his 30-year coaching career. At UWG or at UWG's biggest rival, the results are irrefutable: David Dean is a winner. His teams win and his program flourishes.

Dean is a native of DeKalb County in the metro Atlanta area. He was born in Decatur, and enjoyed a stellar high school career for the Avondale Blue Devils. Dean arrived at Georgia Tech as a walk-on in 1982, but was awarded a scholarship the following season. He played wide receiver for the Jackets through the 1985 campaign.

Married to the former Stacie Stott, the Deans have three daughters: Caroline, Allison, and Natalie.
