WHAT TO WATCH FOR

- It's been a long two weeks since UWG fell on the road to #2 Valdosta State, but after a much needed bye week, the Wolves are ready for the regular season finale as UWG hosts Delta State in what seems to be a win and you're in scenario for the NCAA Division II Playoffs.
- West Georgia enters the week 7-2 and ranked fifth in the latest Super Region 2 Rankings that came out this week. It looks the Wolves could still have a chance to host a first round game if they were to win, and move into the fourth spot when the seedings are announced on Sunday.
- Delta State is coming off of a win over their rival last week, defeating Mississippi College 24-21 in overtime to bring the Heritage Bell back to Cleveland. DSU is 5-5 on the year and has had seven one possession games, dropping four of those decisions.
- Harrison Frost needs just 146 yards on Saturday to become West Georgia's single season passing leader. With 19 yards the Kennesaw native would pass Willie Candler's record set in 2017 with 2,913 yards.
- Mechane Slade is three catches away from setting a new record in single-season receptions. Slade currently has 61 catches and the current record of 63 was set by Detronn Harris in 2002. Slade also ranks third in the GSC in receiving yards with 749.
- Junior kicker Omar Cervantes nailed two more field goals in the loss at Valdosta State and is having an outstanding season. The Fort Valley native is 13-of-16 on field goals this season, drilling 9-of-11 from beyond 30 yards. Cervantes is 3-for-5 from beyond 40 yards with his season long being 46 yards.
- West Georgia will honor 22 seniors prior to kickoff on Saturday on the occasion of their final regular season appearance at University Stadium.

The West Georgia defense has allowed 163 first downs which ranks second in the GSC and is 39th in all of Division II.

LAST MEETING WITH VALDOSTA STATE

November 16, 2019 • University Stadium • Carrollton, GA - The weather wasn't ideal the first time the Delta State Statesmen came to Carrollton, and the Wolves came away with a dramatic win. Trailing by six in the fourth-quarter, the West Georgia Wolves offense engineered a 12-play, 90-yard scoring drive to take a lead, and the defense did the rest as #18 West Georgia defeated #22 Delta State at home in the Gulf South Conference opener. West Georgia had two 90-plus yard scoring drives in that game and despite the rain, Harrison Frost attempted 50 passes.

WIN AND WE'RE IN

After the third installment of the NCAA Super Region 2 Rankings, the West Georgia Wolves sit at fifth in the rankings and in a good spot to make the playoffs with a win on Saturday. West Georgia would really like to move up into the top four and host an opening round game, but would need a win and some help to do that.

The top seven teams are selected to the NCAA Playoff with the top seed earning a first round bye. The higher seeds host, meaning the two, three, and four seeds host the opening round, which is set for November 20.

APPROACHING THE TOP

Just 146 yards separate Harrison Frost and the top of the single-season passing record book. The junior enters the final game of the regular season with 2,768 yards and is nearing the current record held by Willie Candler, who is the all-time leader in career passing yards. In 2017, Candler threw for 2,786 yards and helped the Wolves to a second round appearance in the NCAA Playoffs. Frost has thrown for 19 touchdowns in nine games this season. In comparison, Candler threw for 25 that season in 13 games including the playoffs.

EIGHT AND NINE FOR DAVID DEAN

A win on Saturday for the Wolves would be the eight of the season, finishing the regular season at 8-2. It would be head coach David Dean's eighth season of at least eight wins. To get that done, he will need to beat a team that has been a thorn in his side his entire career as Dean is only 3-9 all-time against Delta State. Of his previous eight seasons with at least eight wins, two have come at West Georgia and six at Valdosta State. Dean has had four seasons of at least 10 wins with the most recent coming in 2018 at UWG.

REPEAT OPPONENT

It's the fifth time in school history that West Georgia is playing an opponent twice in the same season, and the first time it has ever happened in regular season play. The first ever repeat meeting was Delta State in 2014 when UWG played the Statesmen in Carrollton in the regular season then again in the playoffs in Cleveland, and won both games. UWG took on Valdosta State twice in a single season in 2014 and 2015. The last time this occurred was in 2017 when West Georgia and West Florida played twice in three weeks. UWG is 3-1 in the repeat games in school history.

SENIOR DAY

West Georgia will honor 22 seniors prior to kickoff on Saturday on the occasion of their final regular season appearance on Ra-Lin Field.

WOLVES IN NOVEMBER

As the calendar turns to November, and the NCAA Playoffs loom, the Wolves enter a month in which they are 46-51 all-time. Under Dean, the Wolves are 4-6 all-time in the month of November.

SUPERIOR OFFENSIVE LINE PLAY

The last time the Wolves played a game, the offensive line gave up just their fourth sack of the season through nine games. With an average of 0.44 sacks per game, the Wolves rank second in the GSC and third in the nation in sacks allowed per game. Valdosta State is the GSC and the Division II leader in sacks allowed, giving up just 0.11 sacks per game.

The final week of the regular season pits a pair of non-conference games and a pair of conference games with one of those matchups carrying GSC Championship and playoff implications.

WOLVES-STATESMEN CONNECTIONS

- Starting center David Bodden and Delta State's Ty Goldsmith and Adrian Hill all prepped at Alabama power Hoover High School.
- UWG has a pair of Buford High School products in the lineback corp, Matthew Parker and Davin Bryant. Delta State's Innis Claud V prepped at Buford and was in the same class as Parker and helped Buford to a 13-2 record as seniors.
- Delta State's wide receivers coach, Marcus Windham is a former UWG graduate assistant. Windham was on staff of the 2014 team that beat DSU twice including a second round playoff win in Cleveland.

DELTA STATE SCOUTING REPORT

It's been a season of frustration and heartbreak for a Delta State squad that enters the weekend at 5-5 overall and finished up their GSC campaign at 3-4. The Statesmen have had seven one-possession games this season, losing four of those games and winning each of the last three. In their last action, the Statesmen came back late against their in-state rival Mississippi College to send it to overtime, where Connor Mantelli drilled a walk-off field goal to give DSU a 24-21 overtime win. Patrick Shegog has been Delta State's quarterback for much of the season, but has been injured of late. Shegog has thrown for 1,391 yards and nine touchdowns. Deion Dampier is DSU's top rushing threat as the senior has rushed for 651 yards and eight scores. Dohnte Myers is the Statesmen leading receiver with 552 yards and four touchdowns. The Statesmen are solid defensively as Dante Williams leads DSU with 65 tackles, but Marvin Terry's numbers have been ridiculous as he has 55 tackles, 18 tackles for loss, and 10 sacks. Ty Woods has also chipped in with 52 tackles and a pair of interceptions.

HEAD COACH DAVID DEAN

David Dean became the 11th head coach in the history of UWG football in 2017, returning to a program where he was part of two Gulf South Conference championships and three trips to the NCAA Playoffs as an assistant in the 1990s.

Dean arrived in Carrollton in January 2017, on the eve of signing day, and led the Wolves to nine victories and a return to the NCAA Division II Playoffs in his first season.

In his second season in 2018, West Georgia won 10 games and reached the playoffs for the fourth time in the past five seasons.

In the second week of the season in 2019, Dean stepped even more into history, becoming the third coach in Gulf South Conference history with 100 wins in his career as the Wolves defeated Limestone on the road.

Since returning, Dean and his team has produced 27 All-Gulf South Conference selections and 12 All-Americans. Two players from his 2019 squad, John Hurst and Azouyah Alufohai signed undrafted free agent contracts in the National Football League.

Dean was no stranger to the Carrollton campus when he returned to UWG last season. He brought with him a resume that would rival any coach in the nation. As an assistant or as a head coach, David Dean and his football teams are winners.

A former wide receiver at Georgia Tech, Dean got his introduction to the wars of Gulf South Conference football in 1988 when he began a four-year run on the staff at Valdosta State. In 1992 Dean moved to Carrollton for an eight-year run on the staff at West Georgia. That stint included the first winning season at the Division II level, the first NCAA D-II Playoff berth, and the program's first two Gulf South Conference titles.

Dean departed UWG following the 1999 season, joining the staff of Chris Hatcher at Valdosta State. He spent seven seasons as the Blazers' offensive coordinator, a run that included the 2004 NCAA Division II Championship.

In 2007 Dean ascended to the head coaching post at VSU. He had to assemble a coaching staff almost from the ground up as all but one fellow staff member moved on. The results were positive as Valdosta State posted a 13-1 record and won the program's second national championship.

Five years later, Dean was back in the winner's circle again. This time the Blazers lost twice in the regular season, but they were untouchable in the playoffs, averaging 42 points a game during a postseason march to a second national title.

That second national title with the Blazers put Dean in rare company. College football has been played in the state of Georgia since the 1890s, and during that time only three football coaches in this state have won multiple national titles.

Erskine Russell won three FCS crowns at Georgia Southern, while Paul Johnson followed him in Statesboro with a pair of championships of his own, and now it is also David Dean.

Dean's run as head coach at Valdosta State covered nine seasons. Beyond the two national crowns, his Blazer teams posted an impressive record of 79-27, including a mark of 42-19 in games played with the nation's best Division II conference, the Gulf South. His teams advanced to the NCAA Playoffs six times, and Dean's postseason head coaching record is 13-6.

The success of Dean's Valdosta State program resulted in numerous individual plaudits. He captured American Football Coaches Association Division II Coach of the Year honors following both national titles. He was also named 2007 Coach of the Year by Schutt Sports, AFCA Regional Coach of the Year, and GSC Coach of the Year in 2010.

Beyond his individual success, Dean's VSU players captured the highest of honors. His VSU teams had 18 Division II All-America selections, while 10 players signed National Football League contracts. Dean also coached three players who earned GSC Freshman of the Year honors, two league players of the year, and a national defensive player of the year.

Clearly, David Dean has been linked to success throughout his 30-year coaching career. At UWG or at UWG's biggest rival, the results are irrefutable: David Dean is a winner. His teams win and his program flourishes.

Dean is a native of DeKalb County in the metro Atlanta area. He was born in Decatur, and enjoyed a stellar high school career for the Avondale Blue Devils. Dean arrived at Georgia Tech as a walk-on in 1982, but was awarded a scholarship the following season. He played wide receiver for the Jackets through the 1985 campaign.

Married to the former Stacie Stott, the Deans have three daughters: Caroline, Allison, and Natalie.
