QUICK HITS

- For the first time this season, the UWG Wolves are coming off of a loss, and will see what kind of bounce back performance they can get when they welcome the 15th-ranked West Florida Argonauts to town for a top-25 matchup in Gulf South Conference play on Saturday night.
- The Wolves fell 39-38 in heartbreaking fashion last week to the Mississippi College Choctaws on Homecoming, giving UWG their first loss of the season and their first loss to MC in Carrollton since 1991.
- West Georgia will now look to avoid losing back-to-back games at home for the first time since 2012 and will also try to become the first team to win at home in the all-time series between West Georgia and West Florida.
- Jaxton Carson is coming off of a solid performance, racking up 104 yards with three touchdowns on 20 total carries last week. It was the first 100-yard rushing performance by any UWG player this season.
- Devonte Mathews made 12 tackles in the loss to Mississippi College, racking up 10 solo stops. It was the first 12-tackle game since the 2018 season.
- The Wolves had three turnovers in the loss to MC, including a pair of interceptions in the endzone. It was the first time UWG had lost the turnover battle in a game all season.
- Saturday's contest should feature plenty of offense as UWF ranks third in the country in total offense and UWG is 29th. West Florida averages 491.5 yards of offense per game while UWG averages 431.8 per contest.
- West Georgia has the advantage, at least on paper, defensively as UWG ranks 11th in total defense and West Florida is ranked 81st.

Jaxton Carson's game against Mississippi College was overshadowed by the result, but the senior rushed for 104 yards and three touchdowns on 20 carries.

UWG's defense has allowed 54 first downs through four games this season. That ranks the third-best in all of Division II, trailing Ferris State (41) and Ashland (53).

TOP-25 MATCHUP

West Georgia welcomes West Florida to Ra-Lin Field for a top-25 matchup. The Wolves fell to 15th after their loss to Mississippi College and the Argos are back up to 10th after defeating North Greenville on a walk off field goal last Saturday. It's the first regular season top-25 matchup for the Wolves since the Valdosta State game on October 30, 2021. It's the first top-25 matchup at home since hosting West Alabama in week five of the 2021 season. UWA won that matchup 38-20. In 2021, UWG played five top-25 teams in the regular season and was 3-2 in those games.

CARSON GOES FOR 100

Senior running back Jaxton Carson put together the first 100-yard rushing game by any UWG player this season last Saturday. The Phenix City, Alabama native rushed 20 times in the loss, and found the endzone three times. It was the first 100-yard game since the Delta State game on November 13, 2021 when Jace Jordan ran for 115, and also had three touchdowns. Carson is now tied for the Gulf South Conference lead in rushing touchdowns with six on the season. That number ranks 20th in all of Division II.

BOUNCE BACK

After losing to Mississippi College for the first time since 1992, now the Wolves look to avoid back-to-back losses at home for the first time since the 2012 season. That season, UWG fell to West Texas A&M and Shorter in consecutive home games in weeks nine and ten. UWG has lost back-to-back games twice under David Dean, with both of those coming in the 2019 season, although in both of those instances neither were back-to-back games at home.

RONNIE THE RETURNER

Ronnie Blackmon has given UWG a shot in the arm in the punt return game in each of the past two games. The senior from Atlanta now has five returns on the season, and averages 17.4 per return. Against Mississippi College, Blackmon had a 47-yard return and he also had a 25-yard return in the West Alabama game. Blackmon currently ranks eighth in the country and first in the Gulf South Conference in punt returns with the 17.4 average.

TOP TACKLER

Junior defensive back Devonte Mathews enters the UWF game as UWG's top tackler with 20 tackles including 16 solo stops. Against Mississippi College, Mathews had 12 tackles total and 10 solo stops to lead the way. It was the most tackles in a single-game for a UWG player since Montrell Pardue had 12 in a win over Delta State in 2018.

SPREADING THE LOVE

West Georgia is one of two teams in the Gulf South Conference that does not have a player with multiple receiving touchdowns. UWG has thrown for eight touchdowns this season to eight different players. The other team in the league that hasn't had multiple receiving touchdowns by any player is the same triple-option Mississippi College team that rushed for nearly 300 yards against UWG last week and is the nation's third-best rushing attack.

REILLY KEEPS REILLYING

Freshman punter Reilly Mason continues to impress when he's called upon. He punted just twice in the Mississippi College loss and averaged 49.0 yards per punt. Mason currently ranks seventh in the nation in punting, averaging 43.2 yards per punt over 16 thus far in the season. The Sylvester native has downed half of his punts inside the 20-yard line and has six punts of over 50 yards including a long of 56 yards.

THE WEIRDEST SERIES HISTORY EVER

Although it's still a young series, the history between UWG and UWF is a strange one. Through six meetings, including one playoff game, the home team has never won a game. UWG won in Pensacola in 2016, 2018, and 2021 while UWF won in Carrollton twice in 2017 and then defeated UWG on Homecoming in the rain in 2019, which was the last game at Ra-Lin Field.

DEFENSIVE RANKINGS

Despite giving up a lot of yards and points in the Mississippi College loss, the Wolves defense ranks in the top 20 in total defense, passing defense and scoring defense. The Wolves allow 13.2 points per game which ranks 13th in the country and in total defense, UWG allows 249.8 yards per game which ranks 11th in the nation. The Wolves' boast the nation's second-best passing defense, allowing 94.2 passing yards per game.

WOLVES-ARGOS CONNECTIONS

- David Durden and Harrison Frost both played together at their previous institutions, Mercer.
- West Florida's Peewee Jarrett and West Georgia's David Bodden both went to Alabama power, Hoover High School.

CELEBRATING CHAMPIONS

This season marks the 40th anniversary of then West Georgia College winning the NCAA Division III National Championship by defeating Augustana in the Stagg Bowl in 1982. To commemorate that incredible run to a championship, the entire 1982 team is being inducted into the UWG Athletics Hall of Fame this year. Hall of Fame Weekend is set for October 21-22, culminating with the Wolves hosting the Valdosta State Blazers at Ra-Lin Field on October 22.

THIS WEEK IN THE GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE

Saturday marks the first full week of Gulf South Conference play with all eight teams playing a conference game, including one top-25 matchup in Cleveland.

WEST FLORIDA SCOUTING REPORT

Two weeks after falling to Delta State, the Argos got a walk off field goal against North Greenville last week to get back in the win column and move to #10 in the AFCA Coaches Poll. The Argos have one of the most balanced offensive attacks in the country, ranking third in total offense, ninth in rushing offense, and 41st in passing offense. Peewee Jarrett is UWF's quarterback and is a dual-threat QB, rushing for 159 yards and throwing for 897 and 12 touchdowns thus far on the season. Shomari Mason is UWF's top rushing threat, leading the GSC with 128.8 rushing yards per game. David Durden is third in the GSC in receiving with 82.7 yards per game to go with three touchdowns this season. Defensively, Will Breland leads UWF with 26 tackles, two tackles for loss and a sack.

HEAD COACH DAVID DEAN

David Dean became the 11th head coach in the history of UWG football in 2017, returning to a program where he was part of two Gulf South Conference championships and three trips to the NCAA Playoffs as an assistant in the 1990s.

Now, Dean has the distinct title of the winningest head coach in program history after defeating West Alabama in 2022 to earn his 37th career victory as UWG's head coach, passing Charlie Fisher for the most all-time. Dean is also approaching second all-time for most wins by a head coach in Gulf South Conference history.

Dean arrived in Carrollton in January 2017, on the eve of signing day, and led the Wolves to nine victories and a return to the NCAA Division II Playoffs in his first season.

In his second season in 2018, West Georgia won 10 games and reached the playoffs for the fourth time in the past five seasons.

In the second week of the season in 2019, Dean stepped even more into history, becoming the third coach in Gulf South Conference history with 100 wins in his career as the Wolves defeated Limestone on the road.

The 2021 season was a return to the NCAA Playoffs for Dean and the Wolves as UWG finished 9-3 and defeated Albany State in the opening round of the postseason before bowing out in round two.

Since returning, Dean and his team has produced 37 All-Gulf South Conference selections and 14 All-Americans. Two players from his 2019 squad, John Hurst and Azouyah Aluofhai signed undrafted free agent contracts in the National Football League.

Dean was no stranger to the Carrollton campus when he returned to UWG last season. He brought with him a resume that would rival any coach in the nation. As an assistant or as a head coach, David Dean and his football teams are winners.

A former wide receiver at Georgia Tech, Dean got his introduction to the wars of Gulf South Conference football in 1988 when he began a four-year run on the staff at Valdosta State. In 1992 Dean moved to Carrollton for an eight-year run on the staff at West Georgia. That stint included the first winning season at the Division II level, the first NCAA D-II Playoff berth, and the program's first two Gulf South Conference titles.

Dean departed UWG following the 1999 season, joining the staff of Chris Hatcher at Valdosta State. He spent seven seasons as the Blazers' offensive coordinator, a run that included the 2004 NCAA Division II Championship.

In 2007 Dean ascended to the head coaching post at VSU. He had to assemble a coaching staff almost from the ground up as all but one fellow staff member moved on. The results were positive as Valdosta State posted a 13-1 record and won the program's second national championship.

Five years later, Dean was back in the winner's circle again. This time the Blazers lost twice in the regular season, but they were untouchable in the playoffs, averaging 42 points a game during a postseason march to a second national title.

That second national title with the Blazers put Dean in rare company. College football has been played in the state of Georgia since the 1890s, and during that time only three football coaches in this state have won multiple national titles. Erskine Russell won three FCS crowns at Georgia Southern, while Paul Johnson followed him in Statesboro with a pair of championships of his own, and now it is also David Dean.

Dean's run as head coach at Valdosta State covered nine seasons. Beyond the two national crowns, his Blazer teams posted an impressive record of 79-27, including a mark of 42-19 in games played with the nation's best Division II conference, the Gulf South. His teams advanced to the NCAA Playoffs six times, and Dean's postseason head coaching record is 13-6.


The success of Dean's Valdosta State program resulted in numerous individual plaudits. He captured American Football Coaches Association Division II Coach of the Year honors following both national titles. He was also named 2007 Coach of the Year by Schutt Sports, AFCA Regional Coach of the Year, and GSC Coach of the Year in 2010.

Beyond his individual success, Dean's VSU players captured the highest of honors. His VSU teams had 18 Division II All-America selections, while 10 players signed National Football League contracts. Dean also coached three players who earned GSC Freshman of the Year honors, two league players of the year, and a national defensive player of the year.

Clearly, David Dean has been linked to success throughout his 30-year coaching career. At UWG or at UWG's biggest rival, the results are irrefutable: David Dean is a winner. His teams win and his program flourishes.

Dean is a native of DeKalb County in the metro Atlanta area. He was born in Decatur, and enjoyed a stellar high school career for the Avondale Blue Devils. Dean arrived at Georgia Tech as a walk-on in 1982, but was awarded a scholarship the following season. He played wide receiver for the Jackets through the 1985 campaign.

Married to the former Stacie Stott, the Deans have three daughters: Caroline, Allison, and Natalie.
