QUICK HITS

- West Georgia wrapped up the home slate last week with a 49-14 win over Shorter, and now faces the top team in Super Region 2, the undefeated Delta State Statesmen, on the road with their playoff hopes on the line.
- The Wolves have won three straight since dropping back-to-back home games to Mississippi College and West Florida, and look to win four straight for the first time since the opening four games of the 2021 season.
- UWG had a GSC Player of the Week for the second straight week as Ashaud Roberson was named the GSC Freshman of the Week after averaging 11.4 yards per carry and finishing the contest with 80 yards. It was the second time a UWG player was named Freshman of the Week this season.
- Jaxton Carson had his fourth three-touchdown game of the season last week, giving him 17 on the season. On his second of the game, he passed Seth Hinsley's 2014 record of 15 rushing touchdowns to set a new single-season school record.
- West Georgia's defense held Shorter to just two rushing yards last week, and a big part of that was seven sacks as a team, the most since 2016 against North Alabama. Allen Johnson led the way with 2.0 sacks.
- Harrison Frost went over the 2,000 yard mark last week with 240 and three touchdowns against the Hawks. He now has 2,185 yards on the season to go with 17 touchdowns.
- Saturday's game features the GSC's top offense in DSU, and the league's top defense in UWG. Delta State's offense is ranked second in the country while UWG's defense is 35th.
- The Statesmen are coming off of a big win over their in-state rival Mississippi College. After falling down by seven late in the third quarter, DSU scored 21 unanswered to defeat MC, 52-38.

Terrill Cole had 117 receiving yards on Saturday, and in the process became UWG's 17th receiver to eclipse that mark and the first since John Hurst in 2019.

NEW RECORD HOLDER

Senior runningback Jaxton Carson broke UWG's single season rushing touchdown record against Shorter last Saturday, recording a fourth three-touchdown game this season. Carson now has 17 on the season, passing Seth Hinsley's 2014 record in which he rushed for 15 touchdowns on UWG's Super Region 2 Championship team. Carson now ranks fifth in the country in rushing touchdowns and has amassed 778 rushing yards which is good for fourth-best in the GSC and 34th in all of Division II.

STOPPING SHORTER WITH SEVEN SACKS

UWG's defensive line lived in the Shorter backfield last Saturday, recording seven sacks for a total loss of 53 yards. The leader was Allen Johnson who had two while Keith Harris, Shahin O'Neal, and Festus Davies each had one. Marzavion Dix, Deontae Overstreet, Demetrice Lofton, and Jalynn Tarver were each credited with a half sack. It was the most sacks in a single game for UWG since the North Alabama game in 2016. Former UWG great Dylan Donahue had three sacks in that game, but the Wolves fell 24-23 on a missed field goal as time expired.

BEST IN THE NATION

West Georgia's offensive line has allowed just one sack through eight games in 2022. The unit leads the country in sacks allowed and sacks allowed per game, at a 0.12 per game clip. The lone sack given up came in the loss to West Florida and was only for a loss of four yards.

MOVIN' ON UP

Senior quarterback Harrison Frost moved into fifth all-time in career passing yards last week, entering this week with 5,803 passing yards. The Kennesaw native is now 108 passing yards from passing Dallas Dickey for fourth all-time. Dickey threw for 5,911 from 2012-2015. Frost is now up to 42 career touchdowns which is three away from moving into sixth all-time.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

West Georgia had their second Gulf South Conference Freshman of the Week selection of the season this past week as Ashaud Roberson earned the honor. A native of Richmond Hill, Georgia, Roberson ran for a career-high 80 yards on seven carries, averaging 11.4 yards per carry against the Hawks. He also rattled off his longest run of the season and his career, a 26-yard jaunt that set up UWG's final touchdown of the game. It's the second time this season that the Wolves have had a Freshman of the Week, as Reilly Mason also won the award back on September 12.

BACK TO THE DELTA

It's UWG's first trip to the Mississippi Delta since the 2019 season, and it's a tough test awaiting the Wolves, especially the UWG defense. Delta State's offense is second in the country in total offense, averaging 506.6 yards of offense per contest, and their 44.2 points per game is fourth in all of Division II. The offense runs through Patrick Shegog who has rushed for 11 touchdowns and thrown for 16. DSU's defense is third in the GSC in terms of points allowed while UWG's defense is tops in the league in that category.

T-COLE HITS 1K

After an eight catch, 117 yard performance against Shorter, Terrill Cole became the Wolves' 17th 1,000 yard receiver in school history. Cole now has 1,067 career receiving yards and is 176 yards away from cracking the top-10 in career receiving yards. John Hurst, who was the last player to reach 1,000 yards for a career is currently 10th, amassing 1,242 receiving yards from 2016-19.

YOST MAKING THE MOST

For the second straight week, UWG had 12 different receivers catch a pass, and one of those was Mason Yost, who hauled in his first career touchdown reception in the second quarter. It was only his third catch of the season, and it was a two-yard touchdown reception, giving him eight receiving yards this season.

WHITLOCK RUSHED FOR HIS FIRST

UWG's final touchdown of the 49-14 win over Shorter also happened to be a first for Ben Whitlock. The Johns Creek native had already notched his first career passing touchdown against Morehouse, but against Shorter, he scored his first with his legs, running it in from three yards out.

OFFENSIVE CLASH

There's a lot of focus on the DSU offense, and it's explosive 500-plus yards per game that ranks second in the country, but UWG's offense isn't too shabby either. Against Shorter, the Wolves had their third straight 500-yard game of the season, and they rank ninth in the country in total offense, averaging 479.1 per game. UWG is in the top-30 in both rushing offense and passing offense, with UWG's passing game ranking 14th in the country and tops in the GSC with 285.8 yards per contest.

WOLVES-STATESMEN CONNECTIONS

- UWG has two coaches, Brice Carlson and Ashly Salomonsky, who both have spent time on staff at Delta State, most recently with Salomonsky being there in 2021.
- Tyrell Goldsmith and Adrian Hill of Delta State and UWG's David Bodden both prepped at Hoover High School.
- Terrill Cole and DSU's Damon Moore are both graduates of Clay Chalkville High School in Birmingham, Alabama.

CELEBRATING CHAMPIONS

This season marks the 40th anniversary of then West Georgia College winning the NCAA Division III National Championship by defeating Augustana in the Stagg Bowl in 1982. To commemorate that incredible run to a championship, the entire 1982 team was inducted last weekend into the UWG Athletics Hall of Fame.

DELTA STATE SCOUTING REPORT

The biggest turnaround from 2021 to 2022 is the Delta State Statesmen, who roll into week 10 with a 9-0 record and already a share of the Gulf South Conference title. A big key is DSU's offense which is second in the country in total offense, and quarterback Patrick Shegog. The senior from Batesville, Mississippi leads DSU in rushing and passing, finding the endzone 11 times with his legs while throwing for 16. Kory Gainwell is another threat in the backfield as he has 10 rushing touchdowns on the season. Dohnte Myers is the top receiver, with 600 yards and six touchdowns. Marlon Windham leads DSU's defense with 61 tackles and an interception while Tyrell Goldsmith has 48 tackles and two interceptions.

HEAD COACH DAVID DEAN

David Dean became the 11th head coach in the history of UWG football in 2017, returning to a program where he was part of two Gulf South Conference championships and three trips to the NCAA Playoffs as an assistant in the 1990s.

Now, Dean has the distinct title of the winningest head coach in program history after defeating West Alabama in 2022 to earn his 37th career victory as UWG's head coach, passing Charlie Fisher for the most all-time. Dean is also approaching second all-time for most wins by a head coach in Gulf South Conference history.

Dean arrived in Carrollton in January 2017, on the eve of signing day, and led the Wolves to nine victories and a return to the NCAA Division II Playoffs in his first season.

In his second season in 2018, West Georgia won 10 games and reached the playoffs for the fourth time in the past five seasons.

In the second week of the season in 2019, Dean stepped even more into history, becoming the third coach in Gulf South Conference history with 100 wins in his career as the Wolves defeated Limestone on the road.

The 2021 season was a return to the NCAA Playoffs for Dean and the Wolves as UWG finished 9-3 and defeated Albany State in the opening round of the postseason before bowing out in round two.

Since returning, Dean and his team has produced 37 All-Gulf South Conference selections and 14 All-Americans. Two players from his 2019 squad, John Hurst and Azouyah Alufohai signed undrafted free agent contracts in the National Football League.

Dean was no stranger to the Carrollton campus when he returned to UWG last season. He brought with him a resume that would rival any coach in the nation. As an assistant or as a head coach, David Dean and his football teams are winners.

A former wide receiver at Georgia Tech, Dean got his introduction to the wars of Gulf South Conference football in 1988 when he began a four-year run on the staff at Valdosta State. In 1992 Dean moved to Carrollton for an eight-year run on the staff at West Georgia. That stint included the first winning season at the Division II level, the first NCAA D-II Playoff berth, and the program's first two Gulf South Conference titles.

Dean departed UWG following the 1999 season, joining the staff of Chris Hatcher at Valdosta State. He spent seven seasons as the Blazers' offensive coordinator, a run that included the 2004 NCAA Division II Championship.

In 2007 Dean ascended to the head coaching post at VSU. He had to assemble a coaching staff almost from the ground up as all but one fellow staff member moved on. The results were positive as Valdosta State posted a 13-1 record and won the program's second national championship.

Five years later, Dean was back in the winner's circle again. This time the Blazers lost twice in the regular season, but they were untouchable in the playoffs, averaging 42 points a game during a postseason march to a second national title.

That second national title with the Blazers put Dean in rare company. College football has been played in the state of Georgia since the 1890s, and during that time only three football coaches in this state have won multiple national titles. Erskine Russell won three FCS crowns at Georgia Southern, while Paul Johnson followed him in Statesboro with a pair of championships of his own, and now it is also David Dean.

Dean's run as head coach at Valdosta State covered nine seasons. Beyond the two national crowns, his Blazer teams posted an impressive record of 79-27, including a mark of 42-19 in games played with the nation's best Division II conference, the Gulf South. His teams advanced to the NCAA Playoffs six times, and Dean's postseason head coaching record is 13-6.

The success of Dean's Valdosta State program resulted in numerous individual plaudits. He captured American Football Coaches Association Division II Coach of the Year honors following both national titles. He was also named 2007 Coach of the Year by Schutt Sports, AFCA Regional Coach of the Year, and GSC Coach of the Year in 2010.

Beyond his individual success, Dean's VSU players captured the highest of honors. His VSU teams had 18 Division II All-America selections, while 10 players signed National Football League contracts. Dean also coached three players who earned GSC Freshman of the Year honors, two league players of the year, and a national defensive player of the year.

Clearly, David Dean has been linked to success throughout his 30-year coaching career. At UWG or at UWG's biggest rival, the results are irrefutable: David Dean is a winner. His teams win and his program flourishes.

Dean is a native of DeKalb County in the metro Atlanta area. He was born in Decatur, and enjoyed a stellar high school career for the Avondale Blue Devils. Dean arrived at Georgia Tech as a walk-on in 1982, but was awarded a scholarship the following season. He played wide receiver for the Jackets through the 1985 campaign.

Married to the former Stacie Stott, the Deans have three daughters: Caroline, Allison, and Natalie.
