QUICK HITS

- A new campaign is set to kickoff under the Thursday night lights at Ra-Lin Field as West Georgia hosts Carson-Newman.
- The Wolves enter the 2022 season ranked 13th in the AFCA Preseason Coaches' Poll. West Georgia finished last season with a 9-3 mark, bowing out in the second round of the NCAA Playoffs. Carson-Newman is unranked to begin the season after finishing 1-9 in 2021.
- Head Coach David Dean begins his fifth season at the helm of the UWG program. Dean, who was an assistant at UWG in the 1990s, is 34-14 in four seasons as UWG's head coach and needs three wins to pass Charlie Fisher as UWG's all-time winningest head coach.
- UWG was picked third in the GSC Preseason Coaches Poll behind West Florida and preseason favorite Valdosta State. The Wolves also had three players, Deontae Overstreet, Marzavion Dix, and Joe Skinner, to be named to the Preseason All-GSC Team.
- Signal caller Harrison Frost is back for his final season after setting a single-season passing record in 2021, throwing for 3,618 yards and 25 touchdowns.
- Last year's leading tackler returns in 2022 as Deontae Overstreet looks to lead a defensive unit that ranked 35th in scoring defense last season. Overstreet made 59 tackles in 2021 including 40 solo stops.
- The week one matchup is the seventh meeting all-time between UWG and Carson-Newman and the first ever in Carrollton. The Wolves and Eagles have met four times in Tennessee including three in the NCAA Playoffs, and twice on a neutral field in Rome. Last year's win was the first ever over C-N in UWG program history.
- The radio trio of Matt Skinner, Willie Candler, and Cade Parian each make their debuts on Thursday.

683

Terrill Cole is UWG's leading receiver back from last year's team. The Birmingham, Alabama native hauled in 48 catches for 683 yards and two touchdowns last season.

UWG put up 45 points against Carson-Newman in 2021, the most points scored in the history of the series. It was the third most points scored on C-N in 2021.

LAST MEETING WITH CARSON-NEWMAN

September 2, 2021 • Burke-Tarr Stadium • Jefferson City, TN - The Wolves delivered a dominant display in the 2021 season opener, defeating No. 24 Carson-Newman for the first time in program history courtesy of a 45-7 clubbing at Burke-Tarr Stadium in a game the visitors controlled from start to finish against a traditional power from the South Atlantic Conference. It marked the first time the Eagles, who reached the second round of the NCAA Division II Playoffs in 2019, lost by more than 30 points at home in over a decade. It also served as Carson-Newman's most lopsided season-opening loss since 1983.

ODE TO THE PAST

When West Georgia takes the field to begin the 2022 season, they will have a new look from head to toe, including a throw back to the past, a red helmet. West Georgia wore red helmets from the time football returned in 1981 up until 2006. After featuring blue helmets from 2006-2008, UWG brought the red helmet back for five seasons until the white helmet debuted in 2014. This will be the sixth different red helmet design worn by UWG.

WELCOME TO THE CITY OF DREAMS

West Georgia and Carson-Newman have met six times in series history, but the 2022 season opener marks the first time the Eagles have visited the Wolves in Carrollton. The two teams first met in the NCAA Playoffs in 1995 in Jefferson City, and then met in the same scenario again in 1996 and 1998. Each time the Eagles defeated the Wolves, and then the Eagles won both season openers in 2004 and 2005 on a neutral field in Rome, Georgia. Last year's 45-7 on the road was the first win in series history by UWG.

PRESEASON ALL-GSC

Three Wolves were featured on the Preseason All-Gulf South Conference Team as voted on by the league's coaches. Two defensive standouts made the team with 2021 All-GSC selections Marzavion Dix and Deontae Overstreet being picked for the preseason honor. Overstreet led the Wolves in tackles last season and went on to be an All-Super Region 2 selection. Senior long snapper Joe Skinner was also on the team. Skinner is a two-time All-GSC selection at the special teams utility spot.

CLOSING IN ON HISTORY

Head coach David Dean begins the 2022 season with 34 career victories at UWG. Dean, who has been a part of 14 different teams at West Georgia, is three wins away from the top spot in the career victories category. Charlie Fisher, who coached UWG from 1993-1997, won 36 games in that time span with David Dean as his running backs coach. In terms of winning percentage, Dean is third among coaches who coached multiple seasons at UWG, winning 71 percent of his games as head coach.

FROST IN THE RECORD BOOKS

Senior quarterback Harrison Frost had a big 2021, but is looking for bigger and better in 2022. Last season, Frost threw for 3,618 yards and 25 touchdowns, setting a single-season school record in yards, and tying the single-season record for touchdowns. In the career passing marks, Frost is currently seventh in yards after just one season in the red and blue. Frost has a chance to become the fourth player to throw for at least 6,000 yards in a career and only two, Willie Candler and Chris Teal, have eclipsed the 7,000 career passing yards mark.

NEW NUMBER, SAME STREET

Don't look for number 23 to find Deontae Overstreet this season. The Tifton native is in a new number in 2022, sporting number zero, as the first UWG player to ever wear that jersey number. Up until 2020, the number zero wasn't allowed to be worn by the NCAA. UWG picked a good one to be the first to ever wear zero as Overstreet led the team in tackles in 2021, was All-GSC and All-Super Region. Overstreet's best performance last season came in the playoffs at Albany State as he had 11 tackles including a sack in the Wolves' round one win.

GUESS WHO'S BACK

It's not every year you get a former All-American back, and for the Wolves it's a big shot in the arm, as LaPerion Perry returns for the first time since the 2019 season. "LP" had respectable numbers in 2019, but it was his 2018 season that saw him be named an All-American as a return specialist. In 2018, Perry had 22 kickoff returns and two touchdowns and averaged 34.18 yards per return. He also averaged 16.38 yards per return on punt returns and racked up 251 receiving yards and a pair of touchdowns.

EXPERIENCE UP FRONT

West Georgia has a trio of experienced defensive lineman leading the way up front in 2022. Shahin O'Neal, Allen Johnson, and Marzavion Dix have combined to play in 93 games for the Wolves. Dix and O'Neal both had 20 tackles in 2021 and combined to tally 4.5 sacks. Johnson finished the year with 11 tackles and half a sack in his junior season.

NEW KICKER IN CARROLLTON

UWG will have to replace a two-time All-American and the all-time leader in career field goals this year as Omar Cervantes departs after making 15 field goals in 2021. It will be up to sophomore Brock Pellegrino or senior Trey Wiggins to handle the kicking duties this season. Pellegrino was the Wolves' punter in 2021, and Wiggins has experience kicking field goals as he was UWG's placekicker on their 2017 playoff team. That year, Wiggins made 10-of-15 field goals including a long of 35 yards.

CELEBRATING CHAMPIONS

This season marks the 40th anniversary of then West Georgia College winning the NCAA Division III National Championship by defeating Augustana in the Stagg Bowl in 1982. To commemorate that incredible run to a championship, the entire 1982 team is being inducted into the UWG Athletics Hall of Fame this year. Hall of Fame Weekend is set for October 21-22, culminating with the Wolves hosting the Valdosta State Blazers at Ra-Lin Field on October 22.

THIS WEEK IN THE GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE

Three GSC teams open up on Thursday night with Valdosta State hosting Keiser and North Greenville traveling to Furman along with the Wolves and Eagles. All other teams open their 2022 season on Saturday, September 3.

CARSON-NEWMAN SCOUTING REPORT

Carson-Newman is coming off of one of their worst season in school history, going 1-9 and failing to win multiple games for the first time since 1959. The Eagles are historically one of Division II's most successful programs, posting 21 ten-win seasons and they have the most playoff appearances by current DII members since 1980 with 26. So the Eagles will be eager to get back to their winning ways in 2022. They have a new signal caller in Ivan Corbin, a senior transfer from Tusculum and return one of their top targets for years past in Braxton Westfield. Westfield's numbers slipped off in 2021, but in 2019 he was an All-SAC selection with 680 yards and 11 touchdowns. Defensively, Carson-Newman's leading returning tackler is Caleb Goins who had 62 tackles last season with 7.0 tackles for loss.

WOLVES IN GSC & NCAA STATS

HEAD COACH DAVID DEAN

David Dean became the 11th head coach in the history of UWG football in 2017, returning to a program where he was part of two Gulf South Conference championships and three trips to the NCAA Playoffs as an assistant in the 1990s.

Dean arrived in Carrollton in January 2017, on the eve of signing day, and led the Wolves to nine victories and a return to the NCAA Division II Playoffs in his first season.

In his second season in 2018, West Georgia won 10 games and reached the playoffs for the fourth time in the past five seasons.

In the second week of the season in 2019, Dean stepped even more into history, becoming the third coach in Gulf South Conference history with 100 wins in his career as the Wolves defeated Limestone on the road.

The 2021 season was a return to the NCAA Playoffs for Dean and the Wolves as UWG finished 9-3 and defeated Albany State in the opening round of the postseason before bowing out in round two.

Since returning, Dean and his team has produced 37 All-Gulf South Conference selections and 14 All-Americans. Two players from his 2019 squad, John Hurst and Azouyah Alufohai signed undrafted free agent contracts in the National Football League.

Dean was no stranger to the Carrollton campus when he returned to UWG last season. He brought with him a resume that would rival any coach in the nation. As an assistant or as a head coach, David Dean and his football teams are winners.

A former wide receiver at Georgia Tech, Dean got his introduction to the wars of Gulf South Conference football in 1988 when he began a four-year run on the staff at Valdosta State. In 1992 Dean moved to Carrollton for an eight-year run on the staff at West Georgia. That stint included the first winning season at the Division II level, the first NCAA D-II Playoff berth, and the program's first two Gulf South Conference titles.

Dean departed UWG following the 1999 season, joining the staff of Chris Hatcher at Valdosta State. He spent seven seasons as the Blazers' offensive coordinator, a run that included the 2004 NCAA Division II Championship.

In 2007 Dean ascended to the head coaching post at VSU. He had to assemble a coaching staff almost from the ground up as all but one fellow staff member moved on. The results were positive as Valdosta State posted a 13-1 record and won the program's second national championship.

Five years later, Dean was back in the winner's circle again. This time the Blazers lost twice in the regular season, but they were untouchable in the playoffs, averaging 42 points a game during a postseason march to a second national title.

That second national title with the Blazers put Dean in rare company. College football has been played in the state of Georgia since the 1890s, and during that time only three football coaches in this state have won multiple national titles. Erskine Russell won three FCS crowns at Georgia Southern, while Paul Johnson followed him in Statesboro with a pair of championships of his own, and now it is also David Dean.

Dean's run as head coach at Valdosta State covered nine seasons. Beyond the two national crowns, his Blazer teams posted an impressive record of 79-27, including a mark of 42-19 in games played with the nation's best Division II conference, the Gulf South. His teams advanced to the NCAA Playoffs six times, and Dean's postseason head coaching record is 13-6.

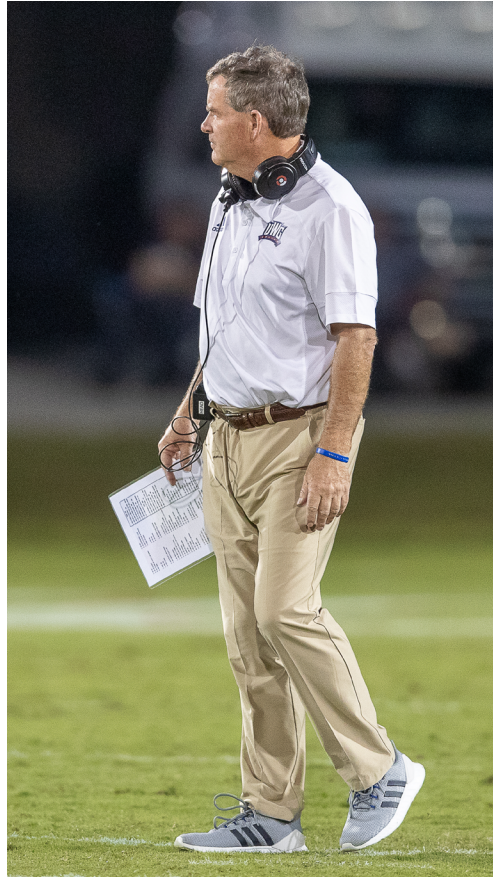
The success of Dean's Valdosta State program resulted in numerous individual plaudits. He captured American Football Coaches Association Division II Coach of the Year honors following both national titles. He was also named 2007 Coach of the Year by Schutt Sports, AFCA Regional Coach of the Year, and GSC Coach of the Year in 2010.

Beyond his individual success, Dean's VSU players captured the highest of honors. His VSU teams had 18 Division II All-America selections, while 10 players signed National Football League contracts. Dean also coached three players who earned GSC Freshman of the Year honors, two league players of the year, and a national defensive player of the year.

Clearly, David Dean has been linked to success throughout his 30-year coaching career. At UWG or at UWG's biggest rival, the results are irrefutable: David Dean is a winner. His teams win and his program flourishes.

Dean is a native of DeKalb County in the metro Atlanta area. He was born in Decatur, and enjoyed a stellar high school career for the Avondale Blue Devils. Dean arrived at Georgia Tech as a walk-on in 1982, but was awarded a scholarship the following season. He played wide receiver for the Jackets through the 1985 campaign.

Married to the former Stacie Stott, the Deans have three daughters: Caroline, Allison, and Natalie.
