STORYLINES

- **NON-CONFERENCE CLASH:** For the final time this season, the Wolves will dip back into non-conference play, hosting the Lincoln Oaklanders in a week 10 clash at University Stadium.
- **STAYING HOME:** It's game three of a four-game home stand for UWG as the Wolves have just two home games remaining. It's been an unusual year with seven home games and just four road games.
- **WHO'S AT QB?:** The Wolves used both Davin Wydner and Quincy Casey in last week's loss to Southern Utah. Coach Taylor said on Monday in his coaches show that Casey's ankle got a little banged up, but it remains unclear who will get the nod at quarterback this week for the Wolves.
- **MIDDLE OF THE DEFENSE:** The linebacker duo of Jay Carter and Micah Thurman are tied for the team lead with 57 tackles, and with three games remaining, they are on pace to post the highest single-season since 2018. That was the last time a UWG player posted 80-plus tackles and the Wolves haven't had a 90-tackle season since 2014.
- **FOURTH IN THE COUNTRY:** West Georgia's defense hit their average with three sacks against Southern Utah last week, and now have 24 team sacks through eight games in 2024. The Wolves average 3.00 sacks trailing Mercer, Central Arkansas, and South Carolina State.
- **ALMOST THERE:** As we've watched senior running back Rajaez Mosley inch closer to a career milestone each week, the Valdosta native enters this week-end needing 51 yards to reach the 2,000 career rushing yards mark. Mosley would become the seventh player to reach that mark and the first since Devontae Jackson in 2017.

NOTEBOOK

CASEY CLOSE TO 1K AT UWG, ECLIPSES 4K FOR HIS CAREER

- Senior quarterback Quincy Casey started again in week nine, throwing for 139 yards and a touchdown. The Memphis, Tennessee native is now 57 yards away from a 1,000-yard season.
- The Memphis, Tennessee native has thrown for 943 yards this season at UWG, with eight touchdowns through five games played. He’s added 152 yards and three touchdowns on the ground.
- Casey is at his third school spending time previously at Jackson State and Alabama A&M. He eclipsed the 4,000 yards passing for his career across the three schools in last week’s performance.

CLOSING IN ON 2K

- Just 51 yards stand between senior running back Rajaez Mosley and the 2,000 career yards mark as the senior enters week seven with 1,949 career rushing yards.
- Mosley currently has 368 yards on the ground this season, and rushed for 45 yards on eight carries on Saturday against Southern Utah.
- If he gets to 2,000 this season, he will become the seventh player in program history to eclipse that mark.

GOING FOR 80

- Jay Carter and Micah Thurman enter the week 10 matchup tied for the team lead with 57 tackles, and are on pace to potentially post the best season defensively by an individual since 2018 when Montrell Pardue had 81 tackles.
- UWG hasn’t had a 90-tackle performance since 2014 when Hall of Famer Tyrell Adams posted 92 as a senior before beginning his NFL career.
- If both Carter and Thurman get to 80 tackles it will mark the first time UWG has had multiple 80-tackles performances in the same season since 2017 when Pardue (82) and Cameron Magee (80) combined for 162 tackles.
- And in case you’re curious, UWG’s last 100-tackle season came from the late John Perkins who was posthumously inducted into the UWG Athletics Hall of Fame in 2023. Perkins made 104 tackles and 15.5 tackles for loss in 2006.

NOTEBOOK

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- West Georgia’s offense is tied for 10th in FCS football in passing offense, throwing for 277.0 yards per game. That number is second in the United Athletic Conference behind Abilene Christian.
- Wide receiver Dylan Gary has hauled in six touchdowns this year, ranking 16th in all of FCS football and second in the UAC. Gary is also one of just 19 players in the country to have a single game with at least three receiving touchdowns.
- Quarterback Davin Wydner’s five rushing touchdowns leads the team and is tied for 14th in the country in rushing TDs by a quarterback.
- It’s been 12 straight games with a catch for T.J. Lockley, dating back to last season, and the junior from Daytona Beach enters week 10 ranked 19th in the country in receptions per game with 5.6.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- As a team, UWG is allowing 3.7 yards per rush which is second in the United Athletic Conference behind Central Arkansas. UWG’s rushing defense ranks third, allowing 156.8 yards per game on the ground.
- Four Wolves, Solomonie Bambara, Malik Charles, Micah Thurman and Mar’Quavious Moss rank in the top ten in the UAC in tackles for loss per game. Bambara leads UWG in that category averaging 1.0 per game.
- As a team, UWG’s defense averages 3.00 sacks per game which is fourth in all of FCS football and trails Central Arkansas, South Carolina State, and Mercer. The nation’s leader in sacks is Mercer who averages 3.43 per game.

HEAD COACH JOEL TAYLOR

Joel Taylor was named the 12th head football coach in University of West Georgia history on December 2, 2023 after almost two decades of successful coaching experience at multiple levels of college football.

His most recent position prior to coming to Carrollton to usher UWG into the Division I era was at Mercer University where he was the defensive coordinator. Regarded as one of the top defensive coordinators in the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS), Taylor completely transformed the Mercer defense in his four seasons in Macon.

At Mercer, Taylor inherited a Mercer defense that ranked 106th in the country in scoring defense prior to his arrival and then saw his defense rank 30th in the same category in 2022. Also in 2022, Taylor's defense ranked 17th nationally in yards per play allowed and gave up just 22.1 points per game. Additionally, Taylor's 2022 Mercer defense led FCS with 17 interceptions and gave up a conference-low 28 touchdowns over the course of the season.

His tenure at Mercer culminated with a second-round appearance in the FCS Playoffs in 2023 as the Bears qualified for the postseason for the first time in program history and won their first ever appearance over Gardner-Webb. In that game, the Bears' surrendered just one touchdown, winning, 17-7.

Taylor has had defensive success everywhere he has coached, including his one season as defensive coordinator at Lenoir-Rhyne. There, Taylor led a Bears' defense that ranked No. 1 nationally with 50 sacks, limited opponents to 17.4 points per game and finished 13-1 with a conference championship and a quarterfinal berth in the NCAA Playoffs.

Numerous players have enjoyed individual success under Taylor's tutelage, most recently Mercer linebacker Isaac Dowling, who was a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award given to the top freshman in the country. At Lenoir-Rhyne, Taylor was instrumental in the development of safety Kyle Dugger, who was a second-round pick by the New England Patriots in 2020.

Prior to his stint at Lenoir-Rhyne, Taylor coached defensive backs and was the defensive passing game coordinator at The Citadel, where he was a part of back-to-back SOCON Championships, including a No. 9 final ranking in the FCS Poll in 2016.

Taylor also spent time at his alma mater, South Carolina State, from 2010-13 and 2005-08, sandwiched around a one-year stint as the defensive ends and outside linebackers coach at Lenoir-Rhyne. He was part of three MEAC Championships and NCAA Playoff Appearances in his time at South Carolina State (2008, 2010 and 2013) and added a Division II Playoff Appearance at Lenoir-Rhyne in 2008.

As a player, Taylor lettered at South Carolina State from 2001-04, was a senior captain and a member of the Bulldogs' 2004 conference championship team.

Originally from Brooklyn, New York, Taylor grew up in Irmo, South Carolina. He completed his bachelor's degree in computer science in 2004 and his master's in rehabilitation counseling in 2008, both from South Carolina State. He is married to the former Mechelle Robertson.
