### KEY STORYLINES

#### THE SERIES

- VT is 1-0 all-time against Bucknell, with the first meeting coming in November of 2013. The Hokies won that contest 87-49 behind 21 points from Uju Ugoka.

#### A WIN WOULD...

- Move the Hokies' record to 2-0 for the eighth straight season.
- Be Tech's third consecutive non-conference victory at home.

#### KING SHINES ON OPENING NIGHT

- Cayla King's 33-point effort on opening night is tied for the seventh-most points that a VT athlete has scored in a game.
- King made a program record nine triples against The Mount, breaking her former teammate Aisha Sheppard's mark. She had made eight on two occasions. Jeni Garber had also made eight in one contest in 1991.
- She moved into eighth place all-time at VT in career 3's with 154, passing Taylor Emery who posted 146 in her two seasons in Blacksburg.

#### BROOKS GETS OFF TO FAST STARTS

- Kenny Brooks is now 7-0 at VT in season openers. In those games the Hokies have an average margin of victory of 42.2 points and are averaging 90.4 points themselves. In season openers under Brooks, VT has scored 96 or more points four times and topped 100 twice.

#### VT BASKETBALL CONNECTS ON 3'S, DROPS 30+

- After opening night, Virginia Tech's women's and men's basketball teams scored 28 combined 3-point FGs. Only Army and Jacksonville (29) scored more. Both VT programs went 14-of-28 in their opening game.
- Tech also boasted the only duo Cayla King (33) and Grant Basile (30) represented the only men's and women's combo from one school to score 30+.

#### TRAYLOR TOPS CENTURY MARK OF HER OWN

- With her three steals Monday night, Kayana Traylor eclipsed the century mark for her career.
- She's now posted 101 in her 122-game career.

## LOOKING BACK AT LAST SEASON...

- The Hokies set numerous program records this season including: most ACC wins in a single season, most wins by 10+ in ACC play, most wins by 20+ in ACC play, most road wins in ACC play and most victories over ranked opponents in a single season with four. The 102 points scored at Syracuse was the most in program history in an ACC contest, as was the 49-point margin in the game.
- Eleven of the Hokies' 13 ACC victories were by double digits. The lone exceptions were a five-point victory over No. 23 UNC and a seven-point win over Miami.

## WHEN THE HOKIES HIT THE CENTURY MARK

- VT scored 101 points to open the season, the 13th game in program history that the team scored 100 or more.
- Six of those occasions came in the team's first game of the season.
- Tech has topped 100 points in the following seasons: 1980, 1982, 1983 (twice), 1984, 1986, 1993, 1996, 2004, 2007, 2019, 2021, 2022.
- Tech has now scored 100+ three times in the Kenny Brooks era, including on two opening nights: 2019 and 2022.

## BACK-TO-BACK 100-POINT PERFORMANCES?

- The Hokies are yet to post consecutive games of 100+ points in their 46 seasons of competition.
- The closest that VT has come was in December of 2004 when they scored 105 against Southern Miss on the 28th and then scored 87 versus Davidson two days later. Both of those games came in the Lady Luck Classic at Cassell Coliseum.



#### MORE ON TECH IN THE NON-CONFERENCE

- Since his arrival in 2016, Coach Brooks has owned the non-conference portion of the schedule, accumulating a 75-15 record.
- He has reached the ACC season unbeaten in the non-conference four times at VT.
- VT is 12-6 against schools from the other Power Five conferences during his tenure, including an impressive 7-2 mark vs. the Big Ten, 4-2 vs. the SEC and a 1-2 record vs. the Big 12. He is yet to face a squad from the Pac 12. This season the Hokies will face three SEC squads: Kentucky and Missouri in the Bahamas and Tennessee in the Jimmy V Women's Classic in Knoxville. Tech will also compete in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge playing host too Nebraska.

#### ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE RETURNS TO CASSELL IN DECEMBER

- Tech defeated Wisconsin 70-60 in 2021 for their sixth consecutive victory in the competition helping the ACC secure another win in The Challenge last season.
- The Hokies are one of two programs across the league to boast a six-game streak in The Challenge (Florida State).
- Coach Brooks is 5-0 in the competition, owning wins over Nebraska, Illinois, Rutgers, Purdue and Wisconsin by an average margin of 19.0 points.
- December 1 VT plays host to Nebraska at 7 p.m. on ACC Network.

#### BROOKS CEMENTS HIS PLACE IN HISTORY

- There have been five ACC WBB head coaches to win each of their first five ACC/Big Ten Challenge games: Kenny Brooks, MaChelle Joseph (2007-11 at GT), Jeff Walz (2014-18 at Louisville), Muffet McGraw (2013-18 at Notre Dame) and Brenda Frese (2007-13 at Maryland). Frese won her first seven games in the competition and since 2013 when UMD moved to the Big Ten, she and the Terps are 5-2 in The Challenge.
- Brooks' 5-0 mark is tied for the third-longest streak to begin a tenure. McGraw (6) and Frese (7) are the only coaches with a longer streak.
- VT is on a six-game streak overall in the competition, which is the second-longest of any ACC squad. FSU is on a nine-game streak.

#### BROOKS LEADS A VETERAN GROUP

- The Hokies' roster features nine athletes who have played collegiate basketball for four or more seasons. That is the most in the ACC. Duke ranks second with eight while Miami has seven.
- Tech's roster boasted 757 games played (465 starts), 17,667 minutes played and 6,993 points scored heading into opening tip on November 7.

## VIRGINIA TECH PROGRAM NOTES

- Elizabeth Kitley's 34 total double-doubles (88 GP) rank second in school history behind only Regan Magarity who tallied 55 in 132 games.

## TRENDS FOR THE HOKIES

- VT is 1-0 with five or more student-athletes scoring in double figures.

## HOKIES BOAST FOUR 1,000-POINT SCORERS

- The Hokies have four athletes that have already scored 1,000 or more collegiate points prior to the start of the 2022-23 season, one of just a few teams in the nation that can assert that. In order those athletes are: Taylor Soule (1,536), Elizabeth Kitley (1,428), Ashley Owusu (1,295) and Kayana Traylor (1,126).

## KITLEY A DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE

- Kitley led the ACC with 15 double-doubles last season.
- Her 34 career double-doubles are second most all-time at VT.
- She tallied 13 her sophomore year and had six as a freshman during a season that she won ACC Freshman of the Year.

## SPECIALTY STATS ON CENTER ELIZABETH KITLEY

- Tech is 17-7 when Kitley scores 20+
- Tech is 3-2 when Kitley scores 30+
- Tech is 31-7 when Kitley records 10+ rebounds
- Tech is 28-6 when Kitley records a double-double
- Tech is 36-21 when Kitley shoots 10+ FGs
- Tech is 20-14 when Kitey shoots 5+ FTs
- Kitley was also honored with the Kay Yow Scholar Athlete of the Year Award in 2022 recognizing the top upperclassman student-athlete.

## NUMEROUS ATHLETES EARN PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- Elizabeth Kitley - ACC Preseason Player of the Year, Preseason All-ACC Team, Lisa Leslie Award Watch List, Preseason All-American, Naismith Trophy Women's Watch List

VT is one of nine schools that has an athlete at three or more positions on the Watch List for that spot on the floor. Duke, Indiana and Stanford are also on three, South Carolina and UConn each covered four positions and Louisville, Tennessee and Texas had an athlete featured at each position.

## PROFICIENT AT THE LONG BALL

- VT owns a 213 game streak making a 3-point FG. The streak began on December 30, 2015 vs. Furman.
- The 213-game streak is the longest in program history since 3FG began in 1987.
- Tech's second-best streak was 87 straight contests (January 14, 1989 - January 25, 1992).

### **SCORING NOTES ON THE HOKIES' PROGRAM**

- In the ACC era, VT WBB has scored 90 or more points on 23 occasions, winning each time. Kenny Brooks has been the head coach for 16 of those games.
- Brooks has had at least one such game in each of his seven seasons in Blacksburg, including four each during the 2017-18 and 2018-19 seasons.

### **TECH ENTERS 22-23 WITH EXPECTATIONS**

- Tech is ranked 13th in the preseason AP Poll, the highest preseason position in program history. The 13 mark is the highest that the program has achieved since the 1999 season. That season, Tech achieved its highest ever ranking in the AP Poll, ninth.
- The Hokies placed three athlete's on the ACC's preseason All-Conference Team: Elizabeth Kitley, Ashley Owusu and Taylor Soule. They became the first program since Notre Dame in 2018 to place three or more on the preseason team.
- VT was selected to finish second in the conference, the program's highest predicted finish since joining the ACC in 2004. Last season VT was picked fourth and finished tied for third.
- Kitley was chosen as the preseason Player of the Year after winning the award last season. Nine women have won the award twice and on each occasion they did so in consecutive seasons.

### **CHASING HISTORY IN THE BIG DANCE**

- After making the program's first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2006 in 2021, the Hokies also made last year's field. A third consecutive trip would be just the second time in VT history that the program has gone three seasons in a row following a four-year stretch from 2003-06.

### **CAYLA THE KING OF THE LONG BALL**

- Senior G Cayla King scored 60 3-pointers last season and upped her scoring average to 8.7 points per game.
- For her career, 154 of her 170 made field goals have come from beyond the arc (90.5%) where she shoots better than 38%.
- In 2021-22 she scored in double figures in five games, all Hokie wins. Three of the five games came in conference play and in each of those contests the Hokies were wearing their gray uniforms.
- VT is 14-1 when King scores 10+ points. The lone loss came by two points to No. 2 NC State (Jan. 24, 2021).

### **GREGG'S IMPACT OFF THE BENCH**

- VT is 9-3 when Gregg plays 20+ minutes.
- VT is 10-4 when Gregg grabs 5+ rebounds.
- VT is 6-3 when Gregg scores 6+ points.

### **JUNIOR TAYLOR GEIMAN BACK ON THE FLOOR FOR BROOKS AND CO.**

- Hanover, Pennsylvania native Taylor Geiman has played in just 32 career games in three seasons, suffering season-ending knee injuries in both of her first two seasons in Blacksburg.
- Back healthy, the G/F is poised to make an impact once again on the court for the Hokies.
- Praised as a 'Swiss Army' knife by Coach Brooks, Geiman can play nearly any position on the floor.
- She played in 13 contests averaging 7.9 minutes. In 2021-22, Geiman connected on a 3-point FG in the win over No. 15 Duke and came off the bench to make a 3FG against NC State in the ACC Tournament.

### **KITLEY'S STAT LINE IN 2021-22 IMPRESSIVE**

- Only four WBB athletes registered a stat line of 18.1 ppg., 9.8 rebounds, .551 FG% while registering 77 or more blocks last season. VT center Elizabeth Kitley was one of them.
- The other three were Yale's Camila Emsbo, South Carolina's Aliyah Boston and Jackson State's Amesha Williams-Holiday.
- Kitley recorded 237 FGs last season, a program record. That figure ranks 10th amongst athletes returning for the 2022-23 season.

### **VT LOOKING TO CAPITALIZE FROM THE CHARITY STRIPE**

- Tech's roster features three of the top seven athletes in terms of FT attempts in the ACC last season.
- Taylor Soule led the conference with 180 attempts (.683), Elizabeth Kitley was third with 145 (.724) and Kayana Traylor was seventh (.816).

Brooks notched his 150th win at Virginia Tech on January 13, 2022 with a 65-54 victory at No. 16 Duke. The win completed the season sweep over the Blue Devils, the first time in program history that the Hokies had accomplished the feat.



### BIOGRAPHY IN BULLETS

- Kenny Brooks was named the seventh head women's basketball coach in Virginia Tech women's basketball history on March 28, 2016 and concluded his sixth season at the helm of the Hokies' program in 2022.
- Since Brooks' arrival in Blacksburg, the Hokies have enjoyed six consecutive winning seasons, and made a return to the NCAA Tournament in 2021 after a 15-year absence.
- In 2021-22 Tech set several program records including placing an athlete on an AP All-American Team for the first time ever (Elizabeth Kitley), having the ACC's Player of the Year (Kitley), going 13-5 in conference and defeating five different ranked teams.
- Tech's 2020-21 season was a special one in several regards, with the Hokies winning their First Round NCAA Tournament game against Marquette, the team securing the program's first win over an AP top four team, a program record six-game winning streak in ACC play, and for the first time, two student-athletes were honored as First Team All-ACC performers.
- The Hokies set numerous program records in 2019-20, most notably winning 11 ACC games for the first time and earning the five seed at the conference's tournament. Center Elizabeth Kitley became the first Hokie to win ACC Freshman of the Year.
- To begin his tenure, Brooks and the Hokies reeled off 15 straight wins to open the 2016-17 season, Tech's strongest start to a season in 18 years. Behind that strong start, Tech climbed to as high as No. 15 in the AP Poll.
- Brooks has ushered in a new era of uptempo basketball at Virginia Tech, as his Hokies have reset the program scoring record twice and surpassed the mark for 3-pointers made.
- During his time in Blacksburg, Brooks has recruited and developed All-ACC performer Taylor Emery, who set the single season scoring record in 2017-18 at 667 points. She also scored the most field goals in a single campaign with 236. She became the fastest player to 1,000 points (55 games) and was the first Hokie to earn first team All-ACC honors when she did so in 2019.
- Five Hokies have reached 1,000 points since Brooks joined Tech including All-ACC performers Emery, Regan Magarity, Aisha Sheppard and Elizabeth Kitley. Magarity graduated in 2019 with her name imprinted all throughout the record book, with over 1,600 points and an ACC record 1,299 rebounds. Sheppard is VT's all-time leading scorer, owns the ACC WBB record for 3FG and was the highest WNBA Draft selection from VT in 2022.
- Brooks joined the Hokies after an impressive 14-seasons at his alma mater, James Madison. He compiled a record of 337-122 (.756) making him the winningest coach in JMU program history. He guided the Dukes to 11 consecutive postseason appearances that included six NCAA bids and five trips to the WNIT.
- Over an 11-year stretch (2005-16), Brooks' squads never won fewer than 24 games, averaging 26.3 wins per year. The Dukes won three consecutive CAA championships under Brooks' tutelage (2014-16) and captured a total of five conference titles.
- During those final three seasons in Harrisonburg, Brooks and the Dukes compiled an impressive 60-3 record in conference play.
- He was named CAA Coach of the Year for a fourth time in 2015-16, while his student-athletes also garnered CAA Player and Rookie of the Year honors.

- Under Brooks, JMU tallied six CAA Players of the Year, three Rookies of the Year and two Defensive Players of the Year. The Dukes also recorded 31 All-CAA selection, 11 Defensive Team and 10 All-Rookie Team selections during his tenure.
- The Waynesboro, Virginia native has coached five WNBA Draft picks; Tamera Young, Lauren Okafor and Jazmon Gwathmey from JMU and Regan Magarity and Aisha Sheppard from Virginia Tech.
- BA 1992 graduate of JMU, Brooks played for three seasons under legendary coach Lefty Driessell and made two NIT appearances while earning a degree in business management. He began his coaching career as a part-time assistant for the 1993-94 JMU men's squad that won the CAA Tournament and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.
- After four seasons as an assistant for the men's program at VMI (1994-98), he moved back to his alma mater as a men's assistant from 1998-2002. He was named interim women's head coach on Dec. 6, 2002 before taking over those duties on a full-time basis on March 21, 2003.

### STATISTICALLY THE BEST

- Brooks has coached his team to leading the nation in a statistical category at both schools: JMU led D1 in rebound margin (+12.9) in 2008 and VT led D1 in free throw percentage in 2019 at 80%.

### KENNY'S FORTRESS IS CASSELL COLISEUM

- In his seven seasons in Blacksburg, Coach Brooks has enjoyed a 77-24 (.762) record in home games played on Carilion Clinic Court at Cassell Coliseum.
- He owns 22 victories by 30+ points against non-conference foes at home and is 49-1 against them in all competitions.

### COMMONWEALTH COMPETITION

- Brooks is 15-8 against the eight in-state foes that he has faced while at VT.
- This season the Hokies will face Longwood and Virginia.
- He is 4-0 vs. Radford, 3-0 vs. George Mason, 3-1 vs. Liberty, 2-0 vs. Richmond, 1-0 vs. Longwood, 1-0 vs. VCU, 4-6 vs. Virginia and 0-1 against JMU.
- Including games played at Cassell, Brooks is 81-29 (.736) in the state of Virginia as the head coach of the Hokies.

### MR. NOVEMBER

- Brooks' career record in the month of November is 81-23 (.778).
- In his 20 completed seasons of being a head coach he has finished the opening month of the season unblemished six times including three times with the Hokies; 2016, 2018 and 2020.

### IF AN EXTRA PERIOD IS NEEDED

- Brooks' career record after regulation is 20-12. He has posted a 4-3 record at VT in overtime.

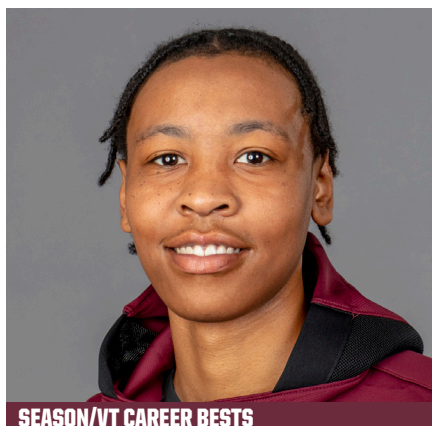

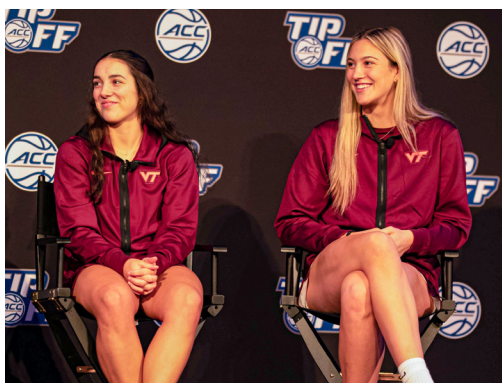

# MOUNT ST. MARY'S 45 NO. 13 VIRGINIA TECH 101

**CASSELL COLISEUM • BLACKSBURG, VA • NOV. 7, 2022 • ATTENDANCE: 2,104**

**BLACKSBURG** - Cayla King sets a program record with nine made three's on the way to a 101-45 win against the Mount St. Mary's Mountaineers at home Monday.

The Hokies (1-0) had five players score in double figures, led by King, who had 33 points. Elizabeth Kitley tacked on 18 points, nine rebounds and six blocks and Taylor Soule chipped in as well with 14 points and four steals.

Soule pulled down four offensive rebounds to lead an offense that racked up second chance opportunities for Virginia Tech, grabbing 13 boards and turning them into 19 second chance points.

Virginia Tech's defense held Mount St. Mary's to only 26.8 percent shooting from the field, including 24.2 percent from beyond the arc. The Hokies also limited Isabella Hunt to 3-of-12 shooting and six points in the game.

#### How It Happened

After jumping out to a 3-2 advantage, Virginia Tech went on a 20-0 run with 6:51 left in the first quarter, culminating in a three from King, to increase its lead to 23-2. The Hokies then lost some of that lead, but still entered the quarter break with a 23-5 advantage. Virginia Tech relied on its three-point shooting in the period, knocking down four shots to account for 12 of its 23 points.

Virginia Tech kept its first quarter lead intact before going on a 12-0 run starting at the 8:12 mark in the second period, highlighted by a three from Georgia Amore, to increase its lead to 37-10. The Mountaineers cut into that lead, but the Hokies still enjoyed a 43-19 advantage heading into halftime. Virginia Tech forced six Mount St. Mary's turnovers in the period and turned them into eight points.

Following intermission, Virginia Tech continued to expand its advantage, pushing it to 54-29 before going on a 12-0 run, punctuated by a basket from Kayana Traylor, to expand its lead further to 66-29 with 2:01 to go in the third. Before the conclusion of the third period, the Mountaineers had cut into that lead somewhat, but the Hokies still entered the fourth quarter with a 68-37 edge. Virginia Tech took advantage of six Mount St. Mary's turnovers in the quarter, scoring eight points off of takeaways.

Virginia Tech kept widening that lead, expanding it to 84-42 before going on a 17-0 run, finished off by Charlise Dunn's three, to grow the lead to 101-42 with 1:20 to go in the contest. The Mountaineers narrowed the margin somewhat before the game was over, but the Hokies still cruised the rest of the way for the 101-45 win. Virginia Tech fired away from deep in the quarter, knocking down six shots to account for 18 of its 33 points.

#### Game Notes

- » The Hokies made half of their attempts from three point range, knocking down 14 of 28 shots.
- » The Hokies held the Mountaineers to only 26.8 percent shooting from the field.
- » The Hokies never trailed after taking a 23-5 first quarter lead.
- » Virginia Tech tallied 21 total assists in the game.
- » Cayla King was deadly from behind the three point line, knocking down nine treys.
- » Five Virginia Tech players scored 10 or more points.
- » The Hokies turned 24 turnovers into 34 points on the offensive end.
- » Virginia Tech had a 45-23 edge on the boards in the win.
- » The Virginia Tech defense forced 24 turnovers.
- » The Hokies were active in affecting shots on the defensive end, tallying seven blocks as a team.
- » Virginia Tech cleaned up on the offensive glass, collecting 13 offensive boards in the game.
- » Cayla King led the Hokies with a game-high 33 points.
- » Virginia Tech got a game-high nine rebounds from Elizabeth Kitley.
