RAMS REVIEW

FIRST-YEAR FIREPOWER - Freshman trio of catcher Jacob Lee, second baseman Nick Flores and shortstop Nick April-Gath had impressive intro weekends to college baseball.

The trio compiled 13 hits, nine runs, seven RBI, two doubles and two home runs. Their combined 21 total bases through four games accounts for over half of the team's total (41).

ON BASE - Centerfielder Seth Werchan leads the Rams with a .500 on-base percentage. He reached base by HBP in the Rams' three most recent contests for a team-leading mark and ties for second on the team with four hits.

LEADING OFF - Nick Flores reached safely batting leadoff in the Rams' first three games (1B, HR, BB), in the fourth he reached on an error and came around to score.

His first collegiate at bat was a second-pitch single and he led off VCU's second game with a first-pitch homer.

TOUGH TO STRIKE OUT - Flores has struck out just once in a team-leading 15 at-bats entering the weekend.

FROM THE BULLPEN - Owen Tappy, the grad student closer, was named the No. 65 relief pitcher in D1Baseball's national preseason player rankings. He currently owns the Rams' win on the mound.

RAMS REVIEW (CONT.)

STRIKING EARLY - The Rams have scored first in three of their four games, scratching runs across in the first innings twice.

A leadoff homer by Nick Flores, a Collin Hughes sacrifice fly and an RBI double from Jacob Lee have the Rams' first inning performance tied with the fifth and eighth, for highest volume of cumulative runs scored.

OPPONENTS UNLOCKED - In addition to Clemson, VCU will face two more opponents in its first three weeks for the first time in program history; Toledo and Penn State, who will compete in the Central Virginia Classic weekend.

PRESEASON FAVORITES - Defending Atlantic 10 Champion VCU was selected as co-preseason favorites, with 2024 A-10 Rournament runner-up Richmond, to win the 2025 A-10 regular season title.

VCU captured the Atlantic 10 Tournament Championship in 2024 with its fourth undefeated run to the A-10 title, winning their third championship in four seasons.

TWINNING! - Twin bothers Casey and Cato Kleinman were reunited at the Division I level after Cato arrived at VCU this season. The pair have a unique story, as they have been teammates three times at the collegiate level. They both attended Santa Clara out of high school (2021) and each spent two seasons at Monterey Peninsula in 2022-23. Splitting up for the first time in 2024, Casey helped VCU to its A-10 title while Cato had an All-Conference season at Chaminade. With the addition of Cato to the Rams roster in 2025, the Kleinmans will close out their collegiate career together.

RAMS IN THE PROS - In the offseason, VCU had a pair of Rams make their MLB debuts as Connor Gillispie was called up to the Guardians and Tyler Locklear made his first appearance with the Seattle Mariners.

Also notable, VCU's 2024 draft class was the first time that three Rams heard their names called since 2019. Notably, Brandon Eike, a 13th round selection, joined Locklear in the Mariners organization and Christian Gordon (Cubs) went in the 16th round.

TOP 100 PROGRAMS - VCU rose again in D1Baseball's bi-annual rankings of the top 100 Division I baseball programs, appearing at #64 following the 2024 season. The rankings evaluate programs based on a multitude of factors, including five-year performance.

FRESH FRONT OFFICE - Head Coach Sean Thompson will coach his first game at Charleston. The first-year coach was elevated to the head role in July 2024 following the departure of Bradley Lecroy after two seasons.

Thompson, a 2018 graduate of VCU, became the program's eighth head coach and the second alum to take the reins, joining Bill Bailey '72, who served as the Rams' head coach in 1976-78.

DYNAMIC DUO - JoJo Howie, a 2015 Rams baseball alum, returned in the offseason to join Thompson's staff as pitching coach. Former teammates, Thompson and Howie helped guide the Rams squad to the program's first NCAA Super Regional in 2015.

REGIONAL RUN-IVERSARY - This year marks the 10-year anniversary of the Rams' 2015 NCAA Dallas Regional Championship, when VCU advanced to the program's first-ever Super Regional at Miami (Fla.). Two of the members of that team, Coach Sean Thompson and Coach JoJo Howie, currently serve on the coaching staff.

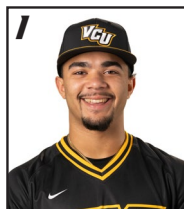

HEAD COACH



SEAN THOMPSON

Sean Thompson, who helped VCU capture Atlantic 10 Conference titles as both a player and coach, as well as an NCAA Regional Championship, was elevated to Head Coach on July 22, 2024.

Thompson, a 2018 VCU graduate and one of the most accomplished pitchers in program history, assumed the reigns after two separate stints as an assistant with the Rams. Thompson rejoined the program for the 2024 season as pitching coach and guided the VCU staff to the Atlantic 10 Conference's top ERA and helped lift the Black and Gold to a league championship and an NCAA Tournament berth. Thompson also played a pivotal role in the development of All-Atlantic 10 Conference pitchers Christian Gordon and Brian Curley, who were subsequently selected by the Cubs and Pirates, respectively, in the 2024 MLB Draft.

Prior to his recent VCU tenure, Thompson spent the 2023 season as an assistant coach at FIU. Working alongside first-year Head Coach Rich Whitten, a former VCU assistant coach, Thompson helped the Panthers to a five-win improvement.

In 2022, Thompson served as pitching coach at Monmouth, where he steered the Hawks to the MAAC's top ERA, as well as the league's second-most strikeouts and second-fewest walks. He also oversaw the development of unanimous 2022 MAAC Pitcher of the Year and First Team All-MAAC selection Trey Dombroski.

Under Thompson's guidance, Dombroski posted one of the best seasons by a Monmouth pitcher in program history with 120 strikeouts – most in program history – and a league-best 3.13 ERA. The lefty was later named Second Team All-American by Collegiate Baseball, ABCA Third Team All-American and ABCA First Team All-East Region for his efforts. He was a fourth-round selection by the Houston Astros organization in the 2022 MLB Draft, while teammate Rob Hensey was picked by the Cincinnati Reds in the ninth round.

In 2021 Thompson made his first return to Richmond, joining the staff as the Director of Pitching Development, where he worked with a Rams pitching staff that saw a pair of players, Tyler Davis and Mason Delane, named to the Atlantic-10 All-Rookie Team.

Thompson was a four-year standout on the mound for the Rams from 2015-18. During his career, which included an A-10 All-Rookie Team selection in 2015, Thompson compiled a 27-10 record and 3.30 ERA over 300 innings with 249 strikeouts. Thompson's 27 victories are the second-most ever by a VCU pitcher, and include the biggest win in program history. As a freshman in 2015, Thompson threw 5.1 innings one-run ball to earn a decision over Dallas Baptist and clinch VCU's first NCAA Regional Championship.

He also worked previously with Flood City Elite travel baseball as an assistant coach, as well as coaching as an assistant with Paul Carpenter's All-American Amateur Baseball Association, helping lead them to a 32-2 record.

Thompson graduated from VCU with a bachelor's degree in Business Communications in 2018.
