VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

- Villanova has earned the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for having the highest GPA out of all 12 teams in the league in each of the last two academic years.
- In the most recent release of NCAA Academic Progress Rate (APR) data, Villanova was one of just six Division I schools and three who play FCS football to have both their football and men's basketball teams be publicly recognized for having a multi-year APR score that ranked in the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide.
- Villanova had 46 student-athletes earn the CAA Commissioner's Academic Award for having a GPA higher than 3.2 in 2017-18. This was the highest number of any CAA Football school.
- Villanova had three student-athletes earn *Philadelphia Inquirer* Academic All-Area honors during the 2017 season. Offensive lineman **Matt Donoghue**, punter **John Hinch** and defensive lineman **Ricky Young** were each voted to the Academic All-Area squad for the combination of having a GPA above a 3.0 and for making key contributions on the field.

THIS WEEK'S NEWS AND NOTES

TODAY'S GAME

- **JMU History:** Villanova and James Madison have played each other during the regular season each year since the first meeting between the teams in 1993. The conference rivals also met in the quarterfinal round of the 2008 playoffs. James Madison currently leads the series by a 15-11 margin.
- **Hosting to Dukes:** James Madison will be making its 14th all-time trip to Villanova Stadium on Saturday afternoon. The Dukes are currently 6-7 in the previous 13 games played at Villanova.
- **Playing the Best:** Villanova will be playing against a nationally-ranked opponent for the third straight week. The team is 0-2 against ranked foes so far in 2018, with a 29-27 loss to No. 18 Stony Brook and a 13-10 setback against No. 25 Maine. Since becoming an FCS member in 1985, the Wildcats are 59-74 (.444) against nationally-ranked squads. More recently however, Villanova is 27-26 in matchups versus ranked teams since the start of the 2008 season.

TEAM NOTES

- **Tough Stretch:** Villanova will play its third straight ranked opponent this Saturday when the No. 6 ranked James Madison Dukes come to town. The Wildcats lost to No. 18 Stony Brook on Sept. 29 (29-27) and No. 25 Maine on Oct. 6 (13-10).

VILLANOVA OFFENSE

- **Moving the Sticks:** Villanova has done a good job of finding big plays and keeping the ball moving on offense this season. Through the first six games of the 2018 campaign, the Wildcats are leading CAA Football and rank 12th in the country with 131 first downs. The offense has tallied 68 first downs on pass plays, 53 on rushing plays and gotten 10 first downs on penalties.
- **Moving Up the Charts:** **Zach Bednarczyk** has moved up two spots on the Villanova all-time passing list in his past two games. Most recently he passed *Tom Colombo* (1989-92) and moved into sixth place on the Wildcats all-time list with 5,941 career yards in 34 games. Bednarczyk needs 300 yards to tie *Chris Whitney* (2007-10) for fifth place. Bednarczyk is also ranked sixth in school history in total offense with 7,134 total yards (5,941 passing; 1,193 rushing).

VILLANOVA DEFENSE

- **Pressure Points:** Villanova kept constant pressure on the Maine offense in last week's game and wound up forcing three turnovers, including two interceptions and a fumble recovery. The defense forced three fumbles in the game, with junior safety **Julian Williams**, junior linebacker **Drew Wiley** and sophomore safety **Nowoola Awopetu** all forcing fumbles. It was the first time since last season against Towson that the Wildcats tallied three forced fumbles in a game. Villanova had only recorded one forced fumble in its first five games this season prior to the Maine game.

THIS WEEK'S NEWS AND NOTES

- **Stopping the Run:** Villanova has held 28 of its last 66 opponents since the start of the 2013 season to fewer than 100 rushing yards, with 13 of those opponents rushing for fewer than 50 yards against the Wildcats defense. The trend has been interrupted in the past two weeks when Stony Brook ran for 161 yards on 47 carries and Maine rushed for 143 yards on 41 attempts.

- **Turnover Tales:** With the three turnovers the defense forced at Maine last week, the Wildcats improved their turnover margin on the season to +2. Villanova has turned the ball over on 11 occasions in 2018 (six interceptions, five lost fumbles) and has recovered 13 turnovers by its opponents (nine interceptions, four fumble recoveries).
- **Picking Off Passes:** Both quarterbacks in this Saturday's game between Villanova and James Madison will have to be careful in the passing game. In the latest CAA Football statistics, the Wildcats and the Dukes are tied for the league lead with nine interceptions by their defenses. Villanova has had six different players record at least one interception on the year, including senior linebacker **Jeff Steeb** and freshman corners **Christian Benford** and **Elijah Trent** who have each recorded two picks. Junior linebacker **Keeling Hunter** registered his first interception of the season at Maine; Hunter was the team leader with four interceptions last year.
- **Defensive Playmaker:** The Wildcats received a strong contribution from junior safety **Julian Williams** in last week's 13-10 loss at Maine. In addition to his four total tackles, Williams tallied an interception and a fumble recovery. The fumble recovery gave Villanova the ball at the Maine 16-yard line and led to the team's only touchdown of the game. This is the second straight year that a Wildcats defender has recorded both an interception and a fumble recovery against the Black Bears. Rasaan Stewart had one of each last season in a 31-0 win over Maine at Villanova Stadium.
- **Blocked Kick:** Junior defensive lineman **Jafonta Johnson** blocked a 40-yard field goal attempt by Maine in the fourth quarter last week. He was the first Villanova player to block a field goal attempt by the opponent since current Kansas City Chiefs linebacker **Tanoh Kpassagnon** blocked a Pittsburgh field goal attempt in the 2016 season opener.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- **Special Teams Standout:** Freshman punter **Nathan Fondacaro** was sensational in last week's game at Maine when he punted six times for an average of 47.3 yards per punt. One of his punts last week included a career-long 63-yard effort. For the year, he has punted 25 times for 1,068 yards for an average of 42.7 yards per punt. Of the 25 punts, nine have been placed inside the 20-yard line and five have been 50 yards or longer.
