VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

- Villanova has earned the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for having the highest GPA out of all 12 teams in the league in each of the last two academic years.
- In the most recent release of NCAA Academic Progress Rate (APR) data, Villanova was one of just six Division I schools and three who play FCS football to have both their football and men's basketball teams be publicly recognized for having a multi-year APR score that ranked in the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide.
- Villanova had 46 student-athletes earn the CAA Commissioner's Academic Award for having a GPA higher than 3.2 in 2017-18. This was the highest number of any CAA Football school.
- Villanova had three student-athletes earn *Philadelphia Inquirer* Academic All-Area honors during the 2017 season. Offensive lineman **Matt Donoghue**, punter **John Hinch** and defensive lineman **Ricky Young** were each voted to the Academic All-Area squad for the combination of having a GPA above a 3.0 and for making key contributions on the field.

THIS WEEK'S NEWS AND NOTES

TODAY'S GAME

- **It's Been A While:** Despite both being members of CAA Football, Villanova and New Hampshire will be playing for the first time since 2013 when the two teams do battle on Saturday afternoon. In that last matchup, New Hampshire tallied a 29-28 home win on October 19, 2013.
- **Hosting New Hampshire:** New Hampshire will be visiting Villanova Stadium for the first time since November 13, 2010. In that game, New Hampshire tallied a 31-24 victory. New Hampshire is 5-6 all-time at Villanova Stadium but leads the all-time series with Villanova by a narrow 12-11 margin.
- **Flashbacks:** Villanova was the defending national champion when New Hampshire made its last visit to the Main Line in 2010. The regular season meeting in 2010 followed a home playoff game against New Hampshire in 2009 in which Villanova tallied a 46-7 victory on its way towards winning the program's first-ever national title. The playoff game was played during an early December blizzard and several inches of snow coated the field during the contest. Villanova set a school record in that game by holding New Hampshire to minus-66 rushing yards.
- **Not What They're Used To:** Villanova and New Hampshire are perennially two of the stronger teams in CAA Football, and when the two teams face each other the matchup has typically been a high-profile one. In fact, this Saturday's game will be the first time since 2001 that the teams play each other when neither one is nationally-ranked. One of the two teams has been ranked in each of the last 10 meetings in the all-time series, with both teams being ranked in six of those head-to-head matchups.
- **Well Rested:** Villanova returns to action this week after having a bye last Saturday. The Wildcats are 13-4 in the last 17 games coming off a bye. Last season, Villanova suffered a 19-14 loss to Elon following the bye.
- **Homecoming History:** It is Homecoming Weekend at Villanova and the Wildcats will be trying to continue their historical success in the annual Homecoming football game. Villanova is 34-19 all-time on Homecoming Weekend, and have won three of the last four Homecoming games.

TEAM NOTES

- **Shutout:** Villanova was shut out for the first time this season and only the third time in the last 14 years when it fell to James Madison, 37-0, two weeks ago. The other shutouts since the start of the 2005 campaign were against Richmond in 2016 (23-0) and in 2017 (22-0). The last time the Wildcats were shut out while allowing 37 or more points was in a 41-0 loss at Maryland during the 1974 season.
- **Giving Up a Punt Return:** In the James Madison game two weeks ago, the Dukes had D'Angelo Amos return two punts for touchdowns in the 37-0 outcome. Villanova had not allowed a punt return touchdown since September 23, 2006 when Greg Ambrogi of Penn had a 60-yard return for a score. The Wildcats have allowed just four punt return touchdowns in the last 19 years (since the start of the 2000 season).
- **What the Numbers Say:** Despite the 37-0 final score against James Madison, it was actually both teams that were held below what their season averages on offense had been entering the game. Villanova was averaging 28.5 points and 414.8 total yards per contest, but its short-handed offense was held to 157 yards in the shutout loss. On the flip side, the Dukes were averaging 426.0 total yards per game entering Saturday's contest but were held to 302 yards by the Wildcats defense.

- **Statistical Oddity:** In the last two games against Maine and James Madison, neither the Wildcats nor their opponent have thrown a passing touchdown. Prior to this year, there had only been 10 games in the previous 15 seasons in which neither Villanova nor the other team had at least one passing touchdown, and none of those 10 contests occurred in consecutive outings.

THIS WEEK'S NEWS AND NOTES

VILLANOVA OFFENSE

- **Milestone Watch:** Senior running back **Aaron Forbes** needs just 79 more rushing yards to become the 11th player in school history to reach 2,000 yards for his career. Forbes has played in 38 career games and has rushed for 1,921 yards and 13 touchdowns on 360 carries (5.3 average yards per rush). Through the first seven games this season, Forbes is leading the Wildcats with 445 rushing yards and four touchdowns. In addition to his rushing totals, Forbes also has 41 career receptions for 306 yards and four scores.
- **Moving Up the Charts:** **Zach Bednarczyk** has moved up two spots on the Villanova all-time passing list in his past two games. Most recently he passed *Tom Colombo* (1989-92) and moved into sixth place on the Wildcats all-time list with 5,941 career yards in 34 games. Bednarczyk needs 300 yards to tie *Chris Whitney* (2007-10) for fifth place. Bednarczyk is also ranked sixth in school history in total offense with 7,134 total yards (5,941 passing; 1,193 rushing). Despite not playing in the last two games due to injury, Bednarczyk still ranks third in CAA Football this season with 12 passing touchdowns. He is also fifth in the league with 80 points responsible for.

VILLANOVA DEFENSE

- **National Recognition:** STATS FCS Football announced on Oct. 11 the 15 freshmen who have been named to the Jerry Rice Award Watch List. The award, named after the legendary Hall of Fame wide receiver, is given to the top freshman in FCS Football. Villanova freshman cornerback Christian Benford was one of the 15 players named to the list. Benford has played in five of the seven games this year and has tallied 32 tackles (26 solo), two interceptions, one tackle for loss and one pass break-up. Benford missed last week's game at Maine due to an injury. For his efforts in 2012, Villanova quarterback John Robertson won the Jerry Rice Award. Robertson went on to win the Walter Payton Award in 2014 as the top player in FCS Football. A national panel of over 150 sports information and media relations directors, broadcasters, writers and other dignitaries will vote on the award following the regular season.
- **Philly Connection:** Two defensive players from Philadelphia were among the top performers for the Wildcats in the James Madison game. Sophomore cornerback **Jaquan Amos** had a team-high nine tackles, including half a tackle for loss, in addition to defending two passes with an interception and a pass breakup. Sophomore linebacker **Amin Black** made his first career start and finished the day with six total tackles, including two tackles for loss and a sack.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- **Fantastic Fondacaro:** Freshman punter Nathan Fondacaro was one of the bright spots for Villanova in the James Madison game. He was credited with seven punts for an average of 45.9 yards, including four attempts of 50 yards or longer and a long punt of 57 yards for the day. He has now drilled nine punts of at least 50 yards this season while landing 10 of his 32 attempts inside the 20-yard line. Fondacaro is averaging 43.4 yards per punt on the year.
