TOP STORIES

• Villanova battled its way to its 16th victory in its last 17 Philadelphia Big Five outings on Thursday night at the Pavilion, rallying from a nine point halftime deficit to down Saint Joseph's 59-56. The victory also pushed the Wildcats' winning streak at the Pavilion to 21 straight games.

• Tonight's contest against the Explorers completes a cycle of 11 games inside 30 days for Villanova to open the season. It also marks the Wildcats 'third game in six days this week. Following tonight's contest, the team takes an eight day break as exams begin at the university.

• Senior Dwayne Anderson's insertion into the starting lineup last Feb. 9 helped ignite Villanova's late-season charge into the NCAA Tournament. On Thursday night he returned to the starting lineup for the first time in 2008-09 after missing seven of the season's first nine games with a stress reaction in his left foot. The 6-6 native of Silver Spring, Md., contributed 10 points and two steals in 31 minutes against the Hawks.

• One key to the victory on Thursday night was free throw shooting. After not stepping to the line in the first half, Villanova sank 14-of-16 of its attempts after intermission, including four crucial makes by Scottie Reynolds and Dante Cunningham in the final 4.8 seconds. The 'Cats have connected on .777 of their free throws through 10 games and ranked ninth nationally in this week's NCAA statistics in that category.

Big Five Battle to the Wire

As one who grew up with and appreciates its history, Villanova head coach Jay Wright has a longstanding affection for the City Series. But as the leader of a unit looking to rally the troops after a Tuesday night loss to No. 6 Texas, Wright brought with him to the Pavilion a fair amount of anxiety on Thursday night.

His coaching concerns manifested themselves as Villanova had to fend off a serious challenge from Saint Joseph's to emerge with a 59-56 victory that was settled in the game's final 10 seconds.

"This is what everybody paid for and remembers about the Big Five," stated Wright. "This was a classic. As a fan I love them but as a coach I don't love the classics. Saint Joseph's played great. They came into this building and played better than us.

"They deserved it but we gutted it out."

The Hawks were in control of the contest in the first half, building a 35-26 edge on the strength of 56 percent shooting from the floor. The Wildcats, meanwhile, struggled to get their offense going.

As is often the case, Villanova used stout defense to give its offense a push. The Wildcats clawed their way back into a 53-52 lead when Reggie Redding sank a jumper with 2:56 left. The contest became a battle of wills and it wasn't until Dante Cunningham stole an inbound pass with four seconds left that the crowd of 6,500 in the Pavilion could exhale.

"I was really proud of our attitude tonight," Wright stated. "We battled through some of the mistakes and found a way."

Reynolds Wrap

Offensive fireworks have been a Scottie Reynolds trademark since he came to Villanova in 2007. But for much of this early season his contributions have come in a wide range of areas that haven't always included points.

On Thursday night, however, he found himself in a familiar role as chief scoring catalyst and crunch time playmaker for the Wildcats. He ended the night with 18 points, including the critical free throws with 4.8 seconds left in regulation that gave Villanova a 57-56 lead.

With VU trailing by one and 10.9 seconds left, Wright had instructed Reynolds to take the ball and make a play. He did and was fouled in the act of shooting by Idris Hilliard.

"With such a small amount of time on the clock we are going to put the ball in his hands every time," stated Wright. "He has won so many games for us."

That was true even on a night when Reynolds was not in his top shooting groove. He was 5-of-15 from the field but his knack for getting to the line paid dividends again. He is 46-of-52 (.885) at the line after dropping in all five of his attempts on Thursday.

In 76 career games, Reynolds has attempted four or more free throws 55 times. In those games, Villanova is 40-15 (.727).

Reynolds was named a pre-season All BIG EAST selection. On Nov. 7, it was announced that he is one of 50 players nationally included on the Wooden Award Preseason watch list.

This season Reynolds averages 3.5 rpg and leads the team with 49 assists (4.9 apg).

Dante's Inferno

Over the course of his first three seasons, Dante Cunningham has been one of Villanova's most dependable defenders, rebounders and leaders. His offense, though, has typically taken a backseat to that of such gifted scorers as Reynolds, Randy Foye, Kyle Lowry, and Curtis Sumpter.

But in 2008-09 Cunningham has moved to the forefront as a major offensive weapon.

"It's pretty much me understanding where shots are coming from and understanding where my teammates have to be to deliver the ball to me," says Cunningham of his offensive gains. "Our guards are getting it done on their end and I'm trying to get it done on my end."

Already this season the 6-8 product of Silver Spring, Md., has twice been named to the BIG EAST Honor Roll and was most valuable player of the Philly Hoop Group Classic. Dating back to last season, he has now scored in double figures in 12 straight games.

On Thursday night he came up with 14 points, four rebounds and that critical steal of the inbound pass with Saint Joseph's eager to take a crack at winning the game.

Cunningham is now 68-of-117 (.581) from the floor this season. He is presently averaging 11.7 shots per game, up from a 7.5 attempt per game average last year.

"Dante has developed into a confident scorer," said Wright. "We have to find more ways to get him the ball."

Cunningham also leads VU in rebounding at 8.0 rpg. He now has 612 career caroms, good for 30th place all-time at Villanova.

Pena Power

It wasn't the stuff of headlines but sophomore forward Antonio Pena made a meaningful contribution to Thursday night's Big Five victory over Saint Joseph's. The 6-8 native of Brooklyn, N.Y., spent most of his night attempting to keep Ahmad Nivins in check and he limited Nivins to six points after intermission.

Pena also grabbed a team-high eight rebounds in 30 minutes (also a season-high).

"Tone did a nice job for us guarding a great player," stated Wright.

The graduate of St. Thomas More School (Conn.) has started all 10 games for Villanova this season, averaging 7.8 points and 5.3 rebounds.

"Dante's off to a great start but in Antonio Pena we have a guy who is getting closer to being that kind of player too," notes Wright.

Defensive Doings

When Villanova jumped out to an 9-1 start a season ago, much of the success could be attributed to an offense that averaged 81.5 ppg.

This year's similar getaway, though, has been as much a product of stout defense as it has superior scoring. While the 'Cats are averaging a respectable 75.4 ppg, they have been just as effective at the other end of the court.

Villanova has limited its opponents to 200-of-518 (.386) shooting from the field thus far in 2008-09 and 57.7 ppg. The 'Cats have not surrendered more than 68 points this season.

In addition, teams are converting just .317 (64-of-202) of their 3-point field goal attempts against VU. Through early February in 2007-08, VU ranked last in 3-point field goal defense in the BIG EAST.

To look at the final boxscore from Thursday night's win at the Pavilion, one would be hardpressed to cite how junior guard Reggie Redding impacted the game. He scored six points and collected two rebounds in 13 minutes.

Yet he may have converted Villanova's two biggest baskets of the evening.

The first pulled the Wildcats to within 50-49 with 4:21 left. The second gave Villanova a 53-52 advantage with 2:52 left. For good measure, he added two free throws with 56 seconds left to give his team the lead again.

"Reggie was awesome," stated Wright. "He does everything for us whenever we need him and wherever we need him."

'Cats Sign Trio of Standouts

A trio of nationally prominent seniors have inked national letters of intent to attend Villanova University in the fall of 2009, it was announced today. The group includes forward Isaiah Armwood from Montrose Christian Academy (Rockville, Md.); guard Maalik Wayns of Philadelphia's Roman Catholic High School and power forward Mouphtaou Yarou, a native of Benin in the republic of West Africa who also attends Montrose Christian Academy.

ESPN.com ranks the class as No. 2 in the nation.

"We are as excited about this class as any we have brought to Villanova," stated head coach Jay Wright. "This group offers us a unique combination of frontcourt and backcourt talent with exceptional skill and incredible character. The loyalty each of these young men has shown to our program through this process is heartwarming to all of us in the Villanova Basketball Family."

Armwood, 6-8, is a versatile forward who has been a fixture for national prep powerhouse Montrose Christian Academy. He averaged 12 points and eight rebounds as a junior before being sidelined by a left knee injury. It is expected that he will be a key performer in his final prep season for Montrose. He is listed as the No. 35 ranked prospect on ESPNU's Top 100 list.

"Isaiah is an athletically gifted wing player who has played four years for coach Stu Vetter at Montrose Christian Academy," stated Wright. "He has been well-schooled in the fundamentals. We expect him to make an immediate impact at Villanova with his quickness and athleticism."

Wayns is a 6-1 guard who averaged 22.4 points, 5.1 assists and 4.8 rebounds per game as a junior at Roman Catholic High School. Last summer, he represented the United States as a member of USA Basketball's 18-and-under team that competed in Argentina. He is ranked by espn.com as the No. 22 senior in the country.

"Maalik Wayns is the leader of this class," said Wright. "He was the first one of this group to commit to us and he encouraged his friends Isaiah and Mough (Yarou) to join him at Villanova. Maalik will be the next in the line of great Villanova guards. We're so proud to have another Roman Catholic Cahillite with us on the Villanova campus."

Rounding out the group of fall signees is Yarou, a 6-9 power forward

who in a short period of time in the United States has emerged as one of the nation's most coveted big men - the No. 27 rated senior prospect in the nation according to espn.com. He enjoyed a breakthrough summer on the AAU circuit and will play this season for Vetter at Montrose Christian Academy.

"Mough' is as skilled a power forward as any frontcourt recruit we have had at Villanova," Wright stated. "He is very intelligent, extremely hard working and will be playing for a legendary coach this season in Stu Vetter at Montrose Christian Academy. Mough will make an immediate impact on our team with his rebounding and shot blocking ability."

Philadelphia Big Five

The Big Five has been part of the Philadelphia basketball scene since 1955 and the City Series a key part of the 'Cats December slate. The Wildcats, who have won or shared the city crown in each of the past four seasons, picked up wins over Penn (Dec. 2) and Saint Joseph's (Dec. 11) in their first two outings. Happy at Home

Villanova will play home games at three sites in 2008-09: the Pavilion, Wachovia Center and Wachovia Spectrum.

The Wildcats have played before a sellout crowd of 6,500 at the Pavilion for 88 consecutive regular season games. The last time they failed to do so came during a snow storm in December of 2000.

Villanova is 44-4 (.917) in the building on Ithan Avenue since 2005. It is now 205-54 (.791) all-time in the Pavilion. Since the start of the 1994-95 season, VU is 143-22 (.867) in the Pavilion. The 'Cats are 73-12 (.859) in Pavilion home games under Jay Wright.

The Wildcats will host three BIG EAST games at the Wachovia Center in Philadelphia this season, beginning on Jan. 10 (Louisville). VU then returns to the Center on Feb. 7 against Syracuse and Feb. 28 when it welcomes Georgetown to the building. Villanova has averaged better than 19,000 in attendance in its Center games since 2005.

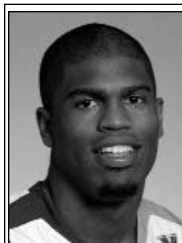

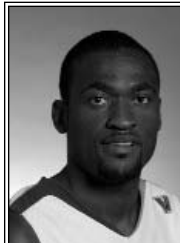
