What to Know Before First Pitch

- ▶ Villanova begins BIG EAST play with a 9-11 record following a 4-0 loss to La Salle on Tuesday. That loss was the first time this season that the team has been shut out by its opponent.
- ▶ This weekend's three-game series will be a chance for two longtime conference rivals to renew their acquaintances. Villanova and Seton Hall did not play each other last season as a result of the rotating conference schedule. Seton Hall last visited the Villanova Ballpark at Plymouth in 2009, when the Wildcats won two games in a three-game set.
- ▶ In his 10th season as head coach of the Wildcats, **Joe Godri** is 12-11 (.522) against the Pirates, with a 6-5 record in home games and a 5-6 record in games at Seton Hall. The teams also met during the BIG EAST Championship back in 2008, with Villanova winning 10-0 in Clearwater, Fla.
- ▶ Senior closer **Mike Francisco** was named to this week's BIG EAST Honor Roll after he registered saves in all three games he appeared in last week. Francisco tied the Villanova career saves record in a 7-6 win versus Manhattan on Sunday afternoon.
- ▶ Junior right fielder **Matt Fleishman** has reached base safely in 16 consecutive games and has been the most consistent Villanova hitter this season. Fleishman is batting a team-best .342 with eight doubles, three home runs, 16 runs batted in and a .608 slugging percentage through 20 games.

MAJORING IN HISTORY

The 2011 season marks the 146th year of Villanova baseball, making the Wildcats the third oldest varsity baseball program in the nation. The two schools with older baseball programs than Villanova are Fordham (151st season) and Yale (147th season).

Villanova has 10 seasons with at least 30 victories, two years with at least 40 wins and an all-time record of 1,780-1,262-29 (.584).

THE 'K' CORNER (MAR. 24): Villanova begins play this weekend leading the BIG EAST Conference in strikeouts per nine innings by its pitching staff. Through their first 20 games of the season the Wildcats have struck out 157 batters in 171.0 innings pitched for an average of 8.26 strikeouts per nine innings. This figure is not only the best in the BIG EAST but also ranks 38th in the entire nation.

WEDNESDAY'S GAME IS FIRST CANCELLATION (MAR 23): Through the first five weeks of the season Villanova has been remarkably lucky with the weather, as the team played each of its first 20 scheduled games without any cancellations or changes due to weather. That stretch included the team being able to play its first eight home games -- encompassing both the Villanova Classic and the Big Five Baseball Bash tournaments -- without interruption, a rarity in recent years. The luck ran out on the team this past Wednesday when the Wildcats game at Penn was cancelled due to wet weather and cold conditions. The game will not be rescheduled.

SCORING OPPORTUNITIES GO UNREDEEMED (MAR. 22): In its 4-0 loss to La Salle on Tuesday afternoon, Villanova had plenty of chances to cash in on run-scoring opportunities thanks to getting seven hits, drawing five walks and having one batter get hit by a pitch. Once there were runners on base, however, the offense went quiet and the Wildcats finished the day going 0-for-12 with runners in scoring position. Villanova is hitting .260 with runners in scoring position for the season, while its opponents bat .325 in the same situations.

WALK TO FIRST, STEAL SECOND (MAR. 22): In the game at La Salle on Tuesday afternoon senior second baseman **Dain Hall** went 2-for-2 with two walks and a stolen base. He continues to ascend the Villanova career lists in each of the latter two categories and now ranks fifth all-time in school history in stolen bases and eighth in walks.

FANTASTIC FLEISHMAN (MAR. 22): Junior right fielder **Matt Fleishman** had a double for his only hit of the game against La Salle this past Tuesday and with that hit extended his current streak of games reaching base safely to 16 in a row. Fleishman has had a hit in 13 of the 16 games and has reached via a walk in the other three contests.

So far this season Fleishman has been the top hitter for the Wildcats and he starts play this weekend leading the team in seven different offensive categories. Fleishman is batting .342 (27-for-79) with eight doubles, two triples and three home runs to compile a .608 slugging percentage. He also has 16 RBI and is tied for the team lead with 15 runs scored. In addition to his offensive performance, Fleishman has also been outstanding in the field for Villanova and has already racked up six outfield assists in 20 games. Fleishman has totaled 69 putouts and seven assists with no errors in his Wildcats career.

OSTAPECK ON A ROLL (MAR. 22): Villanova has received more consistent contributions from its bullpen lately and one of the biggest reasons why has been the terrific relief pitching of sophomore right-hander **Stephen Ostapeck**. In his most recent outing Ostapeck pitched three scoreless innings with three strikeouts and only two hits allowed against La Salle this past Tuesday and in the process extended his consecutive scoreless innings streak to 9 1/3 innings. Prior to the La Salle game, Ostapeck pitched a career-high five scoreless innings and registered a career-best six strikeouts while allowing just two hits in a come-from-behind, 8-4 victory over St. Peter's. He earned his first career victory in that game. Ostapeck has made seven appearances this season and is 1-0 with a 2.12 ERA and 16 strikeouts in 17.0 innings pitched.

FRANCISCO NAMED TO WEEKLY HONOR ROLL (MAR. 21): Senior closer **Mike Francisco** was named to the weekly BIG EAST Honor Roll this Monday for the first time in his career. In three appearances during games played from March 14-20, Francisco had three saves and retired all 10 batters he faced over 3 1/3 innings pitched. FRANCISCO TIES CAREER SAVES RECORD (MAR. 20): In Sunday's 7-6 win over Manhattan senior closer **Mike Francisco** pitched a perfect ninth inning with two strikeouts to register the 17th save of his career. That total ties him for the Villanova career record with James Russell (2000-03) and puts him just one more save away from holding the school mark on his own. Francisco has also moved up to fourth place on the school's career list for games pitched.

QUITE A STREAK FOR FRANCISCO (MAR. 20): The timing could not have been any better for senior closer **Mike Francisco** to tie the Villanova career saves record in his most recent appearance. Francisco has been on quite a roll recently and over his last five outings has retired 17 consecutive batters, with nine of those outs coming in strikeouts. Francisco is tied for the BIG EAST lead with six saves this season and overall has made nine appearances for the year. He has logged 10 2/3 innings pitched this season and struck out 16 batters to average 13.50 strikeouts per nine innings. Francisco also is holding opposing hitters to a .205 batting average against him. Overall, he is 0-2 on the year with a 2.53 ERA and his nine games pitched tie him for the team lead.

RALLY CATS EDGE MANHATTAN (MAR. 20): For the second time in three games Villanova came from behind to win on its home field but the 7-6 win over Manhattan last Sunday afternoon was a particularly exciting one. After trailing 2-1 through the early innings the Wildcats surrendered three unearned runs in the top of the sixth inning to fall into a four-run hole. As they came up in the bottom of the sixth the Wildcats only had two hits in the game but the team came up with four runs on five hits in bottom of the sixth inning and tied the score at 5-5 just as quickly as the Jaspers had extended their own lead.

The tie didn't last long, as Manhattan scored a single run with two outs in the top of the seventh to go back in front 6-5, but Villanova once again answered right away. With two outs in the bottom of the seventh inning, sophomore **Steve Schrenk** delivered a pinch-hit, two-run double which plated two runs to give the Wildcats their first and only lead of the game at 7-6.

SCHRENK STILL STRONG AS A PINCH HITTER (MAR. 20): Sophomore outfielder **Steve Schrenk** has started six of the 12 games he has played in this season and has reached base safely in all of those contests (see note below). His most significant contributions, however, have come in the games that he enters off the bench. As a pinch hitter this season Schrenk has gone 2-for-5 with a walk, double and two RBI. In last Sunday's 7-6 win over Manhattan, Schrenk had a two-out, two-run pinch hit double in the bottom of the seventh inning to score the tying and winning runs for Villanova, which took its only lead of the game on Schrenk's hit. In his career wearing a Wildcats uniform, Schrenk is an outstanding .350 hitter (7-20) in pinch hitting opportunities and has also drawn a pair of walks, good for a .409 on-base percentage as a pinch hitter.

STRONG AS STARTERS (MAR. 20): Sophomore outfielder **Steve Schrenk** and freshman first baseman **Tyler Reich** have each started six games this year. On the surface, their contributions wouldn't appear to be anything special; Schrenk has batted .200 (4-for-20) in his starts while Reich is hitting .125 (2-for-16) as a starter.

Digging a little dipper shows a different story, though, as both players have reached base safely at least once via a hit or a walk in all six of their starts. Reich has been particularly good at getting on base and has drawn eight walks to post a .417 on-base percentage when in the starting lineup. He also has played great defense at first base with 25 putouts and no errors. Villanova has gone 4-2 in the games that Reich has started.

MASTERFUL MCMYNE (MAR. 19): In his fifth start of the season last Saturday against Fairfield, junior right-hander **Kyle McMyne** tossed six scoreless innings and allowed just three hits while striking out eight to earn his third win of the season. McMyne (3-2, 3.19 ERA) has been outstanding in his last three starts, going 2-1 with a 1.35 ERA in that span, which includes 20.0 innings pitched, 26 strikeouts and just 15 hits allowed.

Entering his start against Seton Hall this weekend, McMyne leads the BIG EAST Conference with 39 strikeouts for the season, even though he is only tied for 10th in innings pitched with 31.0. He is holding opponents to a .212 batting average against him and has posted a 1.29 WHIP in his 31.0 innings (24 hits allowed and 16 walks). His 39 strikeouts on the season rank him 24th in the nation.

2011 Season



JONES BREAKS OUT (MAR. 19): Last Saturday in a 4-3 win over Fairfield freshman **Connor Jones** snapped an 0-for-18 drought at the plate with a big hit for Villanova. In the bottom of the third inning with the Wildcats already ahead 3-0, Jones drove a 1-and-0 pitch deep into the gap in left-center field for a double that brought home Matt Fleishman with the fourth Wildcats run of the game. That proved to be the winning run in the contest, as the Stags later scored three times in the seventh inning to pull to within one run.

SURGING PAST ST. PETER'S (MAR. 18): In the first game of last weekend's Big Five Baseball Bash the Wildcats rallied from a 4-0 deficit after the top of the third inning with eight unanswered runs and won the game by an 8-4 final. Senior second baseman **Dain Hall** was in the middle of the comeback, as he drove in the tying run in the bottom of the fifth inning and scored the eventual winning run in the bottom of the seventh. Also in this game, pitchers **Matt Lengel** and **Stephen Ostapeck** registered seven called third strikes on the Peacocks hitters.

BEST OF BATTIPAGLIA (MAR. 16): In the 5-2 win over Lehigh on March 16 junior right-handed pitcher **Jerry Battipaglia** established career highs for both innings pitched and strikeouts in his second start of the season. He tossed eight innings of four-hit ball with just one earned run allowed while striking out six. Battipaglia finished strong by setting down the last eight batters he faced and 11 of the last 12 hitters he saw. He needed just nine pitches to get through the sixth inning and then threw only four pitches to retire the side in order in the seventh inning. In two starts this season, Battipaglia has gone 2-0 with a 1.38 ERA while allowing eight hits and striking out 10 in 13.0 innings pitched.

TWO OUTS, NO HITS (MAR. 16): A big part of the March 16 win over Lehigh was the ability of Villanova pitching to shut the door on the Mountain Hawks batters with two outs. Lehigh went 0-for-9 with two outs in the game and was also just 1-for-12 with runners on base in the contest. The only two runs scored by the Mountain Hawks came in on sacrifice flies in the fourth and fifth innings, respectively.

WORKS FOR WAGER (MAR. 16): When Villanova played Cornell on March 13 head coach **Joe Godri** moved junior first baseman **Kevin Wager** into the leadoff spot for the first time in his career. Wager responded by reaching base four times thanks to three hits and a walk as Villanova registered a 6-3 win. Wager wound up spending four games in the leadoff spot of the order and batted .333 (6-for-18) with just one strikeout in 20 plate appearances.

YOUNG PROVIDES RELIEF (MAR. 13): Freshman pitcher **Pat Young** had back-to-back outstanding relief appearances against Bucknell (Mar. 8) and Cornell (Mar. 13) in which he combined to pitch 6 1/3 innings with only one earned run on three hits allowed, while he walked three and struck out nine. Young was especially good in a 6-3 win over Cornell, when he earned his first collegiate victory with four hitless and scoreless innings of relief. He walked one and struck out five while pitching the fifth through eighth innings. Young has pitched four games out of the bullpen this season and has compiled a 1.80 ERA and a 1.10 WHIP in 10.0 innings pitched, with eight hits allowed and 12 strikeouts.

STRANDED ON BASE (MAR. 11): So far this season the Villanova bullpen has struggled at times with allowing inherited runners to score. That was not the case in a game against Mount St. Mary's on March 11, however, as junior **Julian Diaz** and sophomore **Matt Longfield** each inherited two runners and stranded both on base while combining to register the final five outs of the game without allowing an earned run to score.

MCMYNE IS BIG FIVE PITCHER OF THE WEEK (MAR. 7): For the third straight week to start the season, Villanova received one of the weekly awards from the Philadelphia Big Five when junior right-handed pitcher **Kyle McMyne** was chosen as the Pitcher of the Week on March 7. The recognition came after McMyne worked seven strong innings with 10 strikeouts to earn the win in a 4-3 decision at UNC-Wilmington.

NOTEWORTHY PERFORMANCE FOR MCMYNE (MAR. 4): In a 4-3 win at UNC-Wilmington on March 4, junior right-hander **Kyle McMyne** not only pitched his best game of the season to that point but also notched a pair of strikeout milestones in the process. McMyne allowed just one earned run while striking out 10 batters in seven innings and earned his second win of the season. He struck out the side in the first inning and the last of those three strikeouts was the 100th of his collegiate career. The start also marked the second time in his career that McMyne reached double digits in strikeouts in a game.

ONE AT A TIME (MAR. 4): In its 4-3 win against UNC-Wilmington on March 4, Villanova was just 2-for-10 with runners in scoring position in the game but the team did advance runners on 10-of-18 opportunities to give themselves a chance to score runs with a station-to-station offense. The host Seahawks, however, were only 5-of-19 in advancing runners and went 1-for-10 with runners in scoring position.

HELISEK RECOGNIZED BY BIG EAST AND BIG FIVE (FEB. 28): Junior left-handed pitcher **Kyle Helisek** was voted the Philadelphia Big Five Pitcher of the Week on February 28 and also garnered a spot on the weekly BIG EAST Honor Roll. The awards came after Helisek tossed seven scoreless innings with just two hits allowed against Duke in his second start of the season. He retired 15 of the first 19 batters he faced while not allowing a hit through the first 5 1/3 innings. Helisek exited the game with a 1-0 lead after seven innings but the Blue Devils eventually rallied against the Wildcats bullpen for a 5-1 victory.

AGAINST THE ACC (FEB. 27): Following a three-game sweep at the hands of Duke from February 25-27, head coach **Joe Godri** is now 1-10 in his career versus teams from the Atlantic Coast Conference. The first five losses all came prior to the 2005 season. Villanova knocked off Virginia Tech, 5-3, in a tournament hosted by Savannah State back in 2005. *Note: Godri's record versus ACC teams does not include games that Villanova played against Boston College and Virginia Tech while those teams were members of the BIG EAST Conference.*

FIVE IN A ROW (FEB. 26): Junior left fielder **Andrew Geenen** made his Villanova debut by getting a hit in each of the first five games of the season. Geenen batted .353 (6-for-17) during his five-game hitting streak before going hitless in two at-bats against Duke in the finale of a three-game series on February 27 in the sixth game of the year.

STRANDED (FEB. 26): In a 5-1 loss to Duke in the second game of a three-game series, Villanova went 1-for-12 with runners in scoring position and left 11 runners on base. The team scored its only run in the top of the second inning and led 1-0 after seven innings before the Blue Devils scored five runs in the bottom of the eighth.

IT HAD BEEN A WHILE (FEB. 25): When Villanova and Duke met for a three-game series from February 25-27, it marked the first time the teams had played each other since back in the 1947 season. The Blue Devils won all three games in this year's series and are now 7-0 all-time against the Wildcats. The four games prior to this season took place between the 1929 and 1947 seasons.

FLEISHMAN RECEIVES HONORS FROM THE BIG EAST AND BIG FIVE (FEB. 21): Junior right fielder **Matt Fleishman** was named to the weekly BIG EAST Honor Roll and was also chosen as the Philadelphia Big Five Player of the Week on February 21 after his efforts in the first three games of the season at Norfolk State. Fleishman batted .667 (8-for-12) in the series with five runs scored and eight runs batted in, while collecting three doubles, one triple and two walks. He had a .714 on-base percentage and a 1.083 slugging percentage in the series.

20 IS PLENTY (FEB. 20): Villanova collected 22 hits in a 13-1 win over Norfolk State in the finale of a three-game series on February 20. It marked only the eighth time since the 2000 season that the Wildcats reached 20 hits in a game, while the 22 hits were the most in the 10-year head coaching tenure of **Joe Godri**. The last time Villanova had more than 22 hits in a game came on April 24, 2000 when the team registered 24 hits in a 23-11 win over Philadelphia University.

FLEISHMAN ON FIRE (FEB. 20): Junior right fielder **Matt Fleishman** batted a team-high .667 (8-for-12) in the season-opening three-game series at Norfolk State, including three doubles, one triple and a pair of walks. He had a .714 on-base percentage and a 1.083 slugging percentage for the series. The big numbers may just have been a continuation of the way Fleishman ended the 2010 campaign, when he batted .351 (13-for-37) over the season's final nine games. Including both that stretch and the first three games this year, Fleishman had at least one hit in 11 of 12 games and batted .429 (21-for-49) in that span.

RARE FEAT FOR ALMONTE (FEB. 20): Freshman pitcher **Max Almonte** tossed four scoreless innings of relief in his collegiate debut at Norfolk State on February 20 and in the process earned the victory in a 13-1 decision. Villanova is known for the quality pitchers it brings in to the program but Almonte is the first Wildcat hurler since Dan Farino on March 4, 2001 to be the winning pitcher in the very first game of his collegiate career. For the record, Farino wound up making 60 appearances for Villanova and remains in the program's top-10 for both career games pitched as well as career ERA (3.86).

STARTING OFF ON THE RIGHT FOOT (FEB. 18): Villanova improved to 5-5 in season openers under head coach **Joe Godri** with an 8-7 win over Norfolk State on February 18. This is the second straight year that the Wildcats have topped the Spartans in the first game of the season.

PATIENT OFFENSIVELY: Villanova traditionally plays a base-to-base style of offense and will lean heavily on that philosophy again this season. In recent years, Wildcat hitters have proven their ability at working a count and getting deep into each at bat. Below are some key numbers for the Villanova offense in recent seasons.

HEAD COACH JOE GODRI: Over the past nine years since becoming the head coach of the Villanova baseball program in 2002, **Joe Godri** has built a team that is consistently among the best in the Northeast region. He owns a career record of 249-238-3 (.511) and has led the Wildcats to an average of more than 26 wins per season. In addition, the team has posted a record of .500 or better seven times in his first nine years as head coach, including a 29-23 mark during the 2010 campaign.

The season that just ended was a promising one for Villanova, which fielded an exceptionally young team for the second straight year. The youth movement continued to be a positive one for the Wildcats and the squad registered a number of milestones. Villanova registered the highest batting average (.303), lowest ERA (4.37) and best fielding percentage (.975) of Godri's tenure. Meanwhile, the Wildcats continued to mold future professional players and four players were chosen after the season in the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft. That number was also a new high since Godri has been head coach.

During his time on the Main Line, Godri has emphasized the importance of growing a collegiate baseball program through incremental team achievements that build up to an ultimate goal, which in the Wildcats case means having success in the highly competitive BIG EAST Conference. Villanova has fulfilled all of the above and stands in position to be a perennial contender in the postseason conference championship.

Villanova has developed into one of the top baseball powers in the region under Godri's watch. Over the past eight seasons (2004-11), the Wildcats have gone 139-67-2 (.673) against non-conference competition and posted a record of 95-46-1 (.673) against opponents from the states of Pennsylvania and New Jersey.

In the season prior to being named the head coach, Godri served as the associate head coach in 2001 during the final season of George Bennett's 16-year stay on campus. In this position, Godri had the unique opportunity to recruit the first class that would play for him in 2002. That first recruiting class included eventual Villanova stars Nick Allen, James Baxter, Mark Cardillo, Alan Day and Mike Grodecki. Godri's recruiting classes since then have been on par, as Villanova recruits have been ranked among the top 100 classes in the country in seven of the last nine seasons by the Collegiate Baseball Newspaper.

Godri was named the 10th head coach in the illustrious history of Villanova baseball on May 8, 2001. He took over the reigns from all-time program wins leader George Bennett, a 16-year veteran of the program and a member of the Villanova Varsity Club Hall of Fame. Godri's stint as head coach is actually his second with the Wildcats. He previously came to the Main Line in 1991 and served as the hitting coach for three seasons before returning in 2000 as an assistant coach.

ALUMNI NEWS AND NOTES

PITCHING IN THE PROS: Just prior to the start of the collegiate season, two former Villanova pitchers signed professional contracts with Independent League teams. Left-handed pitcher **Kevin Crimmel** inked a deal with the Joliet Slammers of the Frontier League, while right-hander **Mike Loree** signed with the Long Island Ducks of the Atlantic League.

Crimmel wound up his Villanova career last spring and is tied for the team's all-time lead with 71 career appearances. He made 24 of those appearances as a senior in 2010, when he went 6-2 with three saves and a team-leading 3.02 ERA. Crimmel pitched over the winter for the Palm Desert Coyotes in the California Winter League.

Loree pitched at Villanova from 2004-07 and is the program's all-time leader in innings pitched with 323 1/3 innings in a Wildcat uniform. He was a 2007 draft pick of the San Francisco Giants and pitched for three years in the Giants minor league system from 2007-09, before signing in the Atlantic League and pitching for the Newark Bears last season.

With the signings of Loree and Crimmel, the Wildcats now have eight former players active in minor league baseball. The other six players on the list include pitchers **Kevin Mulvey** (Arizona Diamondbacks), **Jordan Ellis** (Philadelphia Phillies) and **Brian Streilein** (Houston Astros), outfielders **Matt Szczur** (Chicago Cubs) and **Justin Bencsko** (Pittsburgh Pirates) and infielder **Jeremy Hunt** (Quebec Les Capitales, Can-Am League).

MATT SZCZUR REACHES AGREEMENT WITH CHICAGO CUBS: Former Villanova outfielder **Matt Szczur** announced in January that he has reached an agreement with the Chicago Cubs under which he will commit fully to baseball and forego seeking professional football opportunities. Szczur will continue to play in the Cubs organization on a minor league contract and reported to the team for Spring Training on February 24.

For the past four years, Szczur starred as both a baseball and a football student-athlete for the Wildcats. He was originally selected by the Cubs in the fifth round of the 2010 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft.

Szczur combined to bat .347 (35-for-101) with 10 doubles, one triple, 10 RBI, 24 runs scored, a .414 on-base percentage and a .465 slugging percentage in 25 games in the Cubs organization in 2010. He spent the majority of the season with short-season Single-A Boise, where he hit safely in all 18 games with a .397 batting average (29-for-73) to earn a six-game promotion to Single-A Peoria prior to reporting to the Villanova football team in August.

In just two seasons of baseball at Villanova, Szczur made a name for himself as one of the best hitters in program history. He ranks fifth all-time with a .392 (142-for-362) career batting average and is also tied for third with nine triples. He averaged 1.6 hits per game over two seasons and his 142 hits include 23 doubles, nine triples and five home runs. Szczur had a .460 on-base percentage and a .547 slugging percentage for the Wildcats.

In four years of football at Villanova, Szczur played in 47 games and helped the Wildcats go 37-10 (.787) in the games he appeared in. That record included reaching the quarterfinals of the Division I Football Championship in 2008, winning the national title in 2009 and advancing to the semifinals in 2010. His career football totals for Villanova include 1,803 rushing yards and 17 touchdowns, 1,485 receiving yards and 11 scores, 1,690 kickoff return yards and two touchdowns, 206 passing yards (12-of-14) with five touchdowns and a total of 180 points. He racked up 5,234 career all-purpose yards and ended his career ranked 11th in school history in career rushing yards and 14th in career receiving yards. He was the MVP of the 2009 FCS national championship game, when the Wildcats won their first-ever national championship with a 23-21 win over previously unbeaten Montana.

2010 HALL OF FAME INDUCTEE DENNIS MCCAFFERY

McCaffery transferred to Villanova and played the 1990 and 1991 seasons for the Wildcats. In his first season at Villanova, he was named the BIG EAST Player of the Year and a first team all-conference selection in 1990. McCaffery was a starter on the Wildcats 1991 squad which won a BIG EAST title and advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Despite only two years with the team, McCaffery is tied for sixth in school history with a .373 career batting average and he ranks 10th in a single season with 58 RBI in 1991. Following his collegiate career, McCaffery was drafted by the California Angels in the 19th round of the 1991 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft. His career statistics for the Wildcats include a .373 batting average, 95 runs scored, 147 hits, 101 RBI, 27 doubles, 13 home runs, 221 total bases, 45 walks and nine stolen bases. Prior to coming to Villanova, McCaffery was a first team Junior College All-American in 1989, when he also earned all-conference and Region Player of the Year accolades. McCaffery is currently a high school coach in New Jersey and has compiled a record of 263-80 in 12 seasons, including six county championships, 10 conference titles and the 2010 Group III state championship. He was named the New Jersey Baseball Coach of the Year in 2007 and was inducted into the New Jersey Coaches Hall of Fame in 2010.
