



2003-04 Villanova Women's Swimming & Diving Preview

The 2002-03 season marked the ending of one outstanding career and the takeoff of another. Maddy Crippen finished off her career in fine fashion last season by tying the all-time Big East record for individual titles. The big story of the 2002-03 year, however, was the emergence of another star in Becky Koch.

Koch helped lead the Wildcats to a sixth place Big East Championship finish with two individual conference titles. She smashed the Big East record in the 500 yard freestyle, in addition to winning the 1,650 yard freestyle. From there, she took on the nation, traveling to the NCAA Championships where she emerged with All-America honors.

"What is Becky Koch capable of this season?," said head coach Rick Simpson. "Koch is coming off the most demanding summer training program thus far in her career. We have made a solid commitment to two major competitions this year: the NCAA championships and the U.S. Olympic Team Trials. Becky has yet to stop improving. If she continues to progress exponentially, she will certainly be a contender for an NCAA title and an opportunity to swim in Athens."

Koch will look to continue her rise to national prominence this season, and with the help of an outstanding group of fellow returners hopes to take the Wildcats with her.

Sprint Freestyle:

The sprint events will be driven by three returners this year in Nicole Werger, Kiersten Rosenberg, and Amanda Jackson. Newcomers Kristina Lennox and Whitney Roth will round out a strong and growing sprint program.

Distance Freestyle:

This is an area that is becoming a Villanova tradition and with the addition of freshman sensation Jenny Sommerville, the tradition will continue. The group will be led by Koch and backed up by Sommerville, Lauren Schulman and newcomers Jessie Santapaul and Carolyn Gusick and returner Trista Felty.

Individual Medley:

Freshman Annie Kelley will be looking to step in and take the lead in the IM group after the departure of Crippen. She will be joined by other freshmen such as Allie Stine and Michelle Collier. Katie Shipe returns as the leading Villanova scorer in this event at the Big East championships

Butterfly:

This event is one that will be very deep for the `Cats. Leading the way will be Kelley. She will be backed up by Liz Parker, Kelly Ottenbreit and freshman Jessie Santapaul

Breaststroke:

This will be a very young event for the cats this year. Junior Charysse Johnston will lead the way. Joining her will be Michelle Collier, Allie Stine and Danielle Honrath, all first-year Wildcats.

Backstroke:

Tori Delollo looks to ride the momentum that she started at last year's Big East Championships. Delollo is knocking on the door for an NCAA berth and Simpson is quite confident that it will become a reality. Joining her in the backstroke duties will be Katie Shipe and Moira Durkin who has returned to the program. Nichole Werger will assist in the sprint backstroke areas.

Relays:

The relay will be very deep this year. The addition of several key performers will catapult the relays into the top tier of the conference. Big East champion relays are certainly part of the goal structure for our women this year.

Diving:

Seniors Amy Sfara and Julie Rhines will anchor the women's diving team in 2003-04 for the Wildcats. Both bring tremendous experience to diving coach Gary Elder's Villanova squad. Kyla Sullivan will also add depth for the Wildcats this season, along with Maggie Smith.

Simpson on the 2003-04 Wildcats:

"This year's schedule is designed to allow our athletes to see as much Big East competition as possible as we move towards the championships in February.

Individual and in-season goals are certainly part of the plan, but no one can help but make a strong showing at the conference as top priority. We have the potential to have several individual and relay champions and that alone will allow the team to jump up towards the top.

Several of the Wildcat women not only have the potential to qualify for the NCAA championship, but also score."

Athletic Training Room

Villanova Swim Center

Completed in July 1985 at a cost of \$1.5 million, The Swimming Center is home to Villanova's men's and women's swimming and diving teams, and the women's water polo squad. Measuring 25 meter by 25 yards, with depths ranging from 4 1/2 feet to 13 feet, it features 10 lanes for competitive swimming, two 1-meter diving boards, and 3-meter diving platforms. During the summer of 1999, new offices were constructed for the swimming and women's water polo coaching staffs, as well as a meeting room.

Athletic Training Room

Villanova's Jake Nevin Field House features a full-service athletic training room. The facility contains state-of-the-art equipment specifically for the treatment and rehabilitation of athletic injuries. This facility now contains 2,200 square feet of training space. All advanced treatment and rehabilitation is performed under the supervision of four full-time National Athletic Training Association Certified personnel. In the cases requiring physical therapy needs, or subspecialized medical evaluation, outside consultants are utilized.



Weight Training and Conditioning Facilities

Weight Training & Conditioning Facilities

Under the direction of Strength & Conditioning Coach Jeff Watson, Villanova University offers one main weight training & conditioning facility underneath Villanova Stadium for all Wildcat student-athletes. Recently, the weight room was renovated to a 5,900 square foot training center with weight training and cardiovascular machines. There are also other weight training and conditioning facilities for the general Villanova University community on the South Campus and the West Campus. The South Campus facility was also renovated in the summer of 1998 to fit the needs of the general student body.

Academic Support Center

Located within the Jake Nevin Field House is the Villanova Athletic Support Center. Working in conjunction with Dr. Dan Regan, Villanova's Academic Advisor for Athletics, Associate Director of Academic Support Nancy White administers the daily operations of this full-service facility. In addition to an on-line computer which monitors the academic progress of all Wildcat student-athletes, the center includes work space for student-athletes and computer workstations with word-processing and laserjets for use by student-athletes. Also, various computer programs are offered, such as a resumé writing program. Also within this suite of offices are Senior Associate Athletic Director Dave White.



Academic Support Center

Academic Resource Center

The Villanova Department of Athletics expanded Academic Support's domain into the newly renovated stadium. With the addition of a new infrastructure during the summer of 1999, the department's new Academic Resource Center was formed. The benefits of the ARC include:

- Improved efficiency of academic support services to student-athletes.
- Expansion and consolidation of several academic resources, such as freshmen-mentoring and tutoring programs.
- Ability to offer a more personally tailored academic support system to those student-athletes in need.

The ARC includes:

- Private and semi-private tutoring areas.
- Computer equipped study hall housing 50-60 laptop computers.
- Increased space for freshmen-mentoring.
- Conference area for lectures and studyhall.
