■ Villanova opens the home portion of its schedule with Saturday evening's game against Lehigh. It is one of only two home games the Wildcats will play during the first eight weeks (seven games) this year.

■ Villanova will be making its FloFootball debut this week. Nick Mantegna and Steve Pinone have the call as the Wildcats appear on the digital platform for the first of 10 times this season.

■ Villanova leads the all-time series with Lehigh by a 10-5 margin and has won the past seven head-to-head matchups. The teams will be facing each other for the 10th time in the last 16 years on Saturday night.

■ Villanova has gone 26-8 in home openers since becoming a FCS member in 1985. A loss to Towson in last year's home opener snapped a streak of six consecutive victories.

## HOME OPENER SUCCESS

- Villanova opens the home portion of its schedule with Saturday's game against Lehigh.
- Villanova is 26-8 (.765) in home openers since becoming a FCS member in 1985, including wins in six of its last seven home openers.
- A loss to Towson last year snapped a six-game winning streak in home openers which matched the second-longest in school history (1996-01). Villanova's longest winning streak in home openers is 13 straight from 1927-39.

## LEHIGH HISTORY

- Saturday's game against Lehigh will be the 16th meeting in the all-time series and the 10th game between the teams in the last 16 years.
- Villanova leads the series by a 10-5 margin and has won seven straight matchups over the last 12 seasons (2007-08-09-10-16-17-18).
- Villanova is 3-1 in home games against Lehigh, although the last Mountain Hawks win in the series was a 31-28 triumph at Villanova Stadium in 2006.

## PATRIOT LEAGUE COMPETITION

- Villanova will play three straight Patriot League opponents to begin the 2019 season. The first of the three contests was a 34-14 win at Colgate on August 24, while the Wildcats will also travel to Bucknell on September 14.
- Villanova is 33-4 against current Patriot League opponents since becoming a FCS member in 1985 (see chart below) and has won nine straight games against Patriot League foes since a 27-24 loss at Fordham in 2013.
- Eight of the 12 teams in CAA Football will play at least one Patriot League opponent this year. Villanova leads the way with three Patriot League opponents and William & Mary will face two Patriot League teams. Albany, Maine, New Hampshire, Richmond, Stony Brook and Towson will each square off against one Patriot League foe. Last season, CAA Football teams were 7-3 against the Patriot League.
- Villanova is 9-0 all-time against ranked Patriot League opponents, including the 34-14 win over Colgate in Week Zero. That game was the first time ever that an unranked Wildcats team played a ranked Patriot League foe.

## BALANCED ATTACK

- Villanova played a balanced offensive game in its season-opening win at Colgate, as its 444 yards of total offense included 239 yards rushing and 205 yards passing.
- There have been four games in Mark Ferrante's tenure as head coach in which the Wildcats had over 200 yards both on the ground and through the air. All four such games came against Patriot League opponents, including this year's win over Colgate as well as games against Lehigh (2017), Lafayette (2017) and Bucknell (2018).

## GAINING GROUND

- Villanova rushed for 239 yards on 40 carries (6.0 average) in the win at Colgate.
- The rushing attack against Colgate was led by junior **Justin Covington** with 134 yards on 19 carries, while sophomore **Jalen Jackson** had 11 rushes for 64 yards and junior quarterback **Daniel Smith** registered seven carries for 37 yards and a touchdown.

## REACHING THE CENTURY MARK

- Junior running back **Justin Covington** tallied his first career 100-yard rushing game in the win at Colgate. Covington carried a career-high 19 times for 134 yards in the victory to surpass his previous career high of 74 yards from a 2017 game against Lafayette.

## DANDY DEBUT

- Junior transfer quarterback **Daniel Smith** was sensational in his Villanova debut at Colgate. Smith completed 14-of-29 passes for 205 yards and three touchdowns to go with seven carries for 37 yards and a score. Smith is in his first year at Villanova after transferring from Campbell.

## SPREAD THE WEALTH

- Junior quarterback **Daniel Smith** completed 14 passes to eight different receivers in the game at Colgate. Senior tight end **Simon Bingelis** and senior wide receiver **Zac Kerxton** each had three catches to lead the team.
- **Simon Bingelis** had a team-high 58 receiving yards at Colgate, including a 36-yard reception. It was the third time in his career that he led the team in receiving, with the other two occasions coming in 2017 in consecutive games against Richmond and Rhode Island.

## EARNING RECOGNITION

- Junior cornerback **Jaquan Amos** earned both national and conference honors this week. He was named the STATS FCS National Defensive Player of the Week and the CAA Football Defensive Player of the Week for his play in the season-opening win at Colgate.
- Amos tallied seven tackles, a fumble recovery and an interception which he returned 27 yards for a touchdown in the Colgate game. His efforts helped the Wildcats defense hold Colgate to 288 total yards (211 passing, 77 rushing).

## DEFENSIVE TOUCHDOWN

- Junior cornerback **Jaquan Amos** scored his third career defensive touchdown at Colgate when he returned an interception 27 yards for a score. The play came in the second quarter and gave Villanova a 14-0 lead. He had also set up the Wildcats first score of the game with a fumble recovery late in the first quarter which led to a six-play, 62-yard Villanova scoring drive.
- Amos scored two touchdowns as a freshman in 2017 when he had a 35-yard interception return against Lafayette and a 99-yard fumble return against Maine. His 99-yard return tied an FCS record and was only the third fumble return for 99 yards in FCS history. It was also the ninth play of any kind in school history of 99 yards or longer.

## A START TO REMEMBER

- Junior linebacker **Forrest Rhyne** made his first career start in the season opener at Colgate and turned in one of the best performances of his collegiate career. Rhyne led Villanova in tackles with eight, including two tackles for loss and a sack.

## TEAM LEADERS

- Junior running back **Justin Covington**, senior safety **Chucky Smith** and junior linebacker **Forrest Rhyne** have been named the Wildcats captains for the 2019 season following a vote by their teammates.

## COMPLETE STUDENT-ATHLETES

### ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

#### NCAA PUBLIC RECOGNITION AWARD

■ Each year the NCAA recognizes programs that have a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranks within the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. Villanova has earned this award nine times in the 14-year history of the APR program, including in each of the last four years for which data is available.

■ Villanova was one of just five FCS programs in 2017-18 to have both its football and men's basketball programs each public recognition awards.

■ The football team has set a new program record for its highest APR score in each of the past four years.

#### ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

■ One of the highest honors that a student-athlete can achieve is to be named an Academic All-American, an award which encompasses both academic achievement as well as contributions on the field. Villanova has had 12 football student-athletes earn a total of 14 Academic All-America honors over the years.

#### CAA TEAM ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

■ Villanova was the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for both the 2016-17 and the 2017-18 school years. The award is presented at the end of each academic year to the conference school with the highest team GPA.

#### CAA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

■ Villanova has had four student-athletes be named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Nominees for the award must have attained senior standing academically and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

#### CAA ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

■ Student-athletes with a semester GPA of 3.0 or higher are named to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll. Villanova had 41 honorees for the Fall 2018 semester and 38 student-athletes achieve this distinction for the Spring 2019 term.

#### ACADEMIC ALL-AREA TEAMS

■ In conjunction with the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, the sports information directors at the colleges and universities in the Philadelphia area (PhillySIDA) name an Academic All-Area team and a football Performer of the Year each season. # VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

## VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE



A longtime member of the Wildcats coaching staff, Mark Ferrante returns for his third season as head coach in 2019. Ferrante was an assistant coach under Andy Talley for 30 years, including 18 seasons as Assistant Head Coach. It was announced at a press conference on January 30, 2016, that Ferrante would become the 30th head coach of the Villanova Football program following Talley's retirement at the end of the 2016 season.

Last season, Ferrante led an injury riddled team to a 5-6 overall record. Under

Ferrante's direction a season ago, freshman corner Christian Benford was named the CAA Defensive Rookie of the Year and a third team All-CAA honoree. In addition, senior running back Aaron Forbes and senior offensive tackle Ethan Greenidge were named to the All-Conference second team. Ferrante was also instrumental in helping offensive tackle Brandon Hitner (La Rams), safety Rob Rolle (Miami Dolphins) and Greenidge (New Orleans Saints) sign NFL free agent contracts. The Wildcats also continued to excel in the classroom in 2018 as 41 players earned a spot on the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll.

In his first year as the Wildcats mentor in 2017, Ferrante guided Villanova to a 5-6 overall record and 3-5 CAA mark. Ferrante helped four Wildcats earn All-CAA honors in 2017 highlighted by linebacker Ed Shockley and punter John Hinchin who were first team honorees. Villanova also had three players sign NFL free agent contracts including Trey Johnson (Pittsburgh Steelers), Malik Reaves (Kansas City Chiefs) and Shockley (Dallas Cowboys).

Ferrante leads one of the nation's elite FCS programs after playing an instrumental role in the Wildcats rise to national prominence over the past three decades. He has been a part of the coaching staff for all 12 of the team's FCS playoff trips, including three national semifinal appearances and winning the 2009 national championship. Villanova has also won six conference titles, three Lambert Meadowlands Cups and three ECAC Team of the Year awards.

Others have taken note of the success that Ferrante has been a part of throughout his time on the Main Line. At the end of the 2015 season, he was named the FCS Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA). This award was first presented in 1997 and was created to honor assistant coaches who excel in community service, commitment to the student-athlete, on-field coaching success and AFCA professional organization involvement.

Those characteristics exemplify Ferrante's dedication to the complete student-athlete experience, evidence of which can be seen in the program's consistent academic success. The football team has earned public recognition awards from the NCAA in each of the last four years for ranking in the top 10 percent of FCS programs in academic performance measured by the multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR). In addition, a Villanova student-athlete has been named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year four times in the past 12 years. More than 40 student-athletes from the Wildcats have been named to the CAA All-Academic Team in each of the past four academic years.

# VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

## MARK FERRANTE / VILLANOVA COACHING STAFF

As Andy Talley's right-hand man for so many years, Ferrante was involved in every facet of the Wildcats program. On the field, he coached the Villanova offensive line for 27 seasons and developed a unit that was traditionally one of the best in CAA Football. Over the years he has coached three All-Americans, 11 All-East performers and 15 first team all-conference selections.

Two of Ferrante's players went on to be NFL draft picks, including second-round selection Ben Ijalana by the Indianapolis Colts (2011) and seventh-round pick Brad Seaton by the Tennessee Titans (2017). Seaton was a second team CAA Football All-Conference selection in 2016, when the offensive line enabled Villanova to average 206.3 rushing yards and 378.7 yards of total offense per game. The Wildcats ranked third in CAA Football and 24th in the nation in rushing offense, in addition to ranking fourth in the league in total offense and fifth with a scoring average of 24.4 points per game.

Ijalana was an All-American in both 2009 and 2010, as well as being a three-time first team All-CAA selection during his collegiate career. Villanova reached the FCS playoffs in each of Ijalana's last three seasons on the team, winning the 2009 national title and advancing to the semi-final round a year later. The other All-Americans who Ferrante has mentored are Eamonn Allen (2001) and Bryan Russo (1989). Allen earned first team Associated Press All-America recognition in 2001 and was also a first team All-East and first team All-Atlantic 10 selection.

Villanova's offensive line produced 17 All-Conference performers over a nine year span, including six first team selections, five second team picks and six third team honorees. In addition to Ijalana, the other first team selections are Brant Clouser (2010), Dan Shirey (2011) and Vince Kowalski (2014).

Ferrante was a standout collegiate player in his own right prior to joining the coaching ranks. He was the quarterback for Andy Talley at St. Lawrence University, where he was named the 1982 Division III Player of the Year and also earned first team All-East honors. Ferrante directed the offense for a St. Lawrence team that went 10-1 during the 1982 season and reached the national semi-finals in the playoffs.

Ferrante went on to join Talley's coaching staff at St. Lawrence, and spent one season as the running backs coach in 1983. His other coaching stops before coming to Villanova include coaching the running backs at Wagner (1984) and working on the coaching staff at Lafayette (1985-86).

Ferrante and his wife, Georga, reside in Phoenixville, Pa. The couple has a 23-year-old son, Jimmy, who earned his degree from Villanova in 2018.
