TODAY'S GAME

- Villanova will look for its second straight Homecoming Weekend win when it takes on UAlbany on Saturday afternoon for a 3:30 p.m. kickoff. The game can be seen on FloFootball via the FloSports mobile app and the radio broadcast can be heard on the iHeart radio app.
- Villanova enters Saturday's game with a 35-21 record on Homecoming Weekend. In last year's game, the Wildcats snapped a three-game Homecoming losing streak and defeated Rhode Island in a 44-0 rout.
- Saturday's game will only be the third visit to Villanova Stadium by UAlbany since the Great Danes joined CAA Football. The Wildcats have won each of their two previous home games in the series versus UAlbany, with those games coming in 2014 (48-31) and on Homecoming Weekend in 2016 (24-13).
- Senior wide receiver **Jaaron Hayek** moved into 10th place in Villanova history in career receiving yards (2,133) during last week's game at Richmond.

ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Since 1842, Villanova University's Augustinian Catholic intellectual tradition has been the cornerstone of an academic community in which stulearn to think critically, compassionately and succeed while serving others. There are more than 10,000 undergraduate, graduate and law students in the University's six colleges-the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, the Villanova School of Business, the College of Engineering, the M. VILLANOVA ATHLETICS

Villanova University has a long and storied athletics history defined by excellence both in competition and in the classroom. The Villanova Athletics Department is a community of studentathletes, coaches and staff whose primary focus is to achieve academic excellence, while striving to produce teams and individuals committed to athletic competition and outstanding performance. Villanova Athletics sponsors 24 varsity sports, which together include more than 550 student-athletes. In the classroom, these Villanova student-athletes have registered a grade-point average higher than a 3.0 for 36 consecutive semesters. Three Villanova student-athletes have been named Rhodes Scholars, with numerous others earning Academic All-America distinction. Villanova's athletics history includes 21 NCAA team national championships, as well as 131 conference championships. In addition, at least one Villanovan has participated in every Summer Olympics since 1948. Villanova is a member of the BÎG EAST Conference, CAA Football, Colonial Athletic Association (Rowing) and Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (Water Polo).

ACADEMICS

The GPA for more than 550 student-athletes during the Spring 2022 semester was 3.425, making it 15 straight semesters that student-athletes have had a GPA of 3.2 or higher. Success in the classroom has been across-the-board for Villanova Athletics, with every one of the 24 varsity sports programs posting a team GPA over a 3.0 in Spring 2022.

Villanova Athletics continues to shine among the brightest collegiate athletics programs in the country for its student-athletes' combination of academic and athletic success. New data on the Academic Progress Rate measure was released by the NCAA in June 2022 and Villanova had 11 of its varsity sport programs earn a perfect 1000 multi-year score. This is the fifth straight year that the Wildcats have had 10 or more teams earn a 1000 score.

VILLANOVA NOTES

SERIES NOTES

♦ Villanova and UAlbany have played each other on just five previous occasions entering this week's Homecoming Weekend contest at Villanova Stadium. The Wildcats own a 4-1 advantage in the series and have won each of their two previous home games against the Great Danes in 2014 (48-31) and on Homecoming Weekend in 2016 (24-13). The teams played in Albany last year and Villanova tallied a 17-10 victory. The lone win for UAlbany in the series came at Bob Ford Stadium in 2017 when the Great Danes won 19-10 in overtime.

COMING HOME

◆ Villanova returns home for the first time in nearly a month for Saturday's game against UAlbany. Since their last home game against Monmouth on September 24, the Wildcats have played two road games at Maine (October 1) and Richmond (October 15) with a bye week in between. Villanova will play its only two consecutive home games of the season this week and next week, with Hampton coming into town on October 29 for a 1 p.m. game.

HOMECOMING HISTORY

♦ Villanova has traditionally fared well on Homecoming Weekend (35-21, .625), although the Wildcats went into last year's game against Rhode Island having lost three straight Homecoming games from 2017-19. After not having a Homecoming game during the short Spring 2021 season, Villanova changed the trend in a big way last season when it posted a 44-0 win over Rhode Island on October 23, 2021.

DOUBLE DIGIT TACKLERS

♦ For the first time this season, Villanova had two players reach double figures in tackles in last week's game at Richmond. Redshirt freshman linebacker **Shane Hartzell** had 15 total stops against the Spiders and notched his first career game with 10+ tackles. Sophomore **Ethan Potter**, who has shifted to linebacker in the past two games, tied his career high with 11 tackles for the second straight game. The pair also combined for 4.5 tackles for loss in the contest. Hartzell has earned a starting role for the Wildcats this season and leads the team with 42 tackles on the year. He also has team highs of four tackles for loss and two sacks. Potter is second on the team with 40 total stops this season, including 3.5 tackles for loss and half a sack.

DEFENSIVE DOINGS

◆ Despite falling on the road to Richmond last week, the Wildcats saw their defense take a step forward with a solid all-around effort. Villanova held the Spiders more than 100 yards below their average total offense entering the game and also kept Richmond more than 11 points below its season scoring average. Below are specific defensive metrics from the game.

LIMITING THE DAMAGE

♦ Villanova has done a good job of stopping the opposition after the Wildcats commit a turnover. Although the Wildcats have turned the ball over 10 times in their first six games and have a minus-two turnover margin on the season, the Villanova defense has given up points on just two of the 10 opponent drives that began after a turnover. In last week's game at Richmond, the Wildcats threw an interception and lost a fumble but did not allow the Spiders any points after those miscues. For the season Villanova has a 28-14 advantage over its opponents in points off turnovers.

VILLANOVA NOTES

BIG PLAYS APLENTY

- ♦ One of the calling cards for the Villanova offense this season has been the ability to make big plays. In the first six games of the season the Wildcats have generated 29 offensive plays of at least 20 yards, including 19 pass completions and 10 rushes. The trend continued last week despite the Wildcats being held to 275 total yards in their loss to Richmond. Senior running back **TD Ayo-Durojaiye** had rushes for 51 yards and 24 yards during the contest, while junior quarterback **Connor Watkins** threw pass completions of 40 yards and 29 yards to senior receiver **Jaaron Hayek**.
- ♦ Villanova's big-play potential has led to big point totals on the scoreboard. Through the first six games of the season the Wildcats have scored points in 20 of the 24 quarters they have played. The only scoreless periods for Villanova came in the second quarter and the fourth quarter at Army West Point on September 17 as well as the third and fourth periods at Richmond last week. Villanova has scored six of its 25 tocuhdowns this season on plays of 20 yards or longer.

40 OR MORE

♦ The strong right arm of junior quarterback **Connor Watkins** has been one of the linchpins for all of the big plays by the Villanova offense this season. Watkins has competed 12 passes of 40 yards or longer through his first six games as the Wildcats starting quarterback. He showed what he is capable of early on this year, as he had completions of 68 yards and 62 yards to senior wide receiver **Jaaron Hayek** in the first two games of the season along with passes of 66 yards and 60 yards to fifth-year senior **Dez Boykin** in those same two games.

BREAKING AWAY

- ◆ Junior quarterback Connor Watkins and senior wide receiver Jaaron Hayek connected on one of the longest pass plays in school history in the Maine game three weeks ago when Hayek hauled in an 83-yard touchdown reception. The play came on 3rd-and-10 from the Villanova 17-yard line and Watkins' pass traveled 36 yards in the air before Hayek broke away from a defender and caught the ball at the Black Bears 47-yard line. He had an open road to the end zone from there to complete the big play with 47 yards after the catch.
- ♦ The 83-yard play is tied for the fourth-longest pass and passing touchdown in Wildcats history. There are three longer passing touchdowns of 90 yards, 87 yards and 84 yards in the Villanova record book, while Hayek is tied with Robert Brady who caught an 83-yard touchdown bass from Kirk Schulz in a playoff game against Georgia Southern on November 25, 1989.

VILLANOVA NOTES

STRONG START FOR WATKINS

♦ Junior quarterback Connor Watkins was a revelation in the season opener against Lehigh when he set a Villanova record for the most passing yards (298) by a quarterback in their first career start. Watkins went 11-of-15 for 298 yards and three touchdowns in that game, with his 306.2 efficiency rating for the contest the highest among all FCS quarterbacks in the first week of the season. Now at midpoint of his first season as the Wildcats starter, Watkins continues to lead the nation in most passing yards per completion (18.03). He is 67-of-110 through the air for 1,208 yards with 11 touchdowns and nine interceptions. Watkins has also rushed for 208 yards and is tied for the team lead with five rushing touchdowns. He is responsible for 16 of the team's 25 touchdows on the year (11 passing, five rushing).

THE LATEST ON HAYEK

- ♦ Senior wide receiver **Jaaron Hayek** is having an incredible 2022 season and currently ranks second among all FCS players in both receiving yards per game (109.3) and yards per reception (24.3). In the six games Villanova has played this season, Hayek has made 27 catches for 656 yards and six scores. He has 10 receptions of 20 yards or longer and has topped the 100-yard mark in four of six contests. In the game at Maine on October 1, Hayek had career highs of 159 yards and four touchdowns in a 45-20 win. He became only the third player in school history to catch at least four touchdown passes in a single game.
- ♦ Hayek has already moved up eight spots on the Villanova career list for receiving yards this season. He began the year in 18th place with 1,477 career yards and moved into the Wildcats all-time top-10 with his current total of 2,133 yards during the game at Richmond last week. At his current rate of 109.3 receiving yards per game this season, Hayek has a chance to become the first Villanova player to average over 100 yards per game for a full season since Brian Westbrook in 1998 (104.0 yards per contest). Westbrook and fellow former Walter Payton Award winner Brian Finneran (1996, 1997) are the only two Wildcats who have averaged more than 100 receiving yards per game in a season since Villanova became an FCS program in 1985.

RATE OF RETURN

♦ Last week in the game at Richmond fifth-year senior **Dez Boykin** became the fifth player in Villanova history to surpass 1,500 career kickoff return yards. He has returned 64 kickoffs for a total of 1,526 yards and an average of 23.8 yards per return during his Wildcats career. Boykin has been at his best through the first six games of the current season, as his average of 27.7 yards per return leads CAA Football and ranks 12th in the country. He returned one kickoff for 38 yards at Richmond last week and has five returns of 30 yards or longer on the season, including a career-long 68-yard return in the season opener against Lehigh.

VILLANOVA NOTES

PICK OF THE DAY

♦ Junior safety **Jalen Goodman** scored the first points of his career in the game against Maine on October 1 when he returned an interception 23 yards for a touchdown to put the finishing touches on a 45-20 win over the Black Bears. The interception was the first of his career and Goodman's return for a score account for the only points scored by the Villanova defense this season. Prior to his pick-six, the last defensive points scored by the Wildcats came on a touchdown on a return of a blocked punt at UAlbany on October 16 of last season. Villanova's last pick-six before Goodman was by Christian Benford against Bucknell last year on September 11, 2021.

HERE'S THE KICKER

▶ In his first season at Villanova, graduate student Matthew Mercurio has been a standout performer on special teams. Mercurio is a perfect 25-of-25 on PATs in a Wildcats uniform and has also made all five of his six field goal attempts. He has tied a career high by making six PAT attempts without a miss on three occasions, including two straight games against Monmouth and Maine. Mercurio has connected on field goals ranging from 24 yards to 40 yards, with his 40-yard attempt at Army West Point the 10th of his career from 40 yards or longer. He is currently tied for the CAA Football lead and ranks 18th nationally with a field goal percentage of 83.3 percent this season. Prior to coming to Villanova this year, Mercurio was a two-time All-Mountain West honorable mention selection at San Jose State where he amassed 222 points over three seasons.

SPECIAL PERFORMER ON SPECIAL TEAMS

♦ Senior running back **TD Ayo-Durojaiye** has been a standout special teams performer for the Wildcats over the last two seasons and he leads Villanova with 18 tackles on special teams (15 on kickoff returns, three on punt returns) since the start of the 2021 campaign. Ayo-Durojaiye has recorded at least one tackle in 12 of his last 19 games played and had a career-high four stops at Maine three weeks ago. On the flip side of special teams, he has returned nine career kickoff returns for an average of 21.9 yards per return. Ayo-Durojaiye also scored a special teams touchdown at UAlbany last year when he scooped up a blocked punt and returned it 15 yards for a touchdown. As an offensive player, Ayo-Durojaiye's stats include 842 rushing yards and five touchdowns to go along with 21 receptions for 181 yards. He tallied his second career 100-yard rushing game (106) at Richmond last week.

VILLANOVA NOTES

AN INCOMPLETE FEELING

♦ The game against Army West Point on September 17 was the fourth in Villanova history in which the Wildcats opponent did not record a single pass completion. The Black Knights ran the ball 55 times and attempted just one pass on a third-and-eight play from the Army West Point nine-yard line in the second quarter. That one pass attempt was broken up by sophomore cornerback **Kshawn Schulters**. The single pass attempt by the Black Knights is the fewest ever in a game by a Villanova opponent, two fewer than the three pass attempts by Miami (Fla.) in a 1957 game. The previous games in which the opposing team did not record a completion were in 1946 (Detroit), 1958 (Richmond) and 1969 (William & Mary).

GRADUATE TRANSFERS MAKE IMMEDIATE IMPACT

◆ Villanova had three fifth-year transfers make key contributions in a 45-17 win over Lehigh in Week 1. Linebacker **Antonio Montero** from Rice registered a game-high 10 tackles and forced a fumble, linebacker **Danny Abraham** recorded an interception whiich he returned 32 yards to go along with three tackles on the day, and placekicker **Matthew Mercurio** made a 27-yard field goal in addition to going 6-of-6 on PATs. All three players made their official debut for Villanova when the game was played.

SEEING NEW FACES

♦ The Villanova roster has a bit of a different look this season with more than 30 newcomers joining a roster that lost more than a dozen starters from last season, including eight starters lost on defense. During the season opener against Lehigh in Week 1, 11 of the 60 players who saw game action for the Wildcats were making their Villanova debut. In addition, eight different players made the first start of their collegiate careers in the season opener.

SEVENTH-YEAR VETERAN

♦ Graduate student tight end **Tyler Will** is a seventh year collegiate student-athlete this year. Will walked on to the Villanova football team as a senior in school before the 2019 season. He saw most of his time on special teams that year before transitioning to offense during Spring Ball in 2020. Now a veteran of 30 career collegiate games, Will has made eight career receptions for 43 yards and one touchdown to go along with three rushes for 14 yards and a score. On defense and special teams Will has registered 19 total tackles, including seven solo stops and 12 assisted tackles.

2022 TEAM CAPTAINS

◆ Villanova's captains this year are senior running back **DeeWil Barlee**, graduate center **Colin Gamroth**, junior safety **Elijah Glover** and seventh-year senior **Tyler Will**.

PRESEASON RECOGNITION

♦ Villanova was picked as the CAA Football preseason favorite in a poll of league head coaches and sports information directors. The Wildcats earned a total of 270 points in that poll to finish ahead of Delaware (235) and Rhode Island (224). Five players earned individual recognition in preseason balloting. Senior TD Ayo-Durojaiye was picked as a CAA Football preseason all-conference selection along with graduate student left guard Michael Gorbi and center Colin Gamroth. Senior wide receiver Rayjuon Pringle also earned preseason selection, while senior Jaaron Hayek was an honorable mention choice.

COMPLETE STUDENT-ATHLETES

ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

NCAA PUBLIC RECOGNITION AWARD

- Each year the NCAA recognizes programs that have a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranks within the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. Villanova has earned this award nine times in the 16-year history of the APR program, including in four of the last six years for which data is available.
- Villanova was one of just five FCS programs in 2017-18 to have both its football and men's basketball programs each public recognition awards.
- The football team has set a new program record for its highest APR score in four of the last six years.

ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

■ One of the highest honors that a student-athlete can achieve is to be named an Academic All-American, an award which encompasses both academic achievement as well as contributions on the field. Villanova has had 12 football student-athletes earn a total of 14 Academic All-America honors over the years.

CAA TEAM ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

■ Villanova was the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for both the 2016-17 and the 2017-18 school years. The award is presented at the end of each academic year to the conference school with the highest team GPA.

CAA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

■ Villanova has had five student-athletes be named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Nominees for the award must have attained senior standing academically and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

CAA ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

■ Student-athletes with a semester GPA of 3.0 or higher are named to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll. Villanova had 55 honorees for the Fall 2021 semester and 48 student-athletes achieve this distinction for the Spring 2022 term.

ACADEMIC ALL-AREA TEAMS

■ In conjunction with the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, the sports information directors at the colleges and universities in the Philadelphia area (PhillySIDA) name an Academic All-Area team and a football Performer of the Year each season. In the 15 years of the Academic All-Area program, which started with the 2005-06 academic year, the football team has had a total of 54 selections to the Academic All-Area Team. In addition, the Wildcats have had five Performers of the Year.

VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE



Coming off a breakthrough season which included a conference title, FCS playoff appearance and his first Coach of the Year award, Mark Ferrante has Villanova riding a wave of momentum entering his sixth season as head coach. Ferrante begins the 2022 campaign with a career record of 31-21 (.596), including 19 regular season CAA Football wins. He is in his 36th year overall with the Wildcats including his time as head coach and 30 years as an assistant from 1987-2016. Ferrante has been a part of 248 victories and all 14 of the program's FCS playoff appearances during his Villanova tenure.

In addition to being named the CAA Football Coach of the Year last season, Ferrante was the 2021 winner of the AFCA FCS Region 1

Coach of the Year award. That honor made him a finalist for National Coach of the Year consideration and earned him recognition at the AFCA national convention following the season. Ferrante guided the Wildcats to a 10-3 record a year ago and Villanova won a share of the CAA Football title while securing the league's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs. It is the second straight full season (2019, 2021) in which Ferrante guided the Wildcats to postseason play.

Villanova hosted two playoff games last year and advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Division I Football Championship to finish the year ranked in the top-10 nationally (No. 8) in both FCS national polls for the first time since 2014. The Wildcats tallied their seventh season in program history with at least 10 wins and achieved success by playing – and beating – some of the top FCS teams in the nation. Villanova's 10-3 record included four victories over Top 25 opponents, including No. 3 James Madison, No. 18 Rhode Island, No. 21 Richmond and No. 24 Holy Cross. Ferrante led the Wildcats to a 7-1 record against a challenging CAA Football schedule to mark the fifth season since 1988 in which the team had no more than one loss in conference play.

There was star power in all facets of the game for Villanova last season, with Ferrante coaching 11 players who had an opportunity to continue their football careers beyond the college ranks. The group included cornerback Christian Benford who was a sixth round draft pick of the Buffalo Bills. Fellow corner Denzel Williams signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Ravens and linebacker Forrest Rhyne was inked to a free agent contract by the Indianapolis Colts. Benford and Rhyne were consensus first team All-Americans in 2021, while offensive lineman Michael Corbi was also a 2021 All-America selection and was one of 13 Wildcats who were named to the CAA Football All-Conference teams.

In the first five seasons that Ferrante has been head coach the Wildcats have had five major conference award winners and 38 CAA Football All-Conference selections, including 12 first team picks. Christian Benford was the CAA Defensive Rookie of the Year in 2018 and Villanova had consecutive winners of the prestigious Chuck Boone Leadership and Excellence Award which is presented to one senior student-athlete who embodies the highest standards of leadership, integrity, teamwork, and sportsmanship in academics and athletics. Chucky Smith was the 2019 winner of the award and Justin Covington earned the honor for the 2020 season.

Outside of football the Wildcats student-athletes have consistently excelled in their academic pursuits during Ferrante's head coaching tenure. Villanova ranked second in CAA Football in the most recent NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) data which was released in December 2021. The Wildcats had a 95 percent rate and topped all CAA schools with a matching 95 percent federal rate. Additionally, Villanova recorded a multi-year Annual Progress Rate (APR) score of 976 which was well above the average score of 959 for FCS programs.

The Wildcats were named the of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for having the highest GPA among the league's football members in both 2016-17 and 2017-18. On an individual level, football student-athletes have had 419 honorees on the CAA Football All-Academic Team and 361 selections to the Athletic Director's Honor Roll during Ferrante's time as head coach. In 2021-22 alone, Villanova had 73 members of the AD's Honor Roll who each posted a semester GPA of 3.2 or higher. Meanwhile, there were 103 selections from the Wildcats to the CAA All-Academic Team in 2021-22.

Ferrante and the Wildcats made the most out of the opportunity to play four games in a shortened Spring 2021 season and use the experience gained from those games moving forward. The spring games were officially recognized as the 2020 season and Villanova tallied a 2-2 record in four contests against CAA foes, including road wins over Stony Brook and Maine. The abbreviated season had its share of highlights, with eight players chosen for the CAA Football All-Conference teams. Corbi, Rhyne and defensive lineman Malik Fisher were each named first team All-CAA selections.

Villanova came off a 2019 season in which it was ranked as high as No. 5 in the nation. Ferrante guided the Wildcats to a 9-4 record and the program's seventh FCS playoff berth in the previous 12 years in 2019. After being picked to finish ninth in CAA Football before the season the team raced out of the gates with a 6-0 record, including a 3-0 mark in league play by the midpoint of the season. Villanova had 10 players earn All-CAA accolades, including a trio of first team selections in Rhyne, offensive lineman Paul Grattan and punter Nathan Fondacaro.

Eight players have signed NFL free agent contracts since Ferrante became head coach, with the aforementioned Rhyne and Williams joining offensive tackle Brandon Hitner (LA Rams); safety Rob Rolle (Miami Dolphins); offensive lineman Ethan Greenidge (New Orleans Saints); defensive back Trey Johnson (Pittsburgh Steelers); defensive back Malik Reaves (Kansas City Chiefs); and linebacker Ed Shockley (Dallas Cowboys).

Ferrante leads one of the nation's elite FCS programs after playing an instrumental role in the Wildcats rise to national prominence. He has been a part of the coaching staff for all 14 of Villanova's appearances in the FCS playoffs, including the 2009 national championship season and a 2010 semifinal appearance while serving as the Assistant Head Coach on Andy Talley's staff. Ferrante has been a part of Villanova teams that have won seven CAA titles, three Lambert Meadowlands Cups and three ECAC Team of the Year awards.

Ferrante's success during his years as an assistant coach were recognized by others outside the Villanova program. At the end of the 2015 season he was named the FCS Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA). This award was first presented in 1997 and was created to honor assistant coaches who excel in community service, commitment to student-athletes and on-field coaching success.Ferrante was involved in all aspects of the

Villanova program during his time as an assistant on Andy Talley's staff. On the field he coached the offensive line for 27 seasons and developed a unit that was perennially one of the best in CAA Football. Over the years he coached three All-Americans, 11 All-East performers and 15 first team all-conference selections. The offensive line had 17 All-CAA selections in a nine-year span, including three-time first team honoree Ben Ijalana along with first team selections Brant Clouser (2010), Dan Shirey (2011) and Vince Kowalski (2014).

Two of Ferrante's players went on to be selected in the NFL Draft. Ijalana was a second round selection by the Indianapolis Colts in 2011 and Brad Seaton was picked in the seventh round by the Tennessee Titans in 2017. Ijalana was a two-time All-American (2009, 2010) and a three-time first team All-CAA selection during his collegiate career. Villanova reached the FCS playoffs in each of his last three seasons on the team, winning the 2009 national title and advancing to the semifinal round a year later. Seaton was a second team CAA Football All-Conference selection in 2016 when the offensive line enabled the Wildcats to average 206.3 rushing yards and 378.7 yards of total offense per game. Villanova ranked third in the CAA and 24th nationally in rushing offense in addition to ranking fourth in the league in total offense and fifth with a scoring average of 24.4 points per game.

The other All-Americans Ferrante mentored are Eamonn Allen (2001) and Bryan Russo (1989). Allen earned first team Associated Press All-America recognition in 2001 and was also a first team All-East and first team All-Atlantic 10 selection. Russo was chosen as an All-American by the Sports Network and the American Football Coaches Association as a senior in 1989 when he was also a first team all-conference and an All-ECAC selection. He was inducted to Villanova's Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2007.

Ferrante was a standout collegiate performer in his own right prior to joining the football coaching ranks. He was the quarterback for Andy Talley at St. Lawrence where he was named the 1982 Division III Player of the Year to go along with first team All-East honors. Ferrante directed the offense for a St. Lawrence team that went 10-1 during the 1982 season and reached the national semifinals in the playoffs.

Ferrante and his wife, Georgea, reside in Phoenixville, Pa. The couple has a son, Jimmy, who earned his undergraduate degree from Villanova in 2018.
