TODAY'S GAME

■ Villanova plays the second half of its only two-game homestand of the season this week when it hosts Hampton for a 1 p.m. kickoff at Villanova Stadium. The game will air live on FloFootball and the radio call can be heard in the iHeart radio app.

■ Villanova faces CAA Football newcomer Hampton this week in what will be only the second meeting ever between the schools. The lone previous matchup came in the 2003 season opener when the Wildcats posted a 41-6 win at Villanova Stadium.

■ Villanova won as time expired last week in a thriller against UAlbany. Graduate kicker **Matthew Mercurio** made a 28-yard field goal and the Wildcats tallied their first “walk-off” win since the 2013 season finale. Despite leading 21-0 in the closing seconds of the first half and 28-16 with less than two minutes to play in the game, Villanova had to rally in the final 53 seconds after the Great Danes scored two touchdowns for a 29-28 lead. The first score came with 1:54 to play and UAlbany recovered an onside kick before scoring again with 53 seconds left.

NATIONAL RANKINGS

ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Since 1842, Villanova University's Augustinian Catholic intellectual tradition has been the cornerstone of an academic community in which students learn to think critically, act compassionately and succeed while serving others. There are more than 10,000 undergraduate, graduate and law students in the University's six colleges—the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, the Villanova School of Business, the College of Engineering, the M. Louise Fitzpatrick College of Nursing, the College of Professional Studies and the Villanova University Charles Widger School of Law. Ranked among the nation's top universities, Villanova supports its students' intellectual growth and prepares them to become ethical leaders who create positive change everywhere life takes them.

VILLANOVA ATHLETICS

Villanova University has a long and storied athletics history defined by excellence both in competition and in the classroom. The Villanova Athletics Department is a community of student-athletes, coaches and staff whose primary focus is to achieve academic excellence, while striving to produce teams and individuals committed to athletic competition and outstanding performance. Villanova Athletics sponsors 24 varsity sports, which together include more than 550 student-athletes. In the classroom, these Villanova student-athletes have registered a grade-point average higher than a 3.0 for 36 consecutive semesters. Three Villanova student-athletes have been named Rhodes Scholars, with numerous others earning Academic All-America distinction. Villanova's athletics history includes 21 NCAA team national championships, as well as 131 conference championships. In addition, at least one Villanovan has participated in every Summer Olympics since 1948. Villanova is a member of the BIG EAST Conference, CAA Football, Colonial Athletic Association (Rowing) and Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (Water Polo).

ACADEMICS

The GPA for more than 550 student-athletes during the Spring 2022 semester was 3.425, making it 15 straight semesters that student-athletes have had a GPA of 3.2 or higher. Success in the classroom has been across-the-board for Villanova Athletics, with every one of the 24 varsity sports programs posting a team GPA over a 3.0 in Spring 2022.

Villanova Athletics continues to shine among the brightest collegiate athletics programs in the country for its student-athletes' combination of academic and athletic success. New data on the Academic Progress Rate measure was released by the NCAA in June 2022 and Villanova had 11 of its varsity sport programs earn a perfect 1000 multi-year score. This is the fifth straight year that the Wildcats have had 10 or more teams earn a 1000 score.

VILLANOVA NOTES

SERIES NOTES

◆ Villanova welcomes CAA Football newcomer Hampton to Villanova Stadium this week for the second meeting between the schools. The lone previous matchup took place in the 2003 season opener for both teams when the Wildcats tallied a 41-6 victory. Hampton played its past two seasons (2019, 2021) in the Big South prior to joining CAA Football this year.

BACK IN TOWN

◆ Hampton graduate linebacker **Qwahsin Townsel** makes his return to Villanova this week after playing for the Wildcats from 2018-21. Townsel played in 34 games at Villanova during his undergraduate career and tallied 142 total tackles, including 11 tackles for loss and 2.5 sacks. This year as a graduate transfer on the Hampton roster, he is leading the team with 66 tackles and has recorded four tackles for loss, one sack, one interception and one fumble recovery.

HOMESTAND PART TWO

◆ Saturday's game against Hampton is the second half of the Wildcats only consecutive home games of the regular season. Villanova is 2-1 at home this year and is coming off an exciting 31-29 victory over UAlbany on Homecoming Weekend. The other home win this year was in the season opener against Lehigh (45-17), while the Wildcats were defeated at home in their CAA Football opener by Monmouth (49-42) on September 24.

FRENETIC FINISH

◆ Three scoring drives, 17 total points and two lead changes all in the final 114 seconds of the game? Last week's thriller against UAlbany had all of that. Villanova had leads of 21-0 in the closing seconds of the first half and 28-16 with less than two minutes left in the game before a wild finish that saw the Wildcats pull out a 31-29 victory as time expired. It all started with a Great Danes touchdown with 1:54 to play which trimmed the Villanova lead to 28-23. UAlbany then recovered an onside kick and scored again with 54 seconds left to take a 29-28 lead. After a two-point conversion was unsuccessful, the Wildcats got the ball back with 49 seconds to go and drove into field goal range where graduate kicker **Matthew Mercurio** made a walk-off 28-yarder as time expired.

WALK-OFF WIN

◆ Last week's exciting finish against UAlbany was the first "walk-off" win for Villanova since the 2013 season finale against Delaware when a last-second field goal led to a 35-34 win by the Wildcats in the annual "Battle of the Blue" game. That contest against Delaware had an even more stunning finish than the victory over the Great Danes last week. In the 2013 game — played at PPL Park (now known as Subaru Stadium) — the Wildcats trailed 34-12 with less than nine minutes to play before storming back with 23 unanswered points for a 35-34 win. While it had been nearly nine years since Villanova won a game as the clock struck zero, the win over UAlbany marked the eighth game since 2013 that the Wildcats have won in the final minute or later (see graphic at the top of page 4).

MORE ON MERCURIO

◆ Villanova has gotten outstanding production this season from graduate kicker **Matthew Mercurio** in his first season on the Main Line. Mercurio played his undergraduate football at San Jose State and was a two-time honorable mention All-Mountain West selection. He scored 222 points over three seasons while playing for the Spartans, making 90-of-93 PATs and 44-of-54 field goals with nine successful attempts from 40 yards or longer. This season Mercurio has a team-high 47 points through the first seven games of the year. He has made six field goals in eight tries, including the game-winner from 28 yards against UAlbany last week — and is a perfect 29-of-29 on PAT attempts for a high-powered Villanova offense. Entering the game against Hampton this week, Mercurio ranks second in the CAA and 30th nationally with his 75.0 percent field goal rate.

- UAlbany was the first Villanova opponent to have 100+ penalty yards since JMU in 2013
- The game had three scoring drives, 17 points and two lead changes in the final 1:54
- Villanova won as time expired despite leading 21-0 (first half) and 28-16 with 4:44 to play
- Villanova's seventh come-from-behind win in the final minute of play since 2013
- Villanova's second straight Homecoming Weekend win after a three-year losing streak

VILLANOVA NOTES

REACHING THE CENTURY MARK

◆ Senior running back **TD Ayo-Durojaiye** topped 100 rushing yards for the third time this season and the second straight game when he rushed for a career-high 136 yards against UAlbany last week. Ayo-Durojaiye carried the ball a career-high 20 times and averaged 6.8 yards per rush, including a career-long 70-yard touchdown run on the game's second play from scrimmage. Earlier this season Ayo-Durojaiye notched his first career 100-yard game when he ran for 109 yards at LIU on September 10. He also had a 106-yard rushing game at Richmond on October 15. Ayo-Durojaiye enters the Hampton game this week needing only 22 rushing yards to become the 37th player in school history to top 1,000 career yards on the ground.

PASSING TO PRINGLE

◆ Senior wide receiver **Rayjuon Pringle** had his best game of the season in the win over UAlbany last week. He erupted for 143 receiving yards and two touchdowns on just four catches in the 31-29 win, including a 20-yard touchdown reception late in the second quarter and a career-long 80-yard score with 4:44 to play in the contest. It was the sixth career game and first this season topping the 100-yard mark for Pringle. During the game he moved into 20th place in school history with 1,447 career receiving yards. He enters the Hampton game this week need just 53 more yards to become the 18th player in school history to reach the 1,500-yard plateau.

BIG PLAYS APLENTY

◆ Villanova's high-powered offense has produced 37 plays from scrimmage of 20 yards or longer this season, including 16 plays for 40 yards or more through the first seven games. Junior quarterback **Connor Watkins** has 24 pass completions of at least 20 yards and 13 passes of 40+ yards on the year, while the Wildcats also have 13 rushes of 20 yards or more. Two of the four longest plays of the season occurred in the game against UAlbany last week. Senior running back **TD Ayo-Durojaiye** broke away for a career-long 70-yard touchdown run on the second play of the game. Later in the contest, Watkins connected with senior wide receiver **Rayjuon Pringle** on an 80-yard touchdown.

THE WATKINS TO HAYEK CONNECTION

◆ Junior quarterback **Connor Watkins** and senior wide receiver **Jaaron Hayek** have been a dynamic duo this season. In his first year as the starting quarterback Watkins is leading the nation in yards per completion (17.65) and Hayek is ranked third in the country in yards per reception (23.00). Watkins has thrown 13 passes for 40 yards or longer on the season and Hayek has caught nine of those passes, including an 83-yard touchdown reception and two catches of 60+ yards.

PICKING OFF PASSES

◆ Sophomore cornerback **Tyrell Mims** recorded his second career interception in the game against UAlbany last week. His first career pick came against LIU earlier in the year and Mims now leads the team with his two interceptions through the first seven games of the season. The INT against UAlbany last week was particularly noteworthy because it is the only interception that Great Danes quarterback Reese Poffenbarger has thrown on 235 pass attempts this year.

LIMITING THE DAMAGE

◆ Villanova has done a good job of stopping the opposition after the Wildcats commit a turnover. Although the Wildcats have turned the ball over 10 times in their first seven games and have a minus-one turnover margin on the season, the Villanova defense has given up points on just two of the 10 opponent drives that began after a turnover. For the season the Wildcats have a 28-14 advantage over its opponents in points off turnovers.

STRONG START FOR WATKINS

◆ Junior quarterback **Connor Watkins** was a revelation in the season opener against Lehigh when he set a Villanova record for the most passing yards (298) by a quarterback in their first career start. Watkins went 11-of-15 for 298 yards and three touchdowns in that game, with his 306.2 efficiency rating for the contest the highest among all FCS quarterbacks in the first week of the season. Now seven games into his first season as the Wildcats starter, Watkins continues to lead the nation in most passing yards per completion (17.65). He is 85-of-136 through the air for 1,500 yards with 14 touchdowns and nine interceptions. Watkins has also rushed for 208 yards and is tied for the team lead with five rushing touchdowns. He is responsible for 19 of the team's 28 offensive touchdowns on the year.

RATE OF RETURN

◆ In the game at Richmond on October 15 fifth-year senior **Dez Boykin** became the fifth player in Villanova history to surpass 1,500 career kickoff return yards. He has returned 67 kickoffs for a total of 1,585 yards and an average of 23.7 yards per return during his Wildcats career. Boykin has been at his best through the first seven games of the current season, as his average of 26.2 yards per return leads CAA Football and ranks 15th in the country. He has five returns of 30 yards or longer on the season, including a career-long 68-yard return in the season opener against Lehigh.

VILLANOVA NOTES

PICK OF THE DAY

◆ Junior safety **Jalen Goodman** scored the first points of his career in the game against Maine on October 1 when he returned an interception 23 yards for a touchdown to put the finishing touches on a 45-20 win over the Black Bears. The interception was the first of his career and Goodman's return for a score accounts for the only points scored by the Villanova defense this season.

SPECIAL PERFORMER ON SPECIAL TEAMS

◆ Senior running back **TD Ayo-Durojaiye** has been a standout special teams performer for the Wildcats over the last two seasons and he leads Villanova with 18 tackles on special teams (15 on kickoff returns, three on punt returns) since the start of the 2021 campaign. Ayo-Durojaiye has recorded at least one tackle in 12 of his last 20 games played and had a career-high four stops at Maine earlier this month. On the flip side of special teams, he has returned nine career kickoff returns for an average of 21.9 yards per return. Ayo-Durojaiye also scored a special teams touchdown at UAlbany last year when he scooped up a blocked punt and returned it 15 yards for a touchdown. As an offensive player, Ayo-Durojaiye's stats include 978 rushing yards and six touchdowns to go along with 23 receptions for 197 yards. He has 1,387 career all-purpose yards.

GRADUATE TRANSFERS MAKE IMMEDIATE IMPACT

◆ Villanova had three fifth-year transfers make key contributions in a 45-17 win over Lehigh in Week 1. Linebacker **Antonio Montero** from Rice registered a game-high 10 tackles and forced a fumble, linebacker **Danny Abraham** recorded an interception which he returned 32 yards to go along with three tackles on the day, and placekicker **Matthew Mercurio** made a 27-yard field goal in addition to going 6-of-6 on PATs. All three players made their official debut for Villanova when the game was played.

SEEING NEW FACES

◆ The Villanova roster has a bit of a different look this season with more than 30 newcomers joining a roster that lost more than a dozen starters from last season, including eight starters lost on defense. During the season opener against Lehigh in Week 1, 11 of the 60 players who saw game action for the Wildcats were making their Villanova debut. In addition, eight different players made the first start of their collegiate careers in the season opener.

◆ Graduate student tight end **Tyler Will** is a seventh year collegiate student-athlete this year. Will walked on to the Villanova football team as a senior in school before the 2019 season. He saw most of his time on special teams that year before transitioning to offense during Spring Ball in 2020. Now a veteran of 31 career collegiate games, Will has made eight career receptions for 43 yards and one touchdown to go along with three rushes for 14 yards and a score. On defense and special teams Will has registered 21 total tackles, including eight solo stops and 13 assisted tackles.

ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

NCAA PUBLIC RECOGNITION AWARD

■ Each year the NCAA recognizes programs that have a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranks within the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. Villanova has earned this award nine times in the 16-year history of the APR program, including in four of the last six years for which data is available.

■ Villanova was one of just five FCS programs in 2017-18 to have both its football and men's basketball programs each public recognition awards.

■ The football team has set a new program record for its highest APR score in four of the last six years.

ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

■ One of the highest honors that a student-athlete can achieve is to be named an Academic All-American, an award which encompasses both academic achievement as well as contributions on the field. Villanova has had 12 football student-athletes earn a total of 14 Academic All-America honors over the years.

CAA TEAM ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

■ Villanova was the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for both the 2016-17 and the 2017-18 school years. The award is presented at the end of each academic year to the conference school with the highest team GPA.

CAA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

■ Villanova has had five student-athletes be named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Nominees for the award must have attained senior standing academically and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

CAA ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

■ Student-athletes with a semester GPA of 3.0 or higher are named to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll. Villanova had 55 honorees for the Fall 2021 semester and 48 student-athletes achieve this distinction for the Spring 2022 term.

ACADEMIC ALL-AREA TEAMS

■ In conjunction with the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, the sports information directors at the colleges and universities in the Philadelphia area (PhillySIDA) name an Academic All-Area team and a football Performer of the Year each season. In the 15 years of the Academic All-Area program, which started with the 2005-06 academic year, the football team has had a total of 54 selections to the Academic All-Area Team. In addition, the Wildcats have had five Performers of the Year.

VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE



Coming off a breakthrough season which included a conference title, FCS playoff appearance and his first Coach of the Year award, Mark Ferrante has Villanova riding a wave of momentum entering his sixth season as head coach. Ferrante begins the 2022 campaign with a career record of 31-21 (.596), including 19 regular season CAA Football wins. He is in his 36th year overall with the Wildcats including his time as head coach and 30 years as an assistant from 1987-2016. Ferrante has been a part of 248 victories and all 14 of the program's FCS playoff appearances during his Villanova tenure.

In addition to being named the CAA Football Coach of the Year last season, Ferrante was the 2021 winner of the AFCA FCS Region I

Coach of the Year award. That honor made him a finalist for National Coach of the Year consideration and earned him recognition at the AFCA national convention following the season. Ferrante guided the Wildcats to a 10-3 record a year ago and Villanova won a share of the CAA Football title while securing the league's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs. It is the second straight full season (2019, 2021) in which Ferrante guided the Wildcats to postseason play.

Villanova hosted two playoff games last year and advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Division I Football Championship to finish the year ranked in the top-10 nationally (No. 8) in both FCS national polls for the first time since 2014. The Wildcats tallied their seventh season in program history with at least 10 wins and achieved success by playing – and beating – some of the top FCS teams in the nation. Villanova's 10-3 record included four victories over Top 25 opponents, including No. 3 James Madison, No. 18 Rhode Island, No. 21 Richmond and No. 24 Holy Cross. Ferrante led the Wildcats to a 7-1 record against a challenging CAA Football schedule to mark the fifth season since 1988 in which the team had no more than one loss in conference play.

There was star power in all facets of the game for Villanova last season, with Ferrante coaching 11 players who had an opportunity to continue their football careers beyond the college ranks. The group included cornerback Christian Benford who was a sixth round draft pick of the Buffalo Bills. Fellow corner Denzel Williams signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Ravens and linebacker Forrest Rhyne was inked to a free agent contract by the Indianapolis Colts. Benford and Rhyne were consensus first team All-Americans in 2021, while offensive lineman Michael Corbi was also a 2021 All-America selection and was one of 13 Wildcats who were named to the CAA Football All-Conference teams.

In the first five seasons that Ferrante has been head coach the Wildcats have had five major conference award winners and 38 CAA Football All-Conference selections, including 12 first team picks. Christian Benford was the CAA Defensive Rookie of the Year in 2018 and Villanova had consecutive winners of the prestigious Chuck Boone Leadership and Excellence Award which is presented to one senior student-athlete who embodies the highest standards of leadership, integrity, teamwork, and sportsmanship in academics and athletics. Chucky Smith was the 2019 winner of the award and Justin Covington earned the honor for the 2020 season.

Outside of football the Wildcats student-athletes have consistently excelled in their academic pursuits during Ferrante's head coaching tenure. Villanova ranked second in CAA Football in the most recent NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) data which was released in December 2021. The Wildcats had a 95 percent rate and topped all CAA schools with a matching 95 percent federal rate. Additionally, Villanova recorded a multi-year Annual Progress Rate (APR) score of 976 which was well above the average score of 959 for FCS programs.

The Wildcats were named the of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for having the highest GPA among the league's football members in both 2016-17 and 2017-18. On an individual level, football student-athletes have had 419 honorees on the CAA Football All-Academic Team and 361 selections to the Athletic Director's Honor Roll during Ferrante's time as head coach. In 2021-22 alone, Villanova had 73 members of the AD's Honor Roll who each posted a semester GPA of 3.2 or higher. Meanwhile, there were 103 selections from the Wildcats to the CAA All-Academic Team in 2021-22.

VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

MARK FERRANTE / VILLANOVA COACHING STAFF

Ferrante and the Wildcats made the most out of the opportunity to play four games in a shortened Spring 2021 season and use the experience gained from those games moving forward. The spring games were officially recognized as the 2020 season and Villanova tallied a 2-2 record in four contests against CAA foes, including road wins over Stony Brook and Maine. The abbreviated season had its share of highlights, with eight players chosen for the CAA Football All-Conference teams. Corbi, Rhyne and defensive lineman Malik Fisher were each named first team All-CAA selections.

Villanova came off a 2019 season in which it was ranked as high as No. 5 in the nation. Ferrante guided the Wildcats to a 9-4 record and the program's seventh FCS playoff berth in the previous 12 years in 2019. After being picked to finish ninth in CAA Football before the season the team raced out of the gates with a 6-0 record, including a 3-0 mark in league play by the midpoint of the season. Villanova had 10 players earn All-CAA accolades, including a trio of first team selections in Rhyne, offensive lineman Paul Grattan and punter Nathan Fondacaro.

Eight players have signed NFL free agent contracts since Ferrante became head coach, with the aforementioned Rhyne and Williams joining offensive tackle Brandon Hitner (LA Rams); safety Rob Rolle (Miami Dolphins); offensive lineman Ethan Greenidge (New Orleans Saints); defensive back Trey Johnson (Pittsburgh Steelers); defensive back Malik Reaves (Kansas City Chiefs); and linebacker Ed Shockley (Dallas Cowboys).

Ferrante leads one of the nation's elite FCS programs after playing an instrumental role in the Wildcats rise to national prominence. He has been a part of the coaching staff for all 14 of Villanova's appearances in the FCS playoffs, including the 2009 national championship season and a 2010 semifinal appearance while serving as the Assistant Head Coach on Andy Talley's staff. Ferrante has been a part of Villanova teams that have won seven CAA titles, three Lambert Mead-owlands Cups and three ECAC Team of the Year awards.

Ferrante's success during his years as an assistant coach were recognized by others outside the Villanova program. At the end of the 2015 season he was named the FCS Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA). This award was first presented in 1997 and was created to honor assistant coaches who excel in community service, commitment to student-athletes and on-field coaching success. Ferrante was involved in all aspects of the

Villanova program during his time as an assistant on Andy Talley's staff. On the field he coached the offensive line for 27 seasons and developed a unit that was perennially one of the best in CAA Football. Over the years he coached three All-Americans, 11 All-East performers and 15 first team all-conference selections. The offensive line had 17 All-CAA selections in a nine-year span, including three-time first team honoree Ben Ijalana along with first team selections Brant Clouser (2010), Dan Shirey (2011) and Vince Kowalski (2014).

Two of Ferrante's players went on to be selected in the NFL Draft. Ijalana was a second round selection by the Indianapolis Colts in 2011 and Brad Seaton was picked in the seventh round by the Tennessee Titans in 2017. Ijalana was a two-time All-American (2009, 2010) and a three-time first team All-CAA selection during his collegiate career. Villanova reached the FCS playoffs in each of his last three seasons on the team, winning the 2009 national title and advancing to the semifinal round a year later. Seaton was a second team CAA Football All-Conference selection in 2016 when the offensive line enabled the Wildcats to average 206.3 rushing yards and 378.7 yards of total offense per game. Villanova ranked third in the CAA and 24th nationally in rushing offense in addition to ranking fourth in the league in total offense and fifth with a scoring average of 24.4 points per game.

The other All-Americans Ferrante mentored are Eamonn Allen (2001) and Bryan Russo (1989). Allen earned first team Associated Press All-America recognition in 2001 and was also a first team All-East and first team All-Atlantic 10 selection. Russo was chosen as an All-American by the Sports Network and the American Football Coaches Association as a senior in 1989 when he was also a first team all-conference and an All-ECAC selection. He was inducted to Villanova's Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2007.

Ferrante was a standout collegiate performer in his own right prior to joining the football coaching ranks. He was the quarterback for Andy Talley at St. Lawrence where he was named the 1982 Division III Player of the Year to go along with first team All-East honors. Ferrante directed the offense for a St. Lawrence team that went 10-1 during the 1982 season and reached the national semifinals in the playoffs.

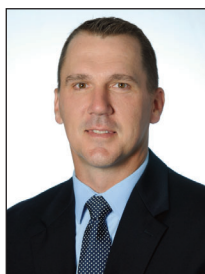

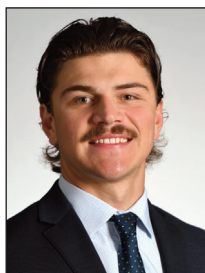
