HEN TRACKS

For the seventh-consecutive season, the annual Battle of the Blue between Delaware and Villanova will serve as the regular season finale for the two teams. It will be the 56th all-time meeting between the two longtime rivals and the game will once again have postseason implications as the Blue Hens are fighting for an at-large bid into the FCS playoffs.

UD is looking to win its second-consecutive game at Villanova Stadium after defeating the Wildcats 27-20 during the 2020-21 Spring season. That victory clinched the CAA Championship for the Blue & Gold. Nolan Henderson completed 20-of-24 passes for 270 yards and touchdown passes to Jourdan Townsend and Bryce De Maille while Thyrick Pitts caught five passes for 104 yards.

Delaware is coming off a heartbreaking 21-13 loss to then-No. 12/13 Richmond last weekend at Delaware Stadium. In a battle between the CAA's top two defenses, the Blue Hens held the Spiders to just four field goals over the first 59 minutes while taking a 13-12 lead. However, Richmond connected on a 39-yard field goal with four seconds remaining and then recovered a fumble in the end zone on the kickoff to snatch victory away from the Blue Hens.

Nolan Henderson completed 23-of-37 passes for 196 yards. He and Marcus Yarns ran for a touchdown, while Quincy Watson led the rushing attack with 62 yards on 10 carries. Jourdan Townsend caught seven passes for 79 yards. Delaware rushed for 163 yards on the day and out-gained Richmond 359-352.

Nic Ware and Noah Plack finished with a team-high nine tackles apiece, while Ware had one of UD's two sacks and Plack recovered one of two fumbles on the day. The defense did not allow an offensive touchdown for the third time in six home games.

Johnny Buchanan has led the Delaware defense all season with six games of at least 10 tackles. He is second in the nation with 118 tackles on the season, which is 25 more than anyone else in the CAA. Buchanan needs just five tackles on Saturday to become the 20th player in program history with 300 career tackles.

Against Richmond, Henderson had a streak snapped of eight-consecutive games with at least 200 yards passing, which is the third-longest streak in program history. Joe Flacco (15, 2006-07) and Matt Nagy (9, 1998) are the only two with longer streaks. Henderson has passed for 25 touchdowns on the season, which is tied for the second most in program history (Andy Hall, 2003). Henderson now has 49 career touchdown passes, which is second all-time at Delaware.

The Blue Hen defense continues to be one of the toughest in all of FCS, ranking third in both scoring (14.9 ppg) and total (281.3 ypg) defense as well as second in pass defense (135.3 ypg). UD had not allowed an opposing quarterback to pass for 200 yards in a game prior to Richmond's Reece Udinski, and has held four opponents under 100 yards passing.

EXPLOSIVE PLAYS

Delaware's high-octane offense has been on display since the first snap of the season. Through the team's first 10 games, UD has had 43 plays go for 20 yards or more. 31 of those have been pass plays with 13 resulting in touchdowns. The Blue Hens had a season-high eight "explosive" plays in their 24-10 win over Towson, and seven in the 42-21 win at Rhode Island.

CLIMBING THE CAREER LADDER

Thyrick Pitts has caught a pass in 40-straight games, which is the second-longest streak in UD history behind only Nihja White (42, 2009-12). Pitts currently ranks ninth all-time at Delaware with 157 career catches, is eighth with 2,230 receiving yards and third with 20 touchdown catches.

Nolan Henderson threw for 200-plus yards in eight-straight games, the third-longest streak in program history, and had a passing TD in nine-straight games. He is second in Delaware history in passing touchdowns (49), fourth in completions (494), sixth in passing yards (5,800).

PITTS' MILESTONE GAME

In Delaware's 35-3 victory over Hampton, Thyrick Pitts had a milestone performance. He caught three scoring passes, becoming the first UD player with three touchdown receptions in a game since Michael Johnson in 2013. His first touchdown catch pushed him past 2,000 career receiving yards, becoming just the ninth player in program history to surpass the milestone.

FLOODING THE TUB

The Blue Hens finished their home regular season slate with a 5-1 record at Delaware Stadium. UD is one of four FCS schools to surpass 100,000 fans at its home games in 2022, achieving its highest total (101,410) since 2014. Delaware averaged 16,902 fans at home games, its highest average since 2013. The home contest against Towson on Oct. 1 had a sellout crowd of 18,905.

Delaware's defense held its opponents without an offensive touchdown in three of its six home games and the Blue Hens are averaging 32.3 ppg while allowing just 11.2 ppg.

HENDERSON'S CAREER PERFORMANCES

Quarterback Nolan Henderson has had several career performances to start the 2022 season. He set career highs in three-consecutive games in completions, pass attempts and passing touchdowns. Between the Rhode Island and Hampton games, he became the first UD quarterback to pass for 4+ touchdowns in consecutive games.

BUCHANAN'S BIG WEEK ONE

Linebacker Johnny Buchanan had a monster week one at Navy, tying a UD record with 23 tackles on the day, including nine solo stops and a forced fumble. He led a defense that allowed just seven points, the fewest by a CAA team against an FBS opponent since 2006, and forced three turnovers while holding Navy 0-for-3 on fourth downs. Buchanan was named both the CAA Defensive Player of the Week and FedEx Ground FCS National Defensive Player of the Week by Stats Perform.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

The Blue Hens will be led by a veteran group of student-athletes that enter the season having played a combined 182 games for the Blue & Gold. Nolan Henderson and Kedrick Whitehead will serve as captains for the third-straight season, while Thyrick Pitts, Johnny Buchanan and Liam Trainer were all selected for the first time. The five captains were chosen by a vote of their teammates.

All student-athlete interviews must be requested through Brendan Thomas in the University of Delaware Athletics Communications Office, and must be arranged at least 24 hours in advance.

Media members will have access to the first 45-60 minutes, depending on that day's practice plan, on Tuesdays and Wednesdays only. Practices will be held at the Delaware Practice Fields beginning at 8 a.m. Please contact Brendan Thomas at least 24 hours in advance if you wish to attend a practice. Head Coach Ryan Carty and requested players will be available after a brief cooling off period following each game. SAME FACES, NEW SIDE OF THE BALL

A pair of Blue Hens switched positions during the spring season and are now lining up on the other side of the ball. Fintan Brose appeared in 13 games over the past two seasons on the defensive line, but is now a part of the offensive line unit. Similarly, Mateo Vandamia was a key member of the tight end corps for the past three seasons, but will now look to make a comparable impact as a linebacker.

IN-STATE QBs

Quarterbacks Nolan Henderson (Smyrna, Del. / Smyrna) and Zach Gwynn (Wilmington, Del. / Salesianum) have each started under center for the Blue Hens in their career, becoming just the third and fourth Delaware natives, respectively, in the past 28 seasons to start for the Blue Hens, joining Sam Postlethwait (2001) and Dale Fry (1993).

BROTHERLY LOVE

Delaware has three sets of brothers on its roster in 2022. Braden and Fintan Brose, twins Christian and Christopher Pierce as well as Liam and Dillon Trainer.

TRANSFERS

Head Coach Ryan Carty brought in 12 transfers this offseason that will look to make an immediate impact for the Blue & Gold. The newcomers cover five different positions and include a 2021 Freshman All-American, two all-conference selections and two Power Five transfers.

1,000 AND COUNTING

Delaware will have a lot of talent lining up at wide receiver this season, but is one of just a few teams in the country to have three receivers that each enter the season with more than 1,000 career receiving yards. Thyrick Pitts, entering his sixth season in the Blue & Gold, has accounted for 1,798 receiving yards and is just 202 yards away from becoming the ninth Blue Hen in program history to amass 2,000 career yards. Michael Jackson Jr., a graduate transfer from VMI, has 1,210 receiving yards over four seasons while Jalyn Witcher, a sophomore transfer from Presbyterian, had a school-record 1,120 yards last year to earn Freshman All-American honors.

MORE BANG FOR YOUR BUCK

Prior to the season, safety Kedrick Whitehead was named to the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List, the award given to the best defensive player in FCS at the end of the season. Whitehead was one of 35 players, including four from the CAA, to be on the original watch list.

Linebacker Johnny Buchanan was added to the watch list midway through the season. They become the first Blue Hens to be considered for the Buck Buchanan Award since Troy Reeder and Nasir Adderley, now teammates on the Los Angeles Chargers, were both finalists for the award in 2018.

WATCH OUT FOR WALTER

Quarterback Nolan Henderson was named a midseason addition to the 2022 Walter Payton Award Watch List, given to the best offensive player in the country at the FCS level. Henderson is the first Blue Hen to be named to the watch list since Dejon Lee prior to the 2021 campaign.

FAMILIAR FACES ON THE COACHING STAFF

The Blue Hens have almost an entirely new coaching staff, with 12 of the 15 staff members new to the program this season. However, three coaches will be familiar to Delaware fans.

Head Coach Ryan Carty donned the Blue & Gold from 2002-06 as a quarterback and was a part of the 2003 national championship team.

Assistant Coach Andrew Pierce was one of the best running backs in program history, compiling 4,459 rushing yards from 2010-13 which still ranks second in program history.

Volunteer Assistant Coach Paul Worrlow (2009-12) ranks fifth all-time in tackles at Delaware with 377 career tackles and rejoins the Blue Hens after an eight-year NFL career with Atlanta, Detroit, Philadelphia and the New York Jets.

AFCA GOODWORKS

Graduate student wide receiver Thyrick Pitts has been named one of the nominees for the 2022 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team. Pitts is one of 114 nominees across all divisions of college football. To be considered for a spot on the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team, each player must be actively involved with a charitable organization or service group while maintaining strong academic standing.

PRESEASON ALL-CAA HONORS

Delaware had a league-high five student-athletes selected to the All-CAA Preseason Team, which was announced during the league's virtual media day on July 28. Wide receiver Thyrick Pitts earned his second-straight nod to the preseason team while defensive back Kedrick Whitehead led a quartet of Blue Hens on the defensive side. He was joined by linebacker Johnny Buchanan as well as defensive linemen Artis Hemmingway and Chase McGowan.

PRESEASON POLLS

Despite a disappointing end to the 2021 season, the Blue Hens have received plenty of preseason recognition. Delaware received seven first-place votes and 235 points overall to finish second in the preseason poll behind only Villanova.

In the national polls, the Blue & Gold were ranked No. 19 in both the Stats Perform and AFCA Coaches FCS Preseason Polls. The Blue Hens are also ranked No. 15 in the HERO Sports Preseason FCS Poll and No. 20 in the 2022 Athlon Sports FCS Preseason Top 25.

ALL-AMERICAN

Fifth-year safety Kedrick Whitehead has been named an All-American five times in his career, including earning third team (Stats Perform) honors in 2021. He was also named First Team All-American in 2020-21 by Stats Perform, Associated Press and Athlon Sports and a HERO Sports Sophomore All-American in 2019.

Going into 2022, Whitehead has been named a Preseason All-American by HERO Sports, Stats Perform and Athlon Sports.

With phase one of the Delaware Stadium renovation project complete, the Blue Hens hold one of the finest facilities in all of Division I football, FBS included. The new Whitney Athletic Center holds a state-of-the-art weight room, nutrition center, academic center, athletic training center and much more. The building provides next-level resources for all Delaware student-athletes.

ROYAL COMPANY

The University of Delaware is one of just three institutions with an alumnus elected President (Biden), a Super Bowl MVP (Flacco), and an NFL MVP (Gannon), along with Stanford and Michigan.

Delaware is one of eight FCS programs with 700 all-time victories. A total of just 39 Division I schools have surpassed 700 all-time wins and Delaware did it in style when it defeated Maine in three overtimes in 2019.

THE HENFL

Currently, there are five active players, three assistant coaches, a general manager, and one scout from Delaware in the league.

For Super Bowl LVI, Delaware was the only FCS program with two alums playing as Troy Reeder started at linebacker for the Los Angeles Rams and Zach Kerr suited up for the Cincinnati Bengals. The Blue Hens were just two of five players on either roster that played at the FCS level. They became the 10th and 11th players in Delaware history to play in the Super Bowl, and Reeder became the third Blue Hen to lift the Lombard Trophy.

SERIES VS. VILLANOVA

OPPONENT NOTES

❖ Villanova comes into Saturday's contest with a 5-5 record and a 3-4 mark in CAA play. The Wildcats have dropped two-straight contests, falling on the road at Towson (27-3) and at William & Mary (45-12).

❖ On offense, the Wildcats are averaging 26.0 ppg and 389.3 ypg, while the Villanova defense is giving up 28.7 ppg and 392.5 ypg.

❖ Connor Watkins has passed for 1,935 yards while completing 56.7 percent of his passes. He has thrown for 16 touchdowns while rushing for seven more. TD Ayo-Durojaiye leads the ground game with 67.6 ypg while Jalen Jackson has added five rushing touchdowns.

❖ In just eight games, Jaaron Hayek leads the way in all receiving categories with 36 catches for 810 yards and eight scores. Rayjuon Pringle has also caught eight touchdown passes.

❖ Defensively, Shane Hartzell has team-highs of 64 tackles, 7.0 TFL and 3.0 sacks. Daniel Abraham and Tyrell Mims have two interceptions apiece.

HISTORY NOTES

❖ Not only the biggest rivalry for the Blue Hens, but the Delaware-Villanova series is one of the longest, with Saturday being the 56th meeting between the two programs.

❖ Villanova leads the all-time series 32-22-1 and has won 15 of the past 17 meetings, including a 21-13 decision in last year's season finale at Delaware Stadium.

❖ In last year's contest, Zach Gwynn finished 14-of-27 passing for 143 yards, while Dejour Lee rushed for 54 yards and a touchdown. Kedrick Whitehead led the defense with 12 tackles and Johnny Buchanan added 11.

❖ The last time the two teams met at Villanova Stadium was during the 2020-21 Spring season finale. Delaware snapped a nine-game losing streak to the Wildcats with a 27-20 win that clinched the CAA Championship for the Blue Hens.

❖ Nolan Henderson completed 20-of-24 passes for 270 yards and touchdown passes to Jourdan Townsend and Bryce De Maille while Thyrick Pitts caught five passes for 104 yards.

HEAD COACH RYAN CARTY

FIRST SEASON

A Delaware alum and member of the 2003 national championship team, Ryan Carty was named the head football coach on Friday, Dec. 10 by Director of Intercollegiate Athletics & Recreation Services, Chrissi Rawak. Carty spent the previous four seasons as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Sam Houston.

"I am thrilled to welcome Ryan Carty as the new head coach of our football program", said UD President Dennis Assanis. "Ryan is a proud Blue Hen who is dedicated to the success of student-athletes, both on the field and in the classroom, and he will bring exceptional creativity, energy and a championship mindset to our talented team. I know all of us — students, alumni, fans and especially Ryan's former teammates — will be looking forward to next season to cheer him and the Fightin' Blue Hens to victory."

"I could not be more excited and proud to bring Coach Carty and his wife Katie home to the University of Delaware," said Rawak. "We set out to find the best fit for Delaware football and we found an individual that exemplifies everything this University represents. Ryan is a winner and a champion, plain and simple. He has succeeded at every stop because he does it the right way and is committed to a culture of excellence."

Known for his explosive plays and high-energy offense, Carty was recognized for his offensive success in the spring 2021 season. Named the FCS Coordinator of the Year by FootballScoop.com and to Dave Campbell's Texas Football's "Top 40 Coaches Under 40" list, Carty played an instrumental part in Sam Houston winning the 2020 FCS National Championship as well as advancing to the 2021 FCS quarterfinals.

Carty's offense helped lead Sam Houston to a 34-10 record from 2018-21 and a 21-1 mark in his final two seasons the past two seasons in Huntsville. The Bearkats had an undefeated regular season in 2021 and advanced to the FCS Quarterfinals. Sam Houston finished the season ranked third in the nation in scoring offense (41.0 ppg), fifth in total offense (490.9 ypg), and sixth in rushing offense (228.2 ypg).

During the Bearkats' undefeated 10-0 spring season, SHSU ranked first nationally in total yards (4,403), first in touchdowns (45), third in first downs (204), seventh in passing yards per attempt (8.6 ypa), eighth in passing yards per completion (14.3 ypc), ninth in scoring offense (38 ppg), 13th in total offense (440 ypg), and 13th in passing offense (282 ypg).

With a proven record as one of the top offensive coordinators and quarterbacks coaches in the nation, Carty coached SHSU quarterback and Walter Payton Award finalist Eric Schmid to Southland Conference Player of the Year honors on his way to leading the FCS in total passing yards in the spring.

During his four-year stint with Sam Houston, the Bearkats advanced to the playoffs in back-to-back years and won two conference titles.

Prior to his stop in Huntsville, Carty was very familiar with the Colonial Athletic Association after an 11-year run on the New Hampshire coaching staff, including six years as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach.

During Carty's stint at New Hampshire, the Wildcats qualified for the FCS playoffs in each of Carty's six seasons as offensive coordinator, compiling an 8-6 postseason record and reaching the semifinals in 2013 and 2014. The Wildcats garnered seven or more wins every season Carty was on staff. As the offensive coordinator, UNH quarterbacks combined for 18,656 Yards and 171 TDs in 80 contests with Carty leading the offense.

Carty, a team captain during his 2006 senior campaign, earned his bachelor's degree in management from Delaware in 2006.

A native of Branchburg, N.J., Carty and his wife, Katie, are happy to join the Blue Hen family.
