TOWSON OPENS NOVEMBER VS. VILLANOVA FOR MILITARY APPRECIATION GAME

L, 10-24 Towson begins the month of November with a 2 p.m. home contest vs. Villanova on Saturday, Nov. 5 for the annual Military Appreciation Game.

Towson is coming off its best offensive performance since 2019, winning at Monmouth 52-48 on Saturday to be 3-5 overall and 1-4 in the CAA. Villanova has won its last two, the previous a 24-10 home win vs. Hampton on Saturday, to enter at 5-3 overall and 3-2 in the CAA. Villanova is receiving votes in each the STATS FCS and AFCA Coaches polls.

These two last played in a thriller on Sept. 21, 2019 at Unitas, with #18 Villanova winning 52-45 in overtime vs. #5 Towson. Villanova leads the all-time series 11-5.

Towson has three regular season games left, including two at home: vs. Villanova on Nov. 5 and vs. Hampton on Nov. 19.

Football Information Credentials

Credential Pick-Up

Media members can pick-up their credentials at the Media Will Call entrance located on the bottom floor of the Unitas Stadium press box. Photo identification is required for pick up.

Game Procedures

Press Box - Seating in the press box is limited to working media and Towson staff only. Space is limited and members of the media will be assigned seats. Spouses, dates, children and other non-workers are not permitted in working media areas in compliance with the working code of the Football Writers Association of America.

Photographers - Print and television photographers are allowed to shoot from both sidelines and both end zones, but are not allowed in the team bench areas. Failure to comply with this policy will result in the revocation of credentials.

Parking - A limited number of parking spaces are available for each home game. The media parking lot is located at the Osler Medical Center. Members of the media who cover Towson regularly will be issued parking passes prior to the start of the season. Visiting media members need to contact the TU media relations office to request parking and will need to give a timely request for the best chance at parking.

Interviews after games on the road will be conducted based on the post-game policy of that institution. Towson personnel will be gathered by the Towson SID, not by any other SID.

TOWSON RETURNS FOR 2022 SEASON

It is a new year for Towson as the Tigers are set for their 53rd season. Rob Ambrose returns at the helm of his 13th season.

It is a new look Towson team with over 50 new players joining since the spring season began. Four starters return on each side of the ball for Towson in 2022.

GIBBS NAMED TO REESE'S SENIOR BOWL WATCH LIST

Jesus Gibbs has been selected to the 10th Annual Reese's Senior Bowl Watch List. The Senior Bowl, set for Feb. 4, 2023, will gather some of the top prospects for the upcoming National Football League (NFL) Draft. Gibbs will look to be the first Towson player to compete in the Reese's Senior Bowl since Tony Vinson played in the game in 1994.

Gibbs, a South Carolina transfer, enters his third year playing for the Tigers in 2022. The standout defensive lineman had three games with at least four tackles each before ending the year due to injury, including three total tackles for loss. He was recently featured on Bruce Feldman's 2022 College Football "Freaks" List as one of the top college football players with unique physical abilities.

WOODS SELECTED TO JERRY RICE AWARD WATCH LIST

Mason Woods has been placed on the 2022 Stats Perform FCS Jerry Rice Award Watch List. The Jerry Rice Award is presented to the top freshman in FCS each year. Woods is one of 25 freshmen across FCS to be on the watch list, including one of four linebackers.

Woods is the first member of the Jerry Rice Award Watch List since Shane Simpson finished ninth in the voting in 2016. Former Towson running back Terrance West won the inaugural Jerry Rice Award for the 2011 season.

Woods has started all eight games this season for the Tigers, standing first on the team with 62 tackles, adding 1.5 sacks, an interception and three pass-breakups.

HAMILTON, HUNTER RECOGNIZED ON CAA PRESEASON AWARDS

Two Tigers were recognized on the CAA preseason awards: Luke Hamilton earned 2022 CAA Football Preseason All-Conference Team while D'Ago Hunter was an honorable mention at kick/punt returner.

Hamilton was the 2021 Second Team All-CAA fullback and picks up his first-ever preseason all-league selection. The senior was one of the top blocking fullbacks in the league last season in seven games played, also making receptions in five contests.

Hunter is recognized in the preseason by the CAA for the first time. The 2021 All-CAA Third Team punt returner, the redshirt senior was Towson's all-purpose yards leader last season with 1,104, including 753 on kickoff returns and 121 on punt returns.

BATTLE FOR GREATER BALTIMORE SERIES EXTENDED THROUGH 2027

In July 2021, Towson and Morgan State announced an extension of the Battle for Greater Baltimore series through the 2027 season. The two teams will alternate hosting rights each year. The teams are separated by five miles, the closest pair of teams in all of FCS play.

Towson hosted Morgan State on Sept. 10, the first game between the two at Unitas since 2017, defeating the Bears 29-21. Towson leads the all-time series 21-6.

With a 334 all-purpose yard performance at Monmouth on Oct. 29, D'Ago Hunter was honored as the Fedex Ground FCS National Special Teams Player of the Week. Hunter earned a 92-yard kickoff return touchdown as well as a 74-yard punt return.

TOWSON PICKED 11TH IN CAA PRESEASON POLL

The Tigers were predicted to finish 11th in the league in the preseason coaches poll. Towson received 81 points in the poll. 2021 CAA co-champion Villanova was predicted to finish first with 16 first-place votes and 270 points while Delaware is second with seven first-place votes and 235 points.

Former Towson players are making their mark in the professional ranks. Tye Smith was in preseason camp with the Minnesota Vikings, seeking to play in his sixth season in the NFL and second with the Vikings. In all, he has played in 45 regular season games, competing at cornerback and special teams.

In 2022, Darius Victor was the Offensive Player of the Year in the reformed USFL, earning 577 rushing yards and nine touchdowns for the North Division regular season champion New Jersey Generals.

Towson has also made its mark in the Canadian Football League. Two former Towson players, Malik Tyne and Andrew Garnett, currently compete for the Edmonton Elks while Tibo Debaillie plays for the BC Lions.

PUNTER FROM DOWN UNDER

Riley Williams, a native of Victoria, Australia, has been a stellar punter for the Tigers, standing fourth in FCS and first in the CAA with 44.9 yards per punt, totaling 1,242 yards on 28 punts.

Williams has 13 punts of 50 yards or further and 12 punts placed inside the 20-yard line.

Towson's influence is growing across the world. Two Towson offensive linemen are from Germany: Roman Wahrheit and Florian Staehler. Towson has other ties to Germany: Konstantinos Kosmakos is an assistant coach for the Marburg Mercenaries, which includes Towson graduate Robert Heyward at linebacker.

New to the team this year from overseas includes punter Riley Williams from Australia and offensive lineman Sahil Bhullar from Canada.

In Ambrose's time, Towson has also had players from Belgium, Finland, Germany, and Norway.

FROM UP AND DOWN THE EAST COAST...

The Towson roster nearly covers every state along the coastline from New York to Florida, with Delaware as the lone exception. 12 states, plus the District of Columbia, are represented by the Tigers. Away from the East Coast, Towson has players from Alabama, Illinois and Oregon.

...AND REPPING THE HOME STATE

The Towson roster represents the Old Line State well, sporting 48 players from the home state of Maryland. This includes six players from Baltimore City/County: Keith Bagwell (Baltimore), Anthony Delle Donne (Baltimore), Dion Crews-Harris (Baltimore), Rishon Holmes (Baltimore), Vinnie Shaffer (Middle River) and Scott Smith III (Brooklandville).

SCOUTING VILLANOVA:

After earning a share of the CAA regular season title last year, Villanova was predicted to finish first in the CAA in the league preseason coaches poll.

Villanova is third in the CAA with 216.9 rushing yards a game, led by senior TD Ayo-Durojalye with 5.9 yards a carry, having 605 yards and two scores. Junior quarterback Connor Watkins has amassed 1,661 passing yards, 338 rushing yards and 22 total touchdowns. The defense allows 26.9 points per game: sophomore Kshawn Schulters lines up in the secondary with 29 tackles and six pass breakups.

--Sept. 10, 2011 (Towson, Md. - Towson 31-10): Towson won its first home CAA game under coach Rob Ambrose with a 31-10 victory over #20 Villanova, shutting out the Wildcats in the first half with a 14-0 advantage and not trailing the rest of the way. It was Towson's first win against a ranked opponent since 2007.

--Oct. 27, 2012 (Villanova, Pa. - Towson 49-35): Towson earned a game with 590 yards of total offense, breaking away in the third quarter to win 49-35 over Villanova, at the time tied for first place in the CAA. The Tigers had 321 rushing yards, including 144 yards and two touchdowns from Terrance West.

--Sept. 15, 2018 (Villanova, Md. - Towson 45-35)
Towson came back from down 14 early with 35 consecutive points for a 45-35 victory at #10 Villanova, its first win over a top-10 opponent since 2013. Tom Flacco had a second-straight 300+ yard passing game. After this win, Towson will be ranked for the first time since 2014 and will remain ranked the rest of the year.

STAN EISENHOOTH ENTERS TOWSON ATHLETICS HALL OF FAME

Among the inductees into the Towson Athletics Hall of Fame Class of 2022 includes former offensive lineman Stan Eisenhooth. He was inducted into the Hall of Fame on Oct. 21.

Eisenhooth started for three years on the Towson offensive line from 1983 to 1985, helping the Tigers to two appearances in the NCAA D2 Playoffs, including getting to the semifinal in 1984.

He would go on to play in the NFL for the Seattle Seahawks and Indianapolis Colts.

CAA FOOTBALL SHAKEUP

CAA Football added a pair of programs in the past academic season: Hampton and Monmouth are new CAA members this year. Though Stony Brook was already a CAA Football member, the Seawolves joined the CAA as a full member this year.

Towson will play each new program this year: at Monmouth on Oct. 29 and vs. Hampton on Nov. 19.

In addition, two more programs will join the conference starting in the 2023-24 athletic year: Campbell and North Carolina A&T.

Not many people have the passion for Towson University as head coach Rob Ambrose. A former player and assistant coach, Ambrose has used that passion to turn the Tigers into one of the top teams in FCS.

In his first 12 years as head coach, Ambrose led the Tigers to six winning seasons, two CAA championships, three playoff appearances and a trip to the 2013 FCS National Championship game.

2019 saw the Tigers earn their second consecutive winning season, being nationally ranked in the top-25 all season long, going as high as No. 5 after a 3-0 start. Towson earned victories over four teams either ranked or receiving votes at the time of the game, including a 45-23 victory over then No. 7 and defending CAA champion Maine in Orono. For the second season in a row, Towson picked up 10 All-CAA selections, including Yeedee Thaenrat being First Team on special teams and Second Team at running back. Tom Flacco moved into third all-time in Towson history with 50 passing touchdowns, also standing in the top-seven in passing yards and passing completions in just two seasons with the Black & Gold. Shane Leatherbury tied a Towson single season record with 12 receiving touchdowns plus the Tigers had two players, Coby Tippett and Keon Paye, earn five interceptions, the first Towson players to have at least five picks in a season since 2004.

The 2013 season was one all Tiger fans will remember. Towson opened the season by going on the road and knocking off Connecticut, 31-18. It marked the first program victory over an FBS opponent. Towson started the season with six straight victories, and ended the regular season with a 10-2 record. The Tigers began their playoff run with a home victory over No. 9 Fordham, before going on the road to knock off No. 2 Eastern Illinois and No. 3 Eastern Washington. The season came to an end with a loss in the National Championship game, but not before the Tigers won a school-record 13 games. Towson finished the season ranked No. 2 in the polls and won the Lambert/Meadowlands Award as the top FCS team in the East. The Tigers were also honored as the ECAC FCS Team of the Year.

Ambrose returned to Towson after spending seven years as an assistant coach at Connecticut, helping the Huskies from an FCS program into a major college contender. During his time in Storrs, Ambrose helped the Huskies to 49 victories, three bowl appearances and a share of the 2007 Big East championship.

Ambrose's coaching career began where his playing career ended as he joined the Tigers as a wide receivers coach in 1993 after spending the 1992 season as a student assistant. Ambrose took over as the offensive coordinator in 1997, and added the associate head coach title in 2000. In his third season, Ambrose's offense led the country in passing yardage (381.2 ypg), while his 2000 team saw Noah Read lead the Patriot League in rushing.
