## TODAY'S GAME

■ Villanova plays its annual FBS game this weekend when it travels to Army West Point on Saturday afternoon for a 12 p.m. kickoff.

■ Villanova and Army West Point have faced each other on 21 previous occasions, but each of those games took place prior to the Wildcats becoming an FCS program in 1985. Army West Point leads the series by an 18-3 margin. The most recent meeting of the teams came in 1977. All 21 games have been played on post in West Point.

■ This is the 15th time in the last 17 years that Villanova will step up in class against an FBS opponent. The Wildcats are 4-20 versus FBS foes since they became an FCS program in 1985. The most recent FBS win was a 19-17 triumph over Temple in the 2018 season opener.

■ Villanova quarterback **Connor Watkins** has thrown eight completions for 38 yards or longer this season. More than half of his passing yards (262 of 494) have come on four passes of 60+ yards in his two starts.

## NATIONAL RANKINGS

### ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Since 1842, Villanova University's Augustinian Catholic intellectual tradition has been the cornerstone of an academic community in which students learn to think critically, act compassionately and succeed while serving others. There are more than 10,000 undergraduate, graduate and law students in the University's six colleges—the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, the Villanova School of Business, the College of Engineering, the M. Louise Fitzpatrick College of Nursing, the College of Professional Studies and the Villanova University Charles Widger School of Law. Ranked among the nation's top universities, Villanova supports its students' intellectual growth and prepares them to become ethical leaders who create positive change everywhere life takes them.

### VILLANOVA ATHLETICS

Villanova University has a long and storied athletics history defined by excellence both in competition and in the classroom. The Villanova Athletics Department is a community of student-athletes, coaches and staff whose primary focus is to achieve academic excellence, while striving to produce teams and individuals committed to athletic competition and outstanding performance. Villanova Athletics sponsors 24 varsity sports, which together include more than 550 student-athletes. In the classroom, these Villanova student-athletes have registered a grade-point average higher than a 3.0 for 36 consecutive semesters. Three Villanova student-athletes have been named Rhodes Scholars, with numerous others earning Academic All-America distinction. Villanova's athletics history includes 21 NCAA team national championships, as well as 129 conference championships. In addition, at least one Villanovan has participated in every Summer Olympics since 1948. Villanova is a member of the BIG EAST Conference, CAA Football, Colonial Athletic Association (Rowing) and Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (Water Polo).

### ACADEMICS

The GPA for more than 550 student-athletes during the Spring 2022 semester was 3.425, making it 15 straight semesters that student-athletes have had a GPA of 3.2 or higher. Success in the classroom has been across-the-board for Villanova Athletics, with every one of the 24 varsity sports programs posting a team GPA over a 3.0 in Spring 2022.

Villanova Athletics continues to shine among the brightest collegiate athletics programs in the country for its student-athletes' combination of academic and athletic success. New data on the Academic Progress Rate measure was released by the NCAA in June 2022 and Villanova had 11 of its varsity sport programs earn a perfect 1000 multi-year score. This is the fifth straight year that the Wildcats have had 10 or more teams earn a 1000 score.

## VILLANOVA NOTES

### SERIES STUFF

- Army West Point leads the all-time series with Villanova by an 18-3 margin
- All 21 previous matchups were played in West Point from 1908 to 1977
- **Villanova wins in the series:** 1915 (16-13), 1948 (47-28) and 1975 (10-0)
- Saturday's game will be the first meeting in Villanova's FCS tenure (since 1985)
- 14 of the 18 wins in the series for the Black Knights have been shutouts

### FCS VS. FBS

- Villanova is playing an FBS opponent for the 15th time in the last 17 years
- Saturday's game will be the 25th overall for the Wildcats against an FBS foe since 1985
- 10 of the previous 24 games have been decided by seven points or fewer (3-7 record)
- Three of the Wildcats last five losses against FBS foes have come by a total of nine points
- Villanova is 4-20 overall in its previous matchups against FBS competition
  - 2002 — *defeated Rutgers (37-19)*
  - 2003 — *defeated Temple (23-20, ot)*
  - 2009 — *defeated Temple (27-24)*
  - 2018 — *defeated Temple (19-17)*
- CAA Football teams own two wins over FBS competition so far this season
  - Delaware defeated Navy (14-7)*
  - William & Mary defeated Charlotte (41-24)*
- CAA Football has at least won FBS win in 12 of the last 15 seasons

### NEW YORK STATE OF MIND

- Villanova travels to New York for the second straight week after playing at LIU last week
- Villanova has a four-game winning streak in the state of New York
  - August 24, 2019 — *defeated Colgate 34-14 in Hamilton, N.Y.*
  - March 6, 2021 — *defeated Stony Brook 16-13 in Stony Brook, N.Y.*
  - October 16, 2021 — *defeated UAlbany 17-10 in Albany, N.Y.*
  - September 10, 2022 — *defeated LIU 38-21 in Brookville, N.Y.*

### THAT'S OFFENSIVE

- Villanova is averaging 9.0 yards per play through the first two games of the season
- Villanova's offense has produced 83 points in just 57 minutes on the field
- In the first two games the Wildcats have 13 scoring drives and just four punts
- Villanova is 32-4 since the start of the 2015 season when it scores 30+ points

### VILLANOVA OFFENSE OVER THE LAST 35 GAMES (SINCE NOV. 3, 2018)

- ▶ Averaged 33.7 points per game while posting a 25-10 record
- ▶ 23 games with 30+ points
- ▶ 11 games with 40+ points
- ▶ 3 games with 50+ points
- ▶ Scored at least 20 points in all 13 games played during the 2019 season  
(third time in school history and first since 1997 topping 20 points in ever game)

### SENSATIONAL START FOR WATKINS

- Junior quarterback **Connor Watkins** is a first-time starter after two seasons as a backup
- Through his first two collegiate starts Watkins is 18-of-27 for 494 yards and five TDs
- Set a Villanova record for most passing yards (298) by a quarterback in first career start
- Eight of his 18 completions this season have been for 38 yards or longer
- Has four passes of 60+ yards which account for 262 of his 494 total passing yards
  - vs. Lehigh — 68 yard touchdown pass to Jaaron Hayek*
  - vs. Lehigh — 66 yard touchdown pass to Dez Boykin*
  - vs. LIU — 62 yard pass to Jaaron Hayek*
  - vs. LIU — 60 yard touchdown pass to Dez Boykin*
- Has scored rushing touchdowns in each of the first two games of the season
- 556 yards of total offense (494 passing, 62 rushing); 42 points responsible for
- His efficiency rating of 306.2 in season opener led all FCS quarterbacks during Week 1

### CENTURY MARK RECEIVER

- Senior wide receiver **Jaaron Hayek** has topped 100 yards in each of the first two games
- Seven career games with 100+ receiving yards; four games scoring two touchdowns
- Had a career-high 141 receiving yards on six catches in the season opener against Lehigh
- Recorded four catches for 120 yards last week at LIU
- Leads CAA Football and ranks sixth in the FCS with 261 receiving yards this season
- During the Lehigh game became the 26th receiver in school history with 100+ catches
- Currently ranks 14th in the Villanova record book with 1,738 career receiving yards
- **Career Stats:** 31 games played, 109 receptions, 1,738 yards, 19 touchdowns

### BIG START FOR BOYKIN

- Fifth-year wide receiver **Dez Boykin** has 283 all-purpose yards through two games
- Ranks eighth in the FCS with 29.0 yards per kickoff return; 18th in all-purpose yards
- Has three receptions for 138 yards and two touchdowns (TD catches of 66 and 60 yards)
- Five kickoff returns for 145 yards (29.0 yards per return with a long return of 68 yards)
- Recorded the longest kick return of his career with a 68-yard return against Lehigh
- Recorded the longest catch of his career with a 66-yard touchdown against Lehigh

### TWO FOR 100

- Senior running backs **DeeWil Barlee** and **TD Ayo-Durojaiye** topped 100 yards at LIU
- **Barlee** — 18 rushes for a career-high 177 yards and a touchdown; had a 71-yard run
- **Ayo-Durojaiye** — 16 rushes for a career-high 109 yards and a touchdown
- Villanova is 15-2 over the last six seasons when it has at least one 100-yard rusher
- Barlee moved up five spots from 29th to 24th in school history with his big game at LIU
- Barlee's career stats: 29 games, 285 rushes, 1,448 yards, 8 TDs, 5.1 yards per carry

### ON THE ROAD AGAIN

- Villanova has won five consecutive road games dating back to last season
- Villanova has won 13 of its last 17 road games since the start of the 2019 season
- Mark Ferrante has a record of 18-10 (.643) in road games as head coach
- The only road loss for the Wildcats last year was at ranked FBS member Penn State
- Dating back to the 2008 season Villanova has gone 52-35 (.598) on the road

### GRADUATE TRANSFERS MAKE IMMEDIATE IMPACT

- Villanova had three fifth-year transfers make key contributions in the season opener
- **Antonio Montero, LB:** Game-high 10 tackles, 0.5 tackles for loss, 1 forced fumble
- **Danny Abraham, LB:** Recorded an interception with a return of 32 yards, three tackles
- **Matthew Mercurio, PK:** Made a 27-yard field goal and was 6-of-6 on PATs
- All three players were making their Villanova debuts in the game

### SPECIAL PERFORMER ON SPECIAL TEAMS

- Senior running back **TD Ayo-Durojaiye** has been a standout special teams performer
- Leads the Wildcats with 12 tackles on special teams over the past two seasons

### ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

#### NCAA PUBLIC RECOGNITION AWARD

■ Each year the NCAA recognizes programs that have a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranks within the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. Villanova has earned this award nine times in the 16-year history of the APR program, including in four of the last six years for which data is available.

■ Villanova was one of just five FCS programs in 2017-18 to have both its football and men's basketball programs each public recognition awards.

■ The football team has set a new program record for its highest APR score in four of the last six years.

■ One of the highest honors that a student-athlete can achieve is to be named an Academic All-American, an award which encompasses both academic achievement as well as contributions on the field. Villanova has had 12 football student-athletes earn a total of 14 Academic All-America honors over the years.

■ Villanova was the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for both the 2016-17 and the 2017-18 school years. The award is presented at the end of each academic year to the conference school with the highest team GPA.

#### CAA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

■ Villanova has had five student-athletes be named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Nominees for the award must have attained senior standing academically and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

#### CAA ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

■ Student-athletes with a semester GPA of 3.0 or higher are named to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll. Villanova had 55 honorees for the Fall 2021 semester and 48 student-athletes achieve this distinction for the Spring 2022 term.

# VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

## VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE



Coming off a breakthrough season which included a conference title, FCS playoff appearance and his first Coach of the Year award, Mark Ferrante has Villanova riding a wave of momentum entering his sixth season as head coach. Ferrante begins the 2022 campaign with a career record of 31-21 (.596), including 19 regular season CAA Football wins. He is in his 36th year overall with the Wildcats including his time as head coach and 30 years as an assistant from 1987-2016. Ferrante has been a part of 248 victories and all 14 of the program's FCS playoff appearances during his Villanova tenure.

In addition to being named the CAA Football Coach of the Year last season, Ferrante was the 2021 winner of the AFCA FCS Region I

Coach of the Year award. That honor made him a finalist for National Coach of the Year consideration and earned him recognition at the AFCA national convention following the season. Ferrante guided the Wildcats to a 10-3 record a year ago and Villanova won a share of the CAA Football title while securing the league's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs. It is the second straight full season (2019, 2021) in which Ferrante guided the Wildcats to postseason play.

Villanova hosted two playoff games last year and advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Division I Football Championship to finish the year ranked in the top-10 nationally (No. 8) in both FCS national polls for the first time since 2014. The Wildcats tallied their seventh season in program history with at least 10 wins and achieved success by playing – and beating – some of the top FCS teams in the nation. Villanova's 10-3 record included four victories over Top 25 opponents, including No. 3 James Madison, No. 18 Rhode Island, No. 21 Richmond and No. 24 Holy Cross. Ferrante led the Wildcats to a 7-1 record against a challenging CAA Football schedule to mark the fifth season since 1988 in which the team had no more than one loss in conference play.

There was star power in all facets of the game for Villanova last season, with Ferrante coaching 11 players who had an opportunity to continue their football careers beyond the college ranks. The group included cornerback Christian Benford who was a sixth round draft pick of the Buffalo Bills. Fellow corner Denzel Williams signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Ravens and linebacker Forrest Rhyne was inked to a free agent contract by the Indianapolis Colts. Benford and Rhyne were consensus first team All-Americans in 2021, while offensive lineman Michael Corbi was also a 2021 All-America selection and was one of 13 Wildcats who were named to the CAA Football All-Conference teams.

In the first five seasons that Ferrante has been head coach the Wildcats have had five major conference award winners and 38 CAA Football All-Conference selections, including 12 first team picks. Christian Benford was the CAA Defensive Rookie of the Year in 2018 and Villanova had consecutive winners of the prestigious Chuck Boone Leadership and Excellence Award which is presented to one senior student-athlete who embodies the highest standards of leadership, integrity, teamwork, and sportsmanship in academics and athletics. Chucky Smith was the 2019 winner of the award and Justin Covington earned the honor for the 2020 season.

Outside of football the Wildcats student-athletes have consistently excelled in their academic pursuits during Ferrante's head coaching tenure. Villanova ranked second in CAA Football in the most recent NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) data which was released in December 2021. The Wildcats had a 95 percent rate and topped all CAA schools with a matching 95 percent federal rate. Additionally, Villanova recorded a multi-year Annual Progress Rate (APR) score of 976 which was well above the average score of 959 for FCS programs.

The Wildcats were named the of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for having the highest GPA among the league's football members in both 2016-17 and 2017-18. On an individual level, football student-athletes have had 419 honorees on the CAA Football All-Academic Team and 361 selections to the Athletic Director's Honor Roll during Ferrante's time as head coach. In 2021-22 alone, Villanova had 73 members of the AD's Honor Roll who each posted a semester GPA of 3.2 or higher. Meanwhile, there were 103 selections from the Wildcats to the CAA All-Academic Team in 2021-22.

# VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

## MARK FERRANTE / VILLANOVA COACHING STAFF

Ferrante and the Wildcats made the most out of the opportunity to play four games in a shortened Spring 2021 season and use the experience gained from those games moving forward. The spring games were officially recognized as the 2020 season and Villanova tallied a 2-2 record in four contests against CAA foes, including road wins over Stony Brook and Maine. The abbreviated season had its share of highlights, with eight players chosen for the CAA Football All-Conference teams. Corbi, Rhyne and defensive lineman Malik Fisher were each named first team All-CAA selections.

Villanova came off a 2019 season in which it was ranked as high as No. 5 in the nation. Ferrante guided the Wildcats to a 9-4 record and the program's seventh FCS playoff berth in the previous 12 years in 2019. After being picked to finish ninth in CAA Football before the season the team raced out of the gates with a 6-0 record, including a 3-0 mark in league play by the midpoint of the season. Villanova had 10 players earn All-CAA accolades, including a trio of first team selections in Rhyne, offensive lineman Paul Grattan and punter Nathan Fondacaro.

Eight players have signed NFL free agent contracts since Ferrante became head coach, with the aforementioned Rhyne and Williams joining offensive tackle Brandon Hitner (LA Rams); safety Rob Rolle (Miami Dolphins); offensive lineman Ethan Greenidge (New Orleans Saints); defensive back Trey Johnson (Pittsburgh Steelers); defensive back Malik Reaves (Kansas City Chiefs); and linebacker Ed Shockley (Dallas Cowboys).

Ferrante leads one of the nation's elite FCS programs after playing an instrumental role in the Wildcats rise to national prominence. He has been a part of the coaching staff for all 14 of Villanova's appearances in the FCS playoffs, including the 2009 national championship season and a 2010 semifinal appearance while serving as the Assistant Head Coach on Andy Talley's staff. Ferrante has been a part of Villanova teams that have won seven CAA titles, three Lambert Meadows Cups and three ECAC Team of the Year awards.

Ferrante's success during his years as an assistant coach were recognized by others outside the Villanova program. At the end of the 2015 season he was named the FCS Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA). This award was first presented in 1997 and was created to honor assistant coaches who excel in community service, commitment to student-athletes and on-field coaching success. Ferrante was involved in all aspects of the

Villanova program during his time as an assistant on Andy Talley's staff. On the field he coached the offensive line for 27 seasons and developed a unit that was perennially one of the best in CAA Football. Over the years he coached three All-Americans, 11 All-East performers and 15 first team all-conference selections. The offensive line had 17 All-CAA selections in a nine-year span, including three-time first team honoree Ben Ijalana along with first team selections Brant Clouser (2010), Dan Shirey (2011) and Vince Kowalski (2014).

Two of Ferrante's players went on to be selected in the NFL Draft. Ijalana was a second round selection by the Indianapolis Colts in 2011 and Brad Seaton was picked in the seventh round by the Tennessee Titans in 2017. Ijalana was a two-time All-American (2009, 2010) and a three-time first team All-CAA selection during his collegiate career. Villanova reached the FCS playoffs in each of his last three seasons on the team, winning the 2009 national title and advancing to the semifinal round a year later. Seaton was a second team CAA Football All-Conference selection in 2016 when the offensive line enabled the Wildcats to average 206.3 rushing yards and 378.7 yards of total offense per game. Villanova ranked third in the CAA and 24th nationally in rushing offense in addition to ranking fourth in the league in total offense and fifth with a scoring average of 24.4 points per game.

The other All-Americans Ferrante mentored are Eamonn Allen (2001) and Bryan Russo (1989). Allen earned first team Associated Press All-America recognition in 2001 and was also a first team All-East and first team All-Atlantic 10 selection. Russo was chosen as an All-American by the Sports Network and the American Football Coaches Association as a senior in 1989 when he was also a first team all-conference and an All-ECAC selection. He was inducted to Villanova's Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2007.

Ferrante was a standout collegiate performer in his own right prior to joining the football coaching ranks. He was the quarterback for Andy Talley at St. Lawrence where he was named the 1982 Division III Player of the Year to go along with first team All-East honors. Ferrante directed the offense for a St. Lawrence team that went 10-1 during the 1982 season and reached the national semifinals in the playoffs.

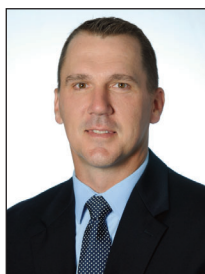

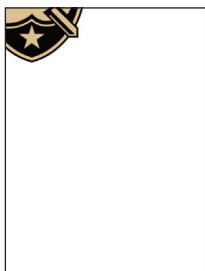
