TODAY'S GAME

- Villanova returns home after two straight road games this week for its conference opener against Monmouth. Kickoff is set for 3:30 p.m. at Villanova Stadium on Saturday afternoon. The game can be seen live on FloFootball and the radio broadcast will air on the Villanova Sports Radio Network.
- Villanova is 25-9 (.735) all-time in league openers. Entering this season the Wildcats have won their CAA Football opener in three straight seasons and eight of the last 10 years.
- Villanova and Monmouth have met on just one previous occasion when they played a non-conference game at Villanova Stadium during the 2011 season. The visiting Hawks won that game, 20-9.
- Villanova head coach Mark Ferrante and Monmouth head coach Kevin Callahan previously served as assistant coaches on the same staff at Wagner in the spring of 1984. Saturday's game will mark the first time that Ferrante and Callahan coach against each other as head coaches.

ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Since 1842, Villanova University's Augustinian Catholic intellectual tradition has been the cornerstone of an academic community in which stulearn to think critically, compassionately and succeed while serving others. There are more than 10,000 undergraduate, graduate and law students in the University's six colleges - the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, the Villanova School of Business, the College of Engineering, the M. Louise Fitzpatrick College of Nursing, the College of Professional Studies and the Villanova University Charles Widger School of Law. Ranked among the nation's top universities, Villanova supports its students' intellectual growth and prepares them to become ethical leaders who create positive change everywhere life takes them.

VILLANOVA ATHLETICS

Villanova University has a long and storied athletics history defined by excellence both in competition and in the classroom. The Villanova Athletics Department is a community of studentathletes, coaches and staff whose primary focus is to achieve academic excellence, while striving to produce teams and individuals committed to athletic competition and outstanding performance. Villanova Athletics sponsors 24 varsity sports, which together include more than 550 student-athletes. In the classroom, these Villanova student-athletes have registered a grade-point average higher than a 3.0 for 36 consecutive semesters. Three Villanova student-athletes have been named Rhodes Scholars, with numerous others earning Academic All-America distinction. Villanova's athletics history includes 21 NCAA team national championships, as well as 129 conference championships. In addition, at least one Villanovan has participated in every Summer Olympics since 1948. Villanova is a member of the BÎG EAST Conference, CAA Football, Colonial Athletic Association (Rowing) and Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (Water Polo).

ACADEMICS

The GPA for more than 550 student-athletes during the Spring 2022 semester was 3.425, making it 15 straight semesters that student-athletes have had a GPA of 3.2 or higher. Success in the classroom has been across-the-board for Villanova Athletics, with every one of the 24 varsity sports programs posting a team GPA over a 3.0 in Spring 2022.

Villanova Athletics continues to shine among the brightest collegiate athletics programs in the country for its student-athletes' combination of academic and athletic success. New data on the Academic Progress Rate measure was released by the NCAA in June 2022 and Villanova had 11 of its varsity sport programs earn a perfect 1000 multi-year score. This is the fifth straight year that the Wildcats have had 10 or more teams earn a 1000 score.

VILLANOVA NOTES

CONFERENCE OPENER

Villanova is 25-9 (.735) all-time in conference openers dating back to the 1988 season when it first became a member of the Yankee Conference. The program's conference history started with the Yankee Conference (1988-96) which would eventually become the Atlantic 10 from 1997 to 2006 and finally CAA Football starting with the 2007 season. Entering this season the Wildcats have won their first league contest of the season in three straight years and eight of the last 10 campaigns.

CAA FOOTBALL SUCCESS

Villanova is one of just three current CAA Football programs — along with New Hampshire and Delaware — to have won at least 150 league games. The win totals include the league's history as the Yankee Conference and the Atlantic 10. New Hampshire has been a member of the league since its formulation in 1947 and has won 250 regular season conference games all-time. Delaware joined the conference in 1986 and has 171 league wins, while Villanova has been a league member since 1988 and has 161 all-time conference wins.

SERIES STUFF

Villanova and Monmouth have met on just one previous occasion which came during the 2011 season. In the Wildcats home opener on September 17, 2011 the visiting Hawks tallied a 20-9 victory at Villanova Stadium. In a low-scoring start to that game, Monmouth led 3-0 at halftime and there were no touchdowns scored in the game until Villanova got on the board at the 9:32 mark of the third quarter. Back in 2011 the Hawks were a member of the Northeast Conference. They eventually moved to the Big South before joining CAA Football this year.

HEAD COACHES REUNITE

Villanova head coach Mark Ferrante and Monmouth head coach Kevin Callahan were briefly assistant coaches on the same Wagner staff in the spring of 1984. Ferrante began his coaching career at his alma mater, St. Lawrence, in 1983 before joining the Wagner staff. Callahan coached at Wagner from 1981-83 and was still on staff when Ferrante was hired, although he would soon move on to begin an eight-year stint at Colgate. This Saturday's game will mark the first time that Ferrante and Callahan oppose each other as head coaches.

HOME COOKING

Villanova opened its season at home this year when it defeated Lehigh (45-17) in a Friday night contest on September 2. It marked the first time since 2004 that the Wildcats played their season opener at home. The friendly confines of Villanova Stadium have been exactly that over the past few years. Villanova has won 11 of its last 16 home games since the start of the 2019 season. Two of the five losses came during an unusual Spring 2021 campaign. Last year the Wildcats were 5-2 at home and earned the right to host a pair of FCS playoff games against Holy Cross and South Dakota State. This year marks the 95th season of football at Villanova Stadium, where the Wildcats have an all-time record of 254-111-5 (.693).

VILLANOVA NOTES

AN INCOMPLETE FEELING

Last week against Army West Point was the fourth time in Villanova history that the other team did not record a single pass completion. The Black Knights ran the ball 55 times and attempted just one pass on a third-and-eight play from the Army West Point nine-yard line in the second quarter. That one pass attempt was broken up by sophomore cornerback **Kshawn Schulters (Roselle, N.J.)** and forced a Black Knights punt. The single pass attempt is the fewest in history by a Villanova opponent in one game. The previous record was three pass attempts in a game by Miami (Fla.) on November 1, 1957.

WHAT'S THE RUSH

On the flip side of Army West Point attempting only one pass last week, the Black Knights recorded the most rushing yards in a single game by a Villanova opponent with a total of 472 yards on 55 carries (8.6 yards per rush). The previous record for rushing yards against the Wildcats had been 436 yards by Rhode Island on October 22, 2005. Prior to last weekend Villanova had not even given up 300 rushing yards in a game in 106 straight contests dating back to October 27, 2012 when Towson recorded 321 yards on the ground against Villanova.

RATE OF RETURN

Fifth year senior **Dez Boykin** has been one of the nation's top kick returners through the early part of the 2022 season. Boykin currently leads CAA Football and ranks second in the FCS with an average of 31.5 yards per kickoff return. Boykin registered his longest career return — for 68 yards — in the season opener against Lehigh. He has returned six kickoffs on the year for a total of 189 yards. Boykin has also gotten off to a fast start offensively and has recorded three receptions for 138 yards and two touchdowns. In each of the first two games of the season against Lehigh (66 yards) and LIU (60 yards) he caught a touchdown pass of more than 60 yards.

40...BUT NOT 50...AND DEFINITELY NOT 60

Army West Point defeated the Wildcats by a final score of 49-10 last week, but an impressive streak continued despite the final outcome. Villanova has not allowed an opponent to score 50 points in a span of 207 games since a 51-40 loss to New Hampshire on October 1, 2005. And 60 points? That hasn't happened for more than 100 years (62 by Army in 1919).

VILLANOVA NOTES

HERE'S THE KICKER

Graduate student **Matthew Mercurio** has been perfect this season in his first year with the Wildcats. Through the first three games of the season Mercurio is 3-of-3 on field goals and 12-of-12 on PATs. He has made one field goal in each of the first three games of the season and connected on a season-long 40-yarder at Army West Point last week. That marked his 10th career field goal of at least 40 yards. Mercurio's career stats also remain unblemished at Michie Stadium at West Point. He played there on October 26, 2019 as a member of the San Jose State roster and went 4-of-4 on field goal tries in a 34-29 victory over the Black Knights.

MAKING AN IMPRESSION

One of the up-and-coming Wildcats through the first three weeks of the season has been redshirt freshman linebacker **Shane Hartzell** who tallied thre tackles in limited action as a true freshman last year. This season Hartzell is tied for the team lead with 18 total tackles, including seven solo stops and 11 assisted tackles. He has also been credited with the only two sacks of the season recorded by the Villanova defense. Hartzell had a sack for a loss of seven yards at LIU on September 10 and added a sack for a 12-yard loss at Army West Point last week.

MOVING UP THE RANKS

Senior wide reciever **Jaaron Hayek** currently ranks 14th in school history with 1,749 career receiving yards. He has already moved up four spots on the Wildcats all-time list this year and needs just 86 more yards to surge into a tie for 11th place in the Villanova record book. Hayek had a pair of big games to start the season, beginning with a career-high 141 yards on six catches in the season opener. He followed up that performance with four catches for 120 yards at LIU on September 10. Despite being held to two catches for 11 yards at Army West Point last week, Hayek still leads CAA Football this season and ranks 17th nationally with 272 receiving yards through three games.

WATKINS WATCH

Junior quarterback **Connor Watkins** is a first-time starter this season after serving as a backup to *Daniel Smith* during the 2020 and 2021 campaigns. In the season opener against Lehigh on September 2, Watkins set a record for the most passing yards by a Villanova quarterback in his first career start. He threw for 298 yards and three touchdowns while going 11-of-15 through the air in the Lehigh game. In the first two games of the season versus the Mountain Hawks and LIU, nearly half (eight of 18) of Watkins' completions were for 38 yards or longer. More than 45 pecent of his passing yards this season have come on four plays, including two completions each for 60 yards or longer to wide receivers **Jaaron Hayek** and **Dez Boykin**.

VILLANOVA NOTES

WILDCATS IN THE PROS

Villanova has five former players on NFL rosters this season, including three who have seen signficant playing time early in the season. Rookie cornerback **Christian Benford** has started each of the season's first two games for the Buffalo Bills and has made six total tackles while recording one tackle for loss and one pass breakup. Veteran linebacker **Austin Calitro** is with the New York Giants and started the season opener at Tennessee. In two games played Calitro has seven total tackles and two tackles for loss. Sixth year pro **Tanoh Kpassagnon**, is a defensive end for the New Orleans Saints and made three assisted tackles in a Week 2 game against Tampa Bay. Offensive lineman **Ethan Greenidge** is on the Saints reserve list and rookie linebacker **Forrest Rhyne** resides on the Indianapolis Colts' practice squad.

GRADUATE TRANSFERS MAKE IMMEDIATE IMPACT

Villanova had three fifth-year transfers make key contributions in a 45-17 win over Lehigh in Week 1. Linebacker **Antonio Montero** from Rice registered a game-high 10 tackles and forced a fumble, linebacker **Danny Abraham** recorded an interception whiich he returned 32 yards to go along with three tackles on the day, and placekicker **Matthew Mercurio** made a 27-yard field goal in addition to going 6-of-6 on PATs. All three players made their official debut for Villanova when the game was played.

SEEING NEW FACES

The Villanova roster has a bit of a different look this season with more than 30 newcomers joining a roster that lost more than a dozen starters from last season, including eight starters lost on defense. During the season opener against Lehigh in Week 1, 11 of the 60 players who saw game action for the Wildcats were making their Villanova debut. In addition, eight different players made the first start of their collegiate careers in the season opener.

VILLANOVA NOTES

SPECIAL PERFORMER ON SPECIAL TEAMS

Senior running back **TD Ayo-Durojaiye** has been a standout special teams performer for the Wildcats over the last two seasons. He leads Villanova with 13 special teams tackles since the start of the 2021 season, including 11 tackles on kickoff returns and two stops on punt returns. Ayo-Durojaiye has registered at least one tackle in 10 of his last 16 games played. On the flip side of special teams, Ayo-Durojaiye has six career kickoff returns for a total of 142 yards (23.7 yards per return). He has also scored a special teams touchdown, with that score coming at UAlbany last season when Ayo-Durojaiye returned a blocked punt for 15 yards and a touchdown.

SEVENTH-YEAR VETERAN

Graduate student tight end **Tyler Will** is a seventh year collegiate student-athlete this year. Will walked on to the Villanova football team as a senior in school before the 2019 season. He saw most of his time on special teams that year before transitioning to offense during Spring Ball in 2020. Now a veteran of 28 career collegiate games, Will has made eight career receptions for 43 yards and one touchdown to go along with three rushes for 14 yards and a score. On defense and special teams Will has registered 19 total tackles, including seven solo stops and 12 assisted tackles.

2022 TEAM CAPTAINS

Villanova's captains this year are senior running back **DeeWil Barlee**, graduate center **Colin Gamroth**, junior safety **Elijah Glover** and seventh-year senior **Tyler Will**.

PRESEASON RECOGNITION

Villanova was picked as the CAA Football preseason favorite in a poll of league head coaches and sports information directors. The Wildcats earned a total of 270 points in that poll to finish ahead of Delaware (235) and Rhode Island (224). Five players earned individual recognition in preseason balloting. Senior **TD Ayo-Durojaiye** was picked as a CAA Football preseason all-conference selection along with graduate student left guard **Michael Gorbi** and center **Colin Gamroth**. Senior wide receiver **Rayjuon Pringle** also earned preseason selection, while senior **Jaaron Hayek** was an honorable mention choice.

ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

NCAA PUBLIC RECOGNITION AWARD

- Each year the NCAA recognizes programs that have a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranks within the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. Villanova has earned this award nine times in the 16-year history of the APR program, including in four of the last six years for which data is available.
- Villanova was one of just five FCS programs in 2017-18 to have both its football and men's basketball programs each public recognition awards.
- The football team has set a new program record for its highest APR score in four of the last six years.

ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

■ One of the highest honors that a student-athlete can achieve is to be named an Academic All-American, an award which encompasses both academic achievement as well as contributions on the field. Villanova has had 12 football studentathletes earn a total of 14 Academic All-America honors over the years.

CAA TEAM ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

■ Villanova was the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for both the 2016-17 and the 2017-18 school years. The award is presented at the end of each academic year to the conference school with the highest team GPA.

CAA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

■ Villanova has had five student-athletes be named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Nominees for the award must have attained senior standing academically and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

CAA ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

■ Student-athletes with a semester GPA of 3.0 or higher are named to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll. Villanova had 55 honorees for the Fall 2021 semester and 48 student-athletes achieve this distinction for the Spring 2022 term.

ACADEMIC ALL-AREA TEAMS

■ In conjunction with the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, the sports information directors at the colleges and universities in the Philadelphia area (PhillySIDA) name an Academic All-Area team and a football Performer of the Year each season. In the 15 years of the Academic All-Area program, which started with the 2005-06 academic year, the football team has had a total of 54 selections to the Academic All-Area Team. In addition, the Wildcats have had five Performers of the Year.

VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE



Coming off a breakthrough season which included a conference title, FCS playoff appearance and his first Coach of the Year award, Mark Ferrante has Villanova riding a wave of momentum entering his sixth season as head coach. Ferrante begins the 2022 campaign with a career record of 31-21 (.596), including 19 regular season CAA Football wins. He is in his 36th year overall with the Wildcats including his time as head coach and 30 years as an assistant from 1987-2016. Ferrante has been a part of 248 victories and all 14 of the program's FCS playoff appearances during his Villanova tenure.

In addition to being named the CAA Football Coach of the Year last season, Ferrante was the 2021 winner of the AFCA FCS Region 1

Coach of the Year award. That honor made him a finalist for National Coach of the Year consideration and earned him recognition at the AFCA national convention following the season. Ferrante guided the Wildcats to a 10-3 record a year ago and Villanova won a share of the CAA Football title while securing the league's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs. It is the second straight full season (2019, 2021) in which Ferrante guided the Wildcats to postseason play.

Villanova hosted two playoff games last year and advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Division I Football Championship to finish the year ranked in the top-10 nationally (No. 8) in both FCS national polls for the first time since 2014. The Wildcats tallied their seventh season in program history with at least 10 wins and achieved success by playing – and beating – some of the top FCS teams in the nation. Villanova's 10-3 record included four victories over Top 25 opponents, including No. 3 James Madison, No. 18 Rhode Island, No. 21 Richmond and No. 24 Holy Cross. Ferrante led the Wildcats to a 7-1 record against a challenging CAA Football schedule to mark the fifth season since 1988 in which the team had no more than one loss in conference play.

There was star power in all facets of the game for Villanova last season, with Ferrante coaching 11 players who had an opportunity to continue their football careers beyond the college ranks. The group included cornerback Christian Benford who was a sixth round draft pick of the Buffalo Bills. Fellow corner Denzel Williams signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Ravens and linebacker Forrest Rhyne was inked to a free agent contract by the Indianapolis Colts. Benford and Rhyne were consensus first team All-Americans in 2021, while offensive lineman Michael Corbi was also a 2021 All-America selection and was one of 13 Wildcats who were named to the CAA Football All-Conference teams.

In the first five seasons that Ferrante has been head coach the Wildcats have had five major conference award winners and 38 CAA Football All-Conference selections, including 12 first team picks. Christian Benford was the CAA Defensive Rookie of the Year in 2018 and Villanova had consecutive winners of the prestigious Chuck Boone Leadership and Excellence Award which is presented to one senior student-athlete who embodies the highest standards of leadership, integrity, teamwork, and sportsmanship in academics and athletics. Chucky Smith was the 2019 winner of the award and Justin Covington earned the honor for the 2020 season.

Outside of football the Wildcats student-athletes have consistently excelled in their academic pursuits during Ferrante's head coaching tenure. Villanova ranked second in CAA Football in the most recent NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) data which was released in December 2021. The Wildcats had a 95 percent rate and topped all CAA schools with a matching 95 percent federal rate. Additionally, Villanova recorded a multi-year Annual Progress Rate (APR) score of 976 which was well above the average score of 959 for FCS programs.

The Wildcats were named the of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for having the highest GPA among the league's football members in both 2016-17 and 2017-18. On an individual level, football student-athletes have had 419 honorees on the CAA Football All-Academic Team and 361 selections to the Athletic Director's Honor Roll during Ferrante's time as head coach. In 2021-22 alone, Villanova had 73 members of the AD's Honor Roll who each posted a semester GPA of 3.2 or higher. Meanwhile, there were 103 selections from the Wildcats to the CAA All-Academic Team in 2021-22.

Ferrante and the Wildcats made the most out of the opportunity to play four games in a shortened Spring 2021 season and use the experience gained from those games moving forward. The spring games were officially recognized as the 2020 season and Villanova tallied a 2-2 record in four contests against CAA foes, including road wins over Stony Brook and Maine. The abbreviated season had its share of highlights, with eight players chosen for the CAA Football All-Conference teams. Corbi, Rhyne and defensive lineman Malik Fisher were each named first team All-CAA selections.

Villanova came off a 2019 season in which it was ranked as high as No. 5 in the nation. Ferrante guided the Wildcats to a 9-4 record and the program's seventh FCS playoff berth in the previous 12 years in 2019. After being picked to finish ninth in CAA Football before the season the team raced out of the gates with a 6-0 record, including a 3-0 mark in league play by the midpoint of the season. Villanova had 10 players earn All-CAA accolades, including a trio of first team selections in Rhyne, offensive lineman Paul Grattan and punter Nathan Fondacaro.

Eight players have signed NFL free agent contracts since Ferrante became head coach, with the aforementioned Rhyne and Williams joining offensive tackle Brandon Hitner (LA Rams); safety Rob Rolle (Miami Dolphins); offensive lineman Ethan Greenidge (New Orleans Saints); defensive back Trey Johnson (Pittsburgh Steelers); defensive back Malik Reaves (Kansas City Chiefs); and linebacker Ed Shockley (Dallas Cowboys).

Ferrante leads one of the nation's elite FCS programs after playing an instrumental role in the Wildcats rise to national prominence. He has been a part of the coaching staff for all 14 of Villanova's appearances in the FCS playoffs, including the 2009 national championship season and a 2010 semifinal appearance while serving as the Assistant Head Coach on Andy Talley's staff. Ferrante has been a part of Villanova teams that have won seven CAA titles, three Lambert Meadowlands Cups and three ECAC Team of the Year awards.

Ferrante's success during his years as an assistant coach were recognized by others outside the Villanova program. At the end of the 2015 season he was named the FCS Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA). This award was first presented in 1997 and was created to honor assistant coaches who excel in community service, commitment to student-athletes and on-field coaching success.Ferrante was involved in all aspects of the

Villanova program during his time as an assistant on Andy Talley's staff. On the field he coached the offensive line for 27 seasons and developed a unit that was perennially one of the best in CAA Football. Over the years he coached three All-Americans, 11 All-East performers and 15 first team all-conference selections. The offensive line had 17 All-CAA selections in a nine-year span, including three-time first team honoree Ben Ijalana along with first team selections Brant Clouser (2010), Dan Shirey (2011) and Vince Kowalski (2014).

Two of Ferrante's players went on to be selected in the NFL Draft. Ijalana was a second round selection by the Indianapolis Colts in 2011 and Brad Seaton was picked in the seventh round by the Tennessee Titans in 2017. Ijalana was a two-time All-American (2009, 2010) and a three-time first team All-CAA selection during his collegiate career. Villanova reached the FCS playoffs in each of his last three seasons on the team, winning the 2009 national title and advancing to the semifinal round a year later. Seaton was a second team CAA Football All-Conference selection in 2016 when the offensive line enabled the Wildcats to average 206.3 rushing yards and 378.7 yards of total offense per game. Villanova ranked third in the CAA and 24th nationally in rushing offense in addition to ranking fourth in the league in total offense and fifth with a scoring average of 24.4 points per game.

The other All-Americans Ferrante mentored are Eamonn Allen (2001) and Bryan Russo (1989). Allen earned first team Associated Press All-America recognition in 2001 and was also a first team All-East and first team All-Atlantic 10 selection. Russo was chosen as an All-American by the Sports Network and the American Football Coaches Association as a senior in 1989 when he was also a first team all-conference and an All-ECAC selection. He was inducted to Villanova's Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2007.

Ferrante was a standout collegiate performer in his own right prior to joining the football coaching ranks. He was the quarterback for Andy Talley at St. Lawrence where he was named the 1982 Division III Player of the Year to go along with first team All-East honors. Ferrante directed the offense for a St. Lawrence team that went 10-1 during the 1982 season and reached the national semifinals in the playoffs.

Ferrante and his wife, Georgea, reside in Phoenixville, Pa. The couple has a son, Jimmy, who earned his undergraduate degree from Villanova in 2018.




