- Villanova and Maine will play each other this weekend for the 25th time. The all-time series favors the Wildcats by a 14-10 margin and Villanova has won six of the last seven matchups, including a 44-17 win in Orono during the Spring 2021 schedule.
- Villanova has won eight consecutive road games against FCS competition dating back to the start of the Spring 2021 campaign. Wildcats head coach **Mark Ferrante** has an 18-11 road record as head coach, including 17-8 versus FCS teams away from home.
- Both projected starting quarterbacks this Saturday Connor Watkins for Villanova and Joe Fagnano for Maine are natives of Williamsport, Pa.. In his first year as the Wildcats starter, Watkins has thrown for 807 yards this season and currently leads all FCS quarterbacks in both yards per attempt (11.87) and yards per completion (18.77).
- Villanova running back **Jalen Jackson** is coming off the best game of his career last Saturday when he rushed 28 times for 187 yards and three touchdowns.

ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Since 1842, Villanova University's Augustinian Catholic intellectual tradition has been the cornerstone of an academic community in which stulearn to think critically, compassionately and succeed while serving others. There are more than 10,000 undergraduate, graduate and law students in the University's six colleges-the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, the Villanova School of Business, the College of Engineering, the M. Louise Fitzpatrick College of Nursing, the College of Professional Studies and the Villanova University Charles Widger School of Law. Ranked among the nation's top universities, Villanova supports its students' intellectual growth and prepares them to become ethical leaders who create positive change everywhere life takes them.

VILLANOVA ATHLETICS

Villanova University has a long and storied athletics history defined by excellence both in competition and in the classroom. The Villanova Athletics Department is a community of studentathletes, coaches and staff whose primary focus is to achieve academic excellence, while striving to produce teams and individuals committed to athletic competition and outstanding performance. Villanova Athletics sponsors 24 varsity sports, which together include more than 550 student-athletes. In the classroom, these Villanova student-athletes have registered a grade-point average higher than a 3.0 for 36 consecutive semesters. Three Villanova student-athletes have been named Rhodes Scholars, with numerous others earning Academic All-America distinction. Villanova's athletics history includes 21 NCAA team national championships, as well as 131 conference championships. In addition, at least one Villanovan has participated in every Summer Olympics since 1948. Villanova is a member of the BÎG EAST Conference, CAA Football, Colonial Athletic Association (Rowing) and Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (Water Polo).

ACADEMICS

The GPA for more than 550 student-athletes during the Spring 2022 semester was 3.425, making it 15 straight semesters that student-athletes have had a GPA of 3.2 or higher. Success in the classroom has been across-the-board for Villanova Athletics, with every one of the 24 varsity sports programs posting a team GPA over a 3.0 in Spring 2022.

Villanova Athletics continues to shine among the brightest collegiate athletics programs in the country for its student-athletes' combination of academic and athletic success. New data on the Academic Progress Rate measure was released by the NCAA in June 2022 and Villanova had 11 of its varsity sport programs earn a perfect 1000 multi-year score. This is the fifth straight year that the Wildcats have had 10 or more teams earn a 1000 score.

VILLANOVA NOTES

SERIES NOTES

♦ Villanova leads the all-time series with Maine by a 14-10 margin and has won six of the last seven meetings. The most recent matchup in the series came during the abbreviated Spring 2021 schedule when the Wildcats traveled to Orono and came away with a 44-17 win. The previous 24 meetings between the teams are evenly split between 12 matchups at Villanova Stadium and 12 games at Alfond Stadium. Villanova is 6-6 all-time in Orono.

FROM THE SAME HOMETOWN

♦ Both projected starting quarterbacks in Saturday's game — Connor Watkins from the Wildcats and Joe Fagnano from Maine — are natives of Williamsport, Pa. They attended different high schools, with Watkins playing his scholastic ball at Loyalsock Township High School and Fagnano competing for Williamsport High School. Watkins is in his first year as the starter for Villanova and currently leads all FCS signal callers with an average of 11.87 yards per pass attempt and an average of 18.77 yards per completion.

ROAD WARRIORS

♦ Villanova has been excellent away from home in recent seasons and is riding a current streak of eight consecutive road wins against FCS competition. The streak began in the Spring 2021 opener when the Wildcats tallied a 16-13 win at Stony Brook and most recently includes a 38-21 win at LIU earlier this year. Mark Ferrante has an 18-11 road record since becoming Villanova head coach in 2017, including a 17-8 mark against FCS teams. The only road losses for the Wildcats over the past two seasons have come to FBS foes Penn State in 2021 and Army West Point two weeks ago.

STRONG START FOR WATKINS

♦ Junior quarterback **Connor Watkins** is in his first year as the Villanova starter after being a backup to Daniel Smith for the past two seasons. In the season opener against Lehigh, Watkins set a record for the most passing yards by a Wildcats quarterback in his first career start when he threw for 298 yards and three touchdowns in a 45-17 victory. Now four games into the season, Watkins has thrown for 807 yards and seven touchdowns. He leads the FCS in yards per attempt (11.87) and yards per completion (18.77) while ranking fifth nationally with a 173.4 efficiency rating. In addition to his passing numbers, Watkins has also rushed for 180 yards and four touchdowns while averaging 6.2 yards per carry.

BIG PLAYS APLENTY

♦ One of the calling cards for the Villanova offense this season has been the ability to make big plays. That starts with the strong right arm of **Connor Watkins**, who has completed nine passes for 40 yards or longer in just four games. In the first two games of the season Watkins had pass completions of 68 yards and 62 yards to senior wide receiver **Jaaron Hayek** as well as completions of 66 yards and 60 yards to fifth-year senior **Dez Boykin**. In his most recent outing, Watkins threw passes for 51 yards and 44 yards to Hayek against Monmouth last weekend.

MOVING ON UP

♦ Senior wide receiver **Jaaron Hayek** has already moved up seven spots on the Wildcats all-time career receiving leaders this season. Hayek currently ranks 11th in school history with 1,885 yards and he needs 237 yards to match Brian White (1999-02) for 10th place. Hayek recorded his eighth career game and third this season with 100+ yards last week against Monmouth when he hauled in six catches for 136 yards. Through four games this year Hayek is leading CAA Football in receiving yards (408), yards per game (102.0) and yards per reception (22.67). He ranks among the national leaders in each of those categories as well, including fifth in yards per game and sixth in receiving yards.

VILLANOVA NOTES

CAREER DAY FOR JACKSON

♦ Villanova senior runnnig back **Jalen Jackson** returned from a one-game absence and had the best game of his career last Saturday against Monmouth. Jackson started his first career game and established new career highs with 28 carries, 187 rushing yards and three rushing touchdowns. He became the first Wildcats player since Aaron Forbes in 2018 to rush for three scores in a game and also surpassed 1,500 career rushing yards during the contest. Jackson currently ranks 22nd in school history with 1,524 career rushing yards.

RATE OF RETURN

♦ Fifth-year senior **Dez Boykin** is one of only eight players in Villanova history to amass more than 1,000 career yards of kickoff returns during his career. Boykin currently ranks fifth in the Wildcats record book with 1,407 career kickoff return yards. He has returned 60 kickoffs and averaged 23.5 yards per return. In four games this year, Boykin has nine kickoff returns for 241 yards. He ranks second in CAA Football and ninth nationally with an average of 26.8 yards per return and he recorded the longest return of his career for 68 yards in the season opener against Lehigh.

FULL HOUSE

♦ Last week's home game against Monmouth during Family Weekend at Villanova drew a sellout crowd of 12,001 to Villanova Stadium. It is the second straight year that the Wildcats have sold out their Family Weekend game, as last season an identical attendance of 12,001 saw Villanova defeat Richmond. In nine home games since the start of the 2021 campaign the Wildcats attendance at Villanova Stadium has increased by 17.8 percent since the 2019 season.

40...BUT NOT 50...AND DEFINITELY NOT 60

♦ In the past two weeks Villanova has allowed 49 points in consecutive losses to Army West Point (49-10) and Monmouth (49-42). It is the first time that the Wildcats have yielded more than 40 points in consecutive games since the final two contests of the 2000 season. Despite the two-game trend, Villanova has nevertheless extended an impressive streak of not letting an opponent reach the 50-point plateau. That has not happened in a span of 208 games since a 51-40 loss to New Hampshire on October 1, 2005. And 60 points? The Wildcats have not allowed 60 points in a game in more than 100 years since giving up 62 to Army West Point in 1919.

VILLANOVA NOTES

AN INCOMPLETE FEELING

♦ The game against Army West Point on September 17 was the fourth in Villanova history in which the Wildcats opponent did not record a single pass completion. The Black Knights ran the ball 55 times and attempted just one pass on a third-and-eight play from the Army West Point nine-yard line in the second quarter. That one pass attempt was broken up by sophomore cornerback **Kshawn Schulters (Roselle, N.J.)**. The single pass attempt by the Black Knights is the fewest ever in a game by a Villanova opponent, two fewer than the three pass attempts by Miami (Fla.) in a 1957 game. The previous three games in which the opposing team did not record a pass completion were in 1946 (Detroit), 1958 (Richmond) and 1969 (William & Mary).

RATE OF RETURN

♦ On the flip side of Army West Point not completing any passes in the September 17 game, the Black Knights recorded the most rushing yards in a single game by a Villanova opponent with 472 yards on 55 carries. The previous top mark for rushing yards against the Wildcats had been 436 yards by Rhode Island during the 2005 season. Prior to the Army West Point game it had been a span of 106 straight contests since 2012 against Towson that Villanova even allowed 300 yards on the ground. Over the past two weeks against the Black Knights and Monmouth, the Wildcats have given up 793 rushing yards and 10 touchdowns.

HERE'S THE KICKER

♦ In his first season at Villanova, graduate student **Matthew Mercurio** has been a standout performer on special teams. Mercurio is a perfect 18-of-18 on PATs in a Wildcats uniform and has also made all three of his field goal attempts. He tied a career high last week against Monmouth when he went 6-of-6 on PATs for the third time in his career and the second time this season. Mercurio has connected on field goals of 27 yards, 34 yards and 40 yards so far this season. His 40-yard attempt at Army West Point was his 10th career field goal from 40 yards or longer. Mercurio was previously a two-time All-Mountain West honorable mention selection at San Jose State where he amassed 222 points over three seasons.

MAKING AN IMPRESSION

♦ One of the up-and-coming Wildcats through the first four games of the season has been redshirt freshman linebacker **Shane Hartzell** who tallied three tackles in limited action as a true freshman last year. This season Hartzell is tied for the team lead with 23 total tackles, including 10 solo stops and 13 assisted tackles. He has also been credited with the only two sacks of the season recorded by the Villanova defense. Hartzell had a sack for a loss of seven yards at LIU on September 10 and added a sack for a 12-yard loss at Army West Point on September 17.

VILLANOVA NOTES

SPECIAL PERFORMER ON SPECIAL TEAMS

♦ Senior running back **TD Ayo-Durojaiye** has been a standout special teams performer for the Wildcats over the last two seasons. He leads Villanova with 14 special teams tackles in that span, including 12 tackles on kickoff returns and two stops on punt returns. This year in four games Ayo-Durojaiye is tied for the team with four special teams tackles. He has recorded at least one tackle in 11 of his last 17 games played. On the flip side of special teams, Ayo-Durojaiye has seven career kickoff returns for 172 yards (24.6 yards per return). He has also scored a special teams touchdown, with that score coming at UAlbany last year when Ayo-Durojaiye scooped up a blocked punt and returned it 15 yards for a touchdown.

GRADUATE TRANSFERS MAKE IMMEDIATE IMPACT

♦ Villanova had three fifth-year transfers make key contributions in a 45-17 win over Lehigh in Week 1. Linebacker **Antonio Montero** from Rice registered a game-high 10 tackles and forced a fumble, linebacker **Danny Abraham** recorded an interception whiich he returned 32 yards to go along with three tackles on the day, and placekicker **Matthew Mercurio** made a 27-yard field goal in addition to going 6-of-6 on PATs. All three players made their official debut for Villanova when the game was played.

SEEING NEW FACES

♦ The Villanova roster has a bit of a different look this season with more than 30 newcomers joining a roster that lost more than a dozen starters from last season, including eight starters lost on defense. During the season opener against Lehigh in Week 1, 11 of the 60 players who saw game action for the Wildcats were making their Villanova debut. In addition, eight different players made the first start of their collegiate careers in the season opener.

SEVENTH-YEAR VETERAN

♦ Graduate student tight end **Tyler Will** is a seventh year collegiate student-athlete this year. Will walked on to the Villanova football team as a senior in school before the 2019 season. He saw most of his time on special teams that year before transitioning to offense during Spring Ball in 2020. Now a veteran of 28 career collegiate games, Will has made eight career receptions for 43 yards and one touchdown to go along with three rushes for 14 yards and a score. On defense and special teams Will has registered 19 total tackles, including seven solo stops and 12 assisted tackles.

2022 TEAM CAPTAINS

◆ Villanova's captains this year are senior running back **DeeWil Barlee**, graduate center **Colin Gamroth**, junior safety **Elijah Glover** and seventh-year senior **Tyler Will**.

PRESEASON RECOGNITION

♦ Villanova was picked as the CAA Football preseason favorite in a poll of league head coaches and sports information directors. The Wildcats earned a total of 270 points in that poll to finish ahead of Delaware (235) and Rhode Island (224). Five players earned individual recognition in preseason balloting. Senior TD Ayo-Durojaiye was picked as a CAA Football preseason all-conference selection along with graduate student left guard Michael Gorbi and center Colin Gamroth. Senior wide receiver Rayjuon Pringle also earned preseason selection, while senior Jaaron Hayek was an honorable mention choice.

Sixth year pro **Tanoh Kpassagnon** is in his second season with the New Orleans Saints and has appeared in two games while playing 37 defensive snaps and on nine special teams plays. In addition to that trio, rookie linebacker **Forrest Rhyne** began the year on the Indianapolis Colts practice squad and offensive lineman **Ethan Greenidge** is on the Saints reserve list due to injury.

ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

NCAA PUBLIC RECOGNITION AWARD

- Each year the NCAA recognizes programs that have a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranks within the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. Villanova has earned this award nine times in the 16-year history of the APR program, including in four of the last six years for which data is available.
- Villanova was one of just five FCS programs in 2017-18 to have both its football and men's basketball programs each public recognition awards.
- The football team has set a new program record for its highest APR score in four of the last six years.

ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

■ One of the highest honors that a student-athlete can achieve is to be named an Academic All-American, an award which encompasses both academic achievement as well as contributions on the field. Villanova has had 12 football student-athletes earn a total of 14 Academic All-America honors over the years.

CAA TEAM ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

■ Villanova was the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for both the 2016-17 and the 2017-18 school years. The award is presented at the end of each academic year to the conference school with the highest team GPA.

CAA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

■ Villanova has had five student-athletes be named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Nominees for the award must have attained senior standing academically and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

CAA ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

■ Student-athletes with a semester GPA of 3.0 or higher are named to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll. Villanova had 55 honorees for the Fall 2021 semester and 48 student-athletes achieve this distinction for the Spring 2022 term.

ACADEMIC ALL-AREA TEAMS

■ In conjunction with the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, the sports information directors at the colleges and universities in the Philadelphia area (PhillySIDA) name an Academic All-Area team and a football Performer of the Year each season. In the 15 years of the Academic All-Area program, which started with the 2005-06 academic year, the football team has had a total of 54 selections to the Academic All-Area Team. In addition, the Wildcats have had five Performers of the Year.

VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE



Coming off a breakthrough season which included a conference title, FCS playoff appearance and his first Coach of the Year award, Mark Ferrante has Villanova riding a wave of momentum entering his sixth season as head coach. Ferrante begins the 2022 campaign with a career record of 31-21 (.596), including 19 regular season CAA Football wins. He is in his 36th year overall with the Wildcats including his time as head coach and 30 years as an assistant from 1987-2016. Ferrante has been a part of 248 victories and all 14 of the program's FCS playoff appearances during his Villanova tenure.

In addition to being named the CAA Football Coach of the Year last season, Ferrante was the 2021 winner of the AFCA FCS Region 1

Coach of the Year award. That honor made him a finalist for National Coach of the Year consideration and earned him recognition at the AFCA national convention following the season. Ferrante guided the Wildcats to a 10-3 record a year ago and Villanova won a share of the CAA Football title while securing the league's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs. It is the second straight full season (2019, 2021) in which Ferrante guided the Wildcats to postseason play.

Villanova hosted two playoff games last year and advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Division I Football Championship to finish the year ranked in the top-10 nationally (No. 8) in both FCS national polls for the first time since 2014. The Wildcats tallied their seventh season in program history with at least 10 wins and achieved success by playing – and beating – some of the top FCS teams in the nation. Villanova's 10-3 record included four victories over Top 25 opponents, including No. 3 James Madison, No. 18 Rhode Island, No. 21 Richmond and No. 24 Holy Cross. Ferrante led the Wildcats to a 7-1 record against a challenging CAA Football schedule to mark the fifth season since 1988 in which the team had no more than one loss in conference play.

There was star power in all facets of the game for Villanova last season, with Ferrante coaching 11 players who had an opportunity to continue their football careers beyond the college ranks. The group included cornerback Christian Benford who was a sixth round draft pick of the Buffalo Bills. Fellow corner Denzel Williams signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Ravens and linebacker Forrest Rhyne was inked to a free agent contract by the Indianapolis Colts. Benford and Rhyne were consensus first team All-Americans in 2021, while offensive lineman Michael Corbi was also a 2021 All-America selection and was one of 13 Wildcats who were named to the CAA Football All-Conference teams.

In the first five seasons that Ferrante has been head coach the Wildcats have had five major conference award winners and 38 CAA Football All-Conference selections, including 12 first team picks. Christian Benford was the CAA Defensive Rookie of the Year in 2018 and Villanova had consecutive winners of the prestigious Chuck Boone Leadership and Excellence Award which is presented to one senior student-athlete who embodies the highest standards of leadership, integrity, teamwork, and sportsmanship in academics and athletics. Chucky Smith was the 2019 winner of the award and Justin Covington earned the honor for the 2020 season.

Outside of football the Wildcats student-athletes have consistently excelled in their academic pursuits during Ferrante's head coaching tenure. Villanova ranked second in CAA Football in the most recent NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) data which was released in December 2021. The Wildcats had a 95 percent rate and topped all CAA schools with a matching 95 percent federal rate. Additionally, Villanova recorded a multi-year Annual Progress Rate (APR) score of 976 which was well above the average score of 959 for FCS programs.

The Wildcats were named the of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for having the highest GPA among the league's football members in both 2016-17 and 2017-18. On an individual level, football student-athletes have had 419 honorees on the CAA Football All-Academic Team and 361 selections to the Athletic Director's Honor Roll during Ferrante's time as head coach. In 2021-22 alone, Villanova had 73 members of the AD's Honor Roll who each posted a semester GPA of 3.2 or higher. Meanwhile, there were 103 selections from the Wildcats to the CAA All-Academic Team in 2021-22.

Ferrante and the Wildcats made the most out of the opportunity to play four games in a shortened Spring 2021 season and use the experience gained from those games moving forward. The spring games were officially recognized as the 2020 season and Villanova tallied a 2-2 record in four contests against CAA foes, including road wins over Stony Brook and Maine. The abbreviated season had its share of highlights, with eight players chosen for the CAA Football All-Conference teams. Corbi, Rhyne and defensive lineman Malik Fisher were each named first team All-CAA selections.

Villanova came off a 2019 season in which it was ranked as high as No. 5 in the nation. Ferrante guided the Wildcats to a 9-4 record and the program's seventh FCS playoff berth in the previous 12 years in 2019. After being picked to finish ninth in CAA Football before the season the team raced out of the gates with a 6-0 record, including a 3-0 mark in league play by the midpoint of the season. Villanova had 10 players earn All-CAA accolades, including a trio of first team selections in Rhyne, offensive lineman Paul Grattan and punter Nathan Fondacaro.

Eight players have signed NFL free agent contracts since Ferrante became head coach, with the aforementioned Rhyne and Williams joining offensive tackle Brandon Hitner (LA Rams); safety Rob Rolle (Miami Dolphins); offensive lineman Ethan Greenidge (New Orleans Saints); defensive back Trey Johnson (Pittsburgh Steelers); defensive back Malik Reaves (Kansas City Chiefs); and linebacker Ed Shockley (Dallas Cowboys).

Ferrante leads one of the nation's elite FCS programs after playing an instrumental role in the Wildcats rise to national prominence. He has been a part of the coaching staff for all 14 of Villanova's appearances in the FCS playoffs, including the 2009 national championship season and a 2010 semifinal appearance while serving as the Assistant Head Coach on Andy Talley's staff. Ferrante has been a part of Villanova teams that have won seven CAA titles, three Lambert Meadowlands Cups and three ECAC Team of the Year awards.

Ferrante's success during his years as an assistant coach were recognized by others outside the Villanova program. At the end of the 2015 season he was named the FCS Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA). This award was first presented in 1997 and was created to honor assistant coaches who excel in community service, commitment to student-athletes and on-field coaching success.Ferrante was involved in all aspects of the

Villanova program during his time as an assistant on Andy Talley's staff. On the field he coached the offensive line for 27 seasons and developed a unit that was perennially one of the best in CAA Football. Over the years he coached three All-Americans, 11 All-East performers and 15 first team all-conference selections. The offensive line had 17 All-CAA selections in a nine-year span, including three-time first team honoree Ben Ijalana along with first team selections Brant Clouser (2010), Dan Shirey (2011) and Vince Kowalski (2014).

Two of Ferrante's players went on to be selected in the NFL Draft. Ijalana was a second round selection by the Indianapolis Colts in 2011 and Brad Seaton was picked in the seventh round by the Tennessee Titans in 2017. Ijalana was a two-time All-American (2009, 2010) and a three-time first team All-CAA selection during his collegiate career. Villanova reached the FCS playoffs in each of his last three seasons on the team, winning the 2009 national title and advancing to the semifinal round a year later. Seaton was a second team CAA Football All-Conference selection in 2016 when the offensive line enabled the Wildcats to average 206.3 rushing yards and 378.7 yards of total offense per game. Villanova ranked third in the CAA and 24th nationally in rushing offense in addition to ranking fourth in the league in total offense and fifth with a scoring average of 24.4 points per game.

The other All-Americans Ferrante mentored are Eamonn Allen (2001) and Bryan Russo (1989). Allen earned first team Associated Press All-America recognition in 2001 and was also a first team All-East and first team All-Atlantic 10 selection. Russo was chosen as an All-American by the Sports Network and the American Football Coaches Association as a senior in 1989 when he was also a first team all-conference and an All-ECAC selection. He was inducted to Villanova's Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2007.

Ferrante was a standout collegiate performer in his own right prior to joining the football coaching ranks. He was the quarterback for Andy Talley at St. Lawrence where he was named the 1982 Division III Player of the Year to go along with first team All-East honors. Ferrante directed the offense for a St. Lawrence team that went 10-1 during the 1982 season and reached the national semifinals in the playoffs.

Ferrante and his wife, Georgea, reside in Phoenixville, Pa. The couple has a son, Jimmy, who earned his undergraduate degree from Villanova in 2018.
