Villanova Game Storylines

- ✓ Fresh off the bye, Maine opens CAA play when it hosts #14 Villanova at Alford Stadium in the 25th all-time meeting between the two programs. Maine is looking to start CAA play at 1-0 for the first time since the 2018 season.
- ✓ Maine enters at 10-14 all-time against Villanova as the teams meet for the 12th time in the last 13 seasons. This is the second consecutive match-up between the two programs in Orono with Villanova winning the 2021 meeting, 44-17. In that game, Maine posted 424 yards of offense as Joe Fagnano went 21-of-35 for 235 yards. Xavier Scott recorded six receptions and his first career 100+ yard performance with 102 yards. Freddie Brock rushed for 88 yards and his first career touchdown. Maine is 6-6 on its home turf against the Wildcats. Villanova has won six of the last seven meetings in the overall series. The two teams first met in 1988, a 20-17 Maine victory on the road. The Black Bears are 4-8 on the road in the all-time series with Villanova.
- ✓ The Black Bears, in search of their first win of the season and Coach Stevens' first win of his head coaching career, are coming off the bye and two weeks removed from a 38-17 loss at Boston College in the second FBS contest of the year for the Black Bears. In defeat, Maine's defense registered three more sacks while the offense produced a season-high 378 yards of offense. Maine which led 10-7 in the game, made it a two score game midway through the third quarter but were unable to close the deficit.
- ✓ Villanova, the CAA preseason coaches poll favorite to win the league, began CAA play with a 49-42 loss against Monmouth. The Wildcats enter play riding a two-game losing skid after falling at Army, 49-10, prior to the Monmouth loss.
- ✓ Maine has recorded 9.0 sacks through two games, just three sacks short of what the Black Bears were able to total in all of 2021. Maine's 3.0 sacks per game rank third among CAA leaders and 23rd in the FCS nation. The CAA opener for Maine pits two of the top passing defenses in the league together in Maine (184.0/4th) and Villanova (154.5/2nd). Joe Fagnano enters play just 41 yards shy of reaching 4,000 yards passing for his career and 438 yards short of moving into 10th on Maine's all-time passing list.

JORDAN STEVENS, HEAD COACH

Jordan Stevens ('10), was named the 37th head football coach at UMaine on Dec. 7, 2021.

Stevens, an All-CAA third team selection with the Black Bears before serving a four-year stint as an assistant coach at UMaine, returned home to Orono after spending the previous seven seasons on staff at Yale.

Stevens played for the Black Bears from 2006-2009 before mentoring Maine's defensive line in an assistant coaching role from March 2011 through February 2015.

A native of Temple, Maine, Stevens mentored nine All-Ivy League players and a pair of All-Colonial Athletic Association honorees during his 11-year assistant coaching career with Yale and UMaine. While at Yale, Stevens spent his first three seasons as the defensive line coach with the Bulldogs before being elevated to assistant head coach and co-defensive coordinator, working specifically with the linebackers, in Jan. 2018. After spending one season working with the linebackers, Stevens returned to his roots, switching back to mentoring the defensive line in a role he would serve from Jan. 2019 until the end of his stint with the Bulldogs.

Stevens served a key role in leading Yale to Ivy League titles in 2017 and, as the assistant head coach and co-defensive coordinator, again in 2019 as the Bulldogs finished both title seasons with a 9-1 mark. In 2017, Stevens helped mentor a defensive unit which led the Ivy League in total defense (302.8 yards per game allowed); scoring defense (15.6 points allowed); rushing defense (73.1 rush yards allowed); third down conversion percentage defense (29.9 percent); and tackles for loss (85). The Bulldogs' numbers were not just impressive against their Ivy League peers but also ranked in the top-10 in the nation in scoring defense, rushing defense, third down conversion percentage defense, and tackles for loss during the 2017 campaign.

The 2021 season saw Yale post some of its best defensive marks in recent history as the unit, under the guidance of Stevens as co-defensive coordinator, led the nation in third down conversion percentage defense (22.1), ranked ninth nationally in sacks per game (3.2/32 total), and checked in 23rd in all of the Football Championship Subdivision in rush defense after allowing just 117.1 yards per game on the ground.

Yale consistently progressed on the defensive side of the ball under Stevens' leadership. In his first season with the defensive line, the Bulldogs posted six sacks and 19 tackles for loss. Three years later, under the direction of Stevens, Yale turned those statistical numbers into 22.5 sacks and 44.5 tackles for loss as the Bulldogs would post 18 or more sacks in three of the last four seasons and 34 or more tackles for loss in four of the last five years.

Stevens began his coaching career at the University of Maine, serving two seasons as the assistant defensive line coach before a two-year stint as the lead defensive line coach at his alma mater in Orono. Stevens, who mentored NFL Draft Pick and two-time All-CAA selection Trevor Bates and All-CAA second team selection and Maine's career sack leader Michael Cole, helped guide the Black Bears to the NCAA FCS Playoffs in 2011 and to a CAA Championship and another trip to the NCAA FCS Playoffs in 2013. Maine's Black Hole defense was impressive during Stevens' time at UMaine, posting the top ranked scoring defense and red zone defense in 2012, the CAA's fourth ranked total defense in 2013, and the CAA's second ranked total defense, 16th in the nation, in 2014.

An All-CAA third team selection at defensive end, UMaine's Most Valuable Player, and a New England Football Writers FCS All-Star selection in 2009, Stevens enjoyed an impressive four-year career with the Black Bears. Stevens appeared in 45 games at UMaine while registering 184 tackles, 24 sacks, 16.0 tackles for loss, three pass breakups, three fumble recoveries, five forced fumbles, while logging a pair of safeties. In 2008, Stevens guided the Black Bears to an appearance in the NCAA FCS Playoffs.

Following his playing career with the Black Bears, Stevens participated in NFL Rookie Mini Camp with the Detroit Lions before signing with the Hartford Colonials of the United Football League for Mini and Training Camp in 2010.

Stevens earned his Bachelor of Science in Business Administration - Management from UMaine in 2010. A Mt. Blue high school graduate, Stevens and his wife, Ellen, have one daughter, Noella and son, Carson.

STEVENS AT THE HELM

- Jordan Stevens (Maine '10) begins his tenure as head coach of the Black Bears in 2022 after being named the 37th head coach in the program's 130 year history on Dec. 7, 2021.
- Stevens, who spent time on Maine's staff as an assistant for four seasons (2011-14) before a seven-year stint at Yale.
- Stevens was an All-CAA third team selection for Maine and racked up 184 tackles, 24 sacks, and 16.0 TFLs in 45 games for the Black Bears.

NEW FACES

- The Black Bears feature six new faces on the coaching staff this season (Kugler - OL; Anthony Murray - DL; McEntire - DB; Walsh - STC/CB; Carey - OLB; Brown - RBs) while also seeing Coach Keyte in his first year as DC.

SACKS RETURN

- Through three games this season, Maine has tallied 9.0 sacks. That number is just three sacks shy of what the Black Bears achieved in all of 2021 (12.0).
- Maine has seen eight different players record at least a half sack this season, led by Justin Sambu (3.0).

BOWMAN WEAPON

- Through two games, tight end Shawn Bowman has emerged as a key weapon for the Black Bears on offense.
- Bowman has tied for Maine's lead in receptions two of the first three games, including a career-high 73 yards receiving against Colgate.
- Bowman has notched a touchdown in two of Maine's first three games, including each of the last two.

INT RATE

- The Black Bears have tallied seven interceptions in their last six games, and six in their last four, dating back to last season.
- Kahzir 'Buggs' Brown has three interceptions in his last four games after notching one at New Mexico and two in the season finale at New Hampshire a year ago.

FAGNANO CLIMBING THE QB CHARTS

- Fagnano currently ranks 11th on Maine's all-time passing yards list at 4,055.
- Fagnano now stands just 438 yards away from matching Bob Wilder for 10th all-time (4,493).
- Fagnano has notched three 300+

yards passing performances in his career.

RUSHING RETURN

- The Black Bears return their four top ball carriers from a year ago including Freddie Brock (132 attempts/720 yds/7 TDs) and Elijah Barnwell (117 attempts/514 yds/4 TDs).

BLACK HOLE

- Maine's 'Black Hole' defense welcomes back including three-year starter Adrian Otero (27 straight starts, 63 tkls in 2021); last year's interception leader in Kahzir 'Buggs' Brown (3 INTs), and Khairi Manns who tied for the team lead with 3.0 sacks in 2021. Maine also features veterans Jamehl Wiley (26 starts) and Josh Lezin (15 starts) on its defensive front.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- Graduate offensive lineman Michael Gerace was named to the CAA Preseason All-Conference Team. Gerace has started 35 games for the Black Bears, including 34 consecutive.
- Freddie Brock and Shawn Bowman each received CAA Preseason Honorable Mention nods.

CAPTAINS

- Following a team vote, the Black Bears elected four captains for the 2022 fall season. Seniors Joe Fagnano and Michael Gerace each earned the honor for the second consecutive season while Adrian Otero and Shawn Bowman were each elected captains for the first time.

TRANSFERS

- Since the spring of 2019, Maine has added 24 transfers/graduate transfers to its roster.
- The Black Bears feature 11 former Football Bowl Subdivision players on this year's roster.

QUICK HITS

RUSHING FOR 100+ IS POSITIVE FOR MAINE

- The Black Bears are 21-8 in their last 29 games when rushing for 100 or more yards.

FAST START

- The Black Bears are 15-4 in the last 18 games in which they've scored first.
- Maine has won 15 of their last 19 games when they've scored first.

CARRYING THE LEAD

- Maine is 101-22 since the beginning of the 2000 season when leading at the half.
- The Black Bears are 13-0 in their last 13 games in which they've taken a lead into the fourth quarter.

CLOSE CALL

- Since 2013, Maine is 25-11 in games decided by seven points or less.

O-LINE - BRICK WALL

- Since 2015, no CAA team has allowed fewer sacks than Maine.

CARRYING #39 WHEREVER THEY GO

- In August of 2018, freshman Darius Minor tragically passed away during an off season workout.
- Then head coach, Joe Harasymiak, declared that no one would wear #39 for the next four seasons.
- The Black Bears carry the #39 with them, hanging it on the sidelines at all games.
