## TODAY'S GAME

■ Villanova returns home for the first time since September 23 to host Elon for a 1 p.m. kickoff at Villanova Stadium. It is just the second visit to the Main Line for the Phoenix, who previously came to Villanova in 2017 and dealt the Wildcats a 19-14 loss. Overall, Villanova leads the series 2-1 and has posted a pair of wins at Elon during the 2016 (42-7) and 2021 (35-0) seasons.

■ Villanova is coming off a 37-14 win over North Carolina A&T in the first-ever game between the teams last weekend.

■ Over the last three weeks Villanova has converted 24-of-41 (58.5%) third down chances, a big turnaround from the first three weeks of the season when the Wildcats only converted 24.2% (8-of-33) of their third down opportunities.

■ Sophomore wide receiver **Jaylan Sanchez** leads the FCS this season with an average of 26.6 yards per reception. He caught six passes for 158 yards and two touchdowns — all career highs — in last week's win at North Carolina A&T.

## VILLANOVA NOTES

### CATCHING UP WITH THE 'CATS

◆ Villanova enters today's game with a 4-2 record on the season and a 2-1 mark in CAA Football league action after defeating North Carolina A&T on the road last week. The other wins for the Wildcats on the year have come against Lehigh, Colgate and Rhode Island. In last week's game the story of the day was the performance of the Villanova offense in the first half. Along the way to building a 30-14 lead at halftime the Wildcats amassed 373 yards of total offense compared to just 54 for the Aggies. Villanova racked up more than 23 minutes (23:09) of possession time in the first half and converted 6-of-9 third down chances while averaging nearly 7.5 yards per play.

### FOURTH TIME FOE

◆ Villanova plays Elon this week for the fourth time since the Phoenix joined CAA Football. The only previous visit that Elon made to Villanova Stadium came in 2017 when the Wildcats were dealt a 19-14 loss on their home turf. Villanova has twice traveled to Elon in league play and has come away with convincing victories in 2016 (42-7) and 2021 (35-0).

### FAMILIAR FACES

◆ There will be two familiar faces on the Elon sideline when the Phoenix visit Villanova Stadium this weekend. Elon head coach **Tony Trisciani** spent five seasons with the Wildcats (2012-16) as an assistant coach on defense working with the team's secondary and handling recruiting efforts under Villanova head coach **Andy Talley**. Trisciani has been at Elon since 2017 and spent two years as the team's associate head coach before ascending to head coach before the 2019 season. Elon's defensive run game coordinator and defensive line coach **Seth Payne** spent one year with the Wildcats as a defensive assistant in 2014.

### OFFENSIVE EFFICIENCY

◆ Fifth year quarterback **Connor Watkins** finished the North Carolina A&T game 16-of-23 for 289 yards and three touchdowns. Villanova amassed a season-high 537 yards of total offense in the contest (289 passing, 248 rushing) and averaged 7.2 yards per play. It was the first time since the Monmouth game last year that the Wildcats topped 500 yards of total offense in a game.

### THE NATION'S TOP TANDEM

◆ Sophomore wide receiver **Jaylan Sanchez** and fifth year quarterback **Connor Watkins** begin play this week leading the country in yards per reception and yards per completion, respectively. Sanchez is averaging 26.6 yards per catch on the year while making 16 receptions for a team-high 425 yards and three touchdowns. He has five catches of 45 yards or longer on the year and scored a pair of touchdowns against North Carolina A&T on receptions of 59 yards and 58 yards.

◆ Watkins has thrown nine pass completions of 40 yards or longer through the first six games and is averaging 17.3 yards per completion on the year. He has thrown for 1,226 yards and an average of 204.3 yards per contest while going 71-of-125 through the air. In last week's win over North Carolina A&T, Watkins threw five completions of 20 yards or longer, including the two long passes to Sanchez and three completions of 20+ yards to fifth year wide receiver **Rayjuon Pringle**.

### FIVE YEARS OF SUCCESS

◆ Over the last five seasons (2019-23) the Wildcats own the best overall record among the current CAA Football teams. Villanova has gone 31-15 (.674) since the start of the 2019 season and won its most recent CAA title in 2021.

◆ Villanova also has the second-best record among CAA Football teams over the last 10 seasons (2014-23), going 67-40 (.626) since the start of the 2014 campaign.

### MOVING THE STICKS

◆ Villanova was 8-of-16 on third down last week to continue an impressive trend over the past three weeks. In the last three games against Rhode Island, UAlbany and North Carolina A&T the Wildcats are a combined 24-of-41 (58.5%) on third down. That is a marked turnaround from the first three games of the season when Villanova converted only 24.2 percent (8-of-33) of its third down chances.

### ON THE RUN

◆ With his 21-yard touchdown run in the second quarter last week, fifth year running back **DeeWil Barlee** became the 12th player in Villanova history to reach 2,000 career rushing yards. His current career totals through the end of the game are 2,032 yards and 14 touchdowns. Barlee ranks 12th in school history and is 128 yards behind former Wildcats quarterback *Chris Whitney* (2007-10) for 11th place. In the same game last week, sixth year running back **Jalen Jackson** rushed for 77 yards and moved up to 14th place in school history with 1,880 career yards. Fifth year rusher **TD Ayo-Durojaiye** added another 61 yards last week to move into 25th place on the Wildcats all-time list with 1,430 yards.

## VILLANOVA NOTES

### HOME IS WHERE THE WINS ARE

◆ Villanova has won each of its past five home games, including a 35-9 win over then-No. 17 Rhode Island last month. Under head coach **Mark Ferrante**, the Wildcats are 20-12 at home. Villanova Stadium has been the on-campus home of the Wildcats since 1927 and the venue is now in its 97th season. Villanova is 259-112-5 (.695) in the stadium's friendly confines.

### SIX CATCHES FOR HAYEK

◆ After missing the first two games of the season with an injury, fifth year wide receiver **Jaaron Hayek** has eased his way back into a full workload in recent weeks. He played 11 snaps in the game at UCF on September 16 and rounded into form against UAlbany with a season-high six catches for 35 yards. Hayek ranks seventh in school history in career receiving yards entering play against Elon this week.

### DEFENSIVE DOINGS

◆ Sixth year linebacker **Danny Abraham** led the Wildcats with seven tackles and had one of the team's four sacks against North Carolina A&T last week. Fifth year defensive ends **Camdon Gagnon** and **Chandon Pierre** in addition to senior safety **Tyrell Mims** also had sacks. The Aggies had only two first downs in the first half and did not record their third first down of the game until the second-to-last play of the third quarter. Villanova wound up with a 25-8 advantage in first downs on the day and finished the game with a 37:40 time of possession.

### THAT'S UNCHARACTERISTIC

◆ Villanova's game at UAlbany was marked by the Wildcats committing five turnovers and being sacked seven times. It was the first time Villanova committed five turnovers in a game in a span of 115 games since September 7, 2013 in a 27-24 loss to Fordham.

◆ It had been nearly the exact same number of games since the Wildcats were sacked seven times in a contest. That had last happened 109 games prior on November 2, 2013 in a 31-21 loss at James Madison.

### BEYOND THE NUMBERS

◆ The official stats from the UAlbany game had Villanova with a season-low total of 71 rushing yards on 29 carries (2.4 yards per carry) while the Great Danes were credited with 33 carries for 116 yards (3.5 yards per carry). Those numbers were heavily influenced by sacks however, including seven sacks recorded by the UAlbany defense. When taking out the sack-adjusted rushing yards, the totals from the game were Villanova with 22 rushes for 127 yards (5.8 yards per carry) and the Great Danes with 31 carries for 134 yards (4.3 yards per carry).

## VILLANOVA NOTES

### LOOKING DOWNFIELD

◆ Fifth year quarterback **Connor Watkins** was 16-of-23 through the air for 289 yards and a season-high three touchdown passes against North Carolina A&T last week. Watkins continues to rank among the national leaders this season in multiple statistical categories. He is leading all FCS signal callers with an average of 17.28 yards per completion and ranks second nationally with 9.82 yards per pass attempt.

◆ Since the start of the 2022 season Watkins has recorded 24 pass completions of 40 yards or longer. That represents more than 12 percent (24 of 199) of his total number of completions since becoming the Wildcats starter under center. In 17 career starts, Watkins is 199-of-358 (55.6%) through the air for 3,284 yards with 24 touchdowns and 16 interceptions. Watkins' tally of long completions is as follows...

### MORE ON WATKINS

◆ In the Colgate game, **Connor Watkins** recorded his first career game with at least two passing and rushing touchdowns in the same contest. He rushed 10 times for a net total of 15 yards and two scores to go along with his record-setting passing performance (8-of-11, 310 yards, 2 TD). The last Villanova quarterback with two or more passing and rushing touchdowns in a game was Daniel Smith who recorded three touchdown passes and two rushing touchdowns against Elon on November 6, 2021.

◆ In the game against Rhode Island, Watkins became the first Villanova quarterback with three rushing touchdowns in a game since John Robertson at UAlbany in 2015.

### HERE'S THE KICKER

◆ Sixth year collegiate kicker **Matthew Mercurio** stayed perfect on the season in last week's game at North Carolina A&T when he made all four of his PATs to go along with kicking a season-high three field goals. He connected on a 25-yard field goal for the first points of the game in the opening quarter, then made attempts from 39 yards and 19 yards in the second quarter. He is now 5-of-5 on field goals this season, including his second-longest attempt as a Wildcat when he made a 44-yarder at UAlbany. That kick was his 12th career field goal of 40 yards or longer and his third in a Villanova uniform. In his two years at Villanova, Mercurio had made 15-of-17 field goal attempts and is a perfect 58-of-58 on extra points. Including his seasons at San Jose State, Mercurio's career totals are 151-of-156 (96.8%) on PATs and 59-of-71 (83.1%) on field goals.

# VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

## VILLANOVA NOTES

### FANTASTIC FONDACARO

◆ Senior punter **Nathan Fondacaro** is ranked second in CAA Football and 12th nationally with an average of 44.1 yards per punt this season. He has kicked at least one punt of 50+ yards in each of his last three games, including for 56 yards against both North Carolina A&T last week and UAlbany the week before. Fondacaro has 33 career punts of 50+ yards, including eight this season and four in his past three games.

◆ After missing last season due to an injury, Fondacaro has returned strong this year and is averaging a career-best 44.1 yards per punt. He has punted 26 times overall with a long punt of 57 yards to go along with four touchbacks, three fair catches, three punts downed inside the 20-yard line and eight punts of 50 yards or longer.

### 40...NOT 50...DEFINITELY NOT 60

◆ Villanova lost to UCF, 48-14, in its annual game against an FBS opponent. Despite the final outcome, the Wildcats maintained their streak of not allowing an opponent to score 50+ points in a game, as noted below.

◆ Villanova has gone 219 straight games without allowing an opponent to score 50 points. It last happened on October 2, 2004 when New Hampshire defeated the Wildcats, 51-40.

◆ Villanova has gone 1,009 straight games without allowing an opponent to score 60 points. It last happened on November 15, 1919 when Army West Point dealt the Wildcats a 62-0 defeat. Villanova has allowed 60 points in just six of its 1,192 games played all-time.

◆ Since becoming an FCS program in 1985, the Wildcats have played 26 games versus FBS foes and have given up 40 or more points in just six of those games.

### RECORD-SETTING EFFICIENCY

◆ In the win over Colgate on September 9, fifth year quarterback **Connor Watkins** became the first player in Villanova history to throw for over 300 yards on fewer than 10 completions. Watkins was 8-of-11 through the air for 310 yards and two touchdowns while averaging an incredible 38.75 yards per completion in the 42-19 win.

◆ Watkins completed three passes of 60 yards or longer in the record-setting performance, with five of his passes going for 43 yards or longer. He threw a 67-yard touchdown pass to fifth year wide receiver **Rayjuon Pringle**, who also hauled in catches of 51 yard and 43 yards. Sophomore wide receiver **Jaylan Sanchez** recorded receptions of 68 yards and 60 yards.

◆ Prior to Watkins' performance versus Colgate the school record for fewest completions in a 300-yard game was more than double Villanova's eight pass completions against Colgate. During the 2019 season **Daniel Smith** threw for 378 yards on 17 completions (17-of-24, 378 yards, 5 TD) against Delaware.

◆ Watkins' average of 38.75 yards per completion in the Colgate game would have set the FCS record for a single game if he had enough completions to qualify for the NCAA minimum standard. The official record for an FCS game is 28.5 yards per completion (17 completions for 485 yards) by Kendrick Nord of Grambling against Alcorn on September 3, 1994.

### STATISTICAL ODDITY

◆ **Connor Watkins'** longest pass in the game against Colgate was for 75 yards, but Villanova's longest reception in the game was for 68 yards. Midway through the second quarter the Wildcats had a 3rd-and-11 play from their own 24-yard line. Watkins looked short right to sophomore receiver **Jaylan Sanchez**, who caught the pass but eventually fumbled at the Colgate 10-yard line after a gain of 66 yards. Fifth year receiver **Rayjuon Pringle** recovered the loose ball at the 8-yard line and kept the play alive until he was brought down at the 1-yard line. Sanchez was credited with 68 yards and Pringle with seven yards.

### ENTERING WITH EXPERIENCE

◆ Villanova has 19 players (out of 93) on its 2023 roster who are graduate students in their fifth or sixth years of playing college football. All 19 graduate students on the roster were listed as starters or reserves on the Wildcats depth chart to open the 2023 season.

◆ In all, the 93 players on the Villanova roster began the 2023 campaign with 1,064 career games played and 369 yards. The current tally for the players on the Wildcats roster is 1,379 career games played with 501 starts.

### PRESEASON HONORS

◆ Wide receiver **Jaaron Hayek** and offensive lineman **Michael Corbi** were each named to the CAA Football Preseason All-Conference Team in a preseason poll of league head coaches. Hayek was a first team All-CAA selection last year and Corbi was a second team pick.

◆ In addition to the two preseason all-conference honorees, safety **Jalen Goodman** and kicker **Matthew Mercurio** garnered honorable mention preseason honors.

### ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

#### NCAA ACADEMIC DATA

■ Each year the NCAA recognizes programs that have a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranks within the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. Villanova has earned this award nine times in the 17-year history of the APR program.

■ In the most recent APR data released in May 2023 the football program's multi-year APR score of 974 was 12 points above the national average for FCS programs.

■ New data on the NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) was released in November 2022 and Villanova led all CAA Football schools with a new program record 96 percent GSR.

#### ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

■ One of the highest honors that a student-athlete can achieve is to be named an Academic All-American, an award which encompasses both academic achievement as well as contributions on the field. Villanova has had 12 football student-athletes earn a total of 14 Academic All-America honors over the years.

#### CAA TEAM ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

■ Villanova was the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for both the 2016-17 and the 2017-18 school years. The award is presented at the end of each academic year to the conference school with the highest team GPA.

#### CAA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

■ Villanova has had five student-athletes be named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Nominees for the award must have attained senior standing academically and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

#### CAA ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

■ Student-athletes with a semester GPA of 3.0 or higher are named to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll. Villanova had 62 honorees for the Fall 2022 semester and 63 student-athletes achieve this distinction for the Spring 2023 term.

#### ACADEMIC ALL-AREA TEAMS

■ In conjunction with the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, the sports information directors at the colleges and universities in the Philadelphia area (PhillySIDA) name an Academic All-Area team and a football Performer of the Year each season. In the 16 years of the Academic All-Area program, which started with the 2005-06 academic year, the football team has had a total of 56 selections to the Academic All-Area Team. In addition, the Wildcats have had five Performers of the Year.

# VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

## VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE



Mark Ferrante is in his seventh season as the Villanova head coach in 2023 and he begins the season with a career record of 37-26 (.587), including 23 regular season CAA Football wins. He is in his 37th year overall with the Wildcats and previously spent 30 years as an assistant coach (1987-2016) on Andy Talley's staff. To date, Ferrante has been a part of 254 victories and all 14 of Villanova's FCS playoff appearances during his time on campus.

Ferrante was named the CAA Football Coach of the Year in 2021 and he has mentored four conference major award winners during his first six seasons as head coach. The honorees include two student-athletes who won the league's prestigious Chuck Boone Leadership and Excellence Award – Chucky Smith (2019) and Justin Covington (2020) – while a

pair of defensive standouts have been named the CAA Football Defensive Player of the Year (Forrest Rhyne; 2021) and the league's Defensive Rookie of the Year (Christian Benford; 2018). Rhyne and Benford have each gone on to play in the NFL. Villanova has earned a total of 42 CAA Football All-Conference selections during Ferrante's head coaching tenure, including 13 first team picks.

Outside of football the Wildcats student-athletes have continually excelled in their academic pursuits under Ferrante's watch. During the 2022-23 academic year, Villanova had 62 selections to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll during the Fall semester and 63 honorees on the Spring semester Honor Roll. There were also 51 student-athletes named to the Athletic Director's Honor Roll during the Fall and 53 selections for the Spring semester. Since Ferrante became head coach, the Wildcats have had a total of 544 CAA honor roll selections and 465 honorees on the Athletic Director's Honor Roll.

Each year the NCAA releases academic data for each Division I sport program's Academic Progress Rate (APR) and NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR). In the latest GSR data released in November 2022, the football program set a new record and topped all CAA schools with a 96 percent success rate. New APR data released in May 2023 showed Villanova with a multi-year score (.974) that is 12 points above the national average for FCS football programs.

Ferrante and his Wildcats will enter the 2023 campaign on a high note after late heroics in the 2022 finale against Delaware led the team to its eighth winning record in the last 10 full seasons played. Villanova defeated the rival Blue Hens in the annual "Battle of the Blue" game to finish the season with a 6-5 overall record and a 4-4 mark in CAAA games. Wide receiver Jaaron Hayek was named to the CAA Football First Team Offense and was one of four All-CAA selections for the 2022 campaign.

The 2021 season was a breakthrough year for the Wildcats and Ferrante was the AFCA FCS Region 1 Coach of the Year, an honor which made him a finalist for National Coach of the Year consideration. Villanova posted a 10-3 record in 2021 and won a share of the CAA Football title while securing the league's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs. It is the second straight full season (2019, 2021) in which Ferrante guided the Wildcats to postseason play.

Villanova hosted two playoff games in 2021 and advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Division I Football Championship to finish the year ranked in the top-10 nationally (No. 8) in both FCS national polls for the first time since 2014. The Wildcats tallied their seventh season in program history with at least 10 wins and achieved success by playing – and beating – some of the top FCS teams in the nation. Villanova's 10-3 record included four victories over Top 25 opponents, including No. 3 James Madison, No. 18 Rhode Island, No. 21 Richmond and No. 24 Holy Cross. Ferrante led the Wildcats to a 7-1 record against a challenging CAA Football schedule to mark the fifth season since 1988 in which the team had no more than one loss in conference play.

There was star power in all facets of the game for Villanova during the 2021 season, with Ferrante coaching 11 players who had an opportunity to continue their football careers beyond the college ranks. The group included cornerback Christian Benford who was a sixth round draft pick of the Buffalo Bills. Fellow corner Denzel Williams signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Ravens and linebacker Forrest Rhyne was inked to a free agent contract by the Indianapolis Colts. Benford and Rhyne were consensus first team All-Americans in 2021, while offensive lineman Michael Corbi was also a 2021 All-America selection and was one of 13 Wildcats who were named to the CAA Football All-Conference teams.

# VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

## MARK FERRANTE / VILLANOVA COACHING STAFF

Ferrante and the Wildcats made the most out of the opportunity to play four games in a shortened Spring 2021 season and use the experience gained from those games moving forward. The spring games were officially recognized as the 2020 season and Villanova tallied a 2-2 record in four contests against CAA foes, including road wins over Stony Brook and Maine. The abbreviated season had its share of highlights, with eight players chosen for the CAA Football All-Conference teams. Corbi, Rhyne and defensive lineman Malik Fisher were each named first team All-CAA selections.

Villanova came off a 2019 season in which it was ranked as high as No. 5 in the nation. Ferrante guided the Wildcats to a 9-4 record and the program's seventh FCS playoff berth in the previous 12 years in 2019. After being picked to finish ninth in CAA Football before the season the team raced out of the gates with a 6-0 record, including a 3-0 mark in league play by the midpoint of the season. Villanova had 10 players earn All-CAA accolades, including a trio of first team selections in Rhyne, offensive lineman Paul Grattan and punter Nathan Fondacaro.

Eight players have signed NFL free agent contracts since Ferrante became head coach, with the aforementioned Rhyne and Williams joining offensive tackle Brandon Hitner (LA Rams); safety Rob Rolle (Miami Dolphins); offensive lineman Ethan Greenidge (New Orleans Saints); defensive back Trey Johnson (Pittsburgh Steelers); defensive back Malik Reaves (Kansas City Chiefs); and linebacker Ed Shockley (Dallas Cowboys).

Ferrante leads one of the nation's elite FCS programs after playing an instrumental role in the Wildcats rise to national prominence. He has been a part of the coaching staff for all 14 of Villanova's appearances in the FCS playoffs, including the 2009 national championship season and a 2010 semifinal appearance while serving as the Assistant Head Coach on Andy Talley's staff. Ferrante has been a part of Villanova teams that have won seven CAA titles, three Lambert Meadowlands Cups and three ECAC Team of the Year awards.

Ferrante's success during his years as an assistant coach were recognized by others outside the Villanova program. At the end of the 2015 season he was named the FCS Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA). This award was first presented in 1997 and was created to honor assistant coaches who excel in community service, commitment to student-athletes and on-field coaching success. Ferrante was involved in all aspects of the

Villanova program during his time as an assistant on Andy Talley's staff. On the field he coached the offensive line for 27 seasons and developed a unit that was perennially one of the best in CAA Football. Over the years he coached three All-Americans, 11 All-East performers and 15 first team all-conference selections. The offensive line had 17 All-CAA selections in a nine-year span, including three-time first team honoree Ben Ijalana along with first team selections Brant Clouser (2010), Dan Shirey (2011) and Vince Kowalski (2014).

Two of Ferrante's players went on to be selected in the NFL Draft. Ijalana was a second round selection by the Indianapolis Colts in 2011 and Brad Seaton was picked in the seventh round by the Tennessee Titans in 2017. Ijalana was a two-time All-American (2009, 2010) and a three-time first team All-CAA selection during his collegiate career. Villanova reached the FCS playoffs in each of his last three seasons on the team, winning the 2009 national title and advancing to the semifinal round a year later. Seaton was a second team CAA Football All-Conference selection in 2016 when the offensive line enabled the Wildcats to average 206.3 rushing yards and 378.7 yards of total offense per game. Villanova ranked third in the CAA and 24th nationally in rushing offense in addition to ranking fourth in the league in total offense and fifth with a scoring average of 24.4 points per game.

The other All-Americans Ferrante mentored are Eamonn Allen (2001) and Bryan Russo (1989). Allen earned first team Associated Press All-America recognition in 2001 and was also a first team All-East and first team All-Atlantic 10 selection. Russo was chosen as an All-American by the Sports Network and the American Football Coaches Association as a senior in 1989 when he was also a first team all-conference and an All-ECAC selection. He was inducted to Villanova's Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2007.

Ferrante was a standout collegiate performer in his own right prior to joining the football coaching ranks. He was the quarterback for Andy Talley at St. Lawrence where he was named the 1982 Division III Player of the Year to go along with first team All-East honors. Ferrante directed the offense for a St. Lawrence team that went 10-1 during the 1982 season and reached the national semifinals in the playoffs.

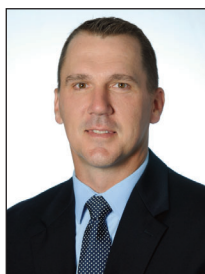

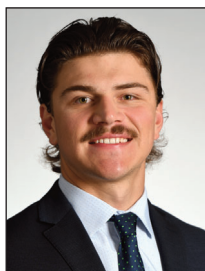
