## TODAY'S GAME

■ Villanova returns from its bye week to host Stony Brook on Saturday afternoon for a 2 p.m. kickoff at Villanova Stadium. The Wildcats have won 16 of their last 22 games coming off a bye week.

■ It is Homecoming Weekend on campus and the Wildcats will look to continue their historical success in Homecoming games. Villanova is 36-21 (.632) all-time in its Homecoming Weekend games, with the first such game occurring in 1958 when the Wildcats defeated Detroit Mercy, 7-0.

■ Villanova recorded the third-highest total of rushing yards in a single game in school history against Elon two weeks ago. The Wildcats rushed for 440 yards on 63 carries to notch the fifth 400+ yard game in the program record book and the first since 2009.

■ First year running back **Isaiah Ragland** became the sixth true freshman in school history to rush for 125 or more yards in a single game when he carried 15 times for 126 yards in the win over Elon.

## VILLANOVA NOTES

### TODAY'S GAME

◆ Villanova (5-2, 3-1 CAA Football) comes off its bye week to host Stony Brook (0-7, 0-5 CAA Football) for a 2 p.m. kickoff at Villanova Stadium on Saturday afternoon. The meeting will be the seventh all-time between the schools and the sixth since the Seawolves joined CAA Football in 2013. Saturday's game can be seen live on FloFootball with **Sam Kuperman** and **Steve Pinone** calling the action, while the radio broadcast with **Ryan Fannon** and **Kevin Reilly** can be heard by looking for the Villanova Sports Radio Network on the iHeart radio mobile app.

### BY THE BYE

◆ Villanova is 16-6 in its last 22 games after a bye week. The long-term trend is a good one despite the Wildcats falling on the road to Richmond, 20-10, last season in their return from the bye week. The 16-6 record does not include the abbreviated slate of four games played in Spring 2021 during the Covid pandemic.

◆ Villanova's last win after a bye week was in the second round of the 2021 FCS playoffs when it defeated Holy Cross after earning a first round bye in the postseason bracket.

### HOW IT STARTED...

◆ The first-ever meeting between Villanova and Stony Brook took place in 2012 in the first round of the FCS playoffs. As it happened, the Seawolves were going to be joining CAA Football the next season and the Wildcats got an early look at them in a postseason setting during Stony Brook's final season in the Big South.

◆ Villanova was defeated in the playoff game during quarterback John Robertson's rookie season, but it avenged the loss with a 35-6 win at home one year later when the teams met as conference foes for the first time. Stony Brook defeated the Wildcats in Stony Brook, N.Y. in 2018 and on Homecoming Weekend at Villanova in 2019.

### ...HOW IT'S GOING

◆ Villanova has won the last two head-to-head matchups with Stony Brook to even the series between the teams at 3-3. This week's game will be the second straight meeting to take place at Villanova Stadium where the Wildcats tallied a 33-14 victory in 2021. Earlier in the same calendar year, Villanova won the Spring 2021 opener at Stony Brook by a 16-13 margin. In the 2021 game, running back **Jalen Jackson** and wide receiver **Jaaron Hayek** each scored two touchdowns.

### HOME IS WHERE THE WINS ARE

◆ Villanova has won each of its first three home games this season against Colgate (42-19), Rhode Island (35-9) and Elon (21-0). The home winning streak is at five games overall dating back to last season and the Wildcats are 20-12 at home during the Mark Ferrante head coaching era. Villanova Stadium opened in 1927 and the Wildcats are 260-112-5 (.696) in what is now their 93rd season in their on-campus home.

### HOMECOMING

◆ Villanova is 36-21 (.632) all-time in Homecoming Weekend games, including wins both last year against UAlbany (31-29) and in 2021 against Rhode Island (44-0). In last year's contest the Wildcats won in walk-off fashion when Matthew Mercurio made a 28-yard field goal as time expired to win a game that featured two lead changes in the final minute of play.

## VILLANOVA NOTES

### FIVE YEARS OF SUCCESS

◆ Over the last five seasons (2019-23) the Wildcats own the best overall winning percentage among the current CAA Football teams. Villanova has gone 32-16 (.667) since the start of the 2019 season and won its most recent CAA title in 2021.

◆ Villanova also has the second-highest winning percentage among CAA Football teams over the last 10 seasons (2014-23), going 68-40 (.630) since the start of the 2014 campaign and making playoff appearances in 2014, 2016, 2019 and 2021.

### DÉJÀ VU:

◆ Two years ago, Villanova made a trip to Elon and came away with a 35-0 shutout victory over the Phoenix. History repeated itself when Elon came to Villanova Stadium and the Wildcats posted a 21-0 win in a rain-soaked game two weeks ago. Villanova had not recorded a shutout win against any other opponents in between the two games versus Elon. The last time the Wildcats tallied shutout victories in consecutive games against the same opponent was against Bucknell in 1991 (40-0) and 1992 (34-0).

### MOVING THE STICKS

◆ Villanova has done an excellent job of converting on third down its past four games. Beginning with the contest against Rhode Island on September 23, the Wildcats have gone 30-of-55 (54.5%) on third down in the four-game stretch. That is a big improvement from the first three games of the season when Villanova converted on just 24.2 percent (8-of-33) of its third down opportunities.

## VILLANOVA NOTES

### RUNNING AMOK

◆ Villanova rushed for 440 yards in its 21-0 win over Elon two weeks ago and recorded the third-highest single-game rushing performance in school history. The only games in the Wildcats record book with higher rushing totals were on November 19, 1949 when Villanova rushed for 627 yards against North Carolina State and on November 13, 1976 in a 494-yard rushing performance against Holy Cross. There have only been five games total in program history (out of 1,196 total) in which the Wildcats have topped 400 rushing yards.

◆ The heavy rain and windy conditions against Elon two weeks ago made it difficult for either team to get its passing game going. Villanova and Elon combined to run the ball on 88 of 111 offensive plays in the contest.

### THE T-D STANDS FOR TOUCHDOWN

◆ Fifth year running back **TD Ayo-Durojaiye** accounted for the only offensive points of the game by either team in the victory over Elon as he rushed for a career-high three touchdowns. Somewhat incredibly, Ayo-Durojaiye was only the Wildcats fourth-leading rusher in the game despite carrying the ball 11 times for 78 yards and the three scores. He tallied the first points of the game on his first offensive snap of the day when he scampered for a one-yard touchdown at the 9:24 mark of the first quarter. Less than four minutes later he broke away from midfield and galloped for a 50-yard coring run. The third touchdown was another one-yard play at 7:02 of the third quarter.

### DEPTH IN THE RUNNING GAME

◆ The 400+ yard ground attack against Elon saw four different players gain at least 78 yards for the Wildcats. Leading the way was freshman running back **Isaiah Ragland** who rushed 15 times for 126 yards while averaging 8.4 yards per carry. His performance was the highest rushing total for a Villanova true freshman since current fifth year senior **DeeWil Barlee** ran for 131 yards against Stony Brook on October 26, 2019.

◆ Fifth year quarterback **Connor Watkins** rushed for 125 yards on 13 carries while averaging 9.6 yards per rush in the Elon game. Sixth year running back **Jalen Jackson** led the Wildcats with 17 carries and ran for 83 yards on the day, while fifth year running back **TD Ayo-Durojaiye** rushed for 78 yards and the game's only three touchdowns.

### TWO FOR 125

◆ The game against Elon was the 29th time in school history that Villanova had two or more players rush for 100 yards or more in a single game. However, it was only the third time ever that the Wildcats had two players rush for at least 125 yards in the same contest. Freshman running back **Isaiah Ragland** (126 yards) and fifth year quarterback **Connor Watkins** (125 yards) became the first Villanova teammates to rush for at least 125 yards in the same game since *Vince Thompson* (162) and *Pat O'Brien* (146) did so against West Virginia on October 29, 1977.

### FRESHMAN FEATS

◆ First year running back **Isaiah Ragland** is only the sixth true freshman in Villanova history to rush for at least 125 yards in a single game. The last to do it is his current teammate, fifth year running back **DeeWil Barlee**, who ran for 131 yards against Stony Brook during his freshman season in 2019.

### FOURTH AND PIVOTAL

◆ In the first quarter of the Elon game there were crucial fourth down plays on successive drives. Elon went for it on fourth-and-two from the Wildcats 41-yard line on their first drive of the day but were stopped by senior linebacker **Brendan Bell** for a turnover on downs. Just three players later Villanova had fourth-and-one at midfield when **TD Ayo-Durojaiye** burst up the middle for a 50-yard touchdown run which gave the Wildcats a 14-0 lead at the 5:33 mark of the first quarter. Amidst the day's damp and dreary conditions there was only one other scoring play in the game's final 54-plus minutes.

# VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

## VILLANOVA NOTES

### DOMINANT DEFENSE

◆ Villanova's defensive effort was just as impressive as its powerful running game in the 21-0 win over Elon two weeks ago. The Wildcats held the Phoenix to just 99 yards of total offense on the day, including 53 rushing yards on 25 carries (2.1 yards per rush) and 46 passing yards on 5-of-13 accuracy (3.5 yards per attempt). Senior linebacker **Brendan Bell** had a team-high seven total tackles, while linebackers **Shane Hartzell** and **Danny Abraham** each recorded sacks. It isn't easy to allow only 99 total yards without forcing a turnover, but the Wildcats did exactly that thanks to stifling Elon into an average of just 2.6 yards per play.

### STAYING ON THE FIELD

◆ Villanova's persistent rushing attack and stifling defense has enabled the Wildcats offense to stay on the field for the bulk of the game in each of the last two outings against North Carolina A&T and Elon. In the 21-0 win over the Phoenix two weeks ago, Villanova held the ball for a season-high 40:49 time of possession with a nearly equal breakdown of 20:14 in the first half and 20:35 in the second half. Over the past two weeks the Wildcats have an advantage of 51-13 in first downs against their opposition and a margin of 78:16-41:44 in time of possession.

### LOOKING DOWNFIELD

◆ Fifth year quarterback **Connor Watkins** was 16-of-23 through the air for 289 yards and a season-high three touchdown passes against North Carolina A&T. Watkins continues to rank among the national leaders this season in multiple statistical categories. He is leading all FCS signal callers with an average of 17.07 yards per completion and ranks third nationally with 9.36 yards per pass attempt.

◆ Since the start of the 2022 season Watkins has recorded 24 pass completions of 40 yards or longer. That represents nearly 12 percent (24 of 202) of his total number of completions since becoming the Wildcats starter under center. In 18 career starts, Watkins is 202-of-368 (54.9%) through the air for 3,320 yards with 24 touchdowns and 17 interceptions. Watkins' tally of long completions is as follows...

### MORE ON WATKINS

◆ In the Colgate game, **Connor Watkins** recorded his first career game with at least two passing and rushing touchdowns in the same contest. He rushed 10 times for a net total of 15 yards and two scores to go along with his record-setting passing performance (8-of-11, 310 yards, 2 TD). The last Villanova quarterback with two or more passing and rushing touchdowns in a game was Daniel Smith who recorded three touchdown passes and two rushing touchdowns against Elon on November 6, 2021.

◆ In the game against Rhode Island, Watkins became the first Villanova quarterback with three rushing touchdowns in a game since John Robertson at UAlbany in 2015.

### HERE'S THE KICKER

◆ Sixth year collegiate kicker **Matthew Mercurio** stayed perfect on the season in the game against Elon when he made all three of his PATs. That followed up a performance against North Carolina A&T on October 7 in which he kicked a season-high three field goals. He connected on a 25-yard field goal in the opening quarter of that game, then made attempts from 39 yards and 19 yards in the second period.

◆ Mercurio is now 5-of-5 on field goals this season, including his second-longest attempt as a Wildcat when he made a 44-yarder at UAlbany. That kick was his 12th career field goal of 40 yards or longer and his third in a Villanova uniform.

◆ In his two years at Villanova, Mercurio had made 15-of-17 field goal attempts and is a perfect 61-of-61 on extra points. Including his seasons at San Jose State, Mercurio's career totals are 154-of-159 (96.9%) on PATs and 59-of-71 (83.1%) on field goals.

### FANTASTIC FONDACARO

◆ Senior punter **Nathan Fondacaro** is ranked second in CAA Football and 15th nationally with an average of 43.4 yards per punt this season. He has kicked at least one punt of 50+ yards in three of his last four games, including for 56 yards against both North Carolina A&T on October 7 and UAlbany the week before. Fondacaro has 33 career punts of 50+ yards, including eight this season and four in his past four games.

◆ After missing last season due to an injury, Fondacaro has returned strong this year and is averaging 43.4 yards per punt. He has punted 27 times overall with a long punt of 57 yards to go along with four touchbacks, four fair catches, three punts downed inside the 20-yard line and eight punts of 50 yards or longer.

### RECORD-SETTING EFFICIENCY

◆ In the win over Colgate on September 9, fifth year quarterback **Connor Watkins** became the first player in Villanova history to throw for over 300 yards on fewer than 10 completions. Watkins was 8-of-11 through the air for 310 yards and two touchdowns while averaging an incredible 38.75 yards per completion in the 42-19 win.

◆ Watkins completed three passes of 60 yards or longer in the record-setting performance, with five of his passes going for 43 yards or longer. He threw a 67-yard touchdown pass to fifth year wide receiver **Rayjuon Pringle**, who also hauled in catches of 51 yard and 43 yards. Sophomore wide receiver **Jaylan Sanchez** recorded receptions of 68 yards and 60 yards.

◆ Prior to Watkins' performance versus Colgate the school record for fewest completions in a 300-yard game was more than double Villanova's eight pass completions against Colgate. During the 2019 season **Daniel Smith** threw for 378 yards on 17 completions (17-of-24, 378 yards, 5 TD) against Delaware.

◆ Watkins' average of 38.75 yards per completion in the Colgate game would have set the FCS record for a single game if he had enough completions to qualify for the NCAA minimum standard. The official record for an FCS game is 28.5 yards per completion (17 completions for 485 yards) by Kendrick Nord of Grambling against Alcorn on September 3, 1994.

### STATISTICAL ODDITY

◆ **Connor Watkins'** longest pass in the game against Colgate was for 75 yards, but Villanova's longest reception in the game was for 68 yards. Midway through the second quarter the Wildcats had a 3rd-and-11 play from their own 24-yard line. Watkins looked short right to sophomore receiver **Jaylan Sanchez**, who caught the pass but eventually fumbled at the Colgate 10-yard line after a gain of 66 yards. Fifth year receiver **Rayjuon Pringle** recovered the loose ball at the 8-yard line and kept the play alive until he was brought down at the 1-yard line. Sanchez was credited with 68 yards and Pringle with seven yards.

### ENTERING WITH EXPERIENCE

- ◆ Villanova has 19 players (out of 93) on its 2023 roster who are graduate students in their fifth or sixth years of playing college football. All 19 graduate students on the roster were listed as starters or reserves on the Wildcats depth chart to open the 2023 season.
- ◆ In all, the 93 players on the Villanova roster began the 2023 campaign with 1,064 career games played and 369 yards. The current tally for the players on the Wildcats roster is 1,430 career games played with 523 starts.

### PRESEASON HONORS

- ◆ Wide receiver **Jaaron Hayek** and offensive lineman **Michael Corbi** were each named to the CAA Football Preseason All-Conference Team in a preseason poll of league head coaches. Hayek was a first team All-CAA selection last year and Corbi was a second team pick.
- ◆ In addition to the two preseason all-conference honorees, safety **Jalen Goodman** and kicker **Matthew Mercurio** garnered honorable mention preseason honors.

### ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

#### NCAA ACADEMIC DATA

■ Each year the NCAA recognizes programs that have a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranks within the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. Villanova has earned this award nine times in the 17-year history of the APR program.

■ In the most recent APR data released in May 2023 the football program's multi-year APR score of 974 was 12 points above the national average for FCS programs.

■ New data on the NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) was released in November 2022 and Villanova led all CAA Football schools with a new program record 96 percent GSR.

#### ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

■ One of the highest honors that a student-athlete can achieve is to be named an Academic All-American, an award which encompasses both academic achievement as well as contributions on the field. Villanova has had 12 football student-athletes earn a total of 14 Academic All-America honors over the years.

#### CAA TEAM ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

■ Villanova was the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for both the 2016-17 and the 2017-18 school years. The award is presented at the end of each academic year to the conference school with the highest team GPA.

#### CAA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

■ Villanova has had five student-athletes be named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Nominees for the award must have attained senior standing academically and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

#### CAA ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

■ Student-athletes with a semester GPA of 3.0 or higher are named to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll. Villanova had 62 honorees for the Fall 2022 semester and 63 student-athletes achieve this distinction for the Spring 2023 term.

#### ACADEMIC ALL-AREA TEAMS

■ In conjunction with the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, the sports information directors at the colleges and universities in the Philadelphia area (PhillySIDA) name an Academic All-Area team and a football Performer of the Year each season. In the 16 years of the Academic All-Area program, which started with the 2005-06 academic year, the football team has had a total of 56 selections to the Academic All-Area Team. In addition, the Wildcats have had five Performers of the Year.

# VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

## VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE



Mark Ferrante is in his seventh season as the Villanova head coach in 2023 and he begins the season with a career record of 37-26 (.587), including 23 regular season CAA Football wins. He is in his 37th year overall with the Wildcats and previously spent 30 years as an assistant coach (1987-2016) on Andy Talley's staff. To date, Ferrante has been a part of 254 victories and all 14 of Villanova's FCS playoff appearances during his time on campus.

Ferrante was named the CAA Football Coach of the Year in 2021 and he has mentored four conference major award winners during his first six seasons as head coach. The honorees include two student-athletes who won the league's prestigious Chuck Boone Leadership and Excellence Award – Chucky Smith (2019) and Justin Covington (2020) – while a

pair of defensive standouts have been named the CAA Football Defensive Player of the Year (Forrest Rhyne; 2021) and the league's Defensive Rookie of the Year (Christian Benford; 2018). Rhyne and Benford have each gone on to play in the NFL. Villanova has earned a total of 42 CAA Football All-Conference selections during Ferrante's head coaching tenure, including 13 first team picks.

Outside of football the Wildcats student-athletes have continually excelled in their academic pursuits under Ferrante's watch. During the 2022-23 academic year, Villanova had 62 selections to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll during the Fall semester and 63 honorees on the Spring semester Honor Roll. There were also 51 student-athletes named to the Athletic Director's Honor Roll during the Fall and 53 selections for the Spring semester. Since Ferrante became head coach, the Wildcats have had a total of 544 CAA honor roll selections and 465 honorees on the Athletic Director's Honor Roll.

Each year the NCAA releases academic data for each Division I sport program's Academic Progress Rate (APR) and NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR). In the latest GSR data released in November 2022, the football program set a new record and topped all CAA schools with a 96 percent success rate. New APR data released in May 2023 showed Villanova with a multi-year score (.974) that is 12 points above the national average for FCS football programs.

Ferrante and his Wildcats will enter the 2023 campaign on a high note after late heroics in the 2022 finale against Delaware led the team to its eighth winning record in the last 10 full seasons played. Villanova defeated the rival Blue Hens in the annual "Battle of the Blue" game to finish the season with a 6-5 overall record and a 4-4 mark in CAAA games. Wide receiver Jaaron Hayek was named to the CAA Football First Team Offense and was one of four All-CAA selections for the 2022 campaign.

The 2021 season was a breakthrough year for the Wildcats and Ferrante was the AFCA FCS Region 1 Coach of the Year, an honor which made him a finalist for National Coach of the Year consideration. Villanova posted a 10-3 record in 2021 and won a share of the CAA Football title while securing the league's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs. It is the second straight full season (2019, 2021) in which Ferrante guided the Wildcats to postseason play.

Villanova hosted two playoff games in 2021 and advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Division I Football Championship to finish the year ranked in the top-10 nationally (No. 8) in both FCS national polls for the first time since 2014. The Wildcats tallied their seventh season in program history with at least 10 wins and achieved success by playing – and beating – some of the top FCS teams in the nation. Villanova's 10-3 record included four victories over Top 25 opponents, including No. 3 James Madison, No. 18 Rhode Island, No. 21 Richmond and No. 24 Holy Cross. Ferrante led the Wildcats to a 7-1 record against a challenging CAA Football schedule to mark the fifth season since 1988 in which the team had no more than one loss in conference play.

There was star power in all facets of the game for Villanova during the 2021 season, with Ferrante coaching 11 players who had an opportunity to continue their football careers beyond the college ranks. The group included cornerback Christian Benford who was a sixth round draft pick of the Buffalo Bills. Fellow corner Denzel Williams signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Ravens and linebacker Forrest Rhyne was inked to a free agent contract by the Indianapolis Colts. Benford and Rhyne were consensus first team All-Americans in 2021, while offensive lineman Michael Corbi was also a 2021 All-America selection and was one of 13 Wildcats who were named to the CAA Football All-Conference teams.

# VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

## MARK FERRANTE / VILLANOVA COACHING STAFF

Ferrante and the Wildcats made the most out of the opportunity to play four games in a shortened Spring 2021 season and use the experience gained from those games moving forward. The spring games were officially recognized as the 2020 season and Villanova tallied a 2-2 record in four contests against CAA foes, including road wins over Stony Brook and Maine. The abbreviated season had its share of highlights, with eight players chosen for the CAA Football All-Conference teams. Corbi, Rhyne and defensive lineman Malik Fisher were each named first team All-CAA selections.

Villanova came off a 2019 season in which it was ranked as high as No. 5 in the nation. Ferrante guided the Wildcats to a 9-4 record and the program's seventh FCS playoff berth in the previous 12 years in 2019. After being picked to finish ninth in CAA Football before the season the team raced out of the gates with a 6-0 record, including a 3-0 mark in league play by the midpoint of the season. Villanova had 10 players earn All-CAA accolades, including a trio of first team selections in Rhyne, offensive lineman Paul Grattan and punter Nathan Fondacaro.

Eight players have signed NFL free agent contracts since Ferrante became head coach, with the aforementioned Rhyne and Williams joining offensive tackle Brandon Hitner (LA Rams); safety Rob Rolle (Miami Dolphins); offensive lineman Ethan Greenidge (New Orleans Saints); defensive back Trey Johnson (Pittsburgh Steelers); defensive back Malik Reaves (Kansas City Chiefs); and linebacker Ed Shockley (Dallas Cowboys).

Ferrante leads one of the nation's elite FCS programs after playing an instrumental role in the Wildcats rise to national prominence. He has been a part of the coaching staff for all 14 of Villanova's appearances in the FCS playoffs, including the 2009 national championship season and a 2010 semifinal appearance while serving as the Assistant Head Coach on Andy Talley's staff. Ferrante has been a part of Villanova teams that have won seven CAA titles, three Lambert Meadowlands Cups and three ECAC Team of the Year awards.

Ferrante's success during his years as an assistant coach were recognized by others outside the Villanova program. At the end of the 2015 season he was named the FCS Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA). This award was first presented in 1997 and was created to honor assistant coaches who excel in community service, commitment to student-athletes and on-field coaching success. Ferrante was involved in all aspects of the

Villanova program during his time as an assistant on Andy Talley's staff. On the field he coached the offensive line for 27 seasons and developed a unit that was perennially one of the best in CAA Football. Over the years he coached three All-Americans, 11 All-East performers and 15 first team all-conference selections. The offensive line had 17 All-CAA selections in a nine-year span, including three-time first team honoree Ben Ijalana along with first team selections Brant Clouser (2010), Dan Shirey (2011) and Vince Kowalski (2014).

Two of Ferrante's players went on to be selected in the NFL Draft. Ijalana was a second round selection by the Indianapolis Colts in 2011 and Brad Seaton was picked in the seventh round by the Tennessee Titans in 2017. Ijalana was a two-time All-American (2009, 2010) and a three-time first team All-CAA selection during his collegiate career. Villanova reached the FCS playoffs in each of his last three seasons on the team, winning the 2009 national title and advancing to the semifinal round a year later. Seaton was a second team CAA Football All-Conference selection in 2016 when the offensive line enabled the Wildcats to average 206.3 rushing yards and 378.7 yards of total offense per game. Villanova ranked third in the CAA and 24th nationally in rushing offense in addition to ranking fourth in the league in total offense and fifth with a scoring average of 24.4 points per game.

The other All-Americans Ferrante mentored are Eamonn Allen (2001) and Bryan Russo (1989). Allen earned first team Associated Press All-America recognition in 2001 and was also a first team All-East and first team All-Atlantic 10 selection. Russo was chosen as an All-American by the Sports Network and the American Football Coaches Association as a senior in 1989 when he was also a first team all-conference and an All-ECAC selection. He was inducted to Villanova's Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2007.

Ferrante was a standout collegiate performer in his own right prior to joining the football coaching ranks. He was the quarterback for Andy Talley at St. Lawrence where he was named the 1982 Division III Player of the Year to go along with first team All-East honors. Ferrante directed the offense for a St. Lawrence team that went 10-1 during the 1982 season and reached the national semifinals in the playoffs.

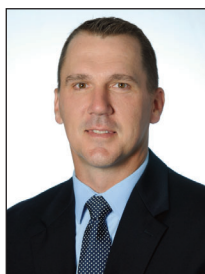

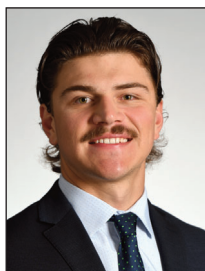
