TODAY'S GAME

- Villanova goes on the road for the second straight week and will play its first game ever against North Carolina A&T when the teams kick off at 4 p.m. on Saturday. The Aggies are in their first season as a member of CAA Football and are the only opponent on this season's regular season schedule that the Wildcats are facing for the first time.
- Villanova is coming off a 31-10 loss to UAlbany last week while North Carolina A&T posted a 28-26 win at Norfolk State.
- Over the last two weeks Villanova has converted 16-of-25 (64.0%) third down chances, including 8-of-13 in the game at UAlbany last week. This is an improvement from the first three games of the season when the Wildcats converted just 24.2% of their third down opportunities (8-of-33).
- Sophomore wide receiver **Jaylan Sanchez** scored his first careet touchdown in the game at UAlbany last week and is currently the FCS leader with an average of 26.7 yards per reception on the season.

VILLANOVA NOTES

CATCHING UP WITH THE 'CATS

♦ Villanova is 3-2 on the season and 1-1 in CAA Football after being a dealt a 31-10 loss at UAlbany last week. This week marks the fourth road game in the first six contests of the year for the Wildcats, who have traveled to Lehigh, UCF and UAlbany so far this season.

ALL ABOUT THE AGGIES

- ◆ North Carolina A&T is in its first year as a member of CAA Football and will be playing its second-ever league game this Saturday. The Aggies are 1-3 on the season and are coming off their first win of the year on the road at Norfolk State, 28-26, last weekend.
- ♦ In their inaugural game as a CAA Football member the Aggies lost on the road to Elon, 27-3, on September 16. North Carolina A&T is the only opponent on this year's Villanova schedule that the Wildcats have never faced.

MOVING THE STICKS

- ♦ In the past two games against Rhode Island and UAlbany, the Wildcats are a combined 16/25 (64%) in converting on third down. Those numbers include a season-best 8/12 third down conversion rate against Rhode Island two weeks ago and a similar 8/13 rate last week versus the Great Danes.
- ◆ The trend is an encouraging one for Villanova, which began the season just 8/33 (24%) on third down through its first three games. The Wildcats are now up to a 41.4% (24/58) conversion rate on third down for the season which is ranked sixth in CAA Football and 35th nationally out of 122 FCS programs.

FIVE YEARS OF SUCCESS

• Over the last five seasons (2019-23) the Wildcats own the best overall record among the current CAA Football teams. Villanova has gone 30-15 (.667) since the start of the 2019 season and won its most recent CAA title in 2021.

♦ Villanova also has the second-best record among CAA Football teams over the last 10 seasons (2014-23), going 66-39 (.629) since the start of the 2014 campaign.

THAT'S UNCHARACTERISTIC

- ♦ Villanova's game at UAlbany last week was marked by the Wildcats committing five turnovers and being sacked seven times. It was the first time Villanova committed five turnovers in a game in a span of 115 games since September 7, 2013 in a 27-24 loss to Fordham
- ♦ It had been nearly the exact same number of games since the Wildcats were sacked seven times in a contest. That had last happened 109 games ago on November 2, 2013 in a 31-21 loss at James Madison.

VILLANOVA NOTES

BEYOND THE NUMBERS

- ◆ Last week's official stats from the UAlbany game had Villanova with a season-low total of 71 rushing yards on 29 carries (2.4 yards per carry) while the Great Danes were credited with 33 carries for 116 yards (3.5 yards per carry). Those numbers were heavily influenced by sacks however, including seven sacks recorded by the UAlbany defense.
- ♦ When taking out the sack-adjusted rushing yards, the totals from last week's game were Villanova with 22 rushes for 127 yards (5.8 yards per carry) and the Great Danes with 31 carries for 134 yards (4.3 yards per carry).

'CATS ON THE RUN

- ♦ Villanova's leading rusher in last week's game was fifth year running back **DeeWil Barlee** who carried nine times for 71 yards and averaged 7.9 yards per carry. During the game Barlee surpassed 1,900 career rushing yards and upped his career total to 1,938 yards. He enters play at North Carolina A&T this week needing 62 rushing yards to become the 12th player in school history to reach 2,000 career yards.
- ♦ Fifth year running back **TD Ayo-Durojaiye** moved up one spot in school history into 27th place on the Wildcats list of career rushing leaders last week. He carried six times for 29 yards in the UAlbany game and now has 1,369 career rushing yards to his credit. Ayo-Durojaiye passed *Angelo Babbaro* (2007-10) last week and is now just 29 yards behind *Austin Medley* (2011-14) for 26th place.

VILLANOVA NOTES

FIRST CAREER TOUCHDOWN FOR SANCHEZ

- ♦ It was only a matter of time before sophomore wide receiver **Jaylan Sanchez** was going to score his first career touchdown and it happened last week when he made a leaping grab over a defender for a 17-yard touchdown reception in the UAlbany game. The play and ensuing PAT tied the score at 10-10 in the second quarter and wound up being the Wildcats lone touchdown of the game.
- ♦ Sanchez has been a vital part of the Villanova offense this season and has 10 catches for 267 yards and the one score on the year. He was the team's leading receiver in the UAlbany game with four catches for 50 yards and the touchdown.
- ♦ One of the factors in Sanchez' success this year has been his penchant for making big plays. Sanchez leads all FCS receivers (minimum 2 receptions per game) with his average of 26.7 yards per reception this season. He has three catches for 45 yards or longer, including receptions of 68 yards and 60 yards in the Colgate game on September 9. That was his first career 100-yard game, as Sanchez needed just the two big plays to amass a career-high 128 yards on the day.

A POWERFUL COMBINATION

- ◆ Fifth year wide receiver **Rayjuon Pringle** entered last week's game at UAlbany ranked number one in the FCS in yards per reception. He dropped down to second in this week's national statistical rankings, but only because he was passed by his own teammate in sophomore receiver **Jaylan Sanchez**. The pair are 1-2 in the nation in yards per reception, while fifth year quarterback **Connor Watkins** similarly leads the country in yards per completion.
- ♦ Sanchez has made 10 receptions for 267 yards (26.7 yards per catch) on the year while Pringle is leading the Wildcats with 12 receptions for 315 yards (26.3 yards per catch). The pair has combined for four of the five Villanova receiving touchdowns through the first five games of the season. Watkins is averaging an FCS-best 17.05 yards per completion on the year.

SIX CATCHES FOR HAYEK

♦ After missing the first two games of the season with an injury, fifth year wide receiver **Jaaron Hayek** has eased his way back into a full workload in recent weeks. He played 11 snaps in the game at UCF on September 16 and rounded into form against UAlbany last week with a season-high six catches for 35 yards. Hayek ranks seventh in school history in career receiving yards and has exactly 2,400 yards coming out of last week's game.

VILLANOVA NOTES

LOOKING DOWNFIELD

- ♦ Fifth year quarterback **Connor Watkins** was 17-of-31 through the air for 198 yards with a touchdown and two interceptions last week at UAlbany. Watkins continues to rank among the national leaders this season in multiple statistical categories. He is leading all FCS signal callers with an average of 17.05 yards per completion and ranks sixth nationally with 9.2 yards per pass attempt.
- ♦ Since the start of the 2022 season Watkins has recorded 22 pass completions of 40 yards or longer. That represents more than 12 percent (22 of 183) of his total number of completions since becoming the Wildcats starter under center. In 16 career starts, Watkins is 183-of-335 (54.5%) through the air for 2,995 yards with 21 touchdowns and 16 interceptions. Watkins' tally of long completions is as follows...

MORE ON WATKINS

- ♦ In the Colgate game, **Connor Watkins** recorded his first career game with at least two passing and rushing touchdowns in the same contest. He rushed 10 times for a net total of 15 yards and two scores to go along with his record-setting passing performance (8-of-11, 310 yards, 2 TD). The last Villanova quarterback with two or more passing and rushing touchdowns in a game was Daniel Smith who recorded three touchdown passes and two rushing touchdowns against Elon on November 6, 2021.
- ◆ In the game against Rhode Island, Watkins became the first Villanova quarterback with three rushing touchdowns in a game since John Robertson at UAlbany in 2015.

HERE'S THE KICKER

- ♦ Sixth year collegiate kicker **Matthew Mercurio** stayed perfect on the season in last week's game at UAlbany when he made his only PAT attempt to go along with kicking a 44-yard field goal that opened the scoring in the first quarter. Although it was only the second field goal made (and attempted) by Mercurio this season, the kick was his 12th career field goal of 40 yards or longer and his third in a Villanova uniform. Mercurio transferred to the Wildcats last season after playing for San Jose State as an undergraduate.
- ♦ In his two years at Villanova, Mercurio had made 12-of14 field goal attempts and is a perfect 54-of-54 on extra points. Including his seasons at San Jose State, Mercurio's career totals are 147-of-152 (96.7%) on PATs and 56-of-68 (82.4%) on field goals.

VILLANOVA NOTES

FANTASTIC FONDACARO

- ◆ Senior punter **Nathan Fondacaro** had touchbacks on both of his punts in the UAlbany game, including a 56-yarder in the second quarter. Fondacaro has 32 career punts of 50+yards, including seven this season and three in his past two games.
- ♦ After missing last season due to an injury, Fondacaro has returned strong this year and is averaging a career-best 44.1 yards per punt. He has punted 23 times overall with a long punt of 57 yards to go along with four touchbacks, three fair catches, three punts downed inside the 20-yard line and seven punts of 50 yards or longer. Fondacaro's average of 44.1 yards per punt ranks second in CAA Football and 15th nationally this season.

40...NOT 50...DEFINITELY NOT 60

- ♦ Villanova lost to UCF, 48-14, in its annual game against an FBS opponent. Despite the final outcome, the Wildcats maintained their streak of not allowing an opponent to score 50+ points in a game, as noted below.
- ◆ Villanova has gone 219 straight games without allowing an opponent to score 50 points. It last happened on October 2, 2004 when New Hampshire defeated the Wildcats, 51-40.
- ♦ Villanova has gone 1,009 straight games without allowing an opponent to score 60 points. It last happened on November 15, 1919 when Army West Point dealt the Wildcats a 62-0 defeat. Villanova has allowed 60 points in just six of its 1,192 games played all-time.
- ◆ Since becoming an FCS program in 1985, the Wildcats have played 26 games versus FBS foes and have given up 40 or more points in just six of those games.

RECORD-SETTING EFFICIENCY

- ♦ In the win over Colgate on September 9, fifth year quarterback **Connor Watkins** became the first player in Villanova history to throw for over 300 yards on fewer than 10 completions. Watkins was 8-of-11 through the air for 310 yards and two touchdowns while averaging an incredible 38.75 yards per completion in the 42-19 win.
- ♦ Watkins completed three passes of 60 yards or longer in the record-setting performance, with five of his passes going for 43 yards or longer. He threw a 67-yard touchdown pass to fifth year wide receiver **Rayjuon Pringle**, who also hauled in catches of 51 yard and 43 yards. Sophomore wide receiver **Jaylan Sanchez** recorded receptions of 68 yards and 60 yards.

- ◆ Prior to Watkins' performance versus Colgate the school record for fewest completions in a 300-yard game was more than double Villanova's eight pass completions against Colgate. During the 2019 season *Daniel Smith* threw for 378 yards on 17 completions (17-of-24, 378 yards, 5 TD) against Delaware.
- ♦ Watkins' average of 38.75 yards per completion in the Colgate game would have set the FCS record for a single game if he had enough completions to qualify for the NCAA minimum standard. The official record for an FCS game is 28.5 yards per completion (17 completions for 485 yards) by Kendrick Nord of Grambling against Alcorn on September 3, 1994.

STATISTICAL ODDITY

♦ Connor Watkins' longest pass in the game against Colgate was for 75 yards, but Villanova's longest reception in the game was for 68 yards. Midway through the second quarter the Wildcats had a 3rd-and-11 play from their own 24-yard line. Watkins looked short right to sophomore receiver Jaylan Sanchez, who caught the pass but eventually fumbled at the Colgate 10-yard line after a gain of 66 yards. Fifth year receiver Rayjuon Pringle recovered the loose ball at the 8-yard line and kept the play alive until he was brought down at the 1-yard line. Sanchez was credited with 68 yards and Pringle with seven yards.

ENTERING WITH EXPERIENCE

- ◆ Villanova has 19 players (out of 93) on its 2023 roster who are graduate students in their fifth or sixth years of playing college football. All 19 graduate students on the roster were listed as starters or reserves on the Wildcats depth chart to open the 2023 season.
- ◆ In all, the 93 players on the Villanova roster began the 2023 campaign with 1,064 career games played and 369 yards. The current tally for the players on the Wildcats roster is 1,328 career games played with 479 starts.

PRESEASON HONORS

- ◆ Wide receiver Jaaron Hayek and offensive lineman Michael Corbi were each named to the CAA Football Preseason All-Conference Team in a preseason poll of league head coaches. Hayek was a first team All-CAA selection last year and Corbi was a second team pick.
- In addition to the two preseason all-conference honorees, safety Jalen Goodman and kicker Matthew Mercurio garnered honorable mention preseason honors.

ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

NCAA ACADEMIC DATA

- Each year the NCAA recognizes programs that have a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranks within the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. Villanova has earned this award nine times in the 17-year history of the APR program.
- In the most recent APR data released in May 2023 the football program's multi-year APR score of 974 was 12 points above the national average for FCS programs.
- New data on the NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) was released in November 2022 and Villanova led all CAA Football schools with a new program record 96 percent GSR.

ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

■ One of the highest honors that a student-athlete can achieve is to be named an Academic All-American, an award which encompasses both academic achievement as well as contributions on the field. Villanova has had 12 football studentathletes earn a total of 14 Academic All-America honors over the years.

CAA TEAM ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

■ Villanova was the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for both the 2016-17 and the 2017-18 school years. The award is presented at the end of each academic year to the conference school with the highest team GPA.

CAA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

■ Villanova has had five student-athletes be named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Nominees for the award must have attained senior standing academically and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

CAA ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

■ Student-athletes with a semester GPA of 3.0 or higher are named to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll, Villanova had 62 honorees for the Fall 2022 semester and 63 student-athletes achieve this distinction for the Spring 2023 term.

ACADEMIC ALL-AREA TEAMS

■ In conjunction with the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, the sports information directors at the colleges and universities in the Philadelphia area (PhillySIDA) name an Academic All-Area team and a football Performer of the Year each season. In the 16 years of the Academic All-Area program, which started with the 2005-06 academic year, the football team has had a total of 56 selections to the Academic All-Area Team. In addition, the Wildcats have had five Performers of the Year.

VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE



Mark Ferrante is in his seventh season as the Villanova head coach in 2023 and he begins the season with a career record of 37-26 (.587), including 23 regular season CAA Football wins. He is in his 37th year overall with the Wildcats and previously spent 30 years as an assistant coach (1987-2016) on Andy Talley's staff. To date, Ferrante has been a part of 254 victories and all 14 of Villanova's FCS playoff appearances during his time on campus.

Ferrante was named the CAA Football Coach of the Year in 2021 and he has mentored four conference major award winners during his first six seasons as head coach. The honorees include two student-athletes who won the league's prestigious Chuck Boone Leadership and Excellence Award — Chucky Smith (2019) and Justin Covington (2020) — while a

pair of defensive standouts have been named the CAA Football Defensive Player of the Year (Forrest Rhyne; 2021) and the league's Defensive Rookie of the Year (Christian Benford; 2018). Rhyne and Benford have each gone on to play in the NFL. Villanova has earned a total of 42 CAA Football All-Conference selections during Ferrante's head coaching tenure, including 13 first team picks.

Outside of football the Wildcats student-athletes have continually excelled in their academic pursuits under Ferrante's watch. During the 2022-23 academic year, Villanova had 62 selections to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll during the Fall semester and 63 honorees on the Spring semester Honor Roll. There were also 51 student-athletes named to the Athletic Director's Honor Roll during the Fall and 53 selections for the Spring semester. Since Ferrante became head coach, the Wildcats have had a total of 544 CAA honor roll selections and 465 honorees on the Athletic Director's Honor Roll.

Each year the NCAA releases academic data for each Division I sport program's Academic Progress Rate (APR) and NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR). In the latest GSR data released in November 2022, the football program set a new record and topped all CAA schools with a 96 percent success rate. New APR data released in May 2023 showed Villanova with a multi-year score (974) that is 12 points above the national average for FCS football programs.

Ferrante and his Wildcats will enter the 2023 campaign on a high note after late heroics in the 2022 finale against Delaware led the team to its eighth winning record in the last 10 full seasons played. Villanova defeated the rival Blue Hens in the annual "Battle of the Blue" game to finish the season with a 6-5 overall record and a 4-4 mark in CAAA games. Wide receiver Jaaron Hayek was named to the CAA Football First Team Offense and was one of four All-CAA selections for the 2022 campaign.

The 2021 season was a breakthrough year for the Wildcats and Ferrante was the AFCA FCS Region 1 Coach of the Year, an honor which made him a finalist for National Coach of the Year consideration. Villanova posted a 10-3 record in 2021 and won a share of the CAA Football title while securing the league's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs. It is the second straight full season (2019, 2021) in which Ferrante guided the Wildcats to postseason play.

Villanova hosted two playoff games in 2021 and advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Division I Football Championship to finish the year ranked in the top-10 nationally (No. 8) in both FCS national polls for the first time since 2014. The Wildcats tallied their seventh season in program history with at least 10 wins and achieved success by playing – and beating – some of the top FCS teams in the nation. Villanova's 10-3 record included four victories over Top 25 opponents, including No. 3 James Madison, No. 18 Rhode Island, No. 21 Richmond and No. 24 Holy Cross. Ferrante led the Wildcats to a 7-1 record against a challenging CAA Football schedule to mark the fifth season since 1988 in which the team had no more than one loss in conference play.

There was star power in all facets of the game for Villanova during the 2021 season, with Ferrante coaching 11 players who had an opportunity to continue their football careers beyond the college ranks. The group included cornerback Christian Benford who was a sixth round draft pick of the Buffalo Bills. Fellow corner Denzel Williams signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Ravens and linebacker Forrest Rhyne was inked to a free agent contract by the Indianapolis Colts. Benford and Rhyne were consensus first team All-Americans in 2021, while offensive lineman Michael Corbi was also a 2021 All-America selection and was one of 13 Wildcats who were named to the CAA Football All-Conference teams.

Ferrante and the Wildcats made the most out of the opportunity to play four games in a shortened Spring 2021 season and use the experience gained from those games moving forward. The spring games were officially recognized as the 2020 season and Villanova tallied a 2-2 record in four contests against CAA foes, including road wins over Stony Brook and Maine. The abbreviated season had its share of highlights, with eight players chosen for the CAA Football All-Conference teams. Corbi, Rhyne and defensive lineman Malik Fisher were each named first team All-CAA selections.

Villanova came off a 2019 season in which it was ranked as high as No. 5 in the nation. Ferrante guided the Wildcats to a 9-4 record and the program's seventh FCS playoff berth in the previous 12 years in 2019. After being picked to finish ninth in CAA Football before the season the team raced out of the gates with a 6-0 record, including a 3-0 mark in league play by the midpoint of the season. Villanova had 10 players earn All-CAA accolades, including a trio of first team selections in Rhyne, offensive lineman Paul Grattan and punter Nathan Fondacaro.

Eight players have signed NFL free agent contracts since Ferrante became head coach, with the aforementioned Rhyne and Williams joining offensive tackle Brandon Hitner (LA Rams); safety Rob Rolle (Miami Dolphins); offensive lineman Ethan Greenidge (New Orleans Saints); defensive back Trey Johnson (Pittsburgh Steelers); defensive back Malik Reaves (Kansas City Chiefs); and linebacker Ed Shockley (Dallas Cowboys).

Ferrante leads one of the nation's elite FCS programs after playing an instrumental role in the Wildcats rise to national prominence. He has been a part of the coaching staff for all 14 of Villanova's appearances in the FCS playoffs, including the 2009 national championship season and a 2010 semifinal appearance while serving as the Assistant Head Coach on Andy Talley's staff. Ferrante has been a part of Villanova teams that have won seven CAA titles, three Lambert Meadowlands Cups and three ECAC Team of the Year awards.

Ferrante's success during his years as an assistant coach were recognized by others outside the Villanova program. At the end of the 2015 season he was named the FCS Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA). This award was first presented in 1997 and was created to honor assistant coaches who excel in community service, commitment to student-athletes and on-field coaching success.Ferrante was involved in all aspects of the

Villanova program during his time as an assistant on Andy Talley's staff. On the field he coached the offensive line for 27 seasons and developed a unit that was perennially one of the best in CAA Football. Over the years he coached three All-Americans, 11 All-East performers and 15 first team all-conference selections. The offensive line had 17 All-CAA selections in a nine-year span, including three-time first team honoree Ben Ijalana along with first team selections Brant Clouser (2010), Dan Shirey (2011) and Vince Kowalski (2014).

Two of Ferrante's players went on to be selected in the NFL Draft. Ijalana was a second round selection by the Indianapolis Colts in 2011 and Brad Seaton was picked in the seventh round by the Tennessee Titans in 2017. Ijalana was a two-time All-American (2009, 2010) and a three-time first team All-CAA selection during his collegiate career. Villanova reached the FCS playoffs in each of his last three seasons on the team, winning the 2009 national title and advancing to the semifinal round a year later. Seaton was a second team CAA Football All-Conference selection in 2016 when the offensive line enabled the Wildcats to average 206.3 rushing yards and 378.7 yards of total offense per game. Villanova ranked third in the CAA and 24th nationally in rushing offense in addition to ranking fourth in the league in total offense and fifth with a scoring average of 24.4 points per game.

The other All-Americans Ferrante mentored are Eamonn Allen (2001) and Bryan Russo (1989). Allen earned first team Associated Press All-America recognition in 2001 and was also a first team All-East and first team All-Atlantic 10 selection. Russo was chosen as an All-American by the Sports Network and the American Football Coaches Association as a senior in 1989 when he was also a first team all-conference and an All-ECAC selection. He was inducted to Villanova's Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2007.

Ferrante was a standout collegiate performer in his own right prior to joining the football coaching ranks. He was the quarterback for Andy Talley at St. Lawrence where he was named the 1982 Division III Player of the Year to go along with first team All-East honors. Ferrante directed the offense for a St. Lawrence team that went 10-1 during the 1982 season and reached the national semifinals in the playoffs.

Ferrante and his wife, Georgea, reside in Phoenixville, Pa. The couple has a son, Jimmy, who earned his undergraduate degree from Villanova in 2018.
