HEN TRACKS

- The Blue Hens close out the regular season at home as they host Villanova at Delaware Stadium. The contest is not only the annual Battle of the Blue but both teams will be playing for at least a share of the 2023 CAA Championship.
- * Saturday will be the 57th all-time meeting between the two programs and will mark the 25th-straight season that the two local rivals will meet on the gridiron. The Wildcats own a 33-22-1 series advantage and have won 11 of the past 12 matchups, but each of the last three meetings have been decided by eight points or less. Delaware's most recent win over Villanova came during the 2020-21 spring season, a 27-20 victory that clinched the CAA Championship for the Blue Hens.
- *A conference title is again at stake on Saturday as Delaware and Villanova are two of four teams tied atop the CAA standings with 6-1 conference records. Any teams that remain tied with just one loss after Saturday's games will be declared co-champions and a tiebreaker will determine the conference's automatic qualifier.
- · If Delaware beats Villanova and remains tied with UAlbany, the Blue Hens would claim the automatic bid by virtue of their win over the highest-placed common opponent - New Hampshire.
- If Delaware beats Villanova and remains tied with Richmond, the Spiders would claim the automatic bid by virtue of their win over the highest-placed common opponent - Elon.
- If Delaware beats Villanova and remains tied with both UAlbany and Richmond, the tiebreaker would come down to point differential in CAA games (21-point cap). Entering Saturday, Delaware is +97, UAlbany is +92 and Richmond is +58 in conference games this year.
- ** The Blue Hens are coming off a 45-7 win at Campbell on Saturday in the first ever meeting between the two teams. Ryan O'Connor finished 19-of-31 passing for 246 yards and four touchdowns. He connected twice on scoring plays to Joshua Youngblood and also threw touchdown passes to Jourdan Townsend and Braden Brose.
- Khalil Dawsey became the first Blue Hen since 2018 to have two interceptions in a game. He returned his first-guarter interception 100 yards for a touchdown to match the longest in program history.
- ** Following their convincing 45-7 win over Campbell, the Blue Hens moved up a couple of spots in the national rankings and now sit at No. 7 in the Stats Perform FCS Top 25 Poll and No. 6 in the AFCA Coaches Poll.
- Jourdan Townsend's 51-yard touchdown catch at Campbell was the 14th scoring grab of his career, tying him for 10th all-time in program history with Michael Johnson (2011-14) and Ron Withelder (1967-69). One more touchdown catch would move Townsend into a tie for sixth.
- With Delaware's 45-point showing at Campbell, the Blue Hens have now scored at least 40 points in five games this season and the offense has moved into the top 10 nationally in scoring offense, ranking ninth with 34.9

STARTING FAST

Delaware owns a 5-1 record since its bye week on September 30. In those five wins, the Blue Hens are outscoring their opponents 88-7 in the first quarter, including a 73-0 edge in the last four victories. UD has scored touchdowns on its first possession in each of its last four wins, including a 75-yard touchdown catch by Marcus Yarns on the first offensive play against Towson and a 51-yard scoring grab by Jourdan Townsend on the second play at Campbell.

RUN MARCUS RUN

Marcus Yarns is putting together one of the best seasons by a running back in the country, ranking third nationally with 17 total touchdowns and 14 rushing touchdowns as well as fourth with 7.49 yards per carry. Yarns has scored a touchdown in eight of Delaware's 10 games this year and multiple touchdowns in six games. His 14 rushing touchdowns are tied with Omar Cuff (2005) and Andrew Pierce (2007) for the 10th-most in a single season in UD history. He needs 251 more rushing yards to become the 20th player in program history to reach the 1,000 yards in a season.

DOMINANCE ON DEFENSE

The UD defense has been dominant in its nine games against FCS opponents this year, allowing just 14.6 points per game and just 60 second-half points. The Blue Hens have 19 takeaways on the season, including 12 interceptions, both of which rank in the top 15 nationally.

Delaware had a streak of 13-straight quarters and 210:41 of game time without allowing a touchdown from the second quarter against Duquesne (Oct. 7) until the fourth quarter against Towson (Oct. 28). UD only allowed field goals in the games against NC A&T and Hampton.

DEFENDING THE TUB

The Blue Hens are 10-2 at Delaware Stadium under head coach Ryan Carty, including a 4-1 mark this year. In its four home victories in 2023, Delaware is outscoring its opponents 33.8-15.5 and averaging nearly 430 yards of total offense per game. The UD defense has allowed just 10 second-half points and opponents are averaging just 110 yards of offense after halftime at Delaware Stadium.

TURNING YARNS INTO YARDS

Running back Marcus Yarns has proven to be a big playmaker out of the UD backfield. He has had long rushing and receiving plays in each of the first four games this season that have resulted in touchdowns. In 2022, Yarns had an 82-vard rush for a score against Delaware State and also caught a 76-yard catch-and-run for a touchdown versus Morgan State.

WHAT A DEBUT!

Quarterback Ryan O'Connor made his first-career start against Stony Brook and looked like a crafty veteran. The junior set career highs in pass attempts (38), completions (24) and passing yards (346), while completing passes to nine different receivers. He became the first Blue Hen to throw for more than 300 yards in a season opener since Trent Hurley in 2012.

PICK YOUR POISON

The Blue Hens had nine different receivers catch a pass in their season-opening win at Stony Brook on August 31. The quartet of Chandler Harvin (5 catches, 100 yards), Kym Wimberly (5, 81), Braden Brose (4, 75) and Jourdan Townsend (3, 46) combined for 17 catches and 302 yards.

WILLIAM V. CAMPBELL TROPHY SEMIFINALIST

Wide receiver Chandler Harvin has been named one of 201 semifinalists, across all divisions of college football, for the prestigious William V. Campbell Trophy. The trophy recognizes an individual as the absolute best in the country for his academic success, football performance and exemplary leadership. Harvin graduated cum laude from Sam Houston State in 2022 with a degree in accounting and a minor in finance. He is currently in his second year of pursuing a master's degree in accounting from Delaware.

NEW SIDE OF THE BALL, NO PROBLEM

Senior Fintan Brose was a defensive lineman when he began his career at Delaware and appeared in 13 games along the defensive front over his first two years. A two-way player in high school, the coaching staff switched him to the offensive line during 2022 spring practices. He quickly climbed the depth chart and started all 13 games in 2022, both at right guard and right tackle. He was rewarded with an All-CAA Third Team selection.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

The Blue & Gold will be led by a veteran group of defensive linemen Chase Mc-Gowan and Ethan Saunders, linebacker Dillon Trainer and offensive lineman Brock Gingrich. All are first-time captains but are no strangers to the field as they have combined to appear in 99 games during their UD careers. The four captains were chosen by a vote of their teammates and coaches.

TRANSFERS

There are plenty of new faces to learn this year as the Blue Hens brought in 45 newcomers ahead of the 2023 season, including 21 transfers from other institutions, that will look to make an immediate impact for the Blue & Gold. The list of transfers includes eight coming from other FCS programs, five out of FBS programs, a Division II All-American and a Division III All-American.

There are also four members of the team whose fathers also suited up for the Blue Hens. Quincy Watson (Rowan Watson), Sean Quick (Paul Quick), Jack Fileppo (John Fileppo) and Donovan Lewis (Marcus Lewis) are all continuing their family legacies at Delaware.

FAMILIAR FACES ON THE COACHING STAFF

12 members of the coaching staff came to Newark within the past two years. Despite so many new faces, two names are very recognizable to Blue Hen fans.

Head coach Ryan Carty donned the Blue & Gold from 2002-06 as a guarterback and was a part of the 2003 national championship team.

Assistant coach Andrew Pierce was one of the best running backs in program history, compiling 4,459 rushing yards from 2010-13 which still ranks second in program history.

1,000 AND COUNTING

Delaware will have a lot of talent lining up at wide receiver this season, with an unprecedented five receivers on the roster that enter the season with more than 1,000 career receiving

Jourdan Townsend - 1,001 yards; Delaware Kym Wimberly - 1,063 yards; Harvard Jalyn Witcher - 1,157 yards; Delaware/Presbyterian Chandler Harvin - 1,589 yards; Delaware/Sam Houston Phil Lutz - 2,256 yards; Tufts

AFCA GOODWORKS

Delaware offensive lineman Brock Gingrich has been named one of the nominees for the 2023 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team. Gingrich is one of 136 nominees across all divisions of college football. Established in 1992, the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team is one of the most coveted community service awards in college football. To be considered for a spot on the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team, each player must be actively involved with a charitable organization or service group while maintaining strong academic standing.

FLOODING THE TUB

Against Duquesne on October 7, a crowd of 18,952 fans watched Delaware's 43-17 win over the Dukes. It was the largest non-neutral crowd in all of the FCS that weekend and the largest Delaware Stadium crowd since 2018. The Blue Hens went 6-1 in the friendly confines of Delaware Stadium in 2022. During its six regular season home games, UD was one of four FCS schools to surpass 100,000 fans, achieving its highest total (101,410) since 2014. Delaware averaged 16,902 fans at home games, its highest average since 2013. The home contest against Towson on October 1 had a sellout crowd of 18,905.

PRESEASON POLLS

After returning to the postseason and advancing to the second round of the 2022 FCS Championship, the Blue Hens have received plenty of preseason recognition. Delaware received one first-place vote and 149 points overall to finish fourth in the CAA preseason poll.

In the national polls, the Blue & Gold were ranked No. 22 in the Stats Perform FCS Preseason Top 25 Poll and No. 21 in the AFCA Coaches FCS Preseason Poll. The Blue Hens also came in at No. 25 in the Athlon Sports' FCS Preseason Top 25 and were receiving votes in the HERO Sports Preseason Top 25 poll.

GAME-CHANGING FACILITIES

With phase one of the Delaware Stadium renovation project complete, the Blue Hens hold one of the finest facilities in all of Division I football, FBS included. The new Whitney Athletic Center holds a state-of-the-art weight room, nutrition center, academic center, athletic training center and much more. The building provides next-level resources for all Delaware student-athletes.

LIFTING THE LOMBARDI

A Blue Hen has lifted the Lombardi Trophy each of the last two years as members of the Super Bowl-winning team. UD alums Brett Veach (general managér), Matt Nagy (quarterbacks coach) and Joe Bleymaier (wide receivers coach) all helped lead the Kansas City Chiefs to Super Bowl LVII. It was Veach's second title as general manager of the Chiefs.

For Super Bowl LVI, Delaware was the only FCS program with two alums playing as Troy Reeder started at linebacker for the Los Angeles Rams and Zach Kerr suited up for the Cincinnati Bengals. Reeder became the fourth Blue Hen ever to win the Super Bowl as a player, joining Jamin Elliott (Patriots), Joe Flacco (Ravens) and Gino Gradkowski (Ravens).

Overall, 11 Blue Hens have played in a Super Bowl.

ROYAL COMPANY

The University of Delaware is one of just three institutions with an alumnus elected President (Biden), a Super Bowl MVP (Flacco), and an NFL MVP (Gannon), along with Stanford and Michigan.

NFL BLOODLINES

There are two members of this year's Delaware roster that are sons of former NFL players. Junior safety Keeno Arrington is the son of Penn State alum and College Football Hall of Famer LaVar Arrington. After a decorated college career, Arrington was selected second overall in the 2000 NFL Draft by Washington and he played for both the Redskins and New York Giants.

Graduate cornerback Jared Duncan is the son of Jamie Duncan, a Delawarean who was a two-time All-American at Vanderbilt and the 1997 SEC Defensive Player of the Year. He was a third-round draft pick in the 1998 NFL Draft by the Tampa Bay Buccaneers, playing seven years for the Bucs, St. Louis and Atlanta.


- Villanova enters Saturday's game ranked No. 10 in the Stats Perform FCS Top 25 Poll and No. 15 in the AFCA Coaches Poll. The Wildcats have an identical record as the Blue Hens, coming in at 8-2 overall and 6-1 in the CAA.
- The offense is averaging 32.3 ppg and 439.0 ypg of total offense, while the defense is allowing 18.7 ppg and a CAA-low 291.6 total yards to opponents.
- **Connor Watkins has passed for 2,110 yards and 17 touchdowns with eight interceptions on the season. He has also rushed for 258 yards and eight scores on the ground.
- √ Jalen Jackson leads the rushing attack with 87.9 yards per game and has scored six touchdowns, while DeeWil Barlee and TD Ayo-DuroJaiye have combined for 11 touchdowns.
- Rayjuon Pringle is second in the CAA with 89.1 receiving yards per game and has caught eight touchdown passes.
- **Brendan Bell leads the Villanova defense with 61 tackles and is tied for the team lead with 8.5 TFLs with Jake Reichwein who also has 4.0 sacks on the season.

HISTORY NOTES

- ** Saturday will be the 57th all-time meeting between the two programs and will mark the 25th-straight season that the two local rivals will meet on the gridiron.
- The Wildcats own a 33-22-1 series advantage and have won 11 of the past 12 matchups, but each of the last three meetings have been decided by eight points or less.
- **Delaware's most recent win over Villanova came during the 2020-21 spring season, a 27-20 victory that clinched the CAA Championship for the Blue Hens.
- *In last season's meeting at Villanova, Nolan Henderson set career highs in both completions and pass attempts, going 37-of-59 through the air for 347 yards and three touchdowns. Thyrick Pitts caught seven passes for 96 yards and two touchdowns, while Jourdan Townsend also has seven catches for 71 yards and a score.

HEAD COACH RYAN CARTY

A Delaware alum and member of the 2003 national championship team, Ryan Carty was named the head football coach in December 2021 by Director of Intercollegiate Athletics & Recreation Services, Chrissi Rawak. Carty spent the previous four seasons as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Sam Houston.

In his first season as head coach, Carty's explosive offense brought Delaware to the FCS playoffs with an 8-5 overall record and a 4-4 record in CAA play. Carty was the first Delaware head football coach to lead the team to the FCS playoffs in his inaugural season. The Blue Hens opened the season strong with a 14-7 win at Navy making the program's first win over a FBS school since 2007. UD had a total of 1,864 rushing yards in 2022 to rank fourth in the CAA and was second with 3,450 passing yards. Ten Blue Hens earned All-CAA awards, including Johnny Buchanan, Noah Plack and Kendrick Whitehead who were named to the All-CAA First Team. Quarterback Nolan Henderson was also named to the All-CAA Second Team. Delaware also had a pair of All-Americans in Johnny Buchanan (7x) and Kendrick Whitehead. Three Blue Hens signed UDFA contracts after the 2023 NFL Draft in Nolan Henderson (Ravens), Thyrick Pitts (Bears) and Kendrick Whitehead (Bucca-

Prior to being named the head coach at his alma mater, Carty spent four seasons as the offensive coordinator at Sam Houston State. Known for his explosive plays and high-energy offense, Carty was recognized for his offensive success in the spring 2021 season. Named the FCS Coordinator of the Year by FootballScoop.com and to Dave Campbell's Texas Football's "Top 40 Coaches Under 40" list, Carty played an instrumental part in Sam Houston winning the 2020 FCS National Championship as well as advancing to the 2021 FCS quarterfinals.

Carty's offense helped lead Sam Houston to a 34-10 record from 2018-21 and a 21-1 mark in his final two seasons the past two seasons in Huntsville. The Bearkats had an undefeated regular season in 2021 and advanced to

the FCS Quarterfinals. Sam Houston finished the season ranked third in the nation in scoring offense (41.0 ppg), fifth in total offense (490.9 ypg), and sixth in rushing offense (228.2 ypg).

During the Bearkats' undefeated 10-0 spring season, SHSU ranked first nationally in total yards (4,403), first in touchdowns (45), third in first downs (204), seventh in passing yards per attempt (8.6 ypa), eighth in passing yards per completion (14.3 ypc), ninth in scoring offense (38 ppg), 13th in total offense (440 ypg), and 13th in passing offense (282 ypg).

With a proven record as one of the top offensive coordinators and quarterbacks coaches in the nation, Carty coached SHSU quarterback and Walter Payton Award finalist Eric Schmid to Southland Conference Player of the Year honors on his way to leading the FCS in total passing yards in the

During his four-year stint with Sam Houston, the Bearkats advanced to the playoffs in back-to-back years and won two conference titles. Prior to his stop in Huntsville, Carty was very familiar with the Colonial Athletic Association after an 11-year run on the New Hampshire coaching staff, including six years as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach.

During Carty's stint at New Hampshire, the Wildcats qualified for the FCS playoffs in each of Carty's six seasons as offensive coordinator, compiling an 8-6 postseason record and reaching the semifinals in 2013 and 2014. The Wildcats garnered seven or more wins every season Carty was on staff. As the offensive coordinator, UNH quarterbacks combined for 18,656 Yards and 171 TDs in 80 contests with Carty leading the offense.

Carty, a team captain during his 2006 senior campaign, earned his bachelor's degree in management from Delaware in 2006.

A native of Branchburg, N.J., Carty and his wife, Katie, are happy to join the Blue Hen family
