TOWSON PLAYS FINAL ROAD GAME OF 2023 AT VILLANOVA

Towson will seek a perfect road record against FCS teams in 2023 on Saturday, Nov. 11, taking on #t13/18 Villanova at 1 p.m. in Philadelphia.

Both teams are coming off road victories. Towson defeated North Carolina A&T in Greensboro 42-32 last Saturday to stand at 4-5 overall and 3-3 in the CAA. Villanova, in a five-way tie for first in the CAA at 5-1 and 7-2 overall, has won its last four, coming off a 45-33 victory at New Hampshire. Villanova, which will have Senior Day on Saturday, is tied for 13th in the FCS Stats Poll and 18th in the AFCA Coaches Poll.

This will be the 18th all-time meeting between these two teams, with Villanova leading 11-6. The last four meetings have were split, with Towson winning 27-3 on Nov. 5, 2022.

This season, Towson is 4-1 in road games, with the only loss coming in the opener at (FBS) Maryland.

Football Information Credentials

Game Procedures

Press Box - Seating in the press box is limited to working media and Towson staff only. Space is limited and members of the media will be assigned seats. Spouses, dates, children and other non-workers are not permitted in working media areas in compliance with the working code of the Football Writers Association of America.

Photographers - Print and television photographers are allowed to shoot from both sidelines and both end zones, but are not allowed in the team bench areas. Failure to comply with this policy will result in the revocation of credentials.

Parking - A limited number of parking spaces are available for each home game. The media parking lot is located at the Osler Medical Center. Members of the media who cover Towson regularly will be issued parking passes prior to the start of the season. Visiting media members need to contact the TU media relations office to request parking and will need to give a timely request for the best chance at parking.

Daily Media Availability

Monday: Coach Shinnick will be available during the Zoom CAA Conference call. His weekly time slot is 12 p.m. Media members are encouraged to contact the CAA to get access to the Zoom call.

Tuesday-Friday: Coach Shinnick, assistant coaches and players will be available at either before or at the conclusion of practice at team's discretion. Requests will need to be in a timely manner to check availability of requested personnel and will be at the discretion of the Towson media relations department.

Sunday: No Availability.

Game Day Saturday: Postgame availability. Members of the Towson Athletics Media Relations staff will escort media representatives to the appropriate areas following the conclusion of the game. The Towson locker room, home and away, is closed to the media at all times.

Coach Shinnick and selected Tiger players will be brought to the designated interview area. At home games, that area is at the bottom of the Field House.

After a 10-minute cooling off period, the visiting team coaches and players will be available for interview first and only if requested by the media. After the visiting team finishes, Coach Shinnick and selected players will be available for interview.

At the midway point of the fourth quarter, interview requests will be collected.

Interviews after games on the road will be conducted based on the post-game policy of that institution. Towson personnel will be gathered by the Towson SID, not by any other person.

Practice Procedures

Covering Practice: Practices will be open for media and can be attended with permission by the Towson media relations department. Please contact Dave Vatz the day before with the requested personnel. Towson football personnel can be potentially made available outside of practice per request to the Towson media relations office.

Coach Shinnick reserves the right to close practice at any time. In addition, no video or photo shots can be taken that reveal a full formation.

A NEW ERA OF TOWSON FOOTBALL BEGINS IN 2023

It is a new year for Towson as the Tigers are set for their 54th season. It is also the first season for new head coach Pete Shinnick.

It is a new look Towson team with 43 new players joining in their first year with Towson, including 27 transfers and 16 true freshmen or first-year players. The offense returns six starters while the defense returns five.

GIBBS NAMED TO SHRINE BOWL 1000, REESE'S SENIOR BOWL WATCHLIST

Jesus Gibbs was selected to the 2024 Shrine Bowl 1000, being named one of the top NFL draft eligible college players in the country. The 1,000 players, selected by NFL scouts and college personnel, are in contention to play in the 2024 East-West Shrine Bowl in Texas. He was also selected to the Reese's Senior Bowl Watchlist for the second consecutive year.

In 32 games in his Towson career since transferring in from South Carolina, Gibbs stands with 100 total tackles, 22.5 tackles for loss and 11 sacks. Gibbs will look to be the second Towson player in the Shrine Bowl, with Tye Smith being the first in 2015.

TAKING DOWN THE CAA PRESEASON FAVORITES

In the early going of the Pete Shinnick era, Towson has already earned a pair of big wins, defeating the two 2022 CAA champions on the road. The Tigers won at then-#14/17 New Hampshire 54-51 (OT) and then-#13 William & Mary 34-24, the two teams predicted to finish first in the league in 2023.

This is the second year in a row where Towson defeated the CAA favorite in the preseason coaches poll. The 2022 CAA preseason favorite was Villanova; Towson won 27-3 on Nov. 5, 2022 at home.

THREE TIGERS RECOGNIZED IN 2023 CAA PRE-SEASON AWARDS

Three Tigers were recognized on the CAA preseason awards: D'Ago Hunter earned 2023 CAA Football Pre-season All-Conference Team at kick returner while Jesus Gibbs and Robert Javier were preseason all-conference honorable mention.

HUNTER HONORED AS STATS PERFORM PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN

D'Ago Hunter was recognized as a 2023 STATS Perform Preseason All-American Third Team as a punt returner.

Last season, Hunter became Towson's first All-American was 2018, amassing 1,207 all-purpose yards off 639 kickoff yards, 195 punt return yards, 262 rushing yards and 111 receiving yards, adding three special teams touchdowns of at least 74 yards each.

BATTLE FOR GREATER BALTIMORE SERIES EXTENDED THROUGH 2027

In July 2021, Towson and Morgan State announced an extension of the Battle for Greater Baltimore series through the 2027 season. The two teams will alternate hosting rights each year. The teams are separated by five miles, the closest pair of teams in all of FCS play.

Towson defeated Morgan State 20-10 in Baltimore on Sept. 16. Towson leads the all-time series 22-6, winning the last six.

TOWSON PICKED NINTH IN CAA PRESEASON POLL

TIGERS IN THE PROS

Towson made its mark in the Canadian Football League, with four former Towson players being part of CFL rosters in week one. Three players have competed in multiple games this season: Tibo Debaillie, Andrew Garnett and Tyrrell Pigrome.

In 2022, Darius Victor was the Offensive Player of the Year in the reformed United States Football League (USFL). He returned to the New Jersey Generals in 2023, finishing third in the league with 554 rushing yards, adding seven combined touchdowns. Two Towson players played in the XFL in 2023, including Tye Smith, who played five seasons in the National Football League.

On Oct. 23, 2023, it was announced that Caleb Smith will play for the Albany Firebirds in 2024 for the new Arena Football League.

PETE SHINNICK - NEW TOWSON HEAD COACH

On Dec. 11, 2022, Pete Shinnick was announced as the new head coach of Towson football. He is the fifth coach in program history.

Shinnick comes to Towson after starting the program at West Florida, leading the Argonauts to the 2019 NCAA DII national title and the 2017 NCAA DII title game. Including going 56-21 in six seasons at West Florida from 2016-22 (no season in 2020 COVID year), Shinnick has a career record of 163-72, including being the head coach at UNC Pembroke and Azusa Pacific.

Shinnick takes over for Rob Ambrose, who served as Towson's head coach from 2009-22. Towson has had five head coaches in program history: Carl Runk (1969-71), Phil Albert (1972-91), Gordy Combs (1992-2008), Ambrose (2009-22) and Pete Shinnick (2023-pres.).

--Sept. 10, 2011 (Towson, Md. - Towson 31-10):

Towson won its first home CAA game under coach Rob Ambrose with a 31-10 victory over #20 Villanova, shutting out the Wildcats in the first half with a 14-0 advantage and not trailing the rest of the way. It was Towson's first win against a ranked opponent since 2007.

--Oct. 27, 2012 (Villanova, Pa. - Towson 49-35):

Towson earned a game with 590 yards of total offense, breaking away in the third quarter to win 49-35 over Villanova, at the time tied for first place in the CAA. The Tigers had 321 rushing yards, including 144 yards and two touchdowns from Terrance West.

--Sept. 15, 2018 (Villanova, Md. - Towson 45-35)

Towson came back from down 14 early with 35 consecutive points for a 45-35 victory at #10 Villanova, its first win over a top-10 opponent since 2013. Tom Flacco had a second-straight 300+ yard passing game. After this win, Towson will be ranked for the first time since 2014 and will stay ranked the rest of the year.

RANDY BIELSKI ENTERS TOWSON ATHLETICS HALL OF FAME

Among the inductees into the Towson Athletics Hall of Fame Class of 2023 includes former defensive back and kicker Randy Bielski. He was inducted into the Hall of Fame on Oct. 6.

The two-time All-American left Towson with then-program records in tackles (288), interceptions (13) and scoring (169), playing from 1976-79. He led Towson to the 1976 Stagg Bowl for an NCAA DIII national title game appearance.

He was the first-ever Towson Tiger to be drafted into the National Football League, being taken as a kicker in the 12th round by the Baltimore Colts in 1980.

CAA FOOTBALL SHAKEUP

CAA Football has undergone changes for the 2023 season, beginning with a new name. The CAA is now the Coastal Athletic Association, officially changing its name on July 20, formerly the Colonial Athletic Association.

CAA Football also welcomed in two new members: Campbell, which joined as a full member this year, and North Carolina A&T, which was a full member last season but joins the CAA Football ranks this year. The CAA now has 15 football members. A 16th, Bryant, will join in the 2024 season.

Wide receiver Sam Reynolds will be on the sideline Saturday after having a general medical condition on Aug. 15. The redshirt sophomore played all 11 games last season.

Towson University Head Coach Pete Shinnick

1st Season as Head Coach

2017, 2019 DII National Coach of the Year



Baltimore native Pete Shinnick, who guided the University of West Florida (UWF) to a Division II national championship in 2019 and playoff appearances in four of the last five seasons played, was named Towson University's head football coach on December 11, 2022.

The son of former Baltimore Colts linebacker Don Shinnick, Pete Shinnick is 159-67 (.704 winning percentage) all-time as a college head coach, spanning 20 seasons with stops at West Florida, UNC Pembroke and Azusa Pacific. He has earned Division II National Coach of the Year twice and is Towson's fifth head coach in its history.

Shinnick came to West Florida in 2014 as the school's first football head coach. Two years later, the Argonauts won five games in their inaugural season. In 2017, the Argos went 11-4 and advanced to the national championship game in just their second season of competition. Shinnick earned the first of two National Coach of the Year awards.

Two years later, UWF went 13-2 and defeated three number one seeds and four-consecutive undefeated teams to win the national title. Shinnick was named the National Coach of the Year for the second time in three seasons while quarterback Austin Reed earned National Freshman of the Year honors after throwing for 4,089 yards and 40 touchdowns. After not playing in 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic, West Florida earned playoff berths the last two seasons. The Argos went 12-2 in 2022, losing in the national semifinals to Ferris State Saturday afternoon. His overall record at UWF was 56-21.

Shinnick was hired at UNC Pembroke in 2006 to bring football back to the university after an absence of more than 50 years. He built the Braves into a nationally ranked Division II team and finished with a 50-24 record over seven seasons (2007-13). The 2013 squad was ranked as high as No. 8 in the American Football Coaches Association national poll.

Shinnick's first head coaching position was at Azusa Pacific (1999-2005). In seven years, his teams were 53-22 and advanced to two national NAIA semifinals. Azusa Pacific set a total of 77 school records under his watch as the Cougars appeared in the NAIA top 25 rankings 48 consecutive times and 75 out of 86 weeks during his tenure.

Shinnick began his coaching career at Richmond in 1988 and had stops at Arkansas (1989), Clemson (1990-91), Oregon State (1992-93), Northern Michigan (1994), St. Cloud State (1995-97) and Humboldt State (1998). He graduated with a bachelor's degree in business from the University of Colorado in 1988. Shinnick appeared in 21 games for Buffaloes as an offensive lineman, including the 1985 Freedom Bowl and the 1986 Bluebonnet Bowl. He earned his master's degree in guidance and counseling from Clemson in 1992.

Pete Shinnick was born in 1965, at Baltimore's MedStar Union Memorial Hospital. His father, Don Shinnick, played 13 seasons at linebacker for the Baltimore Colts (1957-69). The elder Shinnick helped the Colts to the 1958 and 1959 NFL championships and played in Super Bowl III.

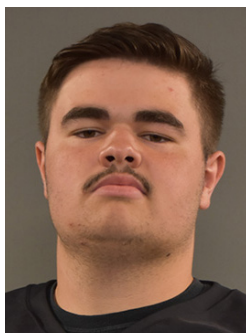
