### **TODAY'S GAME**

- Villanova (7-2, 5-1 CAA Football) plays its final home game of the regular season on Saturday afternoon when it hosts Towson (4-5, 3-3 CAA Football) for a 1 p.m. kickoff at Villanova Stadium. It is Senior Day on Saturday and the Wildcats will honor their graduating class of student-athletes in a ceremony prior to the start of the game. Additionally, the seniors from the band and spirit squads will be recognized on the field at halftime. Saturday's game can be seen live on FloFootball, while the radio call can be heard on the iHeart radio app.
- Senior linebacker **Brendan Bell** was named the CAA Football Co-Defensive Player of the Week on Monday after he had a monster game at New Hampshire. In the 45-33 win, Bell had a career-high 14 tackles to go along with the first interception and first forced fumble of his career.
- Villanova has scored 45 or more points in consecutive conference games in the last two weeks. It is the first time the Wildcats have done this since October 16 and 23, 1999 against Connecticut and Northeastern.

### **VILLANOVA NOTES**

### CATCHING UP WITH THE 'CATS

♦ Villanova has won four straight games and is coming off a 45-33 road win at New Hampshire last week. That victory was the first over UNH since the 2009 playoffs and Villanova's first win in Durham since 2003. During the four-game win streak the Wildcats have an average margin of victory of 23.8 points per game. The streak began with a 37-14 win at North Carolina A&T on October 7, followed by home wins over Elon on October 14 (21-0) and Stony Brook on October 28 (48-13).

### **TOWSON SERIES**

 Villanova leads the all-time series against Towson by a 10-7 margin. The teams faced each other for the first time in 2004 when the Tigers joined what was then the Atlantic 10 Conference. In the years since, the Wildcats have gone 5-3 against Towson at home and 5-4 in road games at Johnny Unitas Stadium in Maryland. Villanova's last win over the Tigers was a 52-45 overtime classic in 2019 when Towson was ranked No. 5 in the country. The most recent matchup in the series was last season when the Wildcats traveled to Towson and suffered a 27-3 setback.

### POLLING PLACES

 Villanova's four-game winning streak has taken it from an unranked team in the national polls to a top-20 squad in both the Stats Perform FCS Top 25 and the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll. In this week's rankings the Wildcats moved up four spots in the Stats poll into a tie for No. 13 along with Florida A&M. Villanova is also ranked No. 18 in the AFCA poll, four spots higher than last week.

### CROWDED AT THE TOP

• Entering play this week there is a five-way tie for first place in the CAA Football standings. Villanova, Delaware, Elon, Richmond and UAlbany are all sporting a 5-1 record in conference play with two weeks remaining in the regular season. Adding intrigue to the large mix of teams are two games within the maelstrom over the next two weeks. Richmond plays host to Elon this week, while Villanova travels to Delaware to end the regular season next week.

### FLIPPING THE SCRIPT

◆ Despite the fact that Villanova and New Hampshire have been conference foes since VU joined what was then the Yankee Conference in 1988, the teams faced each other last weekend for only the third time in the last 10 seasons. Villanova snapped a string of five straight losses to its mascot namesakes with last week's 45-33 win, its first over UNH since a 46-7 victory in the quarterfinal round of the FCS playoffs. Villanova also won on the road against New Hampshire for the first time since a 48-14 win in 2003. VU lost five straight games in Durham in 2005, 2009, 2011, 2013 and 2019.

### **FIVE YEARS OF SUCCESS**

◆ Over the last five seasons (2019-23) the Wildcats own the best overall winning percentage among the current CAA Football teams. Villanova has gone 34-16 (.680) in 50 games played since the start of the 2019 campaign and won its most recent CAA title in 2021. Only the Wildcats along with Monmouth and Delaware have posted a winning percentage above .600 among conference teams in the past five seasons.

♦ Villanova also has the second-highest winning percentage among CAA Football teams over the last 10 seasons (2014-23), going 70-40 (.636) since the start of the 2014 campaign and making FCS playoff appearances in 2014, 2016, 2019 and 2021.

### SECOND WEEKLY HONOR FOR BELL

♦ Senior linebacker **Brendan Bell** was recognized as the CAA Football Co-Defensive Player of the Week for the second time this season when this week's honors were announced on Monday afternoon. Bell is coming off a monster game against New Hampshire where he had a career-high 14 tackles in a 45-33 win. The stat line for Bell last week included eight solo tackles and six assisted stops. He also recorded the first interception and first forced fumble of his career to go along with a pass breakup. The forced fumble in the second quarter led to a Villanova touchdown which tied the score at 10-10.

### **CAA WEEKLY HONORS**

♦ Brendan Bell is one of three Wildcats who have earned CAA Football weekly awards this season. He has been the league's Co-Defensive Player of the Week on September 25 and again this week (November 6). Fifth year quarterback Connor Watkins was named the Co-Offensive Player of the Week on October 30 and freshman running back Isaiah Ragland garnered Rookie of the Week accolades on October 16.

### **DECIDED BY DEFENSE**

♦ Although the 33 points allowed to New Hampshire last week are the most given up by Villanova in a victory since a 52-45 win at Towson in 2019, the turning point in the win over UNH was a number of big plays made by the Wildcats defense. Villanova forced a season-high four turnovers in the victory, including three interceptions by UNH quarterback Max Brosmer who began the day leading the FCS in passing yards and total offense per game. The four turnovers equaled the number that Villanova had forced in the previous seven games combined. It was also the first time since the Rhode Island game on September 23 that the Wildcats won the turnover battle.

### VILLANOVA NOTES

### **LEADING THE WAY**

♦ The strong defensive performance by Villanova last week included senior linebacker **Brendan Bell**, sophomore linebacker **Shane Hartzell** and sophomore safety **Christian Sapp** all recording interceptions. Bell also forced a fumble which fifth year safety **Elijah Glover** returned 40 yards to the six-yard line to set up a Wildcats touchdown. The trio of Bell (14), senior safety **Ty Trinh** (12) and Hartzell (10) all reached double figures in tackles on the day. The 40-yard fumble return by Glover was the longest for Villanova since Jaquan Amos had a 99-yard return for a touchdown against Maine on October 7, 2017.

### **MORE DEFENSIVE DOINGS**

♦ Villanova enters play this week leading CAA Football and ranked 12th in the country in fewest first downs allowed (144, 16.0 per game). The Wildcats also rank second in the conference in both rushing defense (102.0) and total defense (298.3) through nine games played. Villanova ranks 12th nationally in total defense and 13th in rushing defense. VU has allowed fewer than 100 rushing yards five times in nine games played. In fact, taking out a 251-yard rushing performance by FBS and Big 12 member UCF on September 16, the Wildcats rushing defense in its eight other games is just 83.4 yards per contest.

### ON THE GROUND AND IN THE AIR

♦ For the first time this season and only the 36th time in school history, the Wildcats had both a 100+ yard rushing performance and a 100+ yard receiving performance in the same game last week. Sixth year running back **Jalen Jackson** rushed for 145 yards on 19 carries against New Hampshire and fifth year wide receiver **Rayjuon Pringle** tallied four receptions for 104 yards. The last time Villanova had such a game was last season on October 22 against UAlbany when Pringle had 143 receiving yards and **TD Ayo-Durojaiye** rushed for 136 yards.

### MARKING MILESTONES

♦ Sixth year running back **Jalen Jackson** and fifth year wide receiver **Rayjuon Pringle** moved into the top 10 in school history in career rushing yards and career receiving yards, respectively, last week. Jackson currently ranks 10th in career rushing with 2,185 yards while Pringle is ninth in career receiving with 2,264 yards. Villanova has a total of five active players who are ranked in the top 25 in school history in career rushing or receiving yards.

### MOVING THE STICKS

◆ Villanova ranks second in CAA Football and 15th nationally in third down conversions with a rate of 45.3 percent (48-of-106). That is a strong number, but in recent weeks VU has been even more impressive on third down. In the first three games of the season the Wildcats were just 24.2 percent (8-of-33) on third down. In six games since then, Villanova has gone 40-of-73 (54.8%) on third down, including 5-of-10 against New Hampshire last week.

### **VILLANOVA NOTES**

### PUT THE WHISTLE (AND THE LOSSES) AWAY

♦ Villanova has won four straight games and there has been a common theme in those contests: in each of the four games the Wildcats have been whistled for fewer penalties than their opponent. Since the start of last season, Villanova is 8-0 against FCS competition when it commits fewer penalties than its opponent.

### MAKING BIG PLAYS

- ♦ Villanova has recorded 52 plays from scrimmage of 20 yards or longer this season. That total includes 33 pass plays for 20+ yards and 19 rushes for 20 yards or longer. It comes out to an average of 5.8 offensive plays per game which go for at least 20 yards. Of particular note, Villanova has 14 pass completions on the year for 40 yards or longer. The most recent of those came last week when fifth year quarterback **Connor Watkins** and fifth year wide receiver **Rayjuon Pringle** connected on a 68-yard touchdown pass in the fourth quarter against New Hampshire.
- ♦ Connor Watkins has 13 pass completions of 40 yards or longer this season and he is the first quarterback in school history to throw three passes of at least 75 yards in the same year. Below is the breakdown of the big plays that Watkins has made during his career. Since he became the starter under center at the beginning of the 2022 season, Watkins is 13-7 (.650) as a starter and has thrown more than 12 percent of his total completions (28 of 230) for 40 yards or longer.

### **CENTURY MARK RECEIVERS**

- ♦ For only the second time in school history Villanova had three players top 100 receiving yards in the same game during the October 28 win over Stony Brook. The trio of **Rayjuon Pringle**, **Jaylan Sanchez** and **Jaaron Hayek** all had over 100 yards as the Wildcats amassed 398 yards through the air in a 48-13 victory. Pringle had five catches for 196 yards and a touchdown, Sanchez made four catches for 103 yards and a score, and Hayek recorded five catches for 102 yards and two touchdowns. It was the 10th career game with over 100 yards for Hayek which is tied for the third most in school history.
- ◆ The only previous Villanova game in which three players topped 100 receiving yards was on November 18, 2000 in a 59-42 loss to Delaware. The trio of 100-yard receivers on that day included **Brian White** (126), **Brian Westbrook** (116) and **Steve Ward** (100).

### VILLANOVA NOTES

### THE T-D STANDS FOR TOUCHDOWN

♦ Fifth year running back **TD Ayo-Durojaiye** accounted for the only offensive points of the game against Elon as he rushed for a career-high three touchdowns. Somewhat incredibly, Ayo-Durojaiye was only the Wildcats fourth-leading rusher in the game despite carrying the ball 11 times for 78 yards and the three scores. He tallied the first points of the game on his first offensive snap of the day when he scampered for a one-yard touchdown at the 9:24 mark of the first quarter. Less than four minutes later he broke away from midfield and galloped for a 50-yard coring run. The third touchdown was another one-yard play at 7:02 of the third quarter.

### **TWO FOR 125**

♦ The game against Elon was the 29th time in school history that Villanova had two or more players rush for 100 yards or more in a single game. However, it was only the third time ever that the Wildcats had two players rush for at least 125 yards in the same contest. Freshman running back Isaiah Ragland (126 yards) and fifth year quarterback Connor Watkins (125 yards) became the first Villanova teammates to rush for at least 125 yards in the same game since *Vince Thompson* (162) and *Pat O'Brien* (146) did so against West Virginia on October 29, 1977.

### FRESHMAN FEATS

♦ First year running back **Isaiah Ragland** is only the sixth true freshman in Villanova history to rush for at least 125 yards in a single game. The last to do it is his current teammate, fifth year running back **DeeWil Barlee**, who ran for 131 yards against Stony Brook during his freshman season in 2019.

### RECORD-SETTING EFFICIENCY

- ♦ In the win over Colgate on September 9, fifth year quarterback Connor Watkins became the first player in Villanova history to throw for over 300 yards on fewer than 10 completions. Watkins was 8-of-11 through the air for 310 yards and two touchdowns while averaging an incredible 38.75 yards per completion in the 42-19 win.
- ♦ Watkins completed three passes of 60 yards or longer in the recordsetting performance, with five of his passes going for 43 yards or longer. He threw a 67-yard touchdown pass to fifth year wide receiver **Rayjuon Pringle**, who also hauled in catches of 51 yard and 43 yards. Sophomore wide receiver **Jaylan Sanchez** recorded receptions of 68 yards and 60 yards.
- ◆ Prior to Watkins' performance versus Colgate the school record for fewest completions in a 300-yard game was more than double Villanova's eight pass completions against Colgate. During the 2019 season *Daniel Smith* threw for 378 yards on 17 completions (17-of-24, 378 yards, 5 TD) against Delaware.
- ♦ Watkins' average of 38.75 yards per completion in the Colgate game would have set the FCS record for a single game if he had enough completions to qualify for the NCAA minimum standard. The official record for an FCS game is 28.5 yards per completion (17 completions for 485 yards) by Kendrick Nord of Grambling against Alcorn on September 3, 1994.

### STATISTICAL ODDITY

♦ Connor Watkins' longest pass in the game against Colgate was for 75 yards, but Villanova's longest reception in the game was for 68 yards. Midway through the second quarter the Wildcats had a 3rd-and-11 play from their own 24-yard line. Watkins looked short right to sophomore receiver Jaylan Sanchez, who caught the pass but eventually fumbled at the Colgate 10-yard line after a gain of 66 yards. Fifth year receiver Rayjuon Pringle recovered the loose ball at the 8-yard line and kept the play alive until he was brought down at the 1-yard line. Sanchez was credited with 68 yards and Pringle with seven yards.

### **ENTERING WITH EXPERIENCE**

- ◆ Villanova has 19 players (out of 93) on its 2023 roster who are graduate students in their fifth or sixth years of playing college football. All 19 graduate students on the roster were listed as starters or reserves on the Wildcats depth chart to open the 2023 season.
- ◆ In all, the 93 players on the Villanova roster began the 2023 campaign with 1,111 career games played and 369 yards. The current tally for the players on the Wildcats roster is 1,494 career games played with 567 starts.

### PRESEASON HONORS

- Wide receiver Jaaron Hayek and offensive lineman Michael Corbi were each named to the CAA Football Preseason All-Conference Team in a preseason poll of league head coaches. Hayek was a first team All-CAA selection last year and Corbi was a second team pick.
- ◆ In addition to the two preseason all-conference honorees, safety Jalen Goodman and kicker Matthew Mercurio garnered honorable mention preseason honors.

### **ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS**

### NCAA ACADEMIC DATA

- Each year the NCAA recognizes programs that have a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranks within the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. Villanova has earned this award nine times in the 17-year history of the APR program.
- In the most recent APR data released in May 2023 the football program's multi-year APR score of 974 was 12 points above the national average for FCS programs.
- New data on the NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) was released in November 2022 and Villanova led all CAA Football schools with a new program record 96 percent GSR.

### ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

■ One of the highest honors that a student-athlete can achieve is to be named an Academic All-American, an award which encompasses both academic achievement as well as contributions on the field. Villanova has had 12 football student-athletes earn a total of 14 Academic All-America honors over the years.

### CAA TEAM ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

■ Villanova was the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for both the 2016-17 and the 2017-18 school years. The award is presented at the end of each academic year to the conference school with the highest team GPA.

### CAA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

■ Villanova has had five student-athletes be named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Nominees for the award must have attained senior standing academically and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

### **CAA ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL**

■ Student-athletes with a semester GPA of 3.0 or higher are named to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll. Villanova had 62 honorees for the Fall 2022 semester and 63 student-athletes achieve this distinction for the Spring 2023 term.

### ACADEMIC ALL-AREA TEAMS

■ In conjunction with the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, the sports information directors at the colleges and universities in the Philadelphia area (PhillySIDA) name an Academic All-Area team and a football Performer of the Year each season. In the 16 years of the Academic All-Area program, which started with the 2005-06 academic year, the football team has had a total of 56 selections to the Academic All-Area Team. In addition, the Wildcats have had five Performers of the Year.

### VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE



Mark Ferrante is in his seventh season as the Villanova head coach in 2023 and he begins the season with a career record of 37-26 (.587), including 23 regular season CAA Football wins. He is in his 37th year overall with the Wildcats and previously spent 30 years as an assistant coach (1987-2016) on Andy Talley's staff. To date, Ferrante has been a part of 254 victories and all 14 of Villanova's FCS playoff appearances during his time on campus.

Ferrante was named the CAA Football Coach of the Year in 2021 and he has mentored four conference major award winners during his first six seasons as head coach. The honorees include two student-athletes who won the league's prestigious Chuck Boone Leadership and Excellence Award — Chucky Smith (2019) and Justin Covington (2020) — while a

pair of defensive standouts have been named the CAA Football Defensive Player of the Year (Forrest Rhyne; 2021) and the league's Defensive Rookie of the Year (Christian Benford; 2018). Rhyne and Benford have each gone on to play in the NFL. Villanova has earned a total of 42 CAA Football All-Conference selections during Ferrante's head coaching tenure, including 13 first team picks.

Outside of football the Wildcats student-athletes have continually excelled in their academic pursuits under Ferrante's watch. During the 2022-23 academic year, Villanova had 62 selections to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll during the Fall semester and 63 honorees on the Spring semester Honor Roll. There were also 51 student-athletes named to the Athletic Director's Honor Roll during the Fall and 53 selections for the Spring semester. Since Ferrante became head coach, the Wildcats have had a total of 544 CAA honor roll selections and 465 honorees on the Athletic Director's Honor Roll.

Each year the NCAA releases academic data for each Division I sport program's Academic Progress Rate (APR) and NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR). In the latest GSR data released in November 2022, the football program set a new record and topped all CAA schools with a 96 percent success rate. New APR data released in May 2023 showed Villanova with a multi-year score (974) that is 12 points above the national average for FCS football programs.

Ferrante and his Wildcats will enter the 2023 campaign on a high note after late heroics in the 2022 finale against Delaware led the team to its eighth winning record in the last 10 full seasons played. Villanova defeated the rival Blue Hens in the annual "Battle of the Blue" game to finish the season with a 6-5 overall record and a 4-4 mark in CAAA games. Wide receiver Jaaron Hayek was named to the CAA Football First Team Offense and was one of four All-CAA selections for the 2022 campaign.

The 2021 season was a breakthrough year for the Wildcats and Ferrante was the AFCA FCS Region 1 Coach of the Year, an honor which made him a finalist for National Coach of the Year consideration. Villanova posted a 10-3 record in 2021 and won a share of the CAA Football title while securing the league's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs. It is the second straight full season (2019, 2021) in which Ferrante guided the Wildcats to postseason play.

Villanova hosted two playoff games in 2021 and advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Division I Football Championship to finish the year ranked in the top-10 nationally (No. 8) in both FCS national polls for the first time since 2014. The Wildcats tallied their seventh season in program history with at least 10 wins and achieved success by playing – and beating – some of the top FCS teams in the nation. Villanova's 10-3 record included four victories over Top 25 opponents, including No. 3 James Madison, No. 18 Rhode Island, No. 21 Richmond and No. 24 Holy Cross. Ferrante led the Wildcats to a 7-1 record against a challenging CAA Football schedule to mark the fifth season since 1988 in which the team had no more than one loss in conference play.

There was star power in all facets of the game for Villanova during the 2021 season, with Ferrante coaching 11 players who had an opportunity to continue their football careers beyond the college ranks. The group included cornerback Christian Benford who was a sixth round draft pick of the Buffalo Bills. Fellow corner Denzel Williams signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Ravens and linebacker Forrest Rhyne was inked to a free agent contract by the Indianapolis Colts. Benford and Rhyne were consensus first team All-Americans in 2021, while offensive lineman Michael Corbi was also a 2021 All-America selection and was one of 13 Wildcats who were named to the CAA Football All-Conference teams.

### MARK FERRANTE / VILLANOVA COACHING STAFF

Ferrante and the Wildcats made the most out of the opportunity to play four games in a shortened Spring 2021 season and use the experience gained from those games moving forward. The spring games were officially recognized as the 2020 season and Villanova tallied a 2-2 record in four contests against CAA foes, including road wins over Stony Brook and Maine. The abbreviated season had its share of highlights, with eight players chosen for the CAA Football All-Conference teams. Corbi, Rhyne and defensive lineman Malik Fisher were each named first team All-CAA selections.

Villanova came off a 2019 season in which it was ranked as high as No. 5 in the nation. Ferrante guided the Wildcats to a 9-4 record and the program's seventh FCS playoff berth in the previous 12 years in 2019. After being picked to finish ninth in CAA Football before the season the team raced out of the gates with a 6-0 record, including a 3-0 mark in league play by the midpoint of the season. Villanova had 10 players earn All-CAA accolades, including a trio of first team selections in Rhyne, offensive lineman Paul Grattan and punter Nathan Fondacaro.

Eight players have signed NFL free agent contracts since Ferrante became head coach, with the aforementioned Rhyne and Williams joining offensive tackle Brandon Hitner (LA Rams); safety Rob Rolle (Miami Dolphins); offensive lineman Ethan Greenidge (New Orleans Saints); defensive back Trey Johnson (Pittsburgh Steelers); defensive back Malik Reaves (Kansas City Chiefs); and linebacker Ed Shockley (Dallas Cowboys).

Ferrante leads one of the nation's elite FCS programs after playing an instrumental role in the Wildcats rise to national prominence. He has been a part of the coaching staff for all 14 of Villanova's appearances in the FCS playoffs, including the 2009 national championship season and a 2010 semifinal appearance while serving as the Assistant Head Coach on Andy Talley's staff. Ferrante has been a part of Villanova teams that have won seven CAA titles, three Lambert Meadowlands Cups and three ECAC Team of the Year awards.

Ferrante's success during his years as an assistant coach were recognized by others outside the Villanova program. At the end of the 2015 season he was named the FCS Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA). This award was first presented in 1997 and was created to honor assistant coaches who excel in community service, commitment to student-athletes and on-field coaching success.Ferrante was involved in all aspects of the

Villanova program during his time as an assistant on Andy Talley's staff. On the field he coached the offensive line for 27 seasons and developed a unit that was perennially one of the best in CAA Football. Over the years he coached three All-Americans, 11 All-East performers and 15 first team all-conference selections. The offensive line had 17 All-CAA selections in a nine-year span, including three-time first team honoree Ben Ijalana along with first team selections Brant Clouser (2010), Dan Shirey (2011) and Vince Kowalski (2014).

Two of Ferrante's players went on to be selected in the NFL Draft. Ijalana was a second round selection by the Indianapolis Colts in 2011 and Brad Seaton was picked in the seventh round by the Tennessee Titans in 2017. Ijalana was a two-time All-American (2009, 2010) and a three-time first team All-CAA selection during his collegiate career. Villanova reached the FCS playoffs in each of his last three seasons on the team, winning the 2009 national title and advancing to the semifinal round a year later. Seaton was a second team CAA Football All-Conference selection in 2016 when the offensive line enabled the Wildcats to average 206.3 rushing yards and 378.7 yards of total offense per game. Villanova ranked third in the CAA and 24th nationally in rushing offense in addition to ranking fourth in the league in total offense and fifth with a scoring average of 24.4 points per game.

The other All-Americans Ferrante mentored are Eamonn Allen (2001) and Bryan Russo (1989). Allen earned first team Associated Press All-America recognition in 2001 and was also a first team All-East and first team All-Atlantic 10 selection. Russo was chosen as an All-American by the Sports Network and the American Football Coaches Association as a senior in 1989 when he was also a first team all-conference and an All-ECAC selection. He was inducted to Villanova's Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2007.

Ferrante was a standout collegiate performer in his own right prior to joining the football coaching ranks. He was the quarterback for Andy Talley at St. Lawrence where he was named the 1982 Division III Player of the Year to go along with first team All-East honors. Ferrante directed the offense for a St. Lawrence team that went 10-1 during the 1982 season and reached the national semifinals in the playoffs.

Ferrante and his wife, Georgea, reside in Phoenixville, Pa. The couple has a son, Jimmy, who earned his undergraduate degree from Villanova in 2018.
