## TODAY'S GAME

■ Villanova opens conference play with this week's matchup against Rhode Island. The game is the first of eight consecutive contests versus CAA Football foes during the remainder of the regular season.

■ Villanova is 25-10 (.714) in previous league openers and has won its first CAA game in eight of the past 11 seasons. The Wildcats have posted a .500 record or better in 26 of their 35 seasons as a member of the Yankee Conference, Atlantic 10 and CAA Football.

■ Villanova leads the all-time series with Rhode Island by a 20-5 margin and is 12-2 versus the Rams at Villanova Stadium.

■ This week's matchup will be the third straight meeting between the teams which takes place on the Main Line. Rhode Island tallied a 40-37 overtime win during the Spring 2021 season and the Wildcats avenged that loss with a 44-0 win that Fall. Saturday's game will be the second in the all-time series (and the second in a row) in which both teams are nationally-ranked.

## VILLANOVA NOTES

### CATCHING UP WITH THE 'CATS

◆ Villanova (2-1, 0-0 CAA Football) returns home this weekend and will play in its first top-25 matchup of the season. After starting the season with three straight non-conference opponents, the 25th-ranked Wildcats host No. 17 Rhode Island (2-1, 2-0 CAA) to begin their eight-game CAA Football slate. So far this year Villanova has defeated Lehigh (38-10) and Colgate (42-19) while falling to FBS foe and Big 12 member UCF (48-14).

### LEAGUE OPENERS

◆ Villanova first became affiliated with a conference in 1988 when it joined what was then the Yankee Conference. The league became the Atlantic 10 in 1997 and eventually CAA Football in 2007.

◆ Villanova is 25-10 (.714) all-time in conference openers and has won its first CAA game in eight of the last 11 seasons. The trend was interrupted last year when the Wildcats opened conference play at home and were dealt a 49-42 defeat by Monmouth.

◆ Villanova has posted a .500 or better record in conference play in 26 of its first 35 seasons as a member of what is now CAA Football. Last year the Wildcats went 4-4 in league play. Seventh-year head coach **Mark Ferrante** is 23-21 against CAA opponents during his career.

### SERIES HISTORY

◆ Appropriately for a top-25 matchup, there have been 25 previous meetings between Villanova and Rhode Island over the years. The all-time series dates to 1988 when the teams first became conference opponents of each other.

◆ Villanova has a commanding 20-5 edge in the all-time series, including a 12-2 advantage in games played at Villanova Stadium. This week's matchup will be the third straight home game for the Wildcats in the series against the Rams. Rhode Island tallied a 40-37 overtime win over Villanova during the Spring 2021 season, while the Wildcats avenged that defeat with a 44-0 rout of the Rams that Fall.

◆ Only one of the previous 25 matchups in the all-time series occurred when both teams were nationally ranked. It was the most recent game in the series however, as No. 5 Villanova played No. 18 Rhode Island on October 23, 2021.

◆ Villanova and Rhode Island have played once at a neutral site. It came in the second meeting between the teams when the Wildcats defeated the Rams, 28-25, on October 28, 1989 in Milan, Italy.

### FAMILIAR FACE

◆ Rhode Island head coach **Jim Fleming** is in his 10th year leading the Rams and is a former Villanova assistant coach. Fleming served as the Defensive Coordinator for the Wildcats in 1998-99 and was a part of a coaching staff that guided the team to a 13-9 record in those two seasons. Fleming spent two seasons as a head coach at Sacred Heart where he tallied a 21-1 record before taking the head coaching job at Rhode Island.

### READING THE RANKINGS

◆ Villanova is 68-80 against FCS nationally-ranked opponents since 1985. Included in that record is a 52-50 mark when both the Wildcats and the other team are ranked during the week of the game. The last Top 25 matchup Villanova played in was last year at Richmond when Villanova was ranked No. 17 and the Spiders were No. 21.

### HOME IS WHERE THE WINS ARE

◆ Villanova has won each of its past four home games, including a 42-19 win over Colgate in this year's home opener two weeks ago. Under head coach **Mark Ferrante**, the Wildcats are 19-12 at home. Villanova Stadium has been the on-campus home of the Wildcats since 1927 and the venue is now in its 97th season. Villanova is 258-112-5 (.695) in the stadium's friendly confines.

### FIVE YEARS OF SUCCESS

◆ Over the last five seasons (2019-23) the Wildcats own the best overall record among the current CAA Football teams. Villanova has gone 29-14 (.674) since the start of the 2019 season and won its most recent CAA title in 2021.

### TEN YEARS OF SUCCESS

◆ Villanova also has the second-best record among CAA Football teams over the last 10 seasons (2014-23), going 65-38 (.631) since the start of the 2014 campaign.

### 40...NOT 50...DEFINITELY NOT 60

◆ Villanova is coming off a 48-14 loss to UCF last week in its annual game against an FBS opponent. Despite the final outcome, the Wildcats maintained their streak of not allowing an opponent to score 50+ points in a game, as noted below.

◆ Villanova has gone 218 straight games without allowing an opponent to score 50 points. It last happened on October 2, 2004 when New Hampshire defeated the Wildcats, 51-40.

◆ Villanova has gone 1,008 straight games without allowing an opponent to score 60 points. It last happened on November 15, 1919 when Army West Point dealt the Wildcats a 62-0 defeat. Villanova has allowed 60 points in just six of its 1,192 games played all-time.

◆ Since becoming an FCS program in 1985, the Wildcats have played 26 games versus FBS foes and have given up 40 or more points in just six of those games.

## VILLANOVA NOTES

### FOURTH DOWN FODDER

◆ Villanova converted key plays on fourth down during each of its scoring drives in the game at UCF last week. Fifth year quarterback **Connor Watkins** completed a 10-yard pass to fifth year wide receiver **Rayjuon Pringle** on 4th-and-3 from the UCF 18-yard line in the third quarter, then found sophomore wide receiver **Jaylan Sanchez** for a 45-yard completion on 4th-and-8 from the Wildcats own 44-yard line in the fourth quarter.

◆ The results of the two plays mentioned above came as no surprise for a Villanova team which is now 5-of-5 on conversions and has 94 yards on fourth-down plays this season. The Wildcats gained 55 of their 228 total yards against UCF on the two fourth-down attempts.

### MOVING ON UP

◆ Fifth year running back **DeeWil Barlee** and sixth year running back **Jalen Jackson** each moved into the top-15 in school history in career rushing yards during last week's game at UCF. Jackson is now 13th in school history with 1,824 career yards after passing *Pat O'Brien* (1977-80), *Matt Szczur* (2007-10) and *Ralph Pasquariello* (1946-49) during the game. Jackson is tied with Szczur for 15th place with 1,803 yards.

### LOOKING DOWNFIELD

◆ Since the start of the 2022 season **Connor Watkins** has recorded 21 pass completions for 40 yards or longer. That represents more than 13 percent (21 of 158) of his total number of completions since becoming the Wildcats starter under center. In 14 career starts, Watkins is 158-of-290 (54.5%) through the air for 2,631 yards with 20 touchdowns and 13 interceptions. Watkins' tally of long completions is as follows...

## VILLANOVA NOTES

### RECORD-SETTING EFFICIENCY

◆ In the win over Colgate on September 9, fifth year quarterback **Connor Watkins** became the first player in Villanova history to throw for over 300 yards on fewer than 10 completions. Watkins was 8-of-11 through the air for 310 yards and two touchdowns while averaging an incredible 38.75 yards per completion in the 42-19 win.

◆ Watkins completed three passes of 60 yards or longer in the record-setting performance, with five of his passes going for 43 yards or longer. He threw a 67-yard touchdown pass to fifth year wide receiver **Rayjuon Pringle**, who also hauled in catches of 51 yard and 43 yards. Sophomore wide receiver **Jaylan Sanchez** recorded receptions of 68 yards and 60 yards.

◆ Prior to Watkins' performance versus Colgate the school record for fewest completions in a 300-yard game was more than double Villanova's eight pass completions against Colgate. During the 2019 season *Daniel Smith* threw for 378 yards on 17 completions (17-of-24, 378 yards, 5 TD) against Delaware.

◆ Watkins' average of 38.75 yards per completion in the Colgate game would have set the FCS record for a single game if he had enough completions to qualify for the NCAA minimum standard. The official record for an FCS game is 28.5 yards per completion (17 completions for 485 yards) by Kendrick Nord of Grambling against Alcorn on September 3, 1994.

### STATISTICAL ODDITY

◆ **Connor Watkins'** longest pass in the game against Colgate was for 75 yards, but Villanova's longest reception in the game was for 68 yards. Midway through the second quarter the Wildcats had a 3rd-and-11 play from their own 24-yard line. Watkins looked short right to sophomore receiver **Jaylan Sanchez**, who caught the pass but eventually fumbled at the Colgate 10-yard line after a gain of 66 yards. Fifth year receiver **Rayjuon Pringle** recovered the loose ball at the 8-yard line and kept the play alive until he was brought down at the 1-yard line. Sanchez was credited with 68 yards and Pringle with seven yards.

### MORE ON WATKINS

◆ In the Colgate game, **Connor Watkins** recorded his first career game with at least two passing and rushing touchdowns in the same contest. He rushed 10 times for a net total of 15 yards and two scores to go along with his record-setting passing performance (8-of-11, 310 yards, 2 TD). The last Villanova quarterback with two or more passing and rushing touchdowns in a game was *Daniel Smith* who recorded three touchdown passes and two rushing touchdowns against Elon on November 6, 2021.

### FIRST CAREER POINTS FOR ANTONIO JOHNSON

◆ Sophomore tight end **Antonio Johnson** caught his first career touch-down pass in the home opener against Colgate when he snagged a one-yard pass from **Connor Watkins** for a Villanova score in the third quarter. It was his only reception of the game and just the third of his career. Johnson appeared in 10 games as a backup tight end in his red-shirt freshman campaign a year ago but did not record a statistic. This year he has started two of the three Wildcats games and has four receptions for 18 yards and the one score.

### DEFENSIVE DOINGS

◆ Senior linebacker **Brendan Bell** and sophomore cornerback **Devon Marshall** led the Wildcats defensively at UCF last week with nine tackles apiece. They each had seven solo stops on the night, with Bell making two tackles for loss and Marshall adding two pass breakups. Rounding out the defensive leaders were fifth year safety **Elijah Glover** with a season-high eight total stops and three other players who each made seven tackles. Marshall has been one of the Villanova players to watch this season with 18 tackles in three games to go along with a team-high five pass breakups. Sophomore linebacker **Shane Hartzell** leads the squad with 21 tackles on the year.

### ENTERING WITH EXPERIENCE

◆ Villanova has 19 players (out of 93) on its 2023 roster who are graduate students in their fifth or sixth years of playing college football. All 19 graduate students on the roster were listed as starters or reserves on the Wildcats depth chart to open the 2023 season.

◆ In all, the 93 players on the Villanova roster began the 2023 campaign with 1,064 career games played and 369 yards. The current tally for the players on the Wildcats roster is 1,220 career games played with 435 starts.

### PRESEASON HONORS

◆ Wide receiver **Jaaron Hayek** and offensive lineman **Michael Corbi** were each named to the CAA Football Preseason All-Conference Team in a preseason poll of league head coaches. Hayek was a first team All-CAA selection last year and Corbi was a second team pick.

◆ In addition to the two preseason all-conference honorees, safety **Jalen Goodman** and kicker **Matthew Mercurio** garnered honorable mention preseason honors.

## COMPLETE STUDENT-ATHLETES

### ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

#### NCAA ACADEMIC DATA

■ Each year the NCAA recognizes programs that have a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranks within the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. Villanova has earned this award nine times in the 17-year history of the APR program.

■ In the most recent APR data released in May 2023 the football program's multi-year APR score of 974 was 12 points above the national average for FCS programs.

■ New data on the NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) was released in November 2022 and Villanova led all CAA Football schools with a new program record 96 percent GSR.

#### ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

■ One of the highest honors that a student-athlete can achieve is to be named an Academic All-American, an award which encompasses both academic achievement as well as contributions on the field. Villanova has had 12 football student-athletes earn a total of 14 Academic All-America honors over the years.

#### CAA TEAM ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

■ Villanova was the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for both the 2016-17 and the 2017-18 school years. The award is presented at the end of each academic year to the conference school with the highest team GPA.

#### CAA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

■ Villanova has had five student-athletes be named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Nominees for the award must have attained senior standing academically and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

#### CAA ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

■ Student-athletes with a semester GPA of 3.0 or higher are named to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll. Villanova had 62 honorees for the Fall 2022 semester and 63 student-athletes achieve this distinction for the Spring 2023 term.

#### ACADEMIC ALL-AREA TEAMS

■ In conjunction with the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, the sports information directors at the colleges and universities in the Philadelphia area (PhillySIDA) name an Academic All-Area team and a football Performer of the Year each season. In the 16 years of the Academic All-Area program, which started with the 2005-06 academic year, the football team has had a total of 56 selections to the Academic All-Area Team. In addition, the Wildcats have had five Performers of the Year.

# VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

## VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE



Mark Ferrante is in his seventh season as the Villanova head coach in 2023 and he begins the season with a career record of 37-26 (.587), including 23 regular season CAA Football wins. He is in his 37th year overall with the Wildcats and previously spent 30 years as an assistant coach (1987-2016) on Andy Talley's staff. To date, Ferrante has been a part of 254 victories and all 14 of Villanova's FCS playoff appearances during his time on campus.

Ferrante was named the CAA Football Coach of the Year in 2021 and he has mentored four conference major award winners during his first six seasons as head coach. The honorees include two student-athletes who won the league's prestigious Chuck Boone Leadership and Excellence Award – Chucky Smith (2019) and Justin Covington (2020) – while a

pair of defensive standouts have been named the CAA Football Defensive Player of the Year (Forrest Rhyne; 2021) and the league's Defensive Rookie of the Year (Christian Benford; 2018). Rhyne and Benford have each gone on to play in the NFL. Villanova has earned a total of 42 CAA Football All-Conference selections during Ferrante's head coaching tenure, including 13 first team picks.

Outside of football the Wildcats student-athletes have continually excelled in their academic pursuits under Ferrante's watch. During the 2022-23 academic year, Villanova had 62 selections to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll during the Fall semester and 63 honorees on the Spring semester Honor Roll. There were also 51 student-athletes named to the Athletic Director's Honor Roll during the Fall and 53 selections for the Spring semester. Since Ferrante became head coach, the Wildcats have had a total of 544 CAA honor roll selections and 465 honorees on the Athletic Director's Honor Roll.

Each year the NCAA releases academic data for each Division I sport program's Academic Progress Rate (APR) and NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR). In the latest GSR data released in November 2022, the football program set a new record and topped all CAA schools with a 96 percent success rate. New APR data released in May 2023 showed Villanova with a multi-year score (974) that is 12 points above the national average for FCS football programs.

Ferrante and his Wildcats will enter the 2023 campaign on a high note after late heroics in the 2022 finale against Delaware led the team to its eighth winning record in the last 10 full seasons played. Villanova defeated the rival Blue Hens in the annual "Battle of the Blue" game to finish the season with a 6-5 overall record and a 4-4 mark in CAAA games. Wide receiver Jaaron Hayek was named to the CAA Football First Team Offense and was one of four All-CAA selections for the 2022 campaign.

The 2021 season was a breakthrough year for the Wildcats and Ferrante was the AFCA FCS Region 1 Coach of the Year, an honor which made him a finalist for National Coach of the Year consideration. Villanova posted a 10-3 record in 2021 and won a share of the CAA Football title while securing the league's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs. It is the second straight full season (2019, 2021) in which Ferrante guided the Wildcats to postseason play.

Villanova hosted two playoff games in 2021 and advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Division I Football Championship to finish the year ranked in the top-10 nationally (No. 8) in both FCS national polls for the first time since 2014. The Wildcats tallied their seventh season in program history with at least 10 wins and achieved success by playing – and beating – some of the top FCS teams in the nation. Villanova's 10-3 record included four victories over Top 25 opponents, including No. 3 James Madison, No. 18 Rhode Island, No. 21 Richmond and No. 24 Holy Cross. Ferrante led the Wildcats to a 7-1 record against a challenging CAA Football schedule to mark the fifth season since 1988 in which the team had no more than one loss in conference play.

There was star power in all facets of the game for Villanova during the 2021 season, with Ferrante coaching 11 players who had an opportunity to continue their football careers beyond the college ranks. The group included cornerback Christian Benford who was a sixth round draft pick of the Buffalo Bills. Fellow corner Denzel Williams signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Ravens and linebacker Forrest Rhyne was inked to a free agent contract by the Indianapolis Colts. Benford and Rhyne were consensus first team All-Americans in 2021, while offensive lineman Michael Corbi was also a 2021 All-America selection and was one of 13 Wildcats who were named to the CAA Football All-Conference teams.

# VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

## MARK FERRANTE / VILLANOVA COACHING STAFF

Ferrante and the Wildcats made the most out of the opportunity to play four games in a shortened Spring 2021 season and use the experience gained from those games moving forward. The spring games were officially recognized as the 2020 season and Villanova tallied a 2-2 record in four contests against CAA foes, including road wins over Stony Brook and Maine. The abbreviated season had its share of highlights, with eight players chosen for the CAA Football All-Conference teams. Corbi, Rhyne and defensive lineman Malik Fisher were each named first team All-CAA selections.

Villanova came off a 2019 season in which it was ranked as high as No. 5 in the nation. Ferrante guided the Wildcats to a 9-4 record and the program's seventh FCS playoff berth in the previous 12 years in 2019. After being picked to finish ninth in CAA Football before the season the team raced out of the gates with a 6-0 record, including a 3-0 mark in league play by the midpoint of the season. Villanova had 10 players earn All-CAA accolades, including a trio of first team selections in Rhyne, offensive lineman Paul Grattan and punter Nathan Fondacaro.

Eight players have signed NFL free agent contracts since Ferrante became head coach, with the aforementioned Rhyne and Williams joining offensive tackle Brandon Hitner (LA Rams); safety Rob Rolle (Miami Dolphins); offensive lineman Ethan Greenidge (New Orleans Saints); defensive back Trey Johnson (Pittsburgh Steelers); defensive back Malik Reaves (Kansas City Chiefs); and linebacker Ed Shockley (Dallas Cowboys).

Ferrante leads one of the nation's elite FCS programs after playing an instrumental role in the Wildcats rise to national prominence. He has been a part of the coaching staff for all 14 of Villanova's appearances in the FCS playoffs, including the 2009 national championship season and a 2010 semifinal appearance while serving as the Assistant Head Coach on Andy Talley's staff. Ferrante has been a part of Villanova teams that have won seven CAA titles, three Lambert Meadowlands Cups and three ECAC Team of the Year awards.

Ferrante's success during his years as an assistant coach were recognized by others outside the Villanova program. At the end of the 2015 season he was named the FCS Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA). This award was first presented in 1997 and was created to honor assistant coaches who excel in community service, commitment to student-athletes and on-field coaching success. Ferrante was involved in all aspects of the

Villanova program during his time as an assistant on Andy Talley's staff. On the field he coached the offensive line for 27 seasons and developed a unit that was perennially one of the best in CAA Football. Over the years he coached three All-Americans, 11 All-East performers and 15 first team all-conference selections. The offensive line had 17 All-CAA selections in a nine-year span, including three-time first team honoree Ben Ijalana along with first team selections Brant Clouser (2010), Dan Shirey (2011) and Vince Kowalski (2014).

Two of Ferrante's players went on to be selected in the NFL Draft. Ijalana was a second round selection by the Indianapolis Colts in 2011 and Brad Seaton was picked in the seventh round by the Tennessee Titans in 2017. Ijalana was a two-time All-American (2009, 2010) and a three-time first team All-CAA selection during his collegiate career. Villanova reached the FCS playoffs in each of his last three seasons on the team, winning the 2009 national title and advancing to the semifinal round a year later. Seaton was a second team CAA Football All-Conference selection in 2016 when the offensive line enabled the Wildcats to average 206.3 rushing yards and 378.7 yards of total offense per game. Villanova ranked third in the CAA and 24th nationally in rushing offense in addition to ranking fourth in the league in total offense and fifth with a scoring average of 24.4 points per game.

The other All-Americans Ferrante mentored are Eamonn Allen (2001) and Bryan Russo (1989). Allen earned first team Associated Press All-America recognition in 2001 and was also a first team All-East and first team All-Atlantic 10 selection. Russo was chosen as an All-American by the Sports Network and the American Football Coaches Association as a senior in 1989 when he was also a first team all-conference and an All-ECAC selection. He was inducted to Villanova's Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2007.

Ferrante was a standout collegiate performer in his own right prior to joining the football coaching ranks. He was the quarterback for Andy Talley at St. Lawrence where he was named the 1982 Division III Player of the Year to go along with first team All-East honors. Ferrante directed the offense for a St. Lawrence team that went 10-1 during the 1982 season and reached the national semifinals in the playoffs.

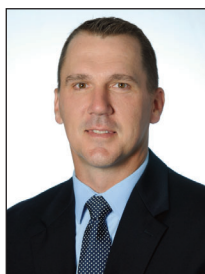

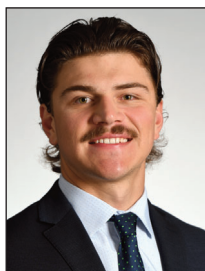
