TODAY'S GAME

■ Villanova opens the home portion of its 2023 schedule on Saturday when it hosts Colgate for a 6 p.m. kickoff. This is one of only two night games on the Wildcats schedule.

■ Last week's 38-10 win over Lehigh marked the seventh consecutive season that the Wildcats have won their season opener. This is the fourth-longest active streak of season-opening wins among FCS teams. The streak coincides with the start of the **Mark Ferrante** head coaching era in 2017.

■ Sixth year running back **Jalen Jackson** rushed for 144 yards on just eight carries despite only playing in the first half against Lehigh last week. He is the third Villanova player ever and the first since 1947 to rush for over 140 yards in a game on eight or fewer carries.

■ Of the 58 players who saw game action for the Wildcats last week, 13 made their collegiate debuts. The newcomers included six players on both offense and defense in addition to one specialist.

VILLANOVA NOTES

ALL THE WAY HOME

◆ Villanova hosts Colgate on Saturday night for its first of five home games during the 2023 regular season. The other home dates are against Rhode Island (September 23), Elon (October 14), Stony Brook (October 28) and Towson (November 3).

◆ This is the 95th season that the Wildcats are playing their home games in the friendly confines of Villanova Stadium. Since the venue opened, Villanova has an all-time record of 257-112-5 (.694) in its on-campus home. Last year the Wildcats were 4-1 in home games.

NIGHTSHIFT

◆ Saturday's game against Colgate is one of just two night games on the Wildcats regular season schedule. The other comes next week when Villanova travels to UCF for a 6:30 p.m. contest in Orlando.

◆ Villanova has won seven consecutive night games since the start of the 2019 season and is 10-3 at night during the **Mark Ferrante** head coaching era. A night game is defined as any contest with a kickoff coming after 5 p.m.

PROVE IT ALL NIGHT

◆ Villanova leads the all-time series against Colgate by a 5-1 margin and has won all five of its matchups against the Raiders since becoming an FCS program in 1985. The most recent meeting between the teams came in the 2019 season opener when the Wildcats made a Week Zero trip to Hamilton, N.Y. and came away with a 34-14 victory.

◆ Colgate's last trip to the Main Line was for a first round FCS playoff game in 2008; Villanova won that game, 55-28. The teams faced each other just once prior to 1985 and it was in a game won by Colgate, 20-14, at Villanova Stadium during the 1978 season. 0

REASON TO BELIEVE

◆ Since becoming an FCS program in 1985, the Wildcats own a 40-4 (.909) record against the teams that currently make up the Patriot League. Villanova is facing a Patriot League foe for the second time in as many weeks after it defeated Lehigh, 38-10, in last week's season opener.

◆ The record of 40-4 against Patriot League teams includes a current streak of 16 straight wins against the conference. Villanova's last loss to a Patriot League opponent came in 2013 to Fordham. Since then, the Wildcats have gone a combined 16-0 against Bucknell, Colgate, Fordham, Holy Cross, Lafayette and Lehigh.

HIGH HOPES

◆ Villanova won its season opener for the seventh straight season when it defeated Lehigh, 38-10, on the road last week. With the win, the Wildcats are tied for the seventh-longest active streak of season-opening wins among FCS schools.

◆ The start of Villanova's streak of seven straight wins in season openers coincides with the beginning of the **Mark Ferrante** head coaching era in 2017. Ferrante is 7-0 in lidlifters and the Wildcats have posted an average margin of victory of 18.3 points in the seven games.

◆ Last week's win over Lehigh marked the first time since the 2021 spring season and only the second time in the last five years that Villanova scored a touchdown of any kind in the first quarter of a season opener. This is the first year since 2018 that the Wildcats scored two first quarter touchdowns in their season opener.

◆ This season is the first time since 2013 that Villanova had both a rushing touchdown and a receiving touchdown in the first quarter of a season opener. In the game against Lehigh fifth year running back **Jalen Jackson (Richmond, Va.)** opened the scoring on a one-yard touchdown scamper with 3:58 left in the first period. Fifth year wide receiver **Rayjun Pringle (Woodbridge, Va.)** caught a 28-yard touchdown pass just over two minutes later.

VILLANOVA NOTES

BORN TO RUN

◆ Sixth year running back **Jalen Jackson (Richmond, Va.)** and fifth year **DeeWil Barlee (Upper Darby, Pa.)** combined to rush for 246 yards in last week's season-opening win. Jackson only played in the first half but still had eight carries for 144 yards on the day. He became the third Villanova player ever and the first since 1947 to rush over 140 yards on eight or fewer carries. Barlee finished the day with 11 rushes for 102 yards.

◆ Last week marked the 27th time in school history that the Wildcats had two players top the 100-yard mark in rushing in the same game. The feat was last accomplished last year in the Hampton game when quarterback **Cononr Watkins (Williamsport, Pa.)** ran for 130 yards and running back **TD Ayo-Durojaiye (Damascus, Md.)** had 112 rushing yards.

◆ **Jalen Jackson** and **DeeWil Barlee** each topped 1,700 career rushing yards during the Lehigh game last week. Barlee ranks 16th in school history with 1,731 rushing yards, just ahead of Jackson in 17th place with 1,711 career yards. When adding in the career totals for **TD Ayo-Durojaiye**, the Wildcats top running back trio has combined for 4,641 career rushing yards and 36 touchdowns.

GLORY DAYS

◆ There is no denying the veteran experience that has a chance to be Villanova's trademark this season. The 93 members of the Wildcats roster began the season with a combined 1,064 collegiate games played, including 369 starts. After 58 players saw game action against Lehigh last week, the collective experience of the Villanova team is up to 1,122 games played.

◆ Villanova's roster this season features 19 players in their fifth or sixth seasons of college football. Each of the 19 graduate students appeared on the Week 1 depth chart for the game against Lehigh last week, including graduate transfers **James Mott (Colorado)**, **Justin Marcus (Monmouth)**, **Camden Gagnon (Brown)**, **Chandon Pierre (North Dakota)** and **Jake Reichwein (Holy Cross)**.

◆ Of the 58 players who saw game action for the Wildcats in last week's season opener, 13 were making their collegiate debuts in the contest. The newcomers included **Kenyon Miles (WR)**, **Turner Inge (LB)**, **Isaiah Wright (RB)**, **Colin Kennedy (LB)**, **Garrett Rogan (DB)**, **Dale Law (LB)**, **Dan McManus (OL)**, **Quin Whalen (OL)**, **Tommy Broderick (OL)**, **Luke Daly (WR)**, **Capri Martin (DL)**, **Mike Kennedy (DL)** and **Daniel Mueller (P)**.

THE PRICE YOU PAY

◆ In the first half of Villanova's game against Lehigh last week the Wildcats defense forced three turnovers on interceptions by **Ty Trinh (Owings Mills, Md.)** and **Tyrell Mims (Philadelphia, Pa.)** to go along with a fumble recovery by **Richie Kimmel (Holmes, Pa.)**.

◆ Each of the three turnovers recovered by the Villanova defense last week were turned into offensive touchdowns. Those possessions and scores all came in the first half of the eventual Wildcats win. Villanova finished the game with a 21-0 scoring advantage on points off turnovers. Last year in 11 games played, the Wildcats scored only 35 points off turnovers the entire year and had just one game where they forced as many as three turnovers.

HUNGRY HEART

◆ In the season opener last week it was good to see fifth year punter and kicker **Nathan Fondacaro** back in action for Villanova. Fondacaro handled the team's punting duties from 2018-21 before having to miss his senior year with an injury in 2022. There was no rust factor in the layoff for Fondacaro, who is not only back to handling punting duties but he also earned the role of being the team's kicker on kickoffs.

◆ In the Lehigh win last week, Fondacaro punted six times for an average of 38.5 yards per punt. He also kicked off six times for an average of 57.7 yards per kickoff. Fondacaro's career punting totals are 160 punts for an average of 40.3 yards. He has landed 44 punts inside the 20-yard line and has kicked 55 punts of 50 yards or longer.

ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

NCAA ACADEMIC DATA

■ Each year the NCAA recognizes programs that have a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranks within the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. Villanova has earned this award nine times in the 17-year history of the APR program.

■ In the most recent APR data released in May 2023 the football program's multi-year APR score of 974 was 12 points above the national average for FCS programs.

■ New data on the NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) was released in November 2022 and Villanova led all CAA Football schools with a new program record 96 percent GSR.

ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

■ One of the highest honors that a student-athlete can achieve is to be named an Academic All-American, an award which encompasses both academic achievement as well as contributions on the field. Villanova has had 12 football student-athletes earn a total of 14 Academic All-America honors over the years.

CAA TEAM ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

■ Villanova was the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award for both the 2016-17 and the 2017-18 school years. The award is presented at the end of each academic year to the conference school with the highest team GPA.

CAA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

■ Villanova has had five student-athletes be named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Nominees for the award must have attained senior standing academically and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

CAA ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

■ Student-athletes with a semester GPA of 3.0 or higher are named to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll. Villanova had 62 honorees for the Fall 2022 semester and 63 student-athletes achieve this distinction for the Spring 2023 term.

ACADEMIC ALL-AREA TEAMS

■ In conjunction with the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, the sports information directors at the colleges and universities in the Philadelphia area (PhillySIDA) name an Academic All-Area team and a football Performer of the Year each season. In the 16 years of the Academic All-Area program, which started with the 2005-06 academic year, the football team has had a total of 56 selections to the Academic All-Area Team. In addition, the Wildcats have had five Performers of the Year.

VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE



Mark Ferrante is in his seventh season as the Villanova head coach in 2023 and he begins the season with a career record of 37-26 (.587), including 23 regular season CAA Football wins. He is in his 37th year overall with the Wildcats and previously spent 30 years as an assistant coach (1987-2016) on Andy Talley's staff. To date, Ferrante has been a part of 254 victories and all 14 of Villanova's FCS playoff appearances during his time on campus.

Ferrante was named the CAA Football Coach of the Year in 2021 and he has mentored four conference major award winners during his first six seasons as head coach. The honorees include two student-athletes who won the league's prestigious Chuck Boone Leadership and Excellence Award – Chucky Smith (2019) and Justin Covington (2020) – while a

pair of defensive standouts have been named the CAA Football Defensive Player of the Year (Forrest Rhyne; 2021) and the league's Defensive Rookie of the Year (Christian Benford; 2018). Rhyne and Benford have each gone on to play in the NFL. Villanova has earned a total of 42 CAA Football All-Conference selections during Ferrante's head coaching tenure, including 13 first team picks.

Outside of football the Wildcats student-athletes have continually excelled in their academic pursuits under Ferrante's watch. During the 2022-23 academic year, Villanova had 62 selections to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll during the Fall semester and 63 honorees on the Spring semester Honor Roll. There were also 51 student-athletes named to the Athletic Director's Honor Roll during the Fall and 53 selections for the Spring semester. Since Ferrante became head coach, the Wildcats have had a total of 544 CAA honor roll selections and 465 honorees on the Athletic Director's Honor Roll.

Each year the NCAA releases academic data for each Division I sport program's Academic Progress Rate (APR) and NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR). In the latest GSR data released in November 2022, the football program set a new record and topped all CAA schools with a 96 percent success rate. New APR data released in May 2023 showed Villanova with a multi-year score (.974) that is 12 points above the national average for FCS football programs.

Ferrante and his Wildcats will enter the 2023 campaign on a high note after late heroics in the 2022 finale against Delaware led the team to its eighth winning record in the last 10 full seasons played. Villanova defeated the rival Blue Hens in the annual "Battle of the Blue" game to finish the season with a 6-5 overall record and a 4-4 mark in CAAA games. Wide receiver Jaaron Hayek was named to the CAA Football First Team Offense and was one of four All-CAA selections for the 2022 campaign.

The 2021 season was a breakthrough year for the Wildcats and Ferrante was the AFCA FCS Region 1 Coach of the Year, an honor which made him a finalist for National Coach of the Year consideration. Villanova posted a 10-3 record in 2021 and won a share of the CAA Football title while securing the league's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs. It is the second straight full season (2019, 2021) in which Ferrante guided the Wildcats to postseason play.

Villanova hosted two playoff games in 2021 and advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Division I Football Championship to finish the year ranked in the top-10 nationally (No. 8) in both FCS national polls for the first time since 2014. The Wildcats tallied their seventh season in program history with at least 10 wins and achieved success by playing – and beating – some of the top FCS teams in the nation. Villanova's 10-3 record included four victories over Top 25 opponents, including No. 3 James Madison, No. 18 Rhode Island, No. 21 Richmond and No. 24 Holy Cross. Ferrante led the Wildcats to a 7-1 record against a challenging CAA Football schedule to mark the fifth season since 1988 in which the team had no more than one loss in conference play.

There was star power in all facets of the game for Villanova during the 2021 season, with Ferrante coaching 11 players who had an opportunity to continue their football careers beyond the college ranks. The group included cornerback Christian Benford who was a sixth round draft pick of the Buffalo Bills. Fellow corner Denzel Williams signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Ravens and linebacker Forrest Rhyne was inked to a free agent contract by the Indianapolis Colts. Benford and Rhyne were consensus first team All-Americans in 2021, while offensive lineman Michael Corbi was also a 2021 All-America selection and was one of 13 Wildcats who were named to the CAA Football All-Conference teams.

Ferrante and the Wildcats made the most out of the opportunity to play four games in a shortened Spring 2021 season and use the experience gained from those games moving forward. The spring games were officially recognized as the 2020 season and Villanova tallied a 2-2 record in four contests against CAA foes, including road wins over Stony Brook and Maine. The abbreviated season had its share of highlights, with eight players chosen for the CAA Football All-Conference teams. Corbi, Rhyne and defensive lineman Malik Fisher were each named first team All-CAA selections.

Villanova came off a 2019 season in which it was ranked as high as No. 5 in the nation. Ferrante guided the Wildcats to a 9-4 record and the program's seventh FCS playoff berth in the previous 12 years in 2019. After being picked to finish ninth in CAA Football before the season the team raced out of the gates with a 6-0 record, including a 3-0 mark in league play by the midpoint of the season. Villanova had 10 players earn All-CAA accolades, including a trio of first team selections in Rhyne, offensive lineman Paul Grattan and punter Nathan Fondacaro.

Eight players have signed NFL free agent contracts since Ferrante became head coach, with the aforementioned Rhyne and Williams joining offensive tackle Brandon Hitner (LA Rams); safety Rob Rolle (Miami Dolphins); offensive lineman Ethan Greenidge (New Orleans Saints); defensive back Trey Johnson (Pittsburgh Steelers); defensive back Malik Reaves (Kansas City Chiefs); and linebacker Ed Shockley (Dallas Cowboys).

Ferrante leads one of the nation's elite FCS programs after playing an instrumental role in the Wildcats rise to national prominence. He has been a part of the coaching staff for all 14 of Villanova's appearances in the FCS playoffs, including the 2009 national championship season and a 2010 semifinal appearance while serving as the Assistant Head Coach on Andy Talley's staff. Ferrante has been a part of Villanova teams that have won seven CAA titles, three Lambert Meadowlands Cups and three ECAC Team of the Year awards.

Ferrante's success during his years as an assistant coach were recognized by others outside the Villanova program. At the end of the 2015 season he was named the FCS Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA). This award was first presented in 1997 and was created to honor assistant coaches who excel in community service, commitment to student-athletes and on-field coaching success. Ferrante was involved in all aspects of the

Villanova program during his time as an assistant on Andy Talley's staff. On the field he coached the offensive line for 27 seasons and developed a unit that was perennially one of the best in CAA Football. Over the years he coached three All-Americans, 11 All-East performers and 15 first team all-conference selections. The offensive line had 17 All-CAA selections in a nine-year span, including three-time first team honoree Ben Ijalana along with first team selections Brant Clouser (2010), Dan Shirey (2011) and Vince Kowalski (2014).

Two of Ferrante's players went on to be selected in the NFL Draft. Ijalana was a second round selection by the Indianapolis Colts in 2011 and Brad Seaton was picked in the seventh round by the Tennessee Titans in 2017. Ijalana was a two-time All-American (2009, 2010) and a three-time first team All-CAA selection during his collegiate career. Villanova reached the FCS playoffs in each of his last three seasons on the team, winning the 2009 national title and advancing to the semifinal round a year later. Seaton was a second team CAA Football All-Conference selection in 2016 when the offensive line enabled the Wildcats to average 206.3 rushing yards and 378.7 yards of total offense per game. Villanova ranked third in the CAA and 24th nationally in rushing offense in addition to ranking fourth in the league in total offense and fifth with a scoring average of 24.4 points per game.

The other All-Americans Ferrante mentored are Eamonn Allen (2001) and Bryan Russo (1989). Allen earned first team Associated Press All-America recognition in 2001 and was also a first team All-East and first team All-Atlantic 10 selection. Russo was chosen as an All-American by the Sports Network and the American Football Coaches Association as a senior in 1989 when he was also a first team all-conference and an All-ECAC selection. He was inducted to Villanova's Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2007.

Ferrante was a standout collegiate performer in his own right prior to joining the football coaching ranks. He was the quarterback for Andy Talley at St. Lawrence where he was named the 1982 Division III Player of the Year to go along with first team All-East honors. Ferrante directed the offense for a St. Lawrence team that went 10-1 during the 1982 season and reached the national semifinals in the playoffs.




