Villanova Game Storylines

✓ Maine returns to Orono for Homecoming Weekend and looks for its third win in its past four outings, and second over a ranked opponent this season, when it welcomes #5 Villanova to Alford Stadium. A win for Maine would mark its highest ranking victory since it knocked off #3 Weber State (2018).

✓ Maine and Villanova meet for the 26th time, and first since 2022. The Black Bears enter action 10-15 all-time against Villanova as the Wildcats are currently riding a three-game win streak in the series. Maine is 6-7 all-time at home against Villanova with its last win in Orono over the Wildcats coming in 2018. Villanova has won seven of the last eight meetings. The two teams first met in 1988, a 20-17 Maine win at Villanova. The Wildcats have won six of the last seven games in Orono. Today's meeting marks the third-straight meeting in Orono for the two clubs as the two teams have not played at Villanova since 2019. Maine's last road win in the series came in 2013. In the last meeting (2022), current Villanova QB Connor Watkins threw four touchdown passes while current Black Bear Montigo Moss recorded a touchdown reception. The game marked head coach Jordan Stevens' fourth career game at the helm for the Black Bears.

✓ Maine, which has won two of its last three, is coming off a 44-21 loss at undefeated Delaware. The Black Bears trailed by just two with 12:00 to play at Delaware but were the victim of 21 unanswered points by the Blue Hens to close the game out. Tavion Banks and Jaharie Martin each registered rushing touchdowns in the win while Montigo Moss led eight Maine pass catchers with four receptions, including a touchdown. Defensively, Xavier Holmes led the way with a career-high 13 tackles, including a career-best 1.5 sacks. His 13 individual tackles were the most individual stops by a Black Bears since 2021 (Ray Miller - 16). Five Black Bears (Holmes, Costanza, Riobe, Vaught, C. Thomas) set career-highs in single game tackles.

✓ Villanova enters play on a two-game win streak after suffering its only loss on the season at Maryland (38-20) back in week four. The Wildcats, coming off their bye, feature the CAA's top defense as they enter play allowing just 17.5 points per game and check in second in yardage surrendered at 327.0. The Wildcats have 10 takeaways on the season and rank ninth in all of FCS, second in the CAA, with a +7 turnover margin. Villanova ranks third in the CAA in rushing offense (205.3) behind David Avit who is averaging 7.5 yards per carry.

JORDAN STEVENS, HEAD COACH

Jordan Stevens ('10), was named the 37th head football coach at UMaine on Dec. 7, 2021.

Stevens, an All-CAA third team selection with the Black Bears before serving a four-year stint as an assistant coach at UMaine, returned home to Orono after spending the previous seven seasons on staff at Yale.

Stevens played for the Black Bears from 2006-2009 before mentoring Maine's defensive line in an assistant coaching role from March 2011 through February 2015.

A native of Temple, Maine, Stevens mentored nine All-Ivy League players and a pair of All-Colonial Athletic Association honorees during his 11-year assistant coaching career with Yale and UMaine. While at Yale, Stevens spent his first three seasons as the defensive line coach with the Bulldogs before being elevated to assistant head coach and co-defensive coordinator, working specifically with the linebackers, in Jan. 2018. After spending one season working with the linebackers, Stevens returned to his roots, switching back to mentoring the defensive line in a role he would serve from Jan. 2019 until the end of his stint with the Bulldogs.

Stevens served a key role in leading Yale to Ivy League titles in 2017 and, as the assistant head coach and co-defensive coordinator, again in 2019 as the Bulldogs finished both title seasons with a 9-1 mark. In 2017, Stevens helped mentor a defensive unit which led the Ivy League in total defense (302.8 yards per game allowed); scoring defense (15.6 points allowed); rushing defense (73.1 rush yards allowed); third down conversion percentage defense (29.9 percent); and tackles for loss (85). The Bulldogs' numbers were not just impressive against their Ivy League peers but also ranked in the top-10 in the nation in scoring defense, rushing defense, third down conversion percentage defense, and tackles for loss during the 2017 campaign.

The 2021 season saw Yale post some of its best defensive marks in recent history as the unit, under the guidance of Stevens as co-defensive coordinator, led the nation in third down conversion percentage defense (22.1), ranked ninth nationally in sacks per game (3.2/32 total), and checked in 23rd in all of the Football Championship Subdivision in rush defense after allowing just 117.1 yards per game on the ground.

Yale consistently progressed on the defensive side of the ball under Stevens' leadership. In his first season with the defensive line, the Bulldogs posted six sacks and 19 tackles for loss. Three years later, under the direction of Stevens, Yale turned those statistical numbers into 22.5 sacks and 44.5 tackles for loss as the Bulldogs would post 18 or more sacks in three of the last four seasons and 34 or more tackles for loss in four of the last five years.

Stevens began his coaching career at the University of Maine, serving two seasons as the assistant defensive line coach before a two-year stint as the lead defensive line coach at his alma mater in Orono. Stevens, who mentored NFL Draft Pick and two-time All-CAA selection Trevor Bates and All-CAA second team selection and Maine's career sack leader Michael Cole, helped guide the Black Bears to the NCAA FCS Playoffs in 2011 and to a CAA Championship and another trip to the NCAA FCS Playoffs in 2013. Maine's Black Hole defense was impressive during Stevens' time at UMaine, posting the top ranked scoring defense and red zone defense in 2012, the CAA's fourth ranked total defense in 2013, and the CAA's second ranked total defense, 16th in the nation, in 2014.

An All-CAA third team selection at defensive end, UMaine's Most Valuable Player, and a New England Football Writers FCS All-Star selection in 2009, Stevens enjoyed an impressive four-year career with the Black Bears. Stevens appeared in 45 games at UMaine while registering 184 tackles, 24 sacks, 16.0 tackles for loss, three pass breakups, three fumble recoveries, five forced fumbles, while logging a pair of safeties. In 2008, Stevens guided the Black Bears to an appearance in the NCAA FCS Playoffs.

Following his playing career with the Black Bears, Stevens participated in NFL Rookie Mini Camp with the Detroit Lions before signing with the Hartford Colonials of the United Football League for Mini and Training Camp in 2010.

Stevens earned his Bachelor of Science in Business Administration - Management from UMaine in 2010. A Mt. Blue high school graduate, Stevens and his wife, Ellen, have one daughter, Noella and son, Carson.



Quick Hits

RETURN GAME STRONG:

Junior kick returner Trevin Ewing, who has named CAA Special Teams Player of the Week on Sept. 16, took back a 98-yard kickoff return for a score against Monmouth. Ewing is one of the most dangerous return-men in the FCS, ranking tops in the CAA and fifth in FCS at 31.4 yards per kickoff return.

RUSHING IMPROVEMENTS:

A year after only rushing for 100+ yards in four games while posting seven total rushing touchdowns on the year, Maine's rushing attack has shown much improvement in the early part of 2024. Maine has rushed for 100+ yards in five of its first six outings while posting nine rushing touchdowns, surpassing its total of all of 2024.

ELEVATED DEFENSE IN THE PAST THREE:

Over its last three games, Maine's defense has forced six turnovers (2 fumbles/4 INTs), registered 10.0 sacks, and have limited the opponent to just 14-of-37 (37.8%).

NEW GUY UNDER CENTER:

- After racking up 3,933 yards passing with 21 touchdowns to go along with 543 rush yards and 16 rushing touchdowns during his 31 games career at Mercer, graduate transfer Carter Peevy joins the Black Bears and will start at quarterback.
- Peevy has had a hand in a touchdown (pass/rush) in 18 of his last 19 games with at least one passing and one rushing touchdown in five of those 19 scoring games.
- In his Maine debut, Peevy led the Black Bears to a 17-14 win over Colgate. In the game, he finished 16-of-21 for 182 yards to go along with a rushing touchdown.

BLACK HOLE

- Maine's Black Hole defense began the year by holding Colgate to just 303 yards. The yardage was the fewest surrendered by Maine since Sept. 10, 2022 (253) - also against Colgate.

STRONG RECEIVING CORPS RETURNS

- Maine's offense welcomes back its top five pass catchers from a year ago, led by preseason CAA honorable mention selection Joe Gillette (36 receptions, 570 yards, 5 TDs), Jamie Lamson (49, 552, 6), and Montigo Moss (37, 408, 3).
- Gillette, who joined Maine in 2023 after transferring from Lafayette, finished the season ranked ninth in the CAA in receiving yards per game (57.0), 14th in total receiving yards (570), and 11th in yards per reception (15.8).
- Lamson, who finished the 2023 season with eight receptions in back to back games and 24 total receptions over the season's final three games, ranked seventh in the league in receptions per game (4.5), 15th in receiving yards per game (50.2), and ninth in the CAA with a team-high six touchdown receptions.
- Moss checked in 15th best among league pass catchers (3.7 per game).

CADOGAN BIG LEG

- Aidan Cadogan, who transferred to Maine from rival UNH, finished the season ranked third in the CAA at 43.5 yards per punt.
- Cadogan's 43.5 yards per punt on the season set a new school record for Maine in the category.
- Overall, Maine led the CAA in yards per punt on the season (42.5).

PERFECT PATs

- The Black Bears have converted on 162 consecutive PATs.

TOUGH SLEDDING

- As is accustomed to the Black Bears, Maine features one of the toughest scheduled in the nation for 2024.
- 10 of the 12 team's on Maine's 2024 schedule had winning records in 2023 with four reaching the FCS playoffs including UAlbany which advanced to the FCS Final Four.

STEVENS AT THE HELM

- Jordan Stevens (Maine '10) begins his third year as head coach of the Black Bears in 2023 after being named the 37th head coach in the program's 130 year history on Dec. 7, 2021.
- Stevens, who spent time on Maine's staff as an assistant for four seasons (2011-14) before a seven-year stint at Yale.
- Stevens was an All-CAA third team selection for Maine and racked up 184 tackles, 24 sacks, and 16.0 TFLs in 45 games for the Black Bears.
- Stevens scored his first career win as head coach with a 31-24 victory at Hampton on Oct. 8, 2022.

NEW FACES ON STAFF

- For the third consecutive season, Maine will feature new coordinators on both sides of the ball. Mikahael Waters, who is in his seventh year on staff but first as the offensive coordinator, will orchestrate Maine's offense while Umberto Di Meo, who spent his first year on staff in 2023 coaching the defensive line, will serve as Maine's defensive coordinator. Spencer Carey was named the special teams coordinator in the spring of 2024.
- Maine also welcomes three new coaches on staff this year in McCormick Stephenson (TE), AJ McLaughlin (DL), Jalen Hairston (S), and Jeb Boudreaux (OLB).

YOU GOT MOSSED

- Moss' touchdown reception against Villanova in 2022 earned him the top ranking on ESPN's weekly segment 'You Got Mossed'.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- Joe Gillette (WR) and Cooper Heisey (TE) were each named CAA Preseason Honorable Mention.

TRANSFERS

- Since the spring of 2019, Maine has added 45 transfers/graduate transfers to its roster, including 11 this season.
- The Black Bears feature 11 former Football Bowl Subdivision players on this year's roster.

CARRYING THE LEAD

- Maine is 105-26 since the beginning of the 2000 season when leading at the half.
- The Black Bears are 19-2 in their last 20 games in which they've taken a lead into the fourth quarter.

CLOSE CALL

- Since 2013, Maine is 27-18 in games decided by seven points or less.
- In 2023, Maine was on the losing end of all three of its games which were decided by 7 points or fewer.

Series Notes

Maine and Villanova meet for the 26th time, and first since 2022. The Black Bears enter action 10-15 all-time against Villanova as the Wildcats are currently riding a three-game win streak in the series. Maine is 6-7 all-time at home against Villanova with its last win in Orono over the Wildcats coming in 2018. Villanova has won seven of the last eight meetings. The two teams first met in 1988, a 20-17 Maine win at Villanova. The Wildcats have won six of the last seven games in Orono. Today's meeting marks the third-straight meeting in Orono for the two clubs as the two teams have not played at Villanova since 2019. Maine's last road win in the series came in 2013. In the last meeting (2022), current Villanova QB Connor Watkins threw four touchdown passes while current Black Bear Montigo Moss recorded a touchdown reception. The game marked head coach Jordan Stevens' fourth career game at the helm for the Black Bears.
