QUICK HITTERS

- This marks the 8th matchup between these two programs, the first since Oct. 28, 2023 where Villanova defeated Stony Brook 48-13 at home.
- In their last time out, the Stony Brook football used a 287-yard output on the ground, including 158 yards and three touchdowns from Roland Dempster, to pick up a 22-3 win against Morgan State on Saturday at LaValle Stadium.
- Stony Brook registered its fourth straight victory, allowing a season-low three points in the win over Morgan State.
- Redshirt senior running back Roland Dempster was named the FCS National Offensive Player of the Week as announced by Stats Perform on Monday.
- The 4-1 start to the season matches Stony Brook's best start to a season since winning four of its first five contests to open the 2018 season.
- For the third straight week, the Seawolves tallied votes from the AFCA FCS Coaches Top 25 poll. The squad also got votes from the Stats Perform FCS Top 25 and was ranked No. 24 in the CBS FCS poll.
- The Seawolves added a plethora of talent through the portal this offseason, including Chance Knox (VMI), Deshawn Jones Jr. (Bowling Green), Jasiah Williams (Richmond), Tyler Knoop (Georgetown), Damion Powell (SOSU), and Kris Caine (ODU) to the 2024 roster.
- The Seawolves return multiple starters on both sides of the ball, including Niko Papic (OL), Collin Tunc (OL), Hunter Barlow (OL), Jayden Cook (RB/WR), Roland Dempster (RB), Cal Redman (TE), Jayce Freeman (WR), Anthony Johnson (WR), Noah Rodriguez (DB), Jalen Hoyle (DB), Rushawn Lawrence (DL), Taylor Bolesta (DL), Dyshier Clary (DL), Rodney Faulk (DE), AJ Roberts (LB) and Anthony Ferrelli (LB), Clayton Taylor (P), and Spencer Biscoe (K).

PRESEASON AWARD HONORS

- Junior Clayton Taylor was named to the preseason watch list for the 2024 Football Championship Subdivision Punter of the Year Award, which honors the nation's top collegiate punter in the FCS.
- Taylor, a junior from Brunswick, Australia, averaged 39.67 yards (ninth most in program history) on 55 punt attempts last year with 16 punts downed inside the 20-yard line,
- RB Roland Dempster and DL Taylor Bolesta were named to the Preseason Phil Steele Preseason Team.
- Anthony Pecorella was named the recipient of the prestigious 2024 John H. Randolph Inspiration Award by the Coastal Athletic Association. The award recognizes individuals, who through strength of character and human spirit, serve as an inspiration to all to maximize their potential and ability for success.

LEADING THE TEAM

- Cal Redman, Jasiah Williams, Taylor Bolesta and Rodney Faulk have been named the captains for the 2024 season.
- Redman, who was a captain last season, started all 10 games for the Seawolves at TE last season. He finished with 210 receiving yards in total and 15 catches in 2023.
- Bolesta, who was also a captain last season, was named Phil Steele Fifth Team All-CAA after tallying seven solo tackles and 13 assisted for 20 total stops in 2023.
- Williams joins Stony Brook after spending the previous four seasons at Richmond. At Richmond, Williams tallied 140 receptions and 1164 yards for six touchdowns.
- Faulk, entering his fourth season with Stony Brook, had six solo tackles and nine assisted tackles for 15 total in 2023. He also contributed 3.0 sacks for 20 yards, 4.5 tackles for loss for 21 yards and was tied for team lead in TFLs.
- Each week, Stony Brook will select a new team captain to fill the fifth role. For the opening game, Coach Cosh and the Seawolves have selected Chance Knox to be the fifth captain representing the special teams.

STONY BROOK SEAWOLVES FOOTBALL

WELCOME TO STONY BROOK, COACH COSH

- Billy Cosh was named the third head coach in Stony Brook football's Division I era on December 13, 2023.
- Cosh joined Stony Brook for his first career head coaching job after spending the 2023 season at Western Michigan as the Broncos' offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach.
- Prior to Western Michigan, Cosh spent three years as an FCS offensive coordinator with Richmond and VMI. He started his coaching career at Concord University (Md.) as an offensive graduate assistant and quarterbacks coach after his playing career at Houston, BCC, James Madison and Kansas State.
- Cosh will be the second-youngest head coach in Division I football, including both the FCS and FBS level. Only Incarnate Word's Clint Killough, 30, is younger.

NEW HEAD COACH, NEW COACHING STAFF

- Under the program's new head coach in Billy Cosh, Stony Brook football announced Anthony Davis II as the program's next offensive coordinator and Scott Lewis as the program's next defensive coordinator.
- Davis, who will also serve as the wide receivers coach, will re-join Cosh from Western Michigan, where he previously served as the running backs coach for the 2023 season.
- Lewis spent the last three seasons at Saint Francis (PA), where he guided the Red Flash to top-20 FCS ranks in four categories in 2022.
- Stony Brook also added D.J. Gillins and Adam Lovan to the offensive coaching staff while Kevin Elliott and Zuril Hendrick join on the defensive side of the ball. Stony Brook retained Chris Bache, Cal Daniels, Sean Hammonds, Josh Heinrich, and Steve Martino on the staff for the upcoming year.

THE TRANSFER PORTAL

- Stony Brook was active in the transfer portal all offseason, with signees from FBS, FCS, Junior College, and Division II players.

NATIONAL SIGNING DAY 2024

- On Feb. 7, 2024, Stony Brook announced the signing of eight new players to its class of 2024

on National Signing Day, bringing their total to 10 incoming freshmen for the signing class of 2024.

- The signing class included the 2023 New York State Player of the Year Sebastian Regis, QB Malachi Marshall from South Carolina who amassed over 4,100 passing yards and 36 total touchdowns in his final two seasons, an All-State safety and candidate for Mr. PA Football in Sam Cooper and Jayson Allen who recorded 57 tackles (28 solo), 12 TFLs, three sacks and blocked four punts along with a field goal as a senior.

SEASON OUTLOOK

- Marshall is the only FBS team on the 2024 slate for the Seawolves. The Labor Day weekend trip to Huntington, W.Va. was Stony Brook's second consecutive and second all-time matchup against the Sun Belt, having traveled to Arkansas State in 2023.
- The Marshall matchup continued Stony Brook's streak of playing an FBS opponent in every full season since 2010 and the Seawolves can pick up their second all-time win (Army West Point, 2012) over an FBS opponent in the Week 1 matchup.
- Stony Brook will play 12 games in its regular season slate for the first time since 2019, where it finished 5-7. The Seawolves will play six times at home, also reaching that mark for the first time since playing seven home games in 2019.
- The squad will face two in-state teams during their 2024 campaign (Fordham and UAlbany).
- In total, Stony Brook will face a pair of teams in UAlbany and Villanova which reached the FCS Playoffs quarterfinal a season ago.

FCS NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Redshirt senior running back Roland Dempster was named the FCS National Offensive Player of the Week as announced by Stats Perform on Monday.
- This marks the third weekly honor of the season for Dempster. The Staten Island native earned CAA Offensive Player of the Week honors on Sept. 9 and Sept. 23. He's also the first player in program history to earn the weekly honor from the Stats Perform organization.
- Dempster helped the Seawolves to their fourth consecutive victory by carrying the ball 25 times for 158 yards and three touchdowns. He added two receptions for a career-best 59 yards to gain a career-high 217 yards from scrimmage.

SEAWOLVES IN THE PROS

- Over the past seven seasons Stony Brook has sent a total of 21 student-athletes to NFL training camps.
- This past offseason, Eric Black signed a

contract with the Saskatchewan Roughriders in the Canadian Football League (CFL) after spending the start of the 2024 season with the Edmonton Elks.

- Most recently, former Stony Brook linebacker Sam Kamara signed with the Browns practice squad on Sept. 2, 2024 and signed to the 52-man squad on Sept. 11, 2024. He recorded two tackles in Week 2 against Jacksonville in his first game of the season and two against the Giants in Week 3.

LAST TIME OUT

- Stony Brook football used a 287-yard output on the ground, including 158 yards and three touchdowns from Roland Dempster, to pick up a 22-3 win against Morgan State on Saturday at LaValle Stadium.
- The Seawolves' defense limited the Bears to three points, tallied nine tackles for loss and forced two turnovers in the victory.
- Cal Redman reeled in four catches for 62 yards to pace Stony Brook's receiving room. RJ Lamarre and Chance Knox reeled in a pair of catches as well. The Seawolves' offense threw the ball just 20 times, carrying the ball 52 times and totaling 287 yards on the ground.
- Tyson McCloud and AJ Roberts registered 10 and nine tackles, respectively, to lead the Stony Brook defense. Clarens Legagneur added three tackles, 1.0 tackle for loss, and a forced fumble and fumble recovery. Taylor Bolesta tallied three tackles, 2.0 TFL, and a sack in the win.
- The Seawolves' four-game winning streak is the program's longest since 2018.
- The 4-1 start to the season matches Stony Brook's best start to a season since winning four of its first five contests to open the 2018 season.

OUTLOOK FOR THE WILDCATS

- Mark Ferrante enters his 8th season at the helm of the Wildcats. He owns a career record of 51-30, including 30-12 in his last four seasons.
- In the CAA Football head coaches preseason poll, Villanova was selected as the preseason league favorite and sixth year quarterback Connor Watkins was chosen as the CAA Football Preseason Offensive Player of the Year. Villanova had a league-high six players named to the league's Preseason All-Conference Team.
- David Avit was named CAA Rookie of the Week last week after rushing for 24 times with 160 yards and a touchdown. It was the most rushing yards by a true freshman in Villanova history since 1977.
- Brendan Bell and Shane Hartzell lead the defense with 42.0 and 39.0 tackles each.

GAINING NATIONAL ATTENTION

- The Seawolves have tallied votes in the AFCA and Stats Perform FCS Top-25 this week.
- In the CBS Sports FCS Top-25 poll, the Seawolves were ranked 24th for the first time this season.
- Stony Brook has tallied votes from the AFCA poll for the last three weeks and have been recognized on the Stats Perform list for the last two weeks.

Billy Cosh was named the third head coach in Stony Brook football's Division I era on December 13, 2023. Cosh joined Stony Brook for his first career head coaching job after spending the 2023 season at Western Michigan as the Broncos' offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach.

With Western Michigan in 2023, Cosh guided the Broncos to top-five ranks in the Mid-American Conference (MAC) in five different statistics – second in passing offense (211.2), third in total offense (365.0) and first downs (19.8), and fifth in scoring (23.7) and offensive efficiency (123.3).

Individually, WMU quarterback Hayden Wolff ranked first in the MAC in completion percentage, completing 65.5 percent of his passes. Wide receiver Kenneth Womack led the league with 6.3 receptions per game and 691 receiving yards. Freshman running back Jalen Buckley ranked third in the league with 91.2 rushing yards per game and tied for fourth with 10 rushing touchdowns.

Cosh's offense was well-represented in the MAC's postseason awards, taking two First Team selections and three Third Team picks, while Buckley was also garnered as the league's Freshman of the Year and later selected to The Athletic Freshman All-America Team.

Prior to Western Michigan, Cosh spent three years as an FCS offensive coordinator, most recently with Richmond in 2022. That season, the Spiders went 9-4 and earned a trip to the second round of the FCS Playoffs, scoring 31.3 points per game, third-most in the CAA.

In the FCS ranks, Richmond finished top-25 in 10 offensive statistics, including second in completion percentage (73.2%), fifth in total first downs (314), and tied for sixth in fewest interceptions thrown (5) in 2022.

Cosh came to Richmond from VMI, where he led the Keydets to top-20 FCS ranks in scoring offense and passing efficiency as the offensive coordinator during his final two seasons. In his first season as offensive coordinator in Lexington, Va., Cosh led the Keydets' offense to seven different top-two SoCon statistical ranks including scoring offense, passing offense and passing efficiency, as VMI took a SoCon title in 2020-21 under his Air Raid offense.

Before becoming an offensive coordinator at VMI, Cosh served as the wide receivers coach in the 2018 and 2019 seasons. He coached 1,000-yard receivers each season, and had three receivers in the top 10 of the SoCon in receiving along with four All-Conference selections among his wideouts during those two seasons.

He started his coaching career at Concord University (Md.) as an offensive graduate assistant and quarterbacks coach. Later, he served as a graduate assistant at Indiana, assisting with the passing game plan and working with quarterbacks and wide receivers, among other duties.

Cosh played five seasons of college football as a quarterback, playing at Houston (2013-14), Butler Community College (2012), James Madison (2011) and Kansas State (2010). He led Butler C.C. to the 2012 NJCCA National Championship, throwing for 2,856 yards and 25 touchdowns that season. He graduated with a degree in sociology from Houston in 2015.

A native of Gambrills, Md., Cosh is the son of long-time college football coach Chris Cosh, who recently served as defensive coordinator at Delaware (2017-19) and Hampton (2022), and most recently served as a senior analyst for Western Michigan in 2023. He and his wife Kelsey have a daughter, Charli.
