TONIGHT'S GAME

■ Villanova has won seven straight season openers dating back to the 2017 season. The streak coincides with the beginning of the **Mark Ferrante** head coaching era and is tied for the third longest active streak among FCS teams.

■ This is the second straight home game in which Villanova is playing Youngstown State. The teams met at Villanova Stadium in last year's playoffs and the Wildcats advanced to the quarterfinal round with a 45-28 victory.

■ The last time Villanova played its home opener against the same opponent it had played in its final home game the year before was in 1968 and 1969 against West Chester.

■ Villanova is the defending CAA Football champion and was picked to repeat atop the league standings in a preseason poll of league head coaches. Starting quarterback **Connor Watkins** was named the league's Preseason Offensive Player of the Year, while he and five others earned Preseason All-CAA accolades.

■ In the Wildcats FCA era (since 1985), the team is 21-18 in season openers. Only two of the 18 losses have come to FCS foes as the team frequently has began the season by playing an FBS opponent.

■ Thursday night's game marks the first time since 2003 that Villanova is opening the season with a weeknight home game against a foe from out of state.

VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK

KICKING IT OFF

- Villanova opens its 127th season of varsity football with Thursday night's game against Youngstown State. It is only the second time in the last 20 years that the Wildcats will open with a home game, as well as the first time since 2003 that Villanova plays a home season opener against an out-of-state opponent. Dating back to 1985 when the Wildcats became an FCS program, the team is 21-18 in season openers. Just two of the 18 losses have come to other FCS opponents, as Villanova has frequently opened its season by stepping up in level versus an FBS foe.

STARTING OFF STRONG

- Villanova has won each of its last seven season openers, a winning streak that happens to coincide with the beginning of the **Mark Ferrante** head coaching era. The streak of seven straight season-opening wins is tied for the third-longest among FCS teams and is the longest in CAA Football entering the 2024 campaign.

LAST YEAR, RIGHT HERE

- Thursday night's season opener will be Youngstown State's second straight game at Villanova Stadium after the Wildcats and Penguins faced each other in a second round playoff game last season. Villanova won that game, 45-28, on December 2, 2023 and advanced to the quarterfinals by posting its first victory over Youngstown State since 1978. The last time the Penguins played a regular season game at Villanova Stadium was in 1999.

THAT HASN'T HAPPENED IN A WHILE

- The last time Villanova played its home opener against the same opponent as it hosted in the final home game of the previous season was in 1968 and 1969 against West Chester. The Wildcats tallied a 63-3 win over their local foes in the final home game of the 1968 campaign and defeated the Golden Rams, 41-14, in the 1969 home opener.

TOP 25 MATCHUP

- Villanova is ranked No. 6 and Youngstown State comes in at No. 25 in the Stats Perform FCS Preseason Top 25 Poll. The matchup of the two teams is the only FCS Top 25 battle during the first week of the regular season. During the Mark Ferrante head coaching era the Wildcats are 13-12 against FCS ranked opponents, including a 6-3 mark in home games versus ranked foes. Thursday night's game will be the first time since Ferrante's head coaching debut in 2017 that Villanova begins the season in a matchup of FCS Top 25 teams. In the 2017 opener, the No. 10 Wildcats defeated No. 17 Lehigh in a 38-35 thriller.

VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK

LOOKING BACK TO LAST YEAR

- Villanova faced Youngstown State in last year's playoffs for the first time since a 1999 regular season game and for the fourth time since 1991 in a playoff setting. For the first time in the four playoff meetings the Wildcats came out on top with a 45-28 victory to advance to the quarterfinal round. Villanova had not beaten Youngstown State since 1978, prior to the Wildcats becoming an FCS program.
- The difference in the game came down to 21 unanswered points scored by Villanova in a stretch of nearly 16 minutes that spanned most of the second quarter and the early part of the third period. After the Penguins went ahead 10-7 in the opening minute of the second quarter, Villanova answered at the 11:36 mark of the period to take the lead for good at 14-10.
- Wildcats quarterback **Connor Watkins** led the way with 331 yards of total offense and three total touchdowns. He was 12-of-21 through the air for 275 yards, including half of his completions going for 20 yards or longer. Watkins also rushed nine times for 56 yards and two touchdowns. He threw a 64-yard touchdown pass to wide receiver **Jaylan Sanchez** (2 catches, 91 yards), while running back **Jalen Jackson** ran for 81 yards and two scores.
- Linebacker **Shane Hartzell** paced a strong defensive effort by the Wildcats last week with a season-high 14 tackles, including seven solo stops and seven assisted tackles. Hartzell and linebacker **Brendan Bell** each registered a career-high three quarterback hurries. Cornerback **Isas Waxter** recorded an interception for the second straight game and **Christian Sapp** also notched his second pick of the season. The team defensive effort included six tackles for loss, three sacks, three pass breakups and six quarterback hurries.

CAA FAVORITES

- Villanova is the defending CAA Football co-champion and earned last season's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs. In a preseason poll of league head coaches, the Wildcats are considered the favorite to finish atop the league standings once again in 2024. Villanova received nine first-place votes and a total of 217 points in the preseason poll to finish ahead of Richmond (one first-place vote, 189 points) and UAlbany (three first-place votes, 179 points).

CAA PRESEASON HONORS

- Starting quarterback **Connor Watkins** was named the CAA Football Preseason Offensive Player of the Year and was one of a league-high six Wildcats who were selected to the CAA Football Preseason All-Conference Team. The other preseason league honorees are offensive lineman **Temí Ajiro-tutu**, linebackers **Brendan Bell** and **Shane Hartzell**, cornerback **Isas Waxter** and safety **Ty Trinh**. Wide receiver Jaylan Sanchez was an honorable mention preseason pick.

PRESEASON NATIONAL HONORS

- Villanova quarterback **Connor Watkins** and cornerback **Isas Waxter** were named to the preseason watch lists for the Walter Payton Award and the Buck Buchanan Award which are presented to the top FCS offensive and defensive player each year. Waxter was also named to the Senior Bowl Watch List, while he and linebacker **Shane Hartzell** earned preseason All-America honors from both Stats Perform and Phil Steele.

VILLANOVA UNIVERSITY

ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Villanova University has a long and storied athletics history defined by excellence both in competition and in the classroom. The Villanova Athletics Department is a community of student-athletes, coaches and staff whose primary focus is to achieve academic excellence, while striving to produce teams and individuals committed to athletic competition and outstanding performance. Villanova Athletics sponsors 24 varsity sports, which together include more than 500 student-athletes. In the classroom, these Villanova student-athletes have registered a grade-point average higher than a 3.0 for 42 consecutive semesters. Three Villanova student-athletes have been named Rhodes Scholars, with numerous others earning Academic All-America distinction. Villanova's athletics history includes 21 NCAA team national championships, as well as more than 100 conference championships. In addition, at least one Villanovan has participated in every Summer Olympics since 1948. Villanova is a member of the BIG EAST Conference, CAA Football, Coastal Athletic Association (Rowing) and Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (Water Polo).

ACADEMICS

The GPA for more than 500 student-athletes during the Spring 2024 semester was 3.489, making it 13 straight semesters that student-athletes have had a GPA of 3.3 or higher. Success in the classroom has been across-the-board for Villanova Athletics, with every one of the 24 varsity sports programs posting a team GPA over a 3.0 in each of the last five semesters.

The most recent NCAA data to be released was the Academic Progress Rate (APR) update in June 2024 in which Villanova Athletics had 13 teams achieve a perfect 1000 score. Only seven Division I schools nationwide and four outside of the Ivy League had as many as 13 teams with a perfect 1000 score. Villanova's overall multi-year score rose one point to 997. The football team's score of 982 led all CAA schools.

VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK

ENTERING WITH EXPERIENCE

■ Villanova begins the 2024 season with a veteran roster that has combined for 976 career games played in college football. After going 10-3 last season, including 7-1 in conference play, and reaching the quarterfinal round of the FCS playoffs, the Wildcats return a total of 11 starters on this year's roster. On the offensive side of the ball, starting quarterback **Connor Watkins** is back along with wide receiver **Jaylan Sanchez**, tight end **Antonio Johnson** and a trio of offensive linemen in **Temi Ajitutu**, **Stephane Voltaire** and **Jake Picard**. On the defensive side, the returning starters include linebackers **Brendan Bell** and **Shane Hartzell** along with cornerback **Isas Waxter** and safeties **Jalen Goodman** and **Ty Trinh**.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

■ Villanova has gone 19-4 (.826) against non-conference FCS opponents since 2016, including a perfect 16-0 regular season record. The trend continued last year with wins over Lehigh (38-10) and Colgate (42-19) to begin the season. The Wildcats have not lost a regular season game to a non-CAA Football team since a 24-13 loss to Penn on September 24, 2015.

SCORING FIRST

■ One of the keys to Villanova's success last season was its ability to get off to fast starts. The Wildcats scored first in 11 of their 13 games in 2023 and nine times put points on the board within the first eight minutes of the game. During **Mark Ferrante's** head coaching tenure, Villanova is 41-10 when it scores first. The Wildcats have grabbed the lead by the end of the first quarter in 46 of Ferrante's 76 career games as a head coach.

FIVE YEARS OF SUCCESS

■ Villanova has the most wins and the highest winning percentage of any current CAA Football school dating back to the start of the 2019 season. In the five-year stretch, the Wildcats have a record of 37-17 (.685) and have gone 25-11 (.694) versus league foes.

REGULAR SEASON SUCCESS

■ Villanova compiled a 9-2 regular season record last year for the second time in the past three seasons. Prior to 2021 the Wildcats had not had a two-loss regular season since posting a 10-2 mark during in 2014. Last year marked the eighth season overall with no more than two regular season losses since Villanova joined a conference in 1988.

ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

NCAA ACADEMIC DATA

■ Each year the NCAA recognizes programs that have a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranks within the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. Villanova has earned this award nine times in the 18-year history of the APR program.

■ In the most recent APR data released in June 2024 the football program's multi-year APR score of 982 was 25 points above the national average for FCS programs.

■ New data on the NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) was released in December 2023 and Villanova led all CAA Football schools while matching a program record at 96 percent.

ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

■ One of the highest honors that a student-athlete can achieve is to be named an Academic All-American, an award which encompasses both academic achievement as well as contributions on the field. Villanova has had 12 football student-athletes earn a total of 14 Academic All-America honors over the years.

CAA TEAM ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

■ Villanova has been the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award four times in the last eight years. The award is presented at the end of each academic year to the conference school with the highest team GPA.

CAA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

■ Villanova has had five student-athletes be named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Nominees for the award must have attained senior standing academically and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

CAA ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

■ Student-athletes with a semester GPA of 3.0 or higher are named to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll. Villanova had 62 honorees for the Fall 2022 semester and 63 student-athletes achieve this distinction for the Spring 2023 term.

ACADEMIC ALL-AREA TEAMS

■ In conjunction with the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, the sports information directors at the colleges and universities in the Philadelphia area (PhillySIDA) name an Academic All-Area team and a football Performer of the Year each season. In the 17 years of the Academic All-Area program, which started with the 2005-06 academic year, the football team has had a total of 60 selections to the Academic All-Area Team. In addition, the Wildcats have had five Performers of the Year.

VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE



Mark Ferrante enters his eighth season as the Thomas and Diane Treacy Endowed Football Head Coach in 2024 and is in his 38th year overall with the Wildcats including his time as head coach and 30 years prior as an assistant coach from 1987-2016. He has been a part of 264 victories and all 15 of the program's FCS playoff appearances during his Villanova tenure. Entering the 2024 season Ferrante has a career head coaching record of 47-29 (.618) which includes 30 regular season CAA Football wins, two league titles and three playoff appearances.

Under Ferrante's watch, the Wildcats have won a share of the CAA Football title and earned the league's automatic bid to the Division I Football Championship in two of the last three seasons. He guided Villanova to its latest conference championship and postseason berth in 2023 when the team went 10-3 and reached the quarterfinal round of the playoffs. The season included three wins over nationally-ranked opponents and the Wildcats clinched their CAA title and automatic playoff bid with a dominant 35-7 win at No. 7 Delaware in the final game of the regular season. Despite being picked to finish seventh in the CAA and not appearing in the pre-season national rankings, Villanova emerged from the year as conference champions and finished the 2023 campaign ranked No. 6 in the final Stats Perform poll of the season.

There was plenty of recognition to go around for a Villanova team which excelled in every facet of the game a year ago. For the third time in the past five seasons the Wildcats had at least 10 players selected to the CAA Football All-Conference teams, led by offensive lineman Michael Corbi and wide receiver Rayjuon Pringle on the first team. Villanova had a dozen all-conference honorees overall, with players on the second team to go along with three third team choices and two honorable mention selections. Corbi went on to be named an All-American by Stats Perform and Phil Steele, while Pringle (Phil Steele) and cornerback Isas Waxter (FCS Football Central) also earned All-America recognition.

In his first seven seasons as head coach, Ferrante has seen the Wildcats win five CAA Football major awards and earn a total of 52 all-conference accolades. Three players under Ferrante's watch - Corbi, cornerback Christian Benford and linebacker Forrest Rhyne - have earned All-America honors from Stats Perform and/or the American Football Coaches Association. Benford and Rhyne were first team All-Americans in 2021. Ferrante is himself one of the CAA Football major award winners after earning his first Coach of the Year honor in 2021.

Villanova had a breakthrough 2021 season which included a conference title and a top-eight seed in the FCS playoffs. In addition to being named the CAA Football Coach of the Year, Ferrante was the 2021 winner of the AFCA FCS Region 1 Coach of the Year award. That honor made him a finalist for National Coach of the Year consideration and earned him recognition at the AFCA national convention following the season. Ferrante guided the Wildcats to a 10-3 record in 2021 and Villanova won a share of the CAA Football title while reaching the playoffs for the second time in his head coaching tenure (2019, 2021).

Ferrante's 2021 squad was the first Wildcats team in seven years to finish the season ranked in the top-10 of both FCS national polls. Villanova came in at No. 8 in the final Stats Perform and AFCS FCS Top 25 rankings while tallying their seventh season in program history with 10 or more victories. The team hosted two playoff games and achieved success by playing - and beating - some of the top FCS teams in the nation. Villanova's 10-3 record was punctuated by four victories over Top 25 opponents, including No. 3 James Madison, No. 18 Rhode Island, No. 21 Richmond and No. 24 Holy Cross. Ferrante led the Wildcats to a 7-1 record against a challenging CAA Football schedule to mark the fifth season since 1988 in which the team had no more than one loss in conference play.

Villanova's league championship teams in 2021 and 2023 featured several players who had an opportunity to continue their football careers beyond the collegiate ranks. Following the 2023 season, running back Jalen Jackson and offensive lineman Nick Torres signed free agent contracts with the Jacksonville Jaguars and the Kansas City Chiefs, respectively. Three other players - running back TD Ayodurojaiye (Chicago Bears/Kansas City Chiefs), linebacker Danny Abraham (Seattle Seahawks) and wide receiver Jaaron Hayek (Kansas City Chiefs) - were invited to attend NFL rookie mini camps.

VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

MARK FERRANTE / VILLANOVA COACHING STAFF

Ferrante coached 11 players on the 2021 team who had professional opportunities, led by Christian Benford who was a sixth round draft pick of the Buffalo Bills and has since gone on to have a successful NFL career in Buffalo. In addition, 2021 CAA Football Defensive Player of the Year and first team All-American Forrest Rhyne signed a free agent contract and played in the NFL with the Indianapolis Colts. Cornerback Denzel Williams signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Ravens.

One of the theme's of Ferrante's head coaching tenure has been his ability to keep his teams largely intact throughout the COVID pandemic and the changing landscape of college sports. Villanova began the 2021 season with 75 out of 85 players returning from the previous Spring, while the members of the 2023 team had combined to play in more than 1,000 college football games even before the season started. Experience wins, and Nova Nation has taken notice. Villanova's average attendance for five regular season home games in 2021 was its highest mark since 2013 and represented a 23 percent increase from 2019 prior to the pandemic. The increased attendance included the Wildcats first home sellout crowd since 2015 during the 2021 Family Weekend game against Richmond.

Ferrante has continually stressed the importance of his student-athletes coming to Villanova for a complete collegiate experience which includes excellence in their academic pursuits. In his first seven years as head coach, the Wildcats have been the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award three times. The award is presented to the team with the highest GPA in the conference each academic year and Villanova has been a repeat winner of the honor for both the 2022-23 and 2023-24 academic years.

The football program has set and tied its highest overall NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) with a mark of 96 percent in each of the past two years. The most recent NCAA GSR data was released in December 2023 and the Wildcats had the highest score among CAA Football teams in both the NCAA metric and the federal rate calculation (93 percent). Additionally, new NCAA Academic Progress Rate (APR) data was released in June 2024 and Villanova's multi-year score of 982 was tied for second among CAA schools.

While winning the CAA Football title in 2023, the Wildcats had 59 student-athletes selected to the CAA Football Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll during the Fall semester and another 56 honorees for the Spring 2024 grading period.

Three student-athletes during the academic year were recognized as High Honors with Distinction for having a perfect 4.0 semester GPA: Nathan Fondacaro achieved this distinction in the Fall, while Tim Brown and Jake Picard did the same in the Spring. Villanova has had more than 650 selections to the CAA Football Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll during Ferrante's head coaching tenure and has had more than 550 selections to the Athletic Director's Honor Roll which is announced each semester for student-athletes who post a GPA of 3.2 or higher during the grading period.

In addition to Benford being an NFL Draft pick and the aforementioned NFL free agent contracts signed by Jackson, Torres, Rhyne and Williams, six players signed free agent contracts earlier in Ferrante's head coaching tenure. The list includes offensive tackle Brandon Hitner (LA Rams); safety Rob Rolle (Miami Dolphins); offensive lineman Ethan Greenidge (New Orleans Saints); defensive back Trey Johnson (Pittsburgh Steelers); defensive back Malik Reaves (Kansas City Chiefs); and linebacker Ed Shockley (Dallas Cowboys).

Ferrante leads one of the nation's elite FCS programs after playing an instrumental role in the Wildcats rise to national prominence. He has been a part of the coaching staff for all 15 of Villanova's appearances in the FCS playoffs, including the 2009 national championship season and a 2010 semifinal appearance while serving as the Assistant Head Coach on Andy Talley's staff. Ferrante has been a part of Villanova teams that have won eight CAA titles, three Lambert Mead-owlands Cups and three ECAC Team of the Year awards.

Ferrante's success during his years as an assistant coach were recognized by others outside the Villanova program. At the end of the 2015 season he was named the FCS Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA). This award was first presented in 1997 and was created to honor assistant coaches who excel in community service, commitment to student-athletes and on-field coaching success.

Ferrante was a standout collegiate performer in his own right prior to joining the football coaching ranks. He was the quarterback for Andy Talley at St. Lawrence where he was named the 1982 Division III Player of the Year to go along with first team All-East honors. Ferrante directed the offense for a St. Lawrence team that went 10-1 during the 1982 season and reached the national semifinals in the playoffs.


