TODAY'S GAME

■ Home. Sweet. Home. After playing on the road in four of the past five weeks, Villanova hosts Hampton this week and kicks off a stretch of playing four of the last five regular season games at home.

■ Speaking of Villanova Stadium, the Wildcats current home winning streak of 18 games since the midpoint of the 2022 season is the longest in school history and the second-longest active home winning streak among all FCS teams, trailing only South Dakota's State's 33 straight.

■ The nation's top kick returner this season is junior **Ja'briel Mace** who tallied his second kickoff return touchdown last week at Elon with a 97-yard burst. Mace is the only FCS player with two kickoff returns for scores this year. He leads the FCS with 500 yards on 15 kickoff returns and is second in the country with an average of 33.3 yards per return. His two touchdowns have come in the span of the last three games. It is the first time the Wildcats have had two kickoff return scores in the span of three games in their FCS era (since 1985).

■ Fifth year collegian **Luke Colella** became the first Villanova player in 15 years to have at least 10 receptions in a game when he caught a career high 10 passes for 125 yards and his first two touchdowns of the season in last week's win at Elon. Colella is in his first year with the Wildcats after playing the past four years at Princeton. He has been an instant star for Villanova and has 40 catches for 596 yards and two scores on the season. He has topped the 100-yard mark three times in the last four games and four times overall this season.

VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK

TODAY'S GAME

- Villanova returns home this week to face Hampton on Saturday afternoon in a 1 p.m. kickoff. The game will be televised locally on NBCSP+ and streams live on FloCollege. **Mike Samsel** and **Steve Pinone** will be in the booth and **Tessa Peloso** on the sidelines. The radio broadcast on the Villanova Sports Radio Network can be heard on Fox Sports Radio Philly which is accessible on mobile devices via the iHeart radio app. Villanova football alum and Varsity Club Hall of Famer **Brett Gordon** joins **Ryan Fannon** on this week's call.

ABOUT VILLANOVA

- Villanova has won three straight conference games over William & Mary (31-24), New Hampshire (37-7) and Elon (29-21) over the past three weeks to improve its record on the year to 4-2 overall and 3-1 in CAA games. The streak has lifted the Wildcats into third place in the league standings halfway through the conference schedule. There has been no shortage of key storylines from the three game winning streak, but among the biggest factors in the team's success has been the play of the defense. Villanova has given up 17.3 points per game during the winning streak compared with allowing 40.0 points per contest in its first three games of the year.

ABOUT HAMPTON

- Hampton is 2-5 overall this season and winless (0-3) in conference play after suffering a 38-21 defeat at home against Campbell last week. The Pirates have scored 13 of their 19 offensive touchdowns this season on the ground and are averaging 184.4 rushing yards per contest thanks to the trio of running back **Jah'Kei Chavis**, quarterback **Isaiah Freeman** and running back **Ja'Quan Snipes** who have all run for over 200 yards on the year. Chavis is leading the way with 281 yards and three scores. Hampton has been notably strong on special teams with redshirt sophomore placekicker **Brett Starling** making all 19 of his PAT attempts in addition to 9-of-10 field goals.

SERIES STUFF

- The all-time series between Villanova and Hampton is a limited one, although the teams did face each other last year in Norfolk when the Wildcats tallied a 20-14 win. Villanova leads the series by a 3-0 margin, including a non-conference win back in 2003 in addition to a pair of triumphs in 2022 and 2024 since the Pirates joined CAA Football.

HOME. SWEET. HOME.

- Villanova has played on the road in four of the past five weeks in travels that have taken **Mark Ferrante** and his team to Penn State, Monmouth, New Hampshire and Elon. The script is flipped the rest of the way during the regular season as the Wildcats will now play four of their last five games at home while only making one short trip to Towson on November 8. The home stretch kicks off with this week's contest against Hampton followed by Homecoming Weekend and a date with UAlbany on October 25.

HOME IS WHERE THE WINS ARE

- Speaking of the friendly confines of Villanova Stadium, the Wildcats have won 18 straight home games since the middle of the 2022 season. It is the longest home winning streak in program history and the second-longest active home win streak in the FCS, trailing only a 33-game streak by South Dakota State. This is the 99th season for VU at its venerable on-campus home, where the Wildcats are 273-112-5 (.706) all-time.

VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK

KICK IT HERE, RETURN IT THERE

- Not only is junior running back and kick return extraordinaire **Ja'briel Mace** the only FCS player with two kickoff return touchdowns this season, he is just the fifth player in school history to have at least two *career* kick returns for scores. Mace gave Villanova the lead for good in its win at Elon last week with a 97-yard return for a touchdown at the 5:10 mark of the fourth quarter. It was just two weeks earlier that Mace had run a kickoff back 100 yards for a TD against William & Mary to break a six-year drought of the Wildcats not having a kick return score. The last player before Mace with a kickoff return touchdown was *Nowoola Awopetu* who had a 100 yard return against Richmond in 2019.

TWO OUT OF THREE AIN'T BAD

- The exploits of **Ja'briel Mace** over the past three weeks make him the third player in school history to have two kickoff return touchdowns in a season. The others are *Brian Westbrook* in 2000 and *Angelo Babbaro* in 2010. Mace's two kick return scores have come in a span of just three games and it is the first time in Villanova's FCS era (since 1985) that the team has had two special teams touchdowns in a three-game span. The previous shortest gap between special teams TDs was in 2010 when Babbaro recorded his two kickoff return scores in a span of four games against Delaware and Eastern Washington.

EVEN MORE RETURN REDUX

- **Ja'briel Mace** ranks first in the nation with his 500 kickoff return yards and two return touchdowns this season. His average of 33.3 yards per return is second in the country and he is bidding to become the first Villanova player to average better than 30 yards on kickoff returns (minimum nine attempts) over a full season since *Bob Dunn* averaged 32.5 yards during the 1963 season. Mace joins *Brian Westbrook* as the only players in school history to have two career plays of any kind for 97 yards or longer. Westbrook had kickoff returns of 99 yards and 98 yards during his career, both in 2001.

MISTER VERSATILITY

- The same explosive speed that makes **Ja'briel Mace** an instant scoring threat on kickoff returns also makes him one of the most versatile players on the Villanova roster. He leads the Wildcats with an average of 104.3 all-purpose yards per game thanks to 500 kickoff return yards, 81 rushing yards for two touchdowns and 45 receiving yards plus a score. In the game at New Hampshire on October 4, Mace scored a career high three TDs on a 31-yard pass play, a two-yard rush, and a one-yard run on a direct snap to him. Mace's 100 yard kickoff return in the William & Mary game was only the eighth player of any kind in school history and the sixth kick return for at least 100 yards.

KEEPING IT 100

- Villanova has a trio of players who are all averaging better than 100 all-purpose yards per game this season. The list begins with **Ja'brriel Mace** who is averaging 104.3 yards per contest, just ahead of sophomore running back **David Avit** at 102.8 all-purpose yards per game and graduate wide receiver **Luke Colella** who is averaging 101.8 all-purpose yards. The only other FCS team in the country that has three players over 100 yards per game is Lehigh.

CATCHING ON

- Fifth year collegian **Luke Colella** had a career high 10 receptions for 125 yards and his first two touchdowns of the season at Elon last week. He is the first Villanova player since *Matt Szczur* against Stephen F. Austin in 2010 to reach double digits in catches in a single contest. Colella has emerged as the top receiver for the Wildcats this season and he has totaled 40 receptions for 596 yards and two touchdowns through the first six games of the season. Colella ranks in the top 10 nationally in receiving yards per game (5th, 99.3); receptions per game (6th, 6.67); and receiving yards (8th, 596).

CENTURY MARK RECEIVER

- **Luke Colella** has topped 100 receiving yards in each of the last two games, three of the last four contests and four times overall this season. The four 100-yard receiving games are already tied for the fifth most in a season in school history, with Colella the first to achieve it since *Rayjuon Pringle* in 2023. The last time a Villanova player had more than four 100-yard receiving games in a season was in 1999 when Varsity Club Hall of Famer *Murle Sango* had six 100-yard games. Over his last four games alone, Colella has caught 34 passes for 469 yards while averaging 8.5 receptions per contest.
- Including his four years at Princeton and this season at Villanova, Colella's career stats at the collegiate level are 34 games played and 133 receptions for 1,784 yards and 13 scores.

LEADING THE WAY

- Villanova head coach **Mark Ferrante** is 39-25 (.609) in regular season CAA Football games during his head coaching career. The win total in league play is the most among the 14 current CAA head coaches, one more than the 38 wins for William & Mary head coach *Mike London*. Ferrante is in his ninth season as head coach of the Wildcats and owns an overall record of 61-35 (.635) with a share of two CAA Football titles and four playoff appearances.

VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK

DEFENSIVE DOINGS

- One of the biggest storylines for the Wildcats over the last three weeks has been the play of its defense, especially compared with the first three games of the season. Below are some of the numbers which illustrate the team's turnaround on defense.

VILLANOVA DEFENSE: FIRST THREE GAMES VERSUS LAST THREE

First Three Games (Colgate, Penn State, Monmouth; 1-2 record)

- ◆ 484.0 yards per game allowed
- ◆ 40.0 points per game allowed
- ◆ Only one total sack recorded
- ◆ Only five total tackles for loss

Last Three Games (William & Mary, New Hampshire, Elon; 3-0 record)

- ◆ 302.3 yards per game allowed
- ◆ 17.3 points per game allowed
- ◆ Nine total sacks recorded (three in each game)
- ◆ 17 total tackles for loss

PROTECTING POSSESSIONS

- Villanova leads CAA Football and ranks fifth nationally with just three turnovers lost this season. That includes each of the last three games in which the Wildcats have not committed a single turnover. Villanova similarly had a three-game stretch last year in which it did not commit a turnover, but there has not been a four-game streak without a miscue in at least 20 years based on immediately available data.

FANTASTIC FIVE

- Villanova has compiled a record of 40-17 (.702) over the last five seasons (2021-25) while making three playoff appearances and winning 10+ games three times. At the start of the season the Wildcats were one of six FCS teams to have won 10 or more games in at least three of the last four years, while in terms of winning percentage Villanova ranked 12th among all FCS teams since the start of the 2021 season. Its 39 wins in the same span of time are the most of any CAA Football member.

DECADE OF DOMINANCE

- Villanova is the only current CAA Football member to have won at least 70 games over the past decade (2015-25). In this stretch the Wildcats have an overall record of 75-43 (.636) and have gone 49-30 (.620) in regular season conference games while making the playoffs five times.

STREAK CONTINUES

- Sixth year collegian **Lucas Kopecky** has caught at least one pass in all 17 college football games he has played in. He extended the streak with two catches for 51 yards at Elon last week, including a deft 44-yard grab along the sideline on the second play of a fourth quarter scoring drive. Kopecky surpassed 500 career receiving yards during the game and now has 40 career catches for 539 yards and three touchdowns. He played four years of lacrosse for Villanova (2021-24) and appeared in 40 games before walking on to the football team as a graduate student before the 2024 season. He was a three-year football letterwinner at Montgomery (N.J.) High School in his scholastic career, earning two all-conference and two honorable mention all-state accolades. Kopecky was third on the team last year with 26 catches for 302 yards and two touchdowns in his gridiron debut.

RECEIVING LINE

- Villanova has had at least seven different receivers catch a pass in each of the first six games of the 2025 season. It is the first time the Wildcats have had a stretch like this since a span of six games during the 2014 season (September 6-October 18). Villanova has had a dozen different players catch at least one pass this year. The team has completed 112 passes overall with 82 caught by wide receivers, 19 by running backs and nine by tight ends. One pass was also caught by redshirt freshman linebacker **Omari Bursey** on a fake punt at New Hampshire on October 4.

VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK

ALL ABOUT AVIT

- Sophomore running back **David Avit** rushed for over 100 yards in three straight games against Monmouth, William & Mary and New Hampshire from September 20 through October 4. During that three-game stretch he amassed 370 rushing yards and seven TDs, including consecutive games against Monmouth and William & Mary in which he scored three touchdowns apiece.
- Avit leads CAA Football and ranks 12th nationally with his seven rushing touchdowns this year, all of which have come in the last four weeks. He ranks in the top 20 nationally in average yards per game (19th, 89.2) and total rushing yards (20th, 535).
- Avit's career totals are up to 1,458 yards and 16 touchdowns in just 20 games played at the collegiate level. He has also recorded 19 receptions for another 257 yards and has caught a pass in every game this season.

RUSHING FOR 1,000

- Sophomore running back **David Avit** became the 43rd player in school history to reach 1,000 career rushing yards during the September 13 game at Penn State. It took just 16 career games played for Avit to reach the 1,000 plateau. The only players in Villanova history who have gotten to 1,000 rushing yards in fewer games are quarterback *John Robertson* (2011-15) who needed 14 games and running back *Gene Filipski* (1952-53) who reached the milestone in just 11 games. Avit was a finalist for last year's Jerry Rice Award which is presented to the top freshman in the FCS. He ranked third among FCS freshmen with 923 rushing yards last season and is on the watch list for this year's Walter Payton Award.

VILLANOVA FOOTBALL HISTORY

- Villanova has compiled a 291-172-1 (.628) record in 40 seasons as an FCS member. The program's success includes 16 appearances in the FCS playoffs and appearing in the final national rankings of the season 19 times in the last 36 years.

ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Since 1842, Villanova University's Augustinian Catholic intellectual tradition has been the cornerstone of an academic community in which students learn to think critically, act compassionately and succeed while serving others. There are more than 10,000 undergraduate, graduate and law students in the University's six colleges – the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, the Villanova School of Business, the College of Engineering, the M. Louise Fitzpatrick College of Nursing, the College of Professional Studies and the Villanova University Charles Widger School of Law. Ranked among the nation's top universities, Villanova supports its students' intellectual growth and prepares them to become ethical leaders who create positive change everywhere life takes them.

VILLANOVA ATHLETICS

Villanova University has a long and storied athletics history defined by excellence both in competition and in the classroom. The Villanova Athletics Department is a community of student-athletes, coaches and staff whose primary focus is to achieve academic excellence, while striving to produce teams and individuals committed to athletic competition and outstanding performance. Villanova Athletics sponsors 24 varsity sports, which together include more than 550 student-athletes. In the classroom, these Villanova student-athletes have registered a grade-point average higher than a 3.0 for 44 consecutive semesters. Three Villanova student-athletes have been named Rhodes Scholars, with numerous others earning Academic All-America distinction. Villanova's athletics history includes 21 NCAA team national championships, as well as more than 100 conference championships. In addition, at least one Villanovan has participated in every Summer Olympics since 1948. Villanova is a member of the BIG EAST Conference, CAA Football, Coastal Athletic Association (Rowing) and Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (Water Polo).

ACADEMICS

The GPA for more than 550 student-athletes in the Spring 2025 semester was 3.495, making it 15 straight semesters that student-athletes have had a GPA of 3.3 or higher. Success in the classroom has been across-the-board for Villanova Athletics, with 87 percent of all student-athletes compiling a GPA of 3.0 or higher and 73 student-athletes from 18 sports maintaining a perfect 4.0 GPA.

The most recent NCAA data to be released was the Academic Progress Rate (APR) update in May 2025 in which Villanova Athletics had 14 earn public recognition for having a multiyear APR score which ranks in the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. That included 13 teams who had a perfect score of 1000, making it eight straight years that the Wildcats have had 10 or more teams achieve a multi-year score of 1000.

VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK

POLLING PLACES

- Villanova is ranked No. 15 in this week's Stats Perform FCS Top 25 and comes in at No. 14 in the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll. This year is the 33rd time in the last 38 seasons that the Wildcats have been nationally ranked at some point during the season.
- Villanova ranks fourth among all teams in FCS history (since 1978) for the number of weeks appearing in the national media poll. In their 332 weeks being nationally ranked, the Wildcats have been in the top 10 for a total of 153 weeks (11th most all-time) and have been ranked in the top five for 66 weeks.

VETERAN EXPERIENCE

- Villanova has 93 players on its 2025 roster and they have played in a combined 1,421 games in their collegiate careers. Leading the way for the Wildcats are 18 players who have played in at least 30 career games, including nine who have played 40 or more. Villanova has six new graduate transfers on the team this year and each played in at least two dozen games prior to arriving on the Main Line. The six are punter **Luke Larsen (East Carolina)**; placekicker **Jack Barnum (Central Connecticut State)**; wide receiver **Luke Colella (Princeton)**; quarterback **Pat McQuaide (Nicholls)**; and defensive backs **Jordan Adderley (Lehigh)** and **Julian Talley (Penn)**.

RECORD-SETTING DEBUT

- No Villanova quarterback has ever thrown for 300 yards in his first start for the team. However, the last two signal callers to debut for the Wildcats have thrown for 298 and 299 yards, respectively. Graduate student **Pat McQuaide**, a transfer from Nicholls, made his first start for VU against Colgate on September 6 and threw for 299 yards and a score. He surpassed the previous school record for most passing yards in the first start for the team which was held for the past three years by **Connor Watkins**, the starter from 2022-24 who threw for 298 yards in his first career start against Lehigh to open the 2022 season. McQuaide is also just the third left-handed quarterback to start for Villanova in their FCS era. The others are *Christian Culicerto (2011)* and *Zach Bednarczyk (2015-18)*.

MORE ON MCQUAIDE

- In addition to setting a record for most passing yards by a quarterback in his first VU start, **Pat McQuaide** became the third straight Villanova starter to win his debut while throwing for over 200 yards and recording at least one passing and rushing touchdown.

ENTERING WITH LIFE EXPERIENCE

- The oldest active player in Division I college football this season is Villanova punter **Luke Larsen** who recently turned 33 years old and made his Wildcats debut in the season opener against Colgate. Larsen is a graduate student transfer from East Carolina and a native of Australia who played Australian Rules Football, volleyball, cricket and tennis during his scholastic career prior to coming to the United States.
- Larsen is off to a strong start for Villanova and has punted 21 times through the first six games of the season. He is averaging 40.2 yards per punt with two attempts for over 50 yards and five that have been downed inside the opponent's 20-yard line. Larsen previously appeared in 43 games at East Carolina and punted 174 times while averaging 40.8 yards per punt. He landed 51 punts inside the 20-yard line, booted 19 punts for 50+ yards and had 75 of 174 attempts fair caught. He ranked second all-time in net punting for the Pirates and was a two-time National Football Foundation Honor Society member.

PRESEASON WATCH LISTS

- Sophomore running back **David Avit** and senior linebacker **Shane Hartzell** have been named to the preseason watch lists for the Walter Payton Award and the Buck Buchanan Award, respectively. These national honors are given to the top offensive and defensive players in the FCS at the end of each season. Villanova is one of 10 teams to have at least one player on both watch lists at the start of the season. The others are Harvard, Illinois State, Montana, Montana State, North Dakota State, Rhode Island, Samford, South Dakota State and UIW.

POSTSEASON SUCCESS

- Villanova is tied for 10th in FCS history with 16 playoff appearances. In their FCS playoff history, the Wildcats have a record of 15-15 with one national championship (2009) and three semifinal berths (2002, 2009, 2010). Villanova has won at least one playoff game in 10 of its last 12 postseason appearances. The 15 playoff wins for the Wildcats are tied for the 12th most ever among current FCS programs.

ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

NCAA ACADEMIC DATA

■ Each year the NCAA recognizes programs that have a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranks within the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. Villanova has earned this award nine times in the 18-year history of the APR program.

■ In the most recent APR data released in June 2025 the football program's multi-year APR score of 982 was 24 points above the national average for FCS programs.

■ New data on the NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) was released in November 2024 and Villanova recorded its fourth straight year with a score of 95 percent or higher.

ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

■ One of the highest honors that a student-athlete can achieve is to be named an Academic All-American, an award which encompasses both academic achievement as well as contributions on the field. Villanova has had 12 football student-athletes earn a total of 14 Academic All-America honors over the years.

CAA TEAM ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

■ Villanova has been the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award five times in the last nine years. The award is presented at the end of each academic year to the conference school with the highest team GPA.

CAA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

■ Villanova has had five student-athletes be named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Nominees for the award must have attained senior standing academically and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

CAA ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

■ Student-athletes with a semester GPA of 3.0 or higher are named to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll. Villanova had 63 honorees for the Fall 2024 semester and 64 student-athletes achieve this distinction for the Spring 2025 term.

ACADEMIC ALL-AREA TEAMS

■ In conjunction with the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, the sports information directors at the colleges and universities in the Philadelphia area (PhillySIDA) name an Academic All-Area team and a football Performer of the Year each season. In the 19 years of the Academic All-Area program, which started with the 2005-06 academic year, the football team has had a total of 64 selections to the Academic All-Area Team. In addition, the Wildcats have had six Performers of the Year.

VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE



Mark Ferrante enters his ninth season as the Thomas and Diane Treacy Endowed Football Head Coach in 2025 and is in his 39th year overall with the Wildcats including his time as head coach and 30 years prior as an assistant coach from 1987-2016. He has been a part of 274 victories and all 16 of the program's FCS playoff appearances during his Villanova tenure. Entering the 2025 season Ferrante has a career head coaching record of 57-33 (.633) which includes 36 regular season CAA Football wins, two league titles and four playoff appearances.

Under Ferrante's watch, the Wildcats have consistently been one of the top teams in the country. Villanova begins the 2025 season as one of six FCS programs to have won 10+

games in at least three of the last four years. During that span (2021-24), the Wildcats have made three playoff appearances and won a share of two CAA Football titles as well as the league's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs in 2021 and 2023. Villanova's overall record over the past four seasons is 36-15 (.706) and that mark includes a 24-8 record versus CAA Football foes and a 22-3 mark at home.

Ferrante guided the Wildcats to its second straight 10-win season in 2024 and its third appearance in the playoffs in the past four seasons. Villanova finished the year ranked No. 12 in the final Stats Perform national poll and was a top 10 team at the end of the season in two of the previous three years. Ferrante ranks third in school history in head coaching wins, while his .633 career winning percentage trails only Harry Stuhldreher (1925-35) and Clipper Smith (1936-42) among Wildcats head coaches who held the position for three or more seasons.

Villanova has consistently earned national recognition for its success during Ferrante's head coaching tenure. Following the 2024 season, linebacker Brendan Bell and cornerback Isas Waxter were selected as All-American by both Stats Perform and the Associated Press. Freshman running back David Avit was the CAA Football Offensive Rookie of the Year and a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award presented to the top FCS freshman. Honors have already started to come in for the 2025 campaign with Avit on the watch list for the Walter Payton Award and linebacker Shane Hartzell on the Buck Buchanan Award preseason watch list. Their accolades make the Wildcats one of 10 schools to have at least one player on the watch lists for the top offensive and defensive honors in the FCS.

In his first eight seasons as head coach, Ferrante has seen the Wildcats win six CAA Football major awards and earn a total of 61 all-conference accolades. Five players under Ferrante's watch - Corbi, cornerback Christian Benford, linebacker Forrest Rhyne and the aforementioned duo of Bell and Waxter - have earned All-America honors from Stats Perform and/or the American Football Coaches Association. Benford and Rhyne were first team All-Americans in 2021. Ferrante is himself one of the CAA Football major award winners after earning his first Coach of the Year honor in 2021.

Villanova's recent teams have featured several players who had an opportunity to continue their football careers beyond the collegiate ranks. Most recent on the list is Isas Waxter who signed with the Seattle Seahawks as an undrafted free agent in 2025. Following the 2023 season, running back Jalen Jackson and offensive lineman Nick Torres signed free agent contracts with the Jacksonville Jaguars and the Kansas City Chiefs, respectively. Three other players - running back TD Ayo-Durojaiye (Chicago Bears/Kansas City Chiefs), linebacker Danny Abraham (Seattle Seahawks) and wide receiver Jaaron Hayek (Kansas City Chiefs) - were invited to attend NFL rookie mini camps.

Ferrante coached 11 players on the 2021 team who had professional opportunities, led by Christian Benford who was a sixth round draft pick of the Buffalo Bills and has since gone on to have a successful NFL career in Buffalo. In addition, 2021 CAA Football Defensive Player of the Year and first team All-American Forrest Rhyne signed a free agent contract and played in the NFL with the Indianapolis Colts. Cornerback Denzel Williams signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Ravens.

One of the themes of Ferrante's head coaching tenure has been his ability to keep his teams largely intact throughout the COVID pandemic and the changing landscape of college sports. Villanova began the 2021 season with 75 out of 85 players returning from the previous Spring, while the members of the 2023 team had

combined to play in more than 1,000 college football games even before the season started. Experience wins, and Nova Nation has taken notice. Villanova's average attendance for five regular season home games in 2021 was its highest mark since 2013 and represented a 23 percent increase from 2019 prior to the pandemic. The increased attendance included the Wildcats first home sellout crowd since 2015 during the 2021 Family Weekend game against Richmond.

Ferrante has continually stressed the importance of his student-athletes coming to Villanova for a complete collegiate experience which includes excellence in their academic pursuits. In his first eight years as head coach, the Wildcats have been the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award four times. The award is presented to the team with the highest GPA in the conference each academic year and Villanova has been a repeat winner of the honor in each of the last three years spanning the 2022-23 through 2024-25 academic years.

The football program set and tied its highest overall NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) with a mark of 96 percent in both 2022 and 2023, while the team has had a mark of at least 95 percent in four consecutive years. The most recent NCAA GSR data was released in November 2024 and the Wildcats were one of two CAA Football teams with a score of at least 95 percent.

During the 2024-25 academic year, the Wildcats had 63 student-athletes selected to the CAA Football Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll during the Fall semester and another 64 honorees for the Spring 2025 grading period. Two student-athletes each semester had perfect 4.0 GPAs: Gilbert Deglau and Chris Dobrydney in the Fall and the duo of Temi Ajitutu and Ryan Kennedy in the Spring. Villanova had a total of 34 selections to the CAA High Honors List in 2024-25 for having a 3.7 or higher semester GPA.

Villanova has had nearly 800 selections to the CAA Football Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll during Ferrante's head coaching tenure and has had more than 650 selections to the Athletic Director's Honor Roll which is announced each semester for student-athletes who post a GPA of 3.2 or higher during the grading period.

Ferrante leads one of the nation's elite FCS programs after playing an instrumental role in the Wildcats rise to national prominence. He has been a part of the coaching staff for all 16 of Villanova's appearances in the FCS playoffs, including

the 2009 national championship season and a 2010 semifinal appearance while serving as the Assistant Head Coach on Andy Talley's staff. Ferrante has been a part of Villanova teams that have won eight CAA titles, three Lambert Meadows Cups and three ECAC Team of the Year awards.

Ferrante was involved in all aspects of the Villanova program during his time as an assistant on Andy Talley's staff. On the field he coached the offensive line for 27 seasons and developed a unit that was perennially one of the best in CAA Football. Over the years he coached three All-Americans, 11 All-East performers and 15 first team all-conference selections. The offensive line had 17 All-CAA selections in a nine-year span, including three-time first team honoree Ben Ijalana along with first team selections Brant Clouser (2010), Dan Shirey (2011) and Vince Kowalski (2014).

Two of Ferrante's players went on to be selected in the NFL Draft. Ijalana was a second round selection by the Indianapolis Colts in 2011 and Brad Seaton was picked in the seventh round by the Tennessee Titans in 2017. Ijalana was a two-time All-American (2009, 2010) and a three-time first team All-CAA selection during his collegiate career. Villanova reached the FCS playoffs in each of his last three seasons on the team, winning the 2009 national title and advancing to the semifinal round a year later. Seaton was a second team CAA Football All-Conference selection in 2016 when the offensive line enabled the Wildcats to average 206.3 rushing yards and 378.7 yards of total offense per game. Villanova ranked third in the CAA and 24th nationally in rushing offense in addition to ranking fourth in the league in total offense and fifth with a scoring average of 24.4 points per game.

The other All-Americans Ferrante mentored are Eamonn Allen (2001) and Bryan Russo (1989). Allen earned first team Associated Press All-America recognition in 2001 and was also a first team All-East and first team All-Atlantic 10 selection. Russo was chosen as an All-American by the Sports Network and the American Football Coaches Association as a senior in 1989 when he was also a first team all-conference and an All-ECAC selection. He was inducted to Villanova's Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2007.

Ferrante and his wife, Georgea, reside in Phoenixville, Pa. The couple has a son, Jimmy, who earned his undergraduate degree from Villanova in 2018.

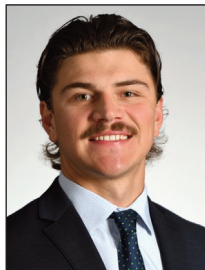

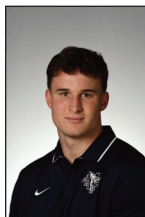
