## **TODAY'S GAME**

- Villanova hosts UAlbany this Saturday in its annual Homecoming Weekend game. Kickoff is scheduled for 3:30 p.m.
- Villanova won its progam record 19th straight home game last week with a 56-14 win over Hampton. The streak is the second longest active home winning streak among FCS teams behind South Dakota State at 33 gin a row. Appropriate for this week, the Wildcats began their winning streak in 2022 with a Homecoming Weekend win over UAlbany.
- Villanova is 38-21 (.644) all-time in its annual Homecoming Weekend games, including a current streak of four consecutive wins.
- Fifth year quarterback **Pat McQuaide** threw a career high five touchdown passes on just 13 passing attempts in last week's game against Hampton. He was 10-of-13 for 166 yards and the five scores.
- Villanova used a season high 78 players in last week's win over Hampton.
- Villanova recorded its first fumble return for a touchdown since 2017 last week when fifth year defensive lineman **Obinna Nwobodo** first forced a fumble and then recovered the ball to return it 53 yards for a score.
- Villanova has scored a non-offensive TD in three of its last four games, including last week's fumble return for a score and two kick-off return touchdowns by **Ja'briel Mace**. It is the first time since 2019 the Wildcats have had three non-offensive touchdowns in a season.

# **VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK**

#### **TODAY'S GAME**

■ Villanova hosts UAlbany on Saturday afternoon for a 3:30 p.m. kickoff. The game will be televised locally on NBCSP+ and streams live on FloCollege with **Nick Mantegna** and **Steve Pinone** calling the action. **Tessa Peloso** provides sideline coverage. The radio broadcast on the Villanova Sports Radio Network can be heard on Fox Sports Radio Philly which is accessible on mobile devices via the iHeart radio app. Villanova alum and Varsity Club Hall of Famer **Brett Gordon** joins **Ryan Fannon** on this week's call.

#### ABOUT VILLANOVA

■ Villanova enters play this week in third place in the CAA Football standings and has won four straight games. Last week, the Wildcats tallied a 56-14 win over Hampton to improve their record to 5-2 overall and 4-1 in conference play. Villanova is one game in the loss column behind Rhode Island (4-0) and Monmouth (3-0) in the standings. During their four game winning streak, the Wildcats have an average margin of victory of 21.8 points and have outscored their opponents by a total margin of 153-66. Villanova is in the second game of playing four out of its last five regular season conests at home. This stretch came after a four-out-of-five game road stretch from September 13-October 11.

#### **ABOUT UALBANY**

■ UAlbany comes into Saturday's game with a 1-6 mark this season and an 0-3 record in league games. The lone win for the Great Danes this season was a 13-10 triumph at home over Cornell on September 20. Two of the team's six losses have come by seven or fewer points and a third was to FBS and Big Ten foe Iowa. UAlbany interim head coach Jared Ambrose has been a part of FCS playoff semifinal appearances with three different CAA Football teams, including the Great Danes in 2023. He was the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for UAlbany from 2022-24 before being named intim head coach on March 4, 2025. Ambrose previously reached the playoff semifinals during assistant coaching stints at Towson (2013) and Delaware (Spring 2021).

#### **SERIES STUFF**

■ Villanova and UAlbany have played each other in seven of the previous 12 seasons since the Great Danes joined CAA Football. The Wildcats lead the all-time series, 5-2, and have won each of the three games played at Villanova Stadium in 2014 (48-31), 2016 (24-13) and 2022 (31-29).

#### HOMECOMING WEEKEND

■ Villanova will look to continue its historical success in Homecoming Weekend games this week. The first time the Wildcats recognized a game as a "Homecoming" game was in 1958 when Villanova defeated Detroit Mercy, 7-0. Beginning with that contest, the Wildcats are 38-21 (.644) all-time on Homecoming Weekend. Villanova has won each of its last four Homecoming games. The streak began in 2021 with a 44-0 win over Rhode Island and continued with wins over UAlbany (31-29) in 2022, Stony Brook (48-13) in 2023 and New Hampshire (14-6) last year.

#### HOW IT STARTED, HOW IT'S (STILL) GOING

■ It is only appropriate this week to recognize that Villanova's active school record 19 game home winning streak began with a Homecoming Weekend win over UAlbany in 2022. The Wildcats have an average margin of victory of 17.2 points during the streak, which is the second longest active home winning streak in the FCS behind South Dakota State which has won 33 in a row entering a home date with North Dakota State this week.

# **VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK**

#### LEADING THE WAY

■ Villanova head coach **Mark Ferrante** tallied his 40th regular season CAA Football win with last week's 56-14 rout of Hampton. Since becoming head coach in 2017, Ferrante has a record of 40-25 (.615) in regular season conference games. His 40 CAA wins are the most of any current head coach in the league, one more than *Mike London* of William & Mary who has won 39 conference games in stops at Richmond and with the Tribe.

#### **FANTASTIC FIVE**

■ Villanova has compiled a record of 41-17 (.707) over the last five seasons (2021-25) while making three playoff appearances and winning 10+ games three times. At the start of the season the Wildcats were one of six FCS teams to have won 10 or more games in at least three of the last four years, while in terms of winning percentage Villanova ranked 12th among all FCS teams since the start of the 2021 season. Its 41 wins in the same span of time are the most of any CAA Football member.

### **DECADE OF DOMINANCE**

■ Villanova is the only current CAA Football member to have won at least 70 games over the past 10 years (2016-25). In this stretch the Wildcats have an overall record of 71-39 (.645) and have gone 46-27 (.630) in regular season conference games while making the playoffs five times.

#### USING THE WHOLE ROSTER

■ Almost every available healthy player — 78 of the 93 players on the roster overall — saw playing time in last week's 56-14 win over Hampton. In addition to being a season high by far for number of players used, the participation for the Hampton game included 17 players — among them 13 true freshmen — who made their collegiate debut. Among the superlatives from the contest: nine different players had at least one rushing attempt, nine different receivers caught a pass and a whopping 32 players recorded at least one tackle.

#### **VETERAN EXPERIENCE**

■ Villanova has 93 players on its 2025 roster and they have played in a combined 1,499 games in their collegiate careers. Leading the way for the Wildcats are 18 players who have played in at least 30 career games, including nine who have played 40 or more. Villanova has six new graduate transfers on the team this year and each played in at least two dozen games prior to arriving on the Main Line. The six are punter Luke Larsen (East Carolina); placekicker Jack Barnum (Central Connecticut State); wide receiver Luke Colella (Princeton); quarterback Pat McQuaide (Nichollas); and defensive backs Jordan Adderley (Lehigh) and Julian Talley (Penn).

# **VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK**

#### **DRIVE FOR FIVE**

■ Graduate quarterback **Pat McQuaide** threw for a career high five touchdowns last week despite only attempting 13 passes. He was 10-of-13 through the air for 166 yards and the five scores. His previous career high for touchdown passes in a single contest was four against Southern last season while he was playing for Nicholls. McQuaide recorded the only the second occurrence in Villanova history of a single game passing efficiency rating over 300. His efficiency rating for the day was 311.1, trailing only the school record of 369.5 by *Connor Watkins* on September 9, 2023 against Colgate when he was 8-of-11 for 310 yards and two touchdowns.

## MORE ON MCQUAIDE

■ Pat McQuaide has been nothing short of a revelation for the Wildcats this season. He played at Nicholls the previous two seasons before coming to Villanova this year, where he has thrown for 1,524 yards and 11 touchdowns while completing 62.5 percent of his pass attempts on the year. McQuaide is the primary reason why the Wildcats have had seven or more receivers catch a pass in every game this season. He ranks third in the CAA in completion percentage, passing yards per game (217.7) and passing yards per completion (13.25). Including his career at Nicholls and this season with the Wildcats, McQuaide has career collegiate totals of 5,938 passing yards and 38 passing touchdowns.

#### TURNOVER FREE

■ Villanova has not committed a turnover in any of the four games during its current win streak. The string of four straight games without a turnover is possibly a school record. Based on available statistics, there has not been a four game string without a turnover dating back to at least 1966.

## **RECEIVING LINE**

■ Villanova has had at least seven different receivers catch a pass in each of the first seven games of the 2025 season. It is the first time in more than 20 years that the Wildcats have had a stretch like this. The last streak of seven games with at least seven receivers was in 2004 when Villanova similarly accomplished the feat in the first seven games of the season. The Wildcats have completed 123 passes overall this season with 91 caught by wide receivers, 20 by running backs and 11 by tight ends. One pass was also caught by redshirt freshman linebacker **Omari Bursey** on a fake punt at New Hampshire.

## **CATCHING ON**

- Fifth year collegian **Luke Colella** has made an instant impact on the Villanova offense in his first year with the team. After playing his undergraduate college ball at Princeton the last four years, Colella is the Wildcats leading receiver this year with 41 catches for 630 yards and three touchdowns. The three scores have all come in the last two weeks and Colella currently ranks in the top 15 in the country in receiving yards (8th), receiving yards per game (10th, 90.0) and receptions per game (13th, 5.9).
- Colella had a career high 10 receptions for 125 yards and two touchdowns at Elon on October 11. It was the first time a Villanova player reached double digits in receptions in a single game since *Matt Szczur* had 11 catches against Stephen F. Austin in the 2010 FCS playoffs. Colella has four 100-yard receiving games this season which is tied for the fifth most in a single year in school history. The last Wildcats player with more than four 100-yard games in a season was *Murle Sango* who tied the school single season record with six in 1999.

# VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK

#### 18 IN A ROW

- Sixth year collegian Lucas Kopecky has caught at least one pass in all 18 college football games he has played in. The streak of 18 straight games with a catch is the longest by a Villanova player since Kevin Gulyas had a reception in 19 straight games spanning the 2014 and 2015 seasons. Kopecky extended his streak to 18 straight with four catches for 46 yards and a touchdown against Hampton last week. His career totals in his 18 games played are now 44 catches for 585 yards and four scores.
- Kopecky played four years of lacrosse for Villanova (2021-24) and appeared in 40 games before walking on to the football team as a graduate student entering the 2024 season. He was a three-year football letterwinner at Montgomery (N.J.) High School in his scholastic career, earning two all-conference and two honorable mention all-state accolades. Kopecky was third on the team last year with 26 catches for 302 yards and two touchdowns in his college football debut.

#### CONTRIBUTIONS FROM TIGHT ENDS

- All four tight ends on the Villanova roster have seen playing time this season. The group includes veteran **Antonio Johnson** who is in his fifth year with the Wildcats along with **Nolan Clayton** (third year), **Sean Brodnik** (second year) and **Sean Welde** (first year). The quartet has combined to make 11 receptions for 112 yards and three touchdowns on the year, with at least one of the four making a catch in six of the seven games played.
- In the Hampton game last week, **Antonio Johnson** had a 10-yard touchdown reception for his third career score and **Sean Brodnik** caught his first career pass for a four-yard touchdown. It was the first time since November 1, 2003 against Richmond that VU had two tight ends catch a touchdown pass in the same game. In the 2003 game the two tight ends with scores were *Anthony Wright* and *Quinn Matt*. Just like Johnson and Brodnik, Wright and Quinn also recorded the third and first touchdowns of their careers that day.
- Prior to last week against Hampton, the last time VU even had two tight ends catch a pass in the same game was on September 16, 2023 against UCF when Johnson and **Justin Marcus** each had one reception.

## VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK

#### **DOMINANT DEFENSE**

- Villanova had a defensive first half to remember in the Hampton game last week. Not only did the Wildcats build a 49-0 halftime lead against the Pirates, but in those first 30 minutes of play the defense gave up just two first downs and 32 total yards. Hampton ran 23 plays in the first half: 16 rushes for a single yard and 5-of-7 passing for 31 yards.
- Strong defensive play has been a hallmark of Villanova's four-game winning streak. Below are some of the key figures that show the team's defensive success over the past four games, compared with the first three games of the season.

It is the first such streak for the Wildcats since 2012 when the defense that year recorded three or more sacks in four straight contests from September 8-29. # VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK

#### FUMBLE RETURN FOR A TOUCHDOWN

■ Prior to last week's game against Hampton, the Wildcats defense had not recovered a fumble by the opposition this season and had not had a fumble recovery for a touchdown in more than eight years. Those are the kinds of trends that are good to wipe off the board, and it only took one player — fifth year defensive lineman **Obinna Nwobodo** — to do it. In the second quarter last week, Nwobodo forced a fumble at the VU 47-yard line, immediately scooped up the ball and then returned it 53 yards for his first career score. It was the second career forced fumble and first recovery for Nwobodo. The last Villanova player with a fumble return touchdown was *Rob Rolle* who went 99 yards for a score against Maine on October 7, 2017.

## THAT'S NOT OFFENSIVE

■ The fumble return touchdown by **Obinna Nwobodo** last week was the first defensive touchdown of the season for Villanova, but it was also the third non-offensive score in the past four games. That is thanks to the efforts of junior **Ja'briel Mace** who registered kickoff returns for touchdowns against William & Mary on September 27 and at Elon on October 11. This is the first time since 2019 that the Wildcats have scored as many as three non-offensive touchdowns in a season. It is the third time during the **Mark Ferrante** coaching era (since 2017) that Villanova has scored three non-offensive touchdowns in a span of four games.

## KICK IT HERE, RETURN IT THERE

■ Not only is junior running back and kick return extraordinaire Ja'briel Mace the only FCS player with two kickoff return touchdowns this season, he is just the fifth player in school history to have at least two *career* kick returns for scores. Mace gave Villanova the lead for good in the win at Elon on October 11 with a 97-yard return for a touchdown at the 5:10 mark of the fourth quarter. It was just two weeks earlier that Mace had run a kickoff back 100 yards for a TD against William & Mary to break a six-year drought of the Wildcats not having a kick return score. The last player before Mace with a kickoff return touchdown was *Nowoola Awopetu* who had a 100 yard return against Richmond in 2019. The five players in Villanova history with multiple career kickoff returns for touchdowns are Mace, *Brian Westbrook (five)*, *Martin Gibson (three)*, *Angelo Babbaro (three)* and *Matt Szczur (two)*.

## ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Since 1842, Villanova University's Augustinian Catholic intellectual tradition has been the cornerstone of an academic community in which stulearn to think critically, compassionately and succeed while serving others. There are more than 10,000 undergraduate, graduate and law students in the University's six colleges - the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, the Villanova School of Business, the College of Engineering, the M. Louise Fitzpatrick College of Nursing, the College of Professional Studies and the Villanova University Charles Widger School of Law. Ranked among the nation's top universities, Villanova supports its students' intellectual growth and prepares them to become ethical leaders who create positive change everywhere life takes them.

#### VILLANOVA ATHLETICS

Villanova University has a long and storied athletics history defined by excellence both in competition and in the classroom. The Villanova Athletics Department is a community of studentathletes, coaches and staff whose primary focus is to achieve academic excellence, while striving to produce teams and individuals committed to athletic competition and outstanding performance. Villanova Athletics sponsors 24 varsity sports, which together include more than 550 student-athletes. In the classroom, these Villanova student-athletes have registered a grade-point average higher than a 3.0 for 44 consecutive semesters. Three Villanova student-athletes have been named Rhodes Scholars, with numerous others earning Academic All-America distinction. Villanova's athletics history includes 21 NCAA team national championships, as well as more than 100 conference championships. In addition, at least one Villanovan has participated in every Summer Olympics since 1948. Villanova is a member of the BIG EAST Conference, CAA Football, Coastal Athletic Association (Rowing) and Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (Water Polo).

## **ACADEMICS**

The GPA for more than 550 student-athletes in the Spring 2025 semester was 3.495, making it 15 straight semesters that student-athletes have had a GPA of 3.3 or higher. Success in the classroom has been across-the-board for Villanova Athletics, with 87 percent of all student-athletes compiling a GPA of 3.0 or higher and 73 student-athletes from 18 sports maintaining a perfect 4.0 GPA.

The most recent NCAA data to be released was the Academic Progress Rate (APR) update in May 2025 in which Villanova Athletics had 14 earn public recognition for having a multiyear APR score which ranks in the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. That included 13 teams who had a perfect score of 1000, making it eight straight years that the Wildcats have had 10 or more teams achieve a multi-year score of 1000.

# **VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK**

#### MORE ON MACE

- The kickoff return touchdowns by **Ja'briel Mace** against William & Mary on September 27 and Elon on October 11 mark the first time in Villanova's FCS era (since 1985) that the team had scored two special teams touchdowns in a span of three games. Mace joins Wildcats alums *Brian Westbrook* (2000) and *Angelo Babbaro* (2010) as the only players in school history to have two kickoff return touchdowns in a season.
- Mace ranks seconds in the country with 500 kickoff return yards and an average of 33.3 yards per return this season. He is bidding to be the first Villanova player to average better than 30 yards on kickoff returns (minimum 250 return yards) over a full season since *Bob Dunn* averaged 32.5 yards during the 1963 season. Mace has already joined *Brian Westbrook* as the only players in school history to have two career plays of any kind for 97 yards or longer.
- Mace's explosive speed makes him a versatile player for Villanova in any role he takes on. In the win at New Hampshire on October 4, Mace scored a career high three touchdowns on a 31-yard pass play, a two-yard rush, and a one-yard run on a direct snap. His 100 yard kickoff return against William & Mary was the eighth play in school history and the sixth kickoff return for 100 yards or longer.

## **PUNT RETURNS**

- True freshman **Braden Reed** has recorded seven returns for a total of 148 yards and an average of 21.1 yards per return this year. Reed's longest punt return was for 41 yards against Hampton, when he also had returns of 23 and 21 yards. He previously had a 26 yard return at Elon. His average of 21.1 yards would rank second nationally if he had enough returns to qualify for the NCAA stats. The only previous Villanova player to average 20 yards or better in a single season was *Dave Parr* in 1957 (23.1 yards per return; nine returns for 208 yards).
- Prior to Reed last week, the last Villanova player to have multiple punt returns for 20+ yards in the same game was *Brandyn Harvey* against Rhode Island in 2009. Reed is also the Wildcats first player since Harvey in 2009 to have four 20+ yard returns in a single season.

#### ALL ABOUT AVIT

- Sophomore running back **David Avit** became the 25th player in school history with more than 1,500 career rushing yards when he reached the milestone agaist Hampton last week. Avit has played in 21 career games and has rushed 272 times for 1,510 yards and 16 touchdowns. His career average of 71.9 rusing yards per game ranks fifth in school history, while his career average of 5.55 yards per carry ranks 10th in the Villanova record book.
- Avit ranks second in CAA Football and 14th nationally with seven rushing touchdowns this season. He leads the Wildcats with 587 rushing yards on 99 carries for the year. All seven of his touchdowns came in a three-game span against Monmouth (3), William & Mary (3) and New Hampshire (1).
- Avit needed just 16 games to reach 1,000 career rushing yards. He achieved the milestone against Penn State on September 13. The only players in Villanova history who have gotten to 1,000 rushing yards in fewer games are quarterback *John Robertson* (2011-15) who needed 14 games and running back *Gene Filipski* (1952-53) who reached the milestone in just 11 games.
- Avit was a finalist for last year's Jerry Rice Award which is presented to the top freshman in the FCS. He ranked third among FCS rookies with 923 rushing yards last season. He was named to this year's preseason watch list for the Walter Payton Award.

#### VILLANOVA FOOTBALL HISTORY

■ Villanova has compiled a 292-172-1 (.629) record in 40 seasons as an FCS member. The program's success includes 16 appearances in the FCS playoffs and appearing in the final national rankings of the season 19 times in the last 36 years.

#### POLLING PLACES

- Villanova is ranked No. 11 in this week's Stats Perform FCS Top 25 and comes in at No. 12 in the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll. This year is the 33rd time in the last 38 seasons that the Wildcats have been nationally ranked at some point during the season.
- Villanova ranks fourth among all teams in FCS history (since 1978) for the number of weeks appearing in the national media poll. In their 332 weeks being nationally ranked, the Wildcats have been in the top 10 for a total of 153 weeks (11th most all-time) and have been ranked in the top five for 66 weeks.
- Only two current FCS programs have been ranked more weeks than Villanova at 332 weeks. Those teams are Montana (448) and Northern Iowa (413). There are 18 FCS programs (current and former) who have been ranked for 200 or more weeks since 1978. All 18 have ascended to No. 1 in the rankings at least once.

## **VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK**

#### **RECORD-SETTING DEBUT**

- No Villanova quarterback has ever thrown for 300 yards in his first start for the team. However, the last two signal callers to debut for the Wildcats have thrown for 298 and 299 yards, respectively. Graduate student **Pat McQuaide**, a transfer from Nicholls, made his first start for VU against Colgate on September 6 and threw for 299 yards and a score. He surpassed the previous school record for most passing yards in the first start for the team which was held for the past three years by *Connor Watkins*, the starter from 2022-24 who threw for 298 yards in his first career start against Lehigh to open the 2022 season.
- In addition to setting a record for most passing yards by a quarter-back in his first VU start, McQuaide became the third straight Villanova starter to win his debut while throwing for over 200 yards and recording at least one passing and rushing touchdown.
- McQuaide is only the third left-handed quarterback to start a game for Villanova in their FCS era. The others are *Christian Culicerto* (2011) and *Zach Bednarczyk* (2015-18).

## ENTERING WITH LIFE EXPERIENCE

- The oldest active player in Division I college football this season is Villanova punter **Luke Larsen** who recently turned 33 years old and made his Wildcats debut in the season opener against Colgate. Larsen is a graduate student transfer from East Carolina and a native of Australia who played Australian Rules Football, volleyball, cricket and tennis during his scholastic career prior to coming to the United States.
- Larsen is having a strong season for Villanova and has punted 21 times through the first seven games of the season. He is averaging 40.2 yards per punt with two attempts for over 50 yards and five that have been downed inside the opponent's 20-yard line. Larsen's next game played will be the 50th of his career and he is just 56 yards shy of 8,000 career punting yards.
- Larsen punted 174 times at East Carolina while averaging 40.8 yards per punt. He landed 51 punts inside the 20-yard line, booted 19 punts for 50+ yards and had 75 of 174 attempts fair caught.

#### PRESEASON WATCH LISTS

■ Sophomore running back **David Avit** and senior linebacker **Shane Hartzell** have been named to the preseason watch lists for the Walter Payton Award and the Buck Buchanan Award, respectively. These national honors are given to the top offensive and defensive players in the FCS at the end of each season. Villaonva is one of 10 teams to have at least one player on both watch lists at the start of the season. The others are Harvard, Illinois State, Montana, Montana State, North Dakota State, Rhode Island, Samford, South Dakota State and IIIW

#### POSTSEASON SUCCESS

■ Villanova is tied for 10th in FCS history with 16 playoff appearances. In their FCS playoff history, the Wildcats have a record of 15-15 with one natonal championship (2009) and three semifinal berths (2002, 2009, 2010). Villanova has won at least one playoff game in 10 of its last 12 postseason appearances. The 15 playoff wins for the Wildcats are tied for the 12th most ever among current FCS programs.

## **COMPLETE STUDENT-ATHLETES**

## **ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS**

#### NCAA ACADEMIC DATA

- Each year the NCAA recognizes programs that have a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranks within the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. Villanova has earned this award nine times in the 18-year history of the APR program.
- In the most recent APR data released in June 2025 the football program's multi-year APR score of 982 was 24 points above the national average for FCS programs.
- New data on the NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) was released in November 2024 and Villanova recorded its fourth straight year with a score of 95 percent or higher.

#### ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

■ One of the highest honors that a student-athlete can achieve is to be named an Academic All-American, an award which encompasses both academic achievement as well as contributions on the field. Villanova has had 12 football student-athletes earn a total of 14 Academic All-America honors over the years.

## CAA TEAM ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

■ Villanova has been the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award five times in the last nine years. The award is presented at the end of each academic year to the conference school with the highest team GPA.

#### CAA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

■ Villanova has had five student-athletes be named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Nominees for the award must have attained senior standing academically and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

### CAA ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

■ Student-athletes with a semester GPA of 3.0 or higher are named to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll. Villanova had 63 honorees for the Fall 2024 semester and 64 student-athletes achieve this distinction for the Spring 2025 term.

#### **ACADEMIC ALL-AREA TEAMS**

## **VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE**



Mark Ferrante enters his ninth season as the Thomas and Diane Treacy Endowed Football Head Coach in 2025 and is in his 39th year overall with the Wildcats including his time as head coach and 30 years prior as an assistant coach from 1987-2016. He has been a part of 274 victories and all 16 of the program's FCS playoff appearances during his Villanova tenure. Entering the 2025 season Ferrante has a career head coaching record of 57-33 (.633) which includes 36 regular season CAA Football wins, two league titles and four playoff appearances.

Under Ferrante's watch, the Wildcats have consistently been one of the top teams in the country. Villanova begins the 2025 season as one of six FCS programs to have won 10+

games in at least three of the last four years. During that span (2021-24), the Wildcats have made three playoff appearances and won a share of two CAA Football titles as well as the league's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs in 2021 and 2023. Villanova's overall record over the past four seasons is 36-15 (.706) and that mark includes a 24-8 record versus CAA Football foes and a 22-3 mark at home.

Ferrante guided the Wildcats to its second straight 10-win season in 2024 and its third appearance in the playoffs in the past four seasons. Villanova finished the year ranked No. 12 in the final Stats Perform national poll and was a top 10 team at the end of the season in two of the previous three years. Ferrante ranks third in school history in head coaching wins, while his .633 career winning percentage trails only Harry Stuhldreher (1925-35) and Clipper Smith (1936-42) among Wildcats head coaches who held the position for three or more seasons.

Villanova has consistently earned national recognition for its success during Ferrante's head coaching tenure. Following the 2024 season, linebacker Brendan Bell and cornerback Isas Waxter were selected as All-American by both Stats Perform and the Associated Press. Freshman running back David Avit was the CAA Football Offensive Rookie of the Year and a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award presented to the top FCS freshman. Honors have already started to come in for the 2025 campaign with Avit on the watch list for the Walter Payton Award and linebacker Shane Hartzell on the Buck Buchanan Award preseason watch list. Their accolades make the Wildcats one of 10 schools to have at least one player on the watch lists for the top offensive and defensive honors in the FCS.

In his first eight seasons as head coach, Ferrante has seen the Wildcats win six CAA Football major awards and earn a total of 61 all-conference accolades. Five players under Ferrante's watch – Corbi, cornerback Christian Benford, linebacker Forrest Rhyne and the aforementioned duo of Bell and Waxter – have earned All-America honors from Stats Perform and/or the American Football Coaches Association. Benford and Rhyne were first team All-Americans in 2021. Ferrante is himself one of the CAA Football major award winners after earning his first Coach of the Year honor in 2021.

Villanova's recent teams have featured several players who had an opportunity to continue their football careers beyond the collegiate ranks. Most recent on the list is Isas Waxter who signed with the Seattle Seahawks as an undrafted free agent in 2025. Following the 2023 season, running back Jalen Jackson and offensive lineman Nick Torres signed free agent contracts with the Jacksonville Jaguars and the Kansas City Chiefs, respectively. Three other players – running back TD Ayo-Durojaiye (Chicago Bears/Kansas City Chiefs), linebacker Danny Abraham (Seattle Seahawks) and wide receiver Jaaron Hayek (Kansas City Chiefs) – were invited to attend NFL rookie mini camps.

Ferrante coached 11 players on the 2021 team who had professional opportunities, led by Christian Benford who was a sixth round draft pick of the Buffalo Bills and has since gone on to have a successful NFL career in Buffalo. In addition, 2021 CAA Football Defensive Player of the Year and first team All-American Forest Rhyne signed a free agent contract and played in the NFL with the Indianapolis Colts. Cornerback Denzel Williams signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Ravens.

One of the themes of Ferrante's head coaching tenure has been his ability to keep his teams largely intact throughout the COVID pandemic and the changing land-scape of college sports. Villanova began the 2021 season with 75 out of 85 players returning from the previous Spring, while the members of the 2023 team had

combined to play in more than 1,000 college football games even before the season started. Experience wins, and Nova Nation has taken notice. Villanova's average attendance for five regular season home games in 2021 was its highest mark since 2013 and represented a 23 percent increase from 2019 prior to the pandemic. The increased attendance included the Wildcats first home sellout crowd since 2015 during the 2021 Family Weekend game against Richmond.

Ferrante has continually stressed the importance of his student-athletes coming to Villanova for a complete collegiate experience which includes excellence in their academic pursuits. In his first eight years as head coach, the Wildcats have been the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award four times. The award is presented to the team with the highest GPA in the conference each academic year and Villanova has been a repeat winner of the honor in each of the last three years spanning the 2022-23 through 2024-25 academic years.

The football program set and tied its highest overall NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) with a mark of 96 percent in both 2022 and 2023, while the team has had a mark of at least 95 percent in four consecutive years. The most recent NCAA GSR data was released in November 2024 and the Wildcats were one of two CAA Football teams with a score of at least 95 percent.

During the 2024-25 academic year, the Wildcats had 63 student-athletes selected to the CAA Football Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll during the Fall semester and another 64 honorees for the Spring 2025 grading period. Two student-athletes each semester had perfect 4.0 GPAs: Gilbert Deglau and Chris Dobrydney in the Fall and the duo of Temi Ajirotutu and Ryan Kennedy in the Spring. Villanova had a total of 34 selections to the CAA High Honors List in 2024-25 for having a 3.7 or higher semester GPA.

Villanova has had nearly 800 selections to the CAA Football Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll during Ferrante's head coaching tenure and has had more than 650 selections to the Athletic Director's Honor Roll which is announced each semester for student-athletes who post a GPA of 3.2 or higher during the grading period.

Ferrante leads one of the nation's elite FCS programs after playing an instrumental role in the Wildcats rise to national prominence. He has been a part of the coaching staff for all 16 of Villanova's appearances in the FCS playoffs, including

the 2009 national championship season and a 2010 semifinal appearance while serving as the Assistant Head Coach on Andy Talley's staff. Ferrante has been a part of Villanova teams that have won eight CAA titles, three Lambert Meadowlands Cups and three ECAC Team of the Year awards.

Ferrante was involved in all aspects of the Villanova program during his time as an assistant on Andy Talley's staff. On the field he coached the offensive line for 27 seasons and developed a unit that was perennially one of the best in CAA Football. Over the years he coached three All-Americans, 11 All-East performers and 15 first team all-conference selections. The offensive line had 17 All-CAA selections in a nine-year span, including three-time first team honoree Ben Ijalana along with first team selections Brant Clouser (2010), Dan Shirey (2011) and Vince Kowalski (2014).

Two of Ferrante's players went on to be selected in the NFL Draft. Ijalana was a second round selection by the Indianapolis Colts in 2011 and Brad Seaton was picked in the seventh round by the Tennessee Titans in 2017. Ijalana was a two-time All-American (2009, 2010) and a three-time first team All-CAA selection during his collegiate career. Villanova reached the FCS playoffs in each of his last three seasons on the team, winning the 2009 national title and advancing to the semifinal round a year later. Seaton was a second team CAA Football All-Conference selection in 2016 when the offensive line enabled the Wildcats to average 206.3 rushing yards and 378.7 yards of total offense per game. Villanova ranked third in the CAA and 24th nationally in rushing offense in addition to ranking fourth in the league in total offense and fifth with a scoring average of 24.4 points per game.

The other All-Americans Ferrante mentored are Eamonn Allen (2001) and Bryan Russo (1989). Allen earned first team Associated Press All-America recognition in 2001 and was also a first team All-East and first team All-Atlantic 10 selection. Russo was chosen as an All-American by the Sports Network and the American Football Coaches Association as a senior in 1989 when he was also a first team all-conference and an All-ECAC selection. He was inducted to Villanova's Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2007.

Ferrante and his wife, Georgea, reside in Phoenixville, Pa. The couple has a son, Jimmy, who earned his undergraduate degree from Villanova in 2018.
