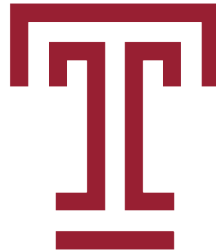

IT'S WORTH NOTING...

~ Junior guard Tyler Perkins, the only returning Wildcat who saw game action in 2024-25, has enhanced his scoring production of late. After scoring eight points in each of VU's first four games, he has tallied 34 in the last two contests (17.0 ppg). In Tuesday night's win over ODU, he led the way with 21 points, seven rebounds and two assists. Included in that effort was his best work from beyond the arc thus far in 2025-26 (3-of-4). He averages 11.0 ppg.

~ Villanova has had its offense flowing early on at Finneran Pavilion. The Wildcats have averaged 91.0 points per game on their home floor thus far in four games.

~ The Wildcats held their own on the glass against the Monarchs even without Duke Brennan in uniform. Villanova out-rebounded ODU 34-29. Nine of the 10 'Cats who saw action had at least one carom, led by Perkins and Matt Hodge (seven apiece).

~ Villanova sank a then program record 19 3-pointers in last season's 95-64 win over Temple. The 2025-26 Wildcats eclipsed that mark with 22 vs. Sacred Hart on Nov. 11 in a 94-60 win.

~ Senior forward Tafara Gapare (Wellington, New Zealand) was one of those who stepped up in Brennan's absence. Gapare logged a season-best 30:13, finishing with six points, six rebounds, three assists and zero turnovers in the win over ODU.

~ Starting guards Bryce Lindsay and Acaden Lewis have been efficient scorers thus far for the Wildcats. Lewis is connecting on .517 of his field goal attempts while Lindsay is converting at a .500 clip, including 22-of-46 from beyond the arc (.478).

~ This is the final pod game ahead of the Big Five Classic. Tonight's winner meets Penn in the title game Saturday night.

Last Time Out

Playing without the nation's top rebounder, Duke Brennan, Villanova held off a pesky Old Dominion squad Tuesday night at Finneran Pavilion 89-75.

Guards Tyler Perkins (21 points), Acaden Lewis (20 points) and Bryce Lindsay (12 points) combined for 53 points in another explosive effort at the Finn.

No Duke

Brennan, averaging 14.4 rpg, was unavailable Tuesday night after suffering a right ankle sprain in the second half of last Wednesday night's 70-55 Big Five win at La Salle.

A Tight One Early

ODU scored the game's first six points before a 5-0 Wildcats' response that was highlighted by a Bryce Lindsay 3-pointer. Over the first 5:14 Nova connected on 2-of-10 field goal attempts against the Monarchs' multiple defenses.

Devin Askew helped get the Wildcats some offense midway through the period, scoring four points to help Villanova grab a 16-15 lead at the 9:40 mark of the first half.

Three's Began to Fall

The Wildcats sank 1-of-5 from beyond the arc over the first half of the period but began to warm up as the game unfolded. Acaden Lewis and Malachi Palmer dropped in deep shots to help stake Villanova to a 31-25 lead.

ODU, though, was even more proficient from deep, sinking 3-of-4 in one stretch to close the gap to 31-30 with 3:57 to play in the first half. The Monarchs tied the contest at 36 before the Wildcats scored the last four points of the half – two on a pretty drive by Lewis – to take a 40-36 lead into the locker room at intermission.

Tafara Gapare stepped forward in Brennan's absence to contribute six points and five boards in the first half. Lewis paced Villanova with eight points in the period. Big Five Rookie of the Week Matt Hodge – whose father Odell was on the ODU bench as Special Assistant to the Head Coach – was limited to six first half

minutes after being whistled for two fouls.

ODU was 6-of-11 from distance in the first half while Villanova was 5-of-14 from that range (.357).

Second Surge

Villanova executed a flawless play on its opening possession, freeing Lindsay for an open 3-pointer at the top of the key. That was followed by a defensive stop, a Lewis drive for two and a Lewis steal that led to a Perkins dunk. The Wildcats were up 47-36 at the 18:41 mark of the second half.

The 'Cats extended the lead by sinking 10-of-14 from the field to open the second half. Villanova held a 64-48 lead but the Monarchs were able to keep scoring and used a 7-0 surge to narrow the deficit to 69-60 with 7:06 left.

But Perkins scored on the next possession and the Wildcats' margin never dipped below double figures again.

Hodge played a pivotal role in the second half. He finished with 12 points and seven rebounds in 22:47. Following the game he was asked about being on the opposite side from his father.

"It meant a lot," Hodge said. "On the other (hand) it was another game. We had to get the win. It's been a long time. I didn't play last year and he has a busy schedule as well. It was fun to have him there. It was straight business during the game. After the game, we embraced each other."

What They Said

Lewis: "Every game I think we're figuring out our role. We haven't had a full team for any game, so far. Tonight, we didn't have Duke. We're figuring it out game by game. As a point guard your role is to be kind of like a servant of the team. You do what needs to be done."

Head Coach Kevin Willard on playing smaller without Brennan: "That's something we're still not very good at because we haven't had time to practice it. The more we practice it, the more comfortable we'll get with five guys out there who can shoot and pass and dribble.

"I think that was a little bit of the first half problems. We just haven't practiced that. When you haven't practiced something and go out there and try to do it, you usually don't do it well."

Acaden Ascends

Guard Acaden Lewis (Washington, D.C.) has quickly established himself as a key ingredient for the Wildcats. On Tuesday night the freshman connected on 8-of-12 field goal attempts, including 2-of-4 from distance, to finish with 20 points, four assists, two steals and just a single turnover.

At 5.2 assists per game, Lewis ranks second in the BIG EAST in that category to Silas Demary Jr. of UConn (6.3 apg). With 31 assists and just 13 turnovers his assist-to-turnover ratio is 2.58, which places him in the top 12 among his BIG EAST peers.

Lewis has begun to extend the Sidwell Friends legacy at Villanova where previous impactful graduates included Josh Hart and Saddiq Bey.

Balance Beam

Entering the season with a roster full of new faces, balance was expected to be a Villanova strength and that has played out over the course of the season's first six games.

Five Wildcats average double figures in scoring, led by Lindsay at 19.0 ppg. Also in that fraternity are Lewis (13.5 ppg), Hodge (12.5), Perkins (11.0) and Brennan (10.2). Askew averages 8.5 ppg with a season-high of 27 against Sacred Heart.

Odds and Ends

The Wildcats enjoyed a 15-7 advantage in points off of turnovers in the win over ODU. In its last four outings VU has an 88-42 edge in that statistical column...

Redshirt freshman Braden Pierce made the first start of his college career in place of Brennan on Tuesday night. The Georgia native logged 12:49 on the court, a season-high, adding two points and two rebounds...

Villanova is averaging 118.3 points per 100 possessions thus far, according to the metrics of Ken Pomeroy at kenpom.com. The Wildcats' overall rank was 41st nationally (+17.29). At the defensive end they stood at No. 59 in the country, surrendering 101.1 points per 100 possessions.

Also of note on the metrics front: the 'Cats rank no. 335 in adjusted tempo (66.9 points per 100 possessions)...

Sophomore guard Malachi Palmer added six points, two rebounds and a steal to the cause on Tuesday night. He saw 15:03 of action off the bench.

The Wildcats are in 1-1 (.500) in the first two Big Five Classic games, having dropped a 57-55 decision to Drexel in 2023 and rebounding with a 94-65 win over the Owls in 2024.

Dante's a Big Five Hall of Famer

Dante Cunningham, the 2009 BIG EAST Most Improved Player and a co-captain on the Wildcats' team that returned the program to the NCAA Final Four after a 24-year absence, will be inducted into the Philadelphia Big Five Hall of Fame on Dec. 6, 2025.

Originally from Silver Spring, Md., Cunningham was a key rotation figure in each of his four seasons at Villanova. It was all capped in his final season of 2008-09, when he led VU with a 16.1 points per game scoring average and 7.5 rebounds per contest average. The Wildcats knocked off American, UCLA, Duke, and Pittsburgh to advance to the Final Four at Detroit's Ford Field.

Cunningham finished with 1,344 points and 819 rebounds in his four seasons. A second round selection of the Portland Trail Blazers, the 6-8 forward played a decade in the National Basketball Association before finishing his career overseas.

The 2025 Big Five Hall of Fame induction class will be celebrated at the Big Five Classic at Xfinity Mobile Arena.

Honoring George Raveling

The Villanova uniforms this season include a patch on the shoulder honoring the memory of class of 1960 graduate George Raveling, a Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame inductee who died earlier this year.

Raveling, a native of Washington, D.C., played basketball for the Wildcats and head coach Alexander Severance from 1957-1960. His 835 career rebounds – amassed in just three varsity seasons – still rank 13th on the program’s all-time carom list. He later became an assistant to Head Coach Jack Kraft, launching a career that would take him to head coaching stops at Washington State, Iowa, and USC. In 2015, he was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and received an honorary doctorate from his alma mater the following year.

Raveling was on stage in 1963 for “The March on Washington” working as event security, when Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., handed him the original copy of the speech that would come to be known as the “I Have a Dream” speech shortly after delivering it.

In 2021, Coach Raveling chose Villanova University to become the next steward of Dr. King’s “I Have a Dream” speech —entrusting Villanova to provide broad access to all those who seek to learn from and be inspired by Dr. King’s words. As such, the University collaborated with The Smithsonian and the National Museum of African American History and Culture in Washington, D.C. to establish an exclusive, long-term “on loan” arrangement.

Villanova University President Rev. Peter M. Donohue, OSA, PhD: “George Raveling was a Villanovan in the truest sense of the word. He left a significant mark on Villanova University and the sport of basketball. He chose Villanova to be the steward of Dr. King’s famous “I Have a Dream” speech, broke down racial barriers as a coach, and became a well-respected and admired figure amongst his professional and personal peers. George will be missed, and our prayers are with the entire Raveling family.”

Villanova William B. Finneran Endowed Head Men’s Basketball Coach Kevin Willard: “Our entire basketball family is saddened to learn of Coach Raveling’s passing. While I am new to Villanova, I have long appreciated the enormous impact Coach has made not just on our game, but on so many of us in it. I know Villanova held a special place in his heart and we are forever grateful for his contributions to this program.”

Home Court Data

Villanova’s campus home court is Finneran Pavilion. The original facility opened in 1986 and was renovated during the 2017-18 basketball season. The lead gift for the \$65 million transformation was made by the late William B. Finneran, for whom the facility was renamed in 2018.

The Wildcats are 356-73 (.830) in the building all-time. The Wildcats are 62-11 in the facility (.849) since it reopened as Finneran Pavilion in 2018-19 and are 4-0 there thus far in 2025-26 (1.000).

Villanova also annually hosts a portion of its home schedule at the recently re-named Xfinity Mobile Arena, formerly the Wells Fargo Center. St. John’s (Jan. 17) and UConn (Feb. 21) will visit the ‘Cats in South Philadelphia this season and Nova will also appear there on Dec. 6 at the Big Five Classic.

WILLIAM B. FINNERAN ENDOWED HEAD COACH

Pittsburgh '97 | First Season at Villanova | 19th Overall

Kevin Willard, who has posted 335 victories across 18 seasons as a head coach and led teams to seven NCAA Tournaments, was named the William B. Finneran Endowed Head Men's Basketball Coach at Villanova University in March 2025. Most recently, Willard guided the University of Maryland to 27 victories, a Top 25 national ranking and a Sweet Sixteen appearance this past week.

"Coach Willard quickly stood out among an impressive pool of candidates during a comprehensive national search," said Villanova University President Rev. Peter M. Donohue, OSA. "Throughout the process, Coach Willard demonstrated that he has the vision and experience to guide Villanova Basketball in the changing world of college athletics. Beyond his notable success on the court, we were also impressed by his ability to articulate how Villanova Basketball fits into the overarching mission of the University."

Willard led the Terrapins to 65 victories in three seasons in College Park, including a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. In 2024-25, he was named the NABC East District Coach of the Year. In his first season at the helm (2022-23), he led the Terps to a 22-13 record, a Top 25 national ranking, and a Second Round NCAA Tournament appearance.

"Coach Willard is an outstanding leader of young men and brings extensive experience and success as a head coach to Villanova," said Villanova Vice President and Director of Athletics Eric Roedel. "We are excited about the future of Villanova Basketball under his leadership, and look forward to welcoming Coach, his wife Julie, and their sons—Colin and Chase—to the Villanova community."

Prior to his tenure at Maryland, Willard coached for 12 seasons at Seton Hall, winning 225 games, including the 2016 Big East Tournament championship at Madison Square Garden that culminated in a 69-67 win over a Villanova team that weeks later would go on to capture the NCAA national championship. The Pirates shared the 2019-20 Big East regular season title with the Wildcats and Creighton in a season that ended prematurely in March due to the COVID-19 pandemic. He is the only coach in Seton Hall program history to post four consecutive 20-win seasons and is second on the program's all-time wins list.

"My family and I would like to thank the Villanova Board of Trustees, President Father Peter Donohue and Eric Roedel for this incredible opportunity," said William B. Finneran Endowed Head Men's Basketball Coach Kevin Willard. "Villanova Basketball has a deep tradition of excellence and a culture that is second to none in college basketball. We are thrilled to be a part of it and join the Villanova community."

From 2010-22 Willard returned Seton Hall to its status as one of the premier programs in the BIG EAST. He reached five NCAA Tournament appearances in the last six events that were played. He led the Pirates to the Big East Tournament Title in 2015-16 and the regular-season title in 2019-20. He was the 2016 Big East Coach of the Year and the 2020 USBWA District II Coach of the Year during those runs. Additionally, he was a three-time Peter A. Carlesimo Met Writers Coach of the Year (2016, 2017, 2019) and the 2019 NABC District 5 Coach of the year. He also has the most non-conference wins of any coach in the nation against Big Ten teams since 2014-15.

In addition to his coach of the year accolades, he was also named one of Forbes Top 10 NCAA Basketball Coaches for the Next 10 Years in 2017. His teams won the prestigious NABC Team Academic Excellence Award for five straight years (2016-20) and earned three NCAA Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Awards.

In a six-year span from 2016-17 through 2021-22, he was one of 10 active head coaches in the Power 6 conferences to achieve a regular-season championship, a conference tournament championship, and a conference coach of the year honor. He also finished in the top-four in the Big East on six occasions. In 2018, he led the Pirates to their first victory in an NCAA Tournament since 2004.

Through his 12 seasons at Seton Hall, Willard produced a 225-161 overall record. He ranks second all-time in victories (225) in Seton Hall basketball history and has the most wins in confer-

ence play in program history (110). He is also the 11th all-time winningest coach in Big East history, dating to the conference's inception in 1979. The Pirates also had 82 combined wins between the Big East regular-season and postseason, second only to Villanova in the conference, since the 2015-16 season.

His teams at Seton Hall were ranked in the Top 25 in five of his last eight seasons with a high ranking of No. 8 in the 2019-20 season. In 2020-21 the Pirates were ranked as high as No. 15 and spent eight weeks in the polls.

Willard's Seton Hall teams also posted an 11-5 record against Big Ten teams over his last eight seasons, which included wins over Maryland in 2018 and 2019. Willard's teams also won road games at Michigan, Iowa, Penn State and Rutgers and beat Indiana at home. Willard held the most non-conference wins over Big Ten teams of any coach since 2014-15.

In 2021-22, Willard led the Pirates to a 21-11 overall record and an 11-8 mark in conference play. That included wins over No. 4 Michigan and No. 7 Texas as part of six NET Quad 1 victories.

Willard coached the Big East Player of the Year in two of his last three years in Myles Powell (2020) and Sandro Mamukelashvili (2021). He mentored two Big East Most Improved Players of the Year in Powell (2018) and Romaro Gill (2020). He coached the Big East Tournament MVP, Isaiah Whitehead (2016); the Big East Defensive Player of the Year, Fuquan Edwin (2014) and Gill (2020); the Big East Rookie of the Year, Angel Delgado (2015) and the Big East Scholar-Athlete of the Year, Michael Nzei (2019) and Ike Obiagu (2021).

Making a huge emphasis on effort in the classroom, Willard's student-athletes combined for 72 BIG EAST All-Academic team selections, and the program boasted a perfect single-year academic progress rate in six of the nine NCAA reports since he served as head coach as well as perfect multi-year APR scores in 2016 and 2017. The NCAA has also recognized Seton Hall with NCAA APR Public Recognition awards for boasting an APR in the top 10 percent in the country three consecutive years from 2015-17.

Willard showed to be a strong evaluator and recruiter of talent, as he brought in a consensus top-15 national recruiting class in 2014, led by Whitehead, the program's first McDonald's All-American since 2001 and just the fifth all-time. His 2021-22 recruiting class was also rated in the top 25 by 247Sports.

The 2020-21 season marked Seton Hall and Willard's sixth consecutive top-four finish in the Big East Conference, one of the best basketball conferences in the country. Only Villanova also completed six straight top-four finishes in the same span.

Willard was named head coach of the Seton Hall men's basketball program on March 29, 2010. He became the 19th head coach in Seton Hall history joining the Pirates after three years serving as the head coach at Iona. In 2007, he had inherited a Gaels team that had won just two games the prior season. In his first year at the helm, the Gaels had a 10-win improvement, ranking as one of the top turnarounds in NCAA Div. I. Then in year three in 2009-10, Willard guided Iona to a 21-10 overall record, and he was named MAAC Coach of the Year.

Prior to the start of his career as a head coach, Willard was an assistant and associate head coach for six years at Louisville, where he was mentored by Naismith Basketball Hall of Famer Rick Pitino. Willard also credits his father, Ralph, as one of his coaching influences. Ralph Willard enjoyed a successful 19-year run as the head coach at Western Kentucky, Pittsburgh and Holy Cross, winning 336 games and advancing to six NCAA Tournaments.

At Louisville, Willard was responsible for assisting with the Cardinals' game preparations, scouting and preparing game plans. He also served as chief recruiting coordinator. During his tenure, Louisville was ranked in the Top 25 for five seasons and reached the postseason in each of his six years. The squad reached the NCAA Tournament on four occasions including a visit to the 2005 Final Four.

Prior to Louisville, Willard worked with Pitino as a coaching associate with the Boston Celtics for four years. His duties with the Celtics included game and practice preparation, scouting and assisting the coaching staff in all facets of basketball operations. He also provided advance scouting, videotape breakdowns and assisted with individual workouts prior to games.

A basketball lifer, Willard played point guard on the Division I level for four years; the last three coming at the University of Pittsburgh. He earned Big East All-Academic honors while appearing in 60 games for the Panthers. He spent his freshman season at Western Kentucky, where he played in the backcourt and sank over 40 percent of his three-point field goal attempts.

Willard hails from New York and was born in Huntington on Long Island, but played his high school basketball at Bowling Green High School (Ky.) while his father was the head coach at Western Kentucky. He earned second-team All-State honors as a senior and helped his team to a combined 76-15 record in his final three prep seasons.

Willard is married to the former Julie Wagner and they have two sons, Colin, who was born in August 2006 and Chase born in June 2008.

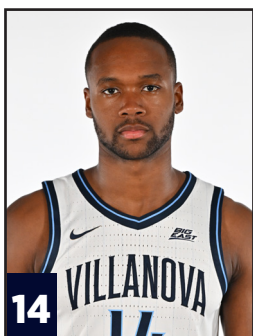

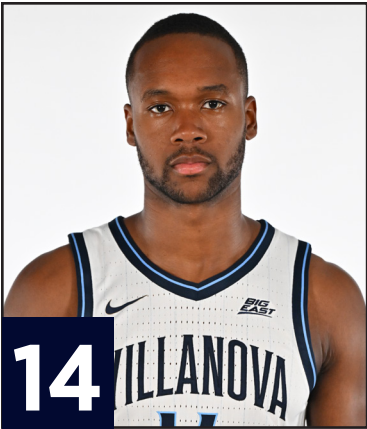

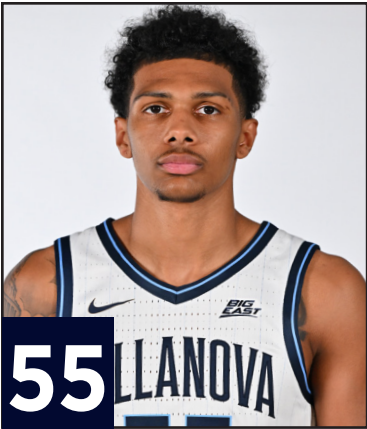
