#### **SETTING THE SCENE**

For the first time since 2004, Goodman Stadium will host an FCS playoff game as Lehigh hosts Villanova in a matchup of future conference rivals for a spot in next week's quarterfinals. The Mountain Hawks completed a 12-0 regular season with a 42-32 win over Lafayette in Rivalry 161 to claim their 14th Patriot League championship, and earned the No. 5 seed and a first round playoff bye. Lehigh rushed for 340 yards against the Leopards, with junior Luke Yoder carrying for 234 and scoring four touchdowns to earn game MVP honors. Villanova comes in riding a nine-game winning streak. The 12th-seeded Wildcats rolled to a 52-7 win over Harvard in their first round game last week.

#### **LEHIGH HEAD COACH KEVIN CAHILL**

Kevin Cahill is in his third season as Lehigh's head coach. He owns a 23-13 record and has guided the Mountain Hawks to back-to-back Patriot League titles and NCAA playoff appearances. He is a two-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award and has won Patriot League Coach or Coaching Staff of the Year in back-to-back seasons. Cahill has mentored 27 All-Patriot League performers and a pair of All-Americans in his two-plus seasons. A coaching veteran with more than 20 years of experience, Cahill came to Lehigh following 10 seasons at Yale University, where he was a member of the coaching staff for three lvy League championship teams and oversaw one of the nation's top offensive units. From 2018-2022 Cahill served as the Bulldogs' Associate Head Coach and Offensive Coordinator. Cahill is a 2001 graduate of Springfield College, where he was a three-year starter at quarterback. #### VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE

A longtime member of the Villanova coaching staff, Mark Ferrante is in his ninth season as head coach. He owns a 66-35 record. Ferrante has been on staff for all 17 of Villanova's FCS playoff appearances, including five as head coach (2019, 2021, 2023, 2024, 2025). Prior to taking over in 2017, Ferrante served under Andy Talley for 30 seasons, coaching the offensive line for 27 seasons, and serving as assistant head coach for the last 18. He was an All-America guarterback for Talley at St. Lawrence, graduating in 1983.

#### **THE SERIES**

Lehigh and Villanova will meet for the 20th time, with the Wildcats holding a 14-5 edge in the series. Villanova has won the last 11 meetings. Lehigh's last win in the series came back in 2006. This will be Villanova's eighth visit to Lehigh since the series resumed in 2004 (2004, 2007, 2010, 2017, 2018, 2021, 2023). Lehigh won the first four meetings (1903, 1914, 1919 and 1924), while Villanova won in 1925 and 1927 prior to the 77-year break in the series. This is the first postseason meeting between the Mountain Hawks and Wildcats.

#### LAST TIME THEY MET

BETHLEHEM, Pa. (9/2/23) - A game-opening onside kick shifted early momentum into Lehigh's favor, but three first-half turnovers led to 21 Villanova points as the visiting Wildcats claimed a 38-10 victory over the Mountain Hawks in the season-opener for both teams at Goodman Stadium. The Mountain Hawks trailed 31-3 at halftime and matched the Wildcats in the second half with both teams tallying one touchdown. Lehigh's score came from a seven-yard pass from sophomore Brayten Silbor to junior Gaige Garcia with 8:02 to play. Villanova's Jalen Jackson and Rayjuon Pringle both scored twice as the Wildcats spoiled the debut of head coach Kevin Cahill. Lehigh was out-gained by Villanova 412-284 and the Wildcats garnered 284 yards on the ground. Silbor finished 23-of-38 for 206 yards with a touchdown and two interceptions in his first career start. Sophomore Geoffrey Jamiel led Lehigh with six receptions for 28 yards, while Garcia finished with 21 rushing yards on six carries and caught three passes for 29 yards. Senior linebacker Mike DeNucci led the defensive effort with seven tackles and a tackle for loss.

#### YODER CARRIES THE LOAD

Junior running back Luke Yoder delivered a performance for the ages in Lehigh's Patriot League title-clinching 42-32 win at Lafayette. Yoder rushed for a career-high 234 yards and four touchdowns on the way to earning game MVP honors. The 234 yards were the fourth-highest single game total in program history and the second-most by a Lehigh rusher in a Rivalry game. He joined Rabih Abdullah (1997) and Jack Rizzo (1971) as Lehigh rushers to score four touchdowns against Lafavette. Yoder earned Patriot League and Stats Perform national Offensive Player of the Week honors for his performance. The Palm Harbor, Fla., native has rushed for 1,329 yards and 15 touchdowns this season, while averaging 7.1 yards per carry. Just the second Lehigh runner with multiple 1,000-yard rushing seasons (Dom Bragalone '19), Yoder was named Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year and a finalist for the Walter Payton Award last week. Yoder's 1,329 yards rank seventh in the FCS and fifth on Lehigh's single-season list.

#### **EIGHT IS GREAT**

One of the key cogs in one of the nation's top defensive units, senior linebacker Tyler Ochojski was named Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year and is a finalist for the Buck Buchanan Award, given to the top defensive player in the FCS. Ochoiski enjoyed a monster game against Georgetown, registering three of Lehigh's seven sacks along with four tackles for loss in the Mountain Hawks' 41-0 shutout. A two-time Patriot League Defensive Player of the Week, Ochojski has 56 tackles in 2025 with 12 tackles for loss and a team-best 10 sacks. He earned his first Patriot League Defensive Player of the Week award after a two-sack effort at Duguesne, including a forced fumble that ultimately sealed the win for Lehigh. Ochojski has seven sacks over Lehigh's last five games.

#### **DOMINANT DEFENSE**

A defensive unit that ranks statistically among the nation's best has keyed Lehigh's 12-0 regular season. The Mountain Hawks lead the Patriot League and rank in the top five nationally in rushing defense (73.7), scoring defense (13.9), sacks (40) and total defense (281.6). Lehigh enters the playoffs with the No. 1 rushing defense and red zone defense (0.655) in the FCS. Prior to Rivalry 161, Lehigh held its previous five opponents to 23 total points. Lehigh has held nine of its 12 opponents under 100 rushing yards including three under 40 yards on the ground.

#### 14 NAMED ALL-PATRIOT LEAGUE

Lehigh placed a league-leading 14 players on the All-Patriot League teams, announced Nov. 25. The Mountain Hawks had 12 first team honorees and a pair of second team selections following their 12-0 regular season. Senior offensive lineman Langston Jones and senior defensive linemen TJ Burke and Matt Spatny all earned first team all-league laurels for the second straight year. Junior running back Luke Yoder, senior wide receiver Geoffrey Jamiel and senior offensive lineman Aidan Palmer landed on the first team after earning second team honors in 2024. Sophomore running back Jaden Green earned second team all-league honors for the second straight season. Lehigh's first time. first team All-Patriot League selections were sophomore quarterback Hayden Johnson, junior tight end Joseph Marranca, senior linebacker Tyler Ochojski, junior cornerback Aidan Singleton, sophomore safety Mekhai Smith and sophomore punter Connor Poole. Senior linebacker Brycen Edwards is a first time all-league selection landing on the second team.

#### FROM COAST TO COAST

The Lehigh coaching staff prides itself in bringing in student-athletes from across the nation. This season, 18 states are represented on the Mountain Hawks roster, including California, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Kentucky, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Texas and Virginia. Twenty-eight Mountain Hawks hail from Pennsylvania while 14 are from New Jersey.

#### **PENNSYLVANIA PROUD**

The Mountain Hawks' roster features 28 student-athletes from the state of Pennsylvania. In recent years, Lehigh has had a handful of Lehigh Valley products on its roster. The Mountain Hawks' 2025 roster includes eight players who played their high school football in the East Penn Conference or the Colonial League. Senior kicker Nick Garrido is from Easton and attended Notre Dame Green Pond. Lehigh has two local junior defensive linemen in Broc Bender (Nazareth) and Andrew Sharga (Northampton). The sophomore class includes four local products: offensive lineman Sammy Ayache (Bethlehem Catholic), safety Nolan Coen (Parkland), quarterback Matt Machalik (Palmerton) and offensive lineman Colby Reph (Northampton). Junior tight end Jake Stalsitz grew up on Center Valley and attended Southern Lehigh before ultimately graduating from Fairview near Erie, Pa.

# LAST TIME OUT

#### **#4 LEHIGH AT #24 LAFAYETTE**

EASTON, Pa. (11/22/25) — Trailing 17-14 at half-time, junior Luke Yoder broke off an 80-yard touchdown run on the first play of the third quarter that gave Lehigh its first lead. The run was part of a career day for Yoder and sparked the fourth-ranked Mountain Hawks to a 42-32 victory over No. 24/RV Lafayette Saturday at Fisher Stadium in the 161st meeting of college football's most-played rivalry.

Lehigh rushed for 320 yards as a team with the Mountain Hawks outscoring the Leopards 28-15 in the second half.

Yoder gained a career-high 234 yards on 19 carries and scored four touchdowns to earn game MVP honors.

The victory was Lehigh's school record-tying 12th of the season. At 12-0 the Mountain Hawks clinched their sixth undefeated regular season and their first since 2001. The Mountain Hawks secured their league-leading 14th Patriot League championship and will head to the FCS playoffs for the second straight year.

Sophomore quarterback Hayden Johnson finished 11-of-16 passing for 159 yards with a touchdown and an interception. He also rushed seven times for 64 yards and a score. Sophomore Jaden Green added 49 yards on five carries.

Junior Mason Humphrey led the receivers with 83 yards on two catches, while senior Geoffrey Jamiel caught five for 26 yards.

Quarterback Dean DeNobile was 26-of-37 for 275 yards and an interception for Lafayette.

Junior William Parton led the Lehigh defense with 11 tackles and a tackle for loss. Senior TJ Burke had Lehigh's lone sack and senior Nick Peltekian had an interception in the second quarter for Lehigh's lone takeaway.

Lehigh scored on a 29-yard Yoder run and 77-yard pass from Johnson to Humphrey in the first half. Yoder rushed for three of his four touchdowns after halftime, plus Johnson capped the scoring with a one-yard run late in the fourth quarter.

#### **GREAT TO BE IN GOODMAN**

Lehigh's 12-0 regular season earned the Mountain Hawks the right to host a playoff game at Goodman Stadium for the third time, and the first time since 2004. The Mountain Hawks defeated Hofstra 24-21 in overtime on Dec. 1, 2001 in the first playoff game at Goodman Stadium. On Nov. 27 2004, Lehigh lost 14-13 to a James Madison team that went on to win the national championship. Lehigh is 6-0 at Goodman Stadium this season as part of its first undefeated regular season home campaign since 2001. Lehigh is 129-74-1 (.635) all-time at Goodman Stadium, which opened in 1988.

#### **STACKING WINS**

With its win over Holy Cross on Nov. 8, Lehigh reached the 10-win mark for the 11th time in program history and the first time since the 2012 squad finished 10-1. The Mountain Hawks now have six 10-win campaigns since 2000. Lehigh's win in Rivalry 161 was its 12th, matching the program record held by the 1977 (12-2), 1998 (12-1) and 2000 (12-1) squads. The 1977 team won a Division II national championship, while the 1998 and 2000 teams won their first round playoff games and advanced to the NCAA quarterfinals.

#### **EARNING THE BYE**

The FCS playoff field expanded from 16 to 20 teams for the 2010 season and then expanded again to its current 24-team format in 2013. Lehigh is making its sixth playoff appearance since the field expanded beyond 16 teams in 2010. As the No. 5 seed in the field of 24, Lehigh earned a first round playoff bye for just the second time. In 2011, when only the top four teams were seeded, the Mountain Hawks were ranked sixth nationally and had to travel to No. 8 Towson for a second round game, which Lehigh won 40-38 on the way to its most recent quarterfinal appearance.

#### **LEHIGH IN THE NCAA PLAYOFFS**

#### LEHIGH REPPIN' THE PL IN THE PLAYOFFS

Lehigh is representing the Patriot League in the playoffs for the 11th time in its 13 appearances at the FCS level. The Mountain Hawks have won at least one playoff game in six of the last 10 appearances representing the league. Dating back to the 2010 season, Patriot League teams are 10-18 in FCS playoff action with Lehigh owning three of those 10 wins. With a win over Villanova Lehigh would be the first Patriot League team to reach the quarterfinals since Colgate in 2018. Last year's first round win over Richmond gave the Mountain Hawks six NCAA playoff wins as a Patriot League member, tying Lehigh with Colgate for the most among Patriot League schools.

#### **SEE YA REAL SOON**

For the second straight year Lehigh will open the postseason against a future conference foe. Last year, Lehigh beat Richmond with the Spiders joining the Patriot League as an associate member in football for the 2025 season. After this season, Villanova is leaving the CAA along with William & Mary to join the Patriot League in 2026.

#### **GOING FOR THE GOLD**

Lehigh took the field in gold helmets against Richmond, marking the first appearance for the gold lids since the Mountain Hawks wore them against Princeton on Sept. 18, 2021. Prior to the Richmond game, Lehigh's last win in the gold helmets was also its last opening day victory, as the Mountain Hawks defeated Saint Francis (Pa.) 21-19 on Sept. 1, 2018. This season, Lehigh has worn gold helmets in its seven Patriot League games and white helmets in its five non-league contests.

#### **GROUND GAME IN GEAR**

Lehigh has now eclipsed the 100-yard rushing mark in 32 straight games dating back to the 2023 season. Lehigh posted its fourth 300-yard rushing game of the season with 340 yards on the ground at Lafayette. Two weeks earlier, Lehigh gained 343 against Holy Cross, its most since gaining 349 on the ground against Fordham in 2016. The Mountain Hawks also rushed for 323 at Bucknell and an even 300 against Penn. Last year, Lehigh led the Patriot League in rushing, averaging 201.8 yards per game. Luke Yoder led the way with 1,014 yards, averaging 5.3 yards per carry. Behind Yoder, first-year running backs Jaden Green and Aaron Crossley and quarterbacks Hayden Johnson and Matt Machalik combined for 1,503 yards and 18 rushing touchdowns while averaging 5.3 yards per rush. Through 12 games, that quintet has gained 2,798 yards and scored 32 touchdowns while averaging 6.2 yards per carry. Lehigh ranks fourth nationally in rushing offense, averaging 235.3 yards per game.

## **GREEN IS MONEY**

Running back Jaden Green enjoyed an outstanding first-year season that culminated in the San Francisco native earning second team All-Patriot League honors while being named a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award. Green rushed for a career-high 147 yards in the win over Fordham and also eclipsed the 100-yard mark against Colgate, while finishing the year with 10 touchdowns. At Richmond, Green's 65-yard touchdown rush helped spur Lehigh's fourth-quarter comeback. Green picked up where he left off in the season opener against Richmond, with 101 scrimmage yards and two touchdowns. He ran for 127 yards and totaled three touchdowns in the win at Bucknell. Green rushed for 95 yards against Penn and added 67 against Yale. He iced the win at Colgate with a 28-yard touchdown run, his third score in the last four games. Green ranks second on the Mountain Hawks with 10 total touchdowns this season and has rushed for 811 yards on the way to earning second team All-Patriot League honors for the second straight year.

#### SHUTOUT DROUGHT OVER

Lehigh's defense pitched a 41-0 shutout against Georgetown, for the Mountain Hawks' first shutout victory since a 27-0 blanking of the Hoyas on Oct. 10, 2009. The Mountain Hawks allowed just 271 yards of offense, registered seven sacks and took the ball away twice. Lehigh also stopped a 4th-and-goal from the 1-yard line in the game's final minute. The Mountain Hawks now have six shutouts since the year 2000. Four of them have come against Georgetown (2002, 2007, 2009, 2025). The other two shutouts were against Bucknell in 2002 and against Drake in 2008.

#### **JAMIEL CATCHES ON**

Senior wide receiver Geoffrey Jamiel has been one of the most productive receivers in program history as well as a leader off the field. Jamiel was the Patriot League Rookie of the Year in 2022 and was Lehigh's top receiver in 2024, hauling in 60 receptions for 768 yards and eight touchdowns on the way to earning second team All-Patriot League honors. He had a huge day in the playoff win at Richmond, with 10 catches for 137 yards, with his 54-yard touchdown catch in the fourth quarter giving the Mountain Hawks the lead for good. This year, Jamiel has four 100-yard receiving games, including backto-back efforts against Bucknell and Penn. He was named Patriot League Offensive Player of the Week after scoring two touchdowns in the win over Penn, including a 20-yard rush on a fake field goal that gave Lehigh the lead for good in the third quarter, and a 35-yard reception early in the fourth. Jamiel established a new career high with 182 receiving yards at Columbia and became the fifth player in program history to surpass 200 receptions at Fordham. With 138 yards and a touchdown at Colgate, Jamiel hit the 1,000yard mark on the season. A first team All-Patriot League honoree for the first time, Jamiel's 1,026 receiving yards rank seventh in the FCS.

#### **HEY-HEY HAYDEN!**

Quarterback Hayden Johnson turned things on late in the 2024 season. Johnson started Lehigh's final four games, including the playoff victory at Richmond. In his first career start, Johnson completed 16-of-21 passes for 204 yards with three touchdowns in a win against Colgate. He went on to complete 10-of-13 passes for 115 yards and a touchdown while rushing for 25 yards and a score to earn the Most Valuable Player award of Lehigh's 38-14 Patriot League title-clinching win over Lafayette in Rivalry 160. The Lancaster, Pa., native became the first first-year player to earn Rivalry game MVP honors since Lafayette's Drew Reed in 2013, and the first Lehigh player to accomplish the feat since Phil Stambaugh in 1996. Johnson completed 14-of-18 for 199 yards and two touchdowns in the playoff win against Richmond. For the season, Johnson completed 67 percent of his passes for 1372 yards and 10 touchdowns. He also rushed 70 times for 307 yards and four touchdowns. Johnson established a new career high with 267 passing yards in the win at Fordham and was named Patriot League Offensive Player of the Week for his efforts. He is averaging 208.5 yards per game over Lehigh's last 10 games with 16 touchdown passes and three interceptions during that time.

#### TURNING AROUND THE TURNOVER STORY

Lehigh has finished with a negative turnover margin in 10 of the last 11 seasons, a trend the Mountain Hawks look to reverse this fall. The Mountain Hawks corralled a Patriot League-leading 14 interceptions in 2024 but still finished the year with a minus-2 turnover margin. With nine takeaways over its last seven games, Lehigh is now plus-10 through 12 games. Sophomore Mekhai Smith has four interceptions and recovered a fumble against Georgetown. Junior Aidan Singleton's second interception of the season was a 26-yard pick-six against the Hoyas. The Mountain Hawks have also recovered six fumbles. Lehigh overcame two turnovers against Holy Cross after turning the ball over just once in its previous seven games.

#### **PROFESSIONAL PEDIGREES**

Lehigh's roster features a quartet of student-athletes whose fathers played in the NFL. Senior offensive lineman Langston Jones' father Keith was a running back for the Atlanta Falcons from 1989-92. Junior running back Luke Yoder's father Todd played nine seasons as a tight end for Tampa Bay, Jacksonville and Washington, winning a Super Bowl with the Bucs in 2002. Junior safety Mason Moore's father Marty played eight seasons as a linebacker, seven of which came with the New England Patriots, and won a Super Bowl in 2001. First-year offensive lineman Jake Thomas' father Tra played 12 years and made three Pro Bowls playing primarily for the Philadelphia Eagles.

#### **WORKING OVERTIME**

The Mountain Hawks have played 14 overtime games since overtime rules were established prior to the 1995 season. Lehigh is 8-6 in overtime games, with its most recent overtime game being last September against Bucknell. Lehigh is 1-0 in overtime in the playoffs with a win over Hofstra at home in 2001.

#### **SACK ATTACK**

One of Lehigh's defensive strengths in recent years has been its ability to get to opposing quarterbacks. Lehigh led the Patriot League with 34 sacks last season and ranked 19th nationally, averaging 2.62 sacks per game. This year, the Mountain Hawks have a Patriot League-best 40 sacks, with their 3.33 sacks per game ranking fourth in the country. Lehigh had a season-high seven sacks against Georgetown and had six-sack efforts in wins over Bucknell and Columbia. Senior Tyler Ochojski leads Lehigh with 10 sacks this season, while senior Matt Spatny has eight. Spatny led the Mountain Hawks with 11.5 last season and broke Lehigh's career sack record at Colgate, reaching 24.5. Lehigh's top five sackers are all seniors with Brycen Edwards (5.5), TJ Burke (4.0) and Dillon Sheehan (2.5) behind Ochojski and Spatny. Fifteen different players have at least half a sack for the Mountain Hawks so far this season. Burke had Lehigh's lone sack at Lafayette.

#### STANDOUT SPATNY

Defensive lineman Matt Spatny was a standout on one of the nation's top defensive units in 2024. Spatny made 36 tackles from his defensive end position and contributed a Patriot League-leading 11.5 sacks, ranking third in the FCS in sacks per game and fifth in overall sacks. Along with center George Padezanin, Spatny was named an honorable mention Associated Press All-American last season, the first All-Americans for Lehigh since 2019. A Preseason All-American and the Patriot League's Preseason Defensive Player of the Year, Spatny missed two games due to injury but has eight sacks in 10 games this season. Spatny was named Patriot League Defensive Player of the Week after registering six tackles, three tackles for loss and two sacks in the win at Columbia. With a second-quarter sack at Colgate he now has 24.5 for his career, breaking the program record (24) previously held by Nick Martucci '99 for Lehigh's career record.

#### TO RUN AND STOP THE RUN

Lehigh has done well to control the ground game on both sides on the way to its 12-0 start. The Mountain Hawks lead the Patriot League and rank in the top four nationally in both rushing offense (235.3 ypg.) and rushing defense (73.7 ypg.). With 340 rushing yards at Lafayette, Lehigh hit the 300-yard rushing mark as a team for the fourth time this season and the ninth time since 2001. Junior Luke Yoder has 1,329 rushing yards and six 100-yard rushing games as Lehigh ranks fourth nationally in rushing offense. The Mountain Hawks lead the FCS in rushing defense and have held six of their last eight opponents and nine of 12 overall under 100 rushing yards. That includes just 29 rushing yards allowed against Penn and just 20 allowed against Holy Cross.

#### **BRYCEN'S BEST**

Fredericksburg, Va., native Brycen Edwards must like facing the Richmond Spiders from his home state. Lehigh's senior linebacker set a then-career high with 12 tackles in last November's FCS playoff win in Richmond. In week one, Edwards spearheaded Lehigh's outstanding defensive effort against the Spiders, with a team-leading eight tackles, plus a tackle for loss and a key third down pass breakup. He added nine tackles in wins over Sacred Heart and Yale and has a team-best 83 tackles through 12 games. Edwards established a new career high with 13 tackles at Fordham. He had two sacks at Columbia and has 5.5 over his last six games.

#### **FOLLOWING THE SAME RECIPE**

Tough defense and a strong rushing attack were hallmarks for the Mountain Hawks in their 2024 championship season, with Lehigh displaying more of the same in 2025. The Mountain Hawks are averaging 235.3 rushing yards through 12 games, including four 300-yard rushing games. Lehigh's defense is only allowing 281.6 yards through 12 games. The Mountain Hawks limited Richmond to 181 yards, including just 88 over the final three quarters. Lehigh limited Columbia to just 42 yards of offense in the first half of its Oct. 11 win and held Holy Cross and Colgate to 215 and 222 total yards in recent victories.

#### **GROWTH ON THE O-LINE**

The growth of a young offensive line helped the Mountain Hawks find success in the second half of 2023, a trend that has continued through last season. Lehigh had a streak of four consecutive 200-yard rushing games last year and has four 300-yard rushing games in 2025. Lehigh has now eclipsed the 100-yard rushing mark in 32 consecutive games dating back to 2023. The Mountain Hawks have also allowed just 25 sacks in that 32-game span. Lehigh utilized the same five-man starting line in its first 10 games last year with two first-years rotating in regularly. Through 12 games this year, Lehigh has utilized the same starting line. All-Patriot League performers Langston Jones and Aidan Palmer man the guard spots. Sophomore Colby Reph moves from guard to center to replace All-American George Padezanin, while sophomores Charles Soska and Sammy Ayache have been the starting tackles. Lehigh is averaging 235.3 rushing yards through 12 games and has allowed just eight sacks.

## **MEKHAI-OH-MY**

Sophomore safety Mekhai Smith has been around the football a lot so far in 2025. Smith has a team leading four interceptions this season with one in four of the Mountain Hawks' first five games this season. The Lower Merion, Pa., product made his first career interception late in the fourth quarter to seal the season-opening win over Richmond. He helped set the tone at Bucknell with an interception on the first play from scrimmage. Smith's interception against Penn came right after Lehigh's lone punt of the day and led to a Luke Yoder touchdown to put the Mountain Hawks up 37-27. If Smith picks off one more pass in 2025, he would have the most interceptions for a Lehigh player in a single season since Jarard Cribbs picked off seven passes in 2010. He picked up his fifth takeaway of the season against Georgetown, forcing a fumble near the goal line and recovering the fumble in the end zone.

#### **DOUBLE TROUBLE**

Running backs Luke Yoder and Jaden Green both eclipsed the 100-yard rushing mark in the win at Bucknell as the Mountain Hawks rushed for 323 yards as a team. Yoder set a then-career high with 174 yards, while Green added 127. The duo totaled four touchdowns, with Green scoring two on the ground and one via a reception. It marked the first time Lehigh had two rushers gain more than 100 yards in a game since Oct. 29, 2016 when Dom Bragalone (192) and Nick Shafnisky (108) eclipsed the century mark in a win over Fordham.

#### JUST FOR KICKS

Lehigh specialists captured three consecutive Patriot League Special Teams Player of the Week awards with sophomore punter Connor Poole honored on Sept. 15 and senior kicker Nick Garrido recognized on Sept. 22 and 29. Poole averaged 52.4 yards on five first-half punts at Duquesne, including a career-long 57 yard effort. Garrido scored a then-career-high 11 points in the win at Bucknell and then surpassed that mark against Penn with 14 points. The Easton, Pa., product is now 9-for-10 on field goals and 35-for-36 on extra points this season.

#### **PRODUCTIVE POOLE**

Sophomore Connor Poole was selected as the first team All-Patriot League punter. In his second season as Lehigh's punter, Poole is averaging 42.4 yards per punt and has placed 15 of 41 kicks inside the opponents' 20-yard line. Poole handled Lehigh's kickoffs for most of his first two seasons and recently took over as Lehigh's placekicker, where he is 3-for-3 on field goals and 16-for-16 on extra point attempts for the Mountain Hawks.

#### **SETTING THE TONE EARLY**

Lehigh benefitted from some outstanding first-half performances on the way to its 9-4 season in 2024. The Mountain Hawks outscored opponents 227-125 in first halves in 2024, including a 190-43 advantage in the first halves of their nine victories. Lehigh was especially tough in the second quarter, outscoring foes 161-68 in the second period last season. In Lehigh's nine wins, the Mountain Hawks outscored opponents 141-13 in the second quarter, with Holy Cross (seven) and Richmond (six) scoring the only opponent second-quarter points in a game won by the Mountain Hawks. So far in 2025 Lehigh has outscored its first 12 opponents 184-79 in first halves and 99-48 in second quarters.

#### **TURN-TURN-TURN IT AROUND**

Hard to believe, but Lehigh was just 2-9 in Kevin Cahill's first season in 2023. Lehigh's 9-4 record in 2024 marked a seven-win improvement over its 2023 campaign, with the Mountain Hawks owning the second-biggest turnaround in FCS football. Only Stony Brook (0-10 to 8-4) had a bigger win improvement than the Mountain Hawks last season at the FCS level.

#### **GROWING UP FAST**

The Mountain Hawks won the 2024 Patriot League title with a roster that included 36 first-years and 25 sophomores, many of who made valuable contributions to Lehigh's championship season. With Lehigh's roster now featuring more of a veteran presence, the Mountain Hawks have brought in just 15 newcomers for 2025, with 13 first-years and a pair of sophomore transfers. The only newcomers that appear on Lehigh's depth chart (page 12) are first-year long snapper Ridgely Ritter, first-year wide receiver Anthony Feaster and sophomore transfer Giacomo Macce. Twenty-three of Lehigh's 39 sophomores appeared in at least one game last season, with eight seeing time in all 13 games. Ritter is the only Lehigh first-year to appear in all 12 games. Macce debuted against Sacred Heart as an extra blocker and has appeared in 11 games. Feaster has seen increased time recently, with 11 receptions in nine games, including four against Georgetown. Seven newcomers have made their Lehigh debuts over the Georgetown and Holy Cross games.

#### **FOUR SCORE**

In addition to being productive, Lehigh's rushing attack shared the wealth in the win over Sacred Heart. Six rushers contributed to the 286-yard output with five of the six gaining at least 16 yards. Running backs Luke Yoder and Jaden Green and quarterbacks Hayden Johnson and Matt Machalik all scored rushing touchdowns. It marked the second straight year that Lehigh had four rushing touchdowns from four different players in its second game of the season. Last year Yoder, Green, Johnson and Dante Perri scored rushing touchdowns in a 49-13 home win over Wagner on Sept. 7.

#### **ACADEMIC RECOGNITION FOR EDWARDS**

Senior linebacker Brycen Edwards was named one of 177 semifinalists for the William V. Campbell Trophy, which recognizes the nation's top football scholar-athlete. A Fredericksburg, Va., native, Edwards carries a 3.34 cumulative GPA majoring in accounting and finance. A three-year starter, Edwards earned second team All-Patriot League and Academic All-Patriot League honors in 2025 and is Lehigh's top tackler with 83 stops through 12 games.

#### **ACADEMIC SUCCESS**

The 2024 season saw senior cornerback Jordan Adderley and sophomore defensive back DJ Brown earn Academic All-Patriot League honors, with Brown also landing on the College Sports Communicators Academic All-District Team. Among players on the 2025 roster, 43 Mountain Hawks own a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better, with 25 over a 3.2 and nine over a 3.5. Senior defensive back CJ Wood leads the team with a 3.87 GPA in accounting, followed by sophomore running back Sam Spector, who holds a 3.85 and sophomore Matt D'Avino, who owns a 3.78. Spector and D'Avino are undeclared in Lehigh's College of Business and Economics.

#### **SCOUTING VILLANOVA**

No strangers to postseason play, Villanova reached the postseason for the fifth time in the last seven seasons as an at-large selection out of the CAA. The Wildcats moved to 10-2 on the season with their ninth straight victory as Villanova throttled Harvard 52-7 last week in the first round. Villanova gained 513 yards of offense, including 319 on the ground. Isaiah Ragland rushed for 152 yards and a 45-yard touchdown. Villanova had 13 players earn All-CAA honors, including return specialist Ja'briel Mace, who was named Special Teams Player of the Year. Mace, Ragland and David Avit have all rushed for more than 600 yards this season and have combined for 19 touchdowns. Quarterback Pat McQuaide has appeared in all 12 games and has thrown 22 touchdown passes with just two interceptions. Shane Hartzell leads the Wildcat defense with 81 tackles, 14 tackles for loss and seven sacks. Graduate student cornerback Jordan Adderley was a member of Lehigh's 2024 Patriot League championship team, but hasn't played for Villanova since October 18.

#### THE SENIOR STORY

Lehigh's 2025 roster features 18 seniors, including one fifth-year student-athlete. Fourteen of the 18 appear on Lehigh's depth chart (page 12), including six projected defensive starters.

#### PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS

Lehigh topped the Patriot League's preseason poll unveiled in late July. The Mountain Hawks garnered 97 points, and 13 of a possible 16 first-place votes in the poll of the league's head coaches and sports information directors. Newcomer Richmond received the other three first place votes. Senior defensive lineman Matt Spatny was voted the Preseason Defensive Player of the Year and was joined on the preseason all-league team by seniors Langston Jones, Aidan Palmer, TJ Burke, Brycen Edwards, Nick Peltekian and junior Luke Yoder. All of Lehigh's preseason honorees earned postseason all-league honors except for Peltekian, who was hampered by injuries but did record an interception in the Lafayette game.

# EAD COACH KEVIN CAHILL



A fiery competitor who is widely regarded as a strong teacher and mentor, Kevin Cahill is in his third season as Lehigh's head coach. Cahill and his staff have worked tirelessly to build "The Nest" at Lehigh, an endeavor that paid off in

Lehigh's league-leading 13th Patriot League title in 2024.

The Mountain Hawks enjoyed the second-largest turnaround in FCS football in 2024, posting a 9-4 record, a nine-win improvement over Cahill's first season. Lehigh won its final five regular season games, clinching its 13th Patriot League title and the league's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs. From there, Lehigh went on the road and defeated Richmond 20-16 for Lehigh's first playoff win since

Ten Mountain Hawks garnered All-Patriot League recognition, with Cahill selected as the Dick Biddle Patriot League Coach of the Year and a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award. Lehigh featured a top-15 rushing offense while the defensive unit ranked among the FCS leaders in pass defense and total defense.

Center George Padezanin and defensive lineman Matt Spatny earned All-America honors from the Associated Press, becoming Lehigh's first football All-Americans in five years.

In his first season as a head coach Cahill saw three of his players earn All-Patriot League recognition: defensive lineman Dean Colton, linebacker Mike DeNucci and safety Nick Peltekian. Cahill picked up his first victory as a head coach on Sept. 9, 2023 at Merrimack and his first Patriot League win Oct. 21 at Bucknell.

Cahill was named the 30th head coach in Lehigh football history on Dec. 19, 2022. A coaching veteran with more than 20 years of experience, Cahill came to Lehigh following 10 seasons at Yale University, where he was a member of the coaching staff for three Ivy League championship teams and oversaw one of the nation's top offensive units.

From 2018-22 Cahill served as Yale's Associate Head Coach and Offensive Coordinator, working directly with the quarterbacks. In 2022, the Bulldogs went 8-2 overall and 6-1 in Ivy League play to capture their third lvy crown in the last five seasons. Yale boasted the top-ranked offense in the Ivy League and ranked in the top 25 in the FCS in total offense for the fourth time in the last five seasons

Under Cahill's guidance, Yale quarterback Nolan Grooms thrived in his first full season as a starter. Grooms threw for 1,660 yards and 14 touchdowns and added 745 yards and six touchdowns on the ground on the way to winning the Asa S. Bushnell Cup as the Ivy League's Offensive Player of the Year.

Cahill initially came to Yale as Special Teams Coordinator and Wide Receivers Coach in 2012 and took over the guarterbacks in 2014 while also serving as Assistant Head Coach and Passing Game Coordinator. His highly-touted offense helped Yale capture Ivy League titles in 2017 and 2019 in addition to the 2022 championship.

Cahill moved on to Yale following four seasons on the staff at the University of Maine, including three as Special Teams Coordinator, while also coaching the wide receivers and running backs during his tenure. He helped the Black Bears to a pair of FCS playoff appearances and mentored six all-conference performers including All-Americans Jared Turcotte and Jhamal Fluellen.

During the 2006 and 2007 campaigns, Cahill coached at Murray State University, where coached the wide receivers and was the Racers' Recruiting Coordinator. He mentored two all-conference student-athletes.

Cahill's first Division I experience was at the University of Tennessee-Martin in 2004 and 2005, where he helped the program record its first winning season in 13 years. He began his coaching career at Maine Maritime Academy in 2001 before returning to his alma mater, Springfield College for two seasons.

As a student-athlete, Cahill was a three-year starter at quarterback and a three-year starting pitcher on the baseball team at Springfield College. He helped lead Springfield College to a pair of NCAA playoff appearances and was twice recognized as the ECAC Division III New England Player of the

A native of New York Mills, N.Y., Cahill graduated from Springfield College in 2001 with a degree in physical education. He added a masters in athletic administration from Springfield in 2004.

Cahill and his wife Carah have three children: sons Patrick and Thomas and a daughter Elizabeth.
