TODAY'S GAME

- It is Family Weekend at Villanova and the Wildcats will play their only home contest in the span of more than a month when they kick off against William & Mary on Saturday. The game comes in the middle of a stretch where VU is playing four of five games on the road.
- Villanova has won a program record 17 straight home games dating back to the middle of the 2022 season. The streak is the second longest active home winning streak in the FCS behind South Dakota's 31 consecutive wins.
- William & Mary joined what was then the Yankee Conference in 1993 and since then has been a league foe of the Wildcats in the Yankee Conference and successively the Atlantic 10 and CAA Football. The conference rivalry is set to continue beyond this year, as the two schools announced six weeks apart this Spring that they would join the Patriot League in 2026 as associate members in football. Upon making the conference move, the Wildcats and the Tribe will be reunited with another former CAA rival in Richmond.
- Graduate quarterback Pat McQuaide topped 5,000 career passing yards in last week's game at Monmouth. He threw for 333 yards and two touchdowns in the game and has now thrown for 5,073 yards (445-of-772) with 30 touchdowns as a collegian.
- Sixth year collegian **Lucas Kopecky** joined the football team as a walk-on last season after a four-year lacrosse career for the Wildcats. He has played in 14 career games on the gridiron and has made at least one catch in every one.

VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK

TODAY'S GAME

■ Villanova takes on William & Mary in a Family Weekend game this Saturday afternoon. Kickoff is scheduled for 3:30 p.m. at Villanova Stadium as the Wildcats play their only home game in a five-week span. Saturday's game will stream live on FloCollege with Ben Curtis and Steve Pinone calling the action plus Tessa Peloso providing sideline coverage. The radio broadcast on the Villanova Sports Radio Network has Ryan Fannon and Nick Mantegna in the booth. Their call can be heard on Fox Sports Radio Philly which is accessible on mobile devices via the iHeart radio app.

ABOUT VILLANOVA

■ Villanova opened the season at home on September 6 but is now in the middle of a stretch of playing four road games in a span of five weeks. In the past two weeks the Wildcats have traveled to one of the top-ranked FBS members (No. 2 Penn State) and a nationally ranked conference foe (then-No. 21 Monmouth). Last week's game at Monmouth was the conference opener for both teams and Villanova fell behind early against the nation's top-ranked passing offense and was forced to play catch-up the entire way.

ABOUT WILLIAM & MARY

■ William & Mary is 2-2 overall this season and carries a 1-0 mark in conference play after a come-from-behind win over Maine three weeks ago. That game was a home victory for the Tribe and saw running back Rashad Raymond score the go-ahead and eventual game-winning touchdown on a one-yard run with 3:11 to play. William & Mary ranks ninth in the FCS this season with a plus-four turnover margin and has turned the ball over just one time while forcing its opponents into five miscues.

CONFERENCE RIVALS

■ Villanova and William & Mary first played each other back in 1966 but they have been conference opponents under the banners of the Yankee Conference, the Atlantic 10 and most recently CAA Football since 1993. That rivalry is set to continue beyond this season as both schools will join the Patriot League as associate members in football starting in 2026. William & Mary announced its move to the Patriot League on April 25 of this year, followed six weeks later by Villanova on June 5.

SERIES STUFF

- William & Mary leads the all-time series with Villanova by a 20-16-1 margin and also has an advantage of 14-11 in regular season conference games. The road team had won five straight games in the series until the last meeting in 2022 when the Tribe posted a home win over the Wildcats.
- Villanova is 11-9 at home in the all-time series against William & Mary but has lost the last three games played at Villanova Stadium in 2015, 2018 and 2021. The last Wildcats home win in the series was in 2013 (20-16), while their last victory overall versus W&M was a 2019 thriller (35-28) at Zable Stadium in Williamsburg.
- One of the most significant wins in program history was at Villanova Stadium in 2009 when the Wildcats defeated the Tribe, 14-13, in the semifinal round of the FCS playoffs. The win, played in frigig temperatures on a Friday night, advanced Villanova to its first ever FCS national championship game where it would go on to capture the title with a win over Montana.

VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK

MILESTONE MAN

■ Graduate quarterback **Pat McQuaide** surpassed 5,000 career passing yards in the game at Monmouth last week. His career stats include the past two seasons as a starter at Nicholls in addition to his first three games with the Wildcats this season. McQuaide is 445-of-772 through the air in his collegiate career with 5,073 passing yards to go along with 30 touchdowns and two interceptions. He threw for 333 yards (25-of-43) and two scores last week to tally his third career 300-yard game and first in a Villanova uniform.

STREAK CONTINUES

■ Sixth year collegian Lucas Kopecky has caught at least one pass in all 14 college football games he has played in. He extended the streak with two catches for 26 yards last week at Monmouth and now has career totals of 34 catches for 433 yards and two touchdowns. Kopecky played four years of lacrosse for Villanova (2021-24) before walking on to the football team as a graduate student before the 2024 season. He was a three-year football letterwinner at Montgomery (N.J.) High School during his scholastic career, earning two all-conference and two honorable mention all-state accolades.

CENTURY MARK RECEIVER

■ Villanova has gotten a big boost at wide receiver from 2025 newcomer **Luke Colella**. He has topped 100 receiving yards in two of the season's first three games, including last week when he made a career high nine catches at Monmouth and finished the day with 117 yards. Colella played at Princeton during his undergraduate career and is a veteran of 31 collegiate games played between the Tigers and the Wildcats. His career totals are 108 catches for 1,432 yards and 11 touchdowns.

RECEIVING LINE

■ Villanova has had at least seven different receivers catch a pass in each of the first three games of the 2025 season, including eight last week at Monmouth. So far this season the Wildcats have had 40 completions to wide receivers, 10 to running backs and six to tight ends.

GROUND GAME

■ Sophomore running back **David Avit** rushed for 135 yards and three touchdowns in last week's game at Monmouth. It was his third career game with over 100 rushing yards and his second with at least three touchdowns. The game marked his first occasion with both of those milestones in 2025. Avit is the Wildcats leading rusher this season with 237 yards on the ground and three touchdowns so far on the year.

RUSHING FOR 1,000

■ Sophomore running back **David Avit** became the 43rd player in school history to reach 1,000 career rushing yards during the September 13 game at Penn State. It took just 16 career games played for Avit to reach the 1,000 plateau. The only players in Villanova history who have gotten to 1,000 rushing yards in fewer games are quarterback *John Robertson* (2011-15) who needed 14 games and running back *Gene Filipski* (1952-53) who reached the milestone in just 11 games. Avit has 216 carries for 1,160 yards and 12 TDs in his collegiate career to go along with 16 receptions for another 222 yards. Avit was a finalist for last year's Jerry Rice Award which is presented to the top freshman in the FCS. He ranked third among FCS freshmen with 923 rushing yards last season and is on the watch list for this year's Walter Payton Award.

VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK

DEFENSIVE DOINGS

- Prior to its trip to FCS No. 2 Penn State two weeks ago, Villanova had not allowed an opponent to score 50 points in a game in 20 years. It has now happened in consecutive weeks as the Wildcats allowed 52 points to the Nittany Lions and 51 last week against Monmouth. It is the first time since 1954 that Villanova has surrendered 50 points twice in a row. Despite the exception from the norm, there have been positive signs from a young and athletic defense through the season's first three games...
- Villanova had 14 pass breakups through its first two games played this season, including eight in the season opener against Colgate and six at Penn State. The last time VU had as many as 14 pass breakups in a two-game span was during the 2021 season against UAlbany and Rhode Island. The team hasn't had this many pass breakups in the first two games of a season in at least 20 years based on immediately available data. Redshirt freshman safety **Anthony Hawkins** leads the team so far with three pass breakups on the year.
- Villanova did not allow a play from scrimmage of longer than 23 yards in its game at Penn State. Although the Nittany Lions had four pass completions that ranged between 21-23 yards, the Wildcats defense held Penn State to a respectable 6.7 average yards per play in the game. It was the fewest yards per play by an FBS opponent against VU since a 2018 win over Temple when Villanova held the Owls to 4.8 yards per play.
- On the opening drive of the game at Penn State, the Nittany Lions converted two straight third down chances to extend what would eventually be a 12-play scoring drive. From that point on however, the Wildcats defense held Penn State to just 3-of-9 on third down the rest of the game. Through three games played this season, Villanova has allowed just five third down conversions in the second half (5-of-14) by its opponents.
- Seven of the starters on the current Villanova depth chart are in their first year in a starting role this season. That group includes redshirt freshman linebacker **Omari Bursey**, junior linebacker **Turner Inge**, sophomore corners **Zahmir Dawud** and **Newtom Essiem**, and a trio of safeties in redshirt freshman **Anthony Hawkins**, senior **Christian Sapp** and senior **Garrett Rogan**.
- Not all of the faces are new ones on the Villanova defense. All three starting defensive linemen from a year ago Ayden Howard, Obinna Nwobodo and Capri Martin are back this year, as is preseason All-American Shane Hartzell to anchor the defense from his linebacker position. Hartzell already has 24 tackles through the first three games this season, including a game-high nine total stops in each of the last two outings. His fifth tackle of the game against Penn State was the 300th stop of his career. Hartzell has 313 total tackles, 24.5 tackles for loss and 13 sacks in 45 career games played.

FANTASTIC FIVE

■ Villanova has compiled a record of 37-17 (.685) over the last five seasons (2021-25) while making three playoff appearances and winning 10+ games three times. At the start of the season the Wildcats were one of six FCS teams to have won 10 or more games in at least three of the last four years, while in terms of winning percentage Villanova ranked 12th among all FCS teams since the start of the 2021 season. Its 37 wins in the same span of time are the most of any CAA Football member.

VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK

DECADE OF DOMINANCE

■ Villanova is the only current CAA Football member to have won at least 70 games over the past decade (2015-25). In this strech the Wildcats have an overall record of 73-43 (.629) and have gone 47-30 (.610) in regular season conference games while making the playoffs five times.

- Villanova is ranked No. 20 in this week's Stats Perform FCS Top 25 and comes in at No. 22 in the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll. This year is the 33rd time in the last 38 seasons that the Wildcats have been nationally ranked at some point during the season.
- Villanova ranks fourth among all teams in FCS history (since 1978) for the number of weeks appearing in the national media poll. In their 329 weeks being nationally ranked, the Wildcats have been in the top 10 for a total of 153 weeks (11th most all-time) and have been ranked in the top five for 66 weeks.

VILLANOVA NOTEBOOK

RECORD-SETTING DEBUT

■ No Villanova quarterback has ever thrown for 300 yards in his first start for the team. However, the last two signal callers to debut for the Wildcats have thrown for 298 and 299 yards, respectively. Graduate student Pat McQuaide, a transfer from Nicholls, made his first start for VU against Colgate on September 6 and threw for 299 yards and a score. He surpassed the previous school record for most passing yards in the first start for the team which was held for the past three years by Connor Watkins, the starter from 2022-24 who threw for 298 yards in his first career start against Lehigh to open the 2022 season. McQuaide is also just the third left-handed quarterback to start for Villanova in their FCS era. The others are Christian Culicerto (2011) and Zach Bednarczyk (2015-18).

MORE ON MCQUAIDE

■ In addition to setting a record for most passing yards by a quarterback in his first VU start, **Pat McQuaide** became the third straight Villanova starter to win his debut while throwing for over 200 yards and recording at least one passing and rushing touchdown.

VILLANOVA FOOTBALL HISTORY

■ Villanova has compiled a 288-172-1 (.626) record in 40 seasons as an FCS member. The program's success includes 16 appearances in the FCS playoffs and appearing in the final national rankings of the season 19 times in the last 36 years.

ENTERING WITH LIFE EXPERIENCE

- The oldest active player in Division I college football this season is Villanova punter **Luke Larsen** who recently turned 33 years old and made his Wildcats debut in the season opener against Colgate. Larsen is a graduate student transfer from East Carolina and a native of Australia who played Australian Rules Football, volleyball, cricket and tennis during his scholastic career prior to coming to the United States.
- Larsen is off to a strong start for Villanova and has punted 17 times through the first three games of the season. He is averaging 40.3 yards per punt with two attempts for over 50 yards and four that have been downed inside the opponent's 20-yard line. Larsen previously appeared in 43 games at East Carolina and punted 174 times while averaging 40.8 yards per punt. He landed 51 punts inside the 20-yard line, booted 19 punts for 50+ yards and had 75 of 174 attempts fair caught. He ranked second all-time in net punting for the Pirates and was a two-time National Football Foundation Honor Society member in 2024 and 2025.

VETERAN EXPERIENCE

■ Villanova has 93 players on its 2025 roster and they have played in a combined 1,259 games in their collegiate careers. Leading the way for the Wildcats are 15 players who have played in at least 30 career games, including seven who have played 40 or more. Villanova has six new graduate transfers on the team this year and each played in at least two dozen games prior to arriving on the Main Line. The six are punter Luke Larsen (East Carolina); placekicker Jack Barnum (Central Connecticut State); wide receiver Luke Colella (Princeton); quarterback Pat McQuaide (Nichollas); and defensive backs Jordan Adderley (Lehigh) and Julian Talley (Penn).

PRESEASON WATCH LISTS

■ Sophomore running back **David Avit** and senior linebacker **Shane Hartzell** have been named to the preseason watch lists for the Walter Payton Award and the Buck Buchanan Award, respectively. These national honors are given to the top offensive and defensive players in the FCS at the end of each season. Villaonva is one of 10 teams to have at least one player on both watch lists at the start of the season. The others are Harvard, Illinois State, Montana, Montana State, North Dakota State, Rhode Island, Samford, South Dakota State and UIW.

NATIONAL ATTENTION

■ Fifth year offensive lineman **Jake Picard** and senior linebacker **Shane Hartzell** generated preseason All-America buzz entering the year. Picard is on the Stats Perform Preseason All-America first team and Hartzell appears on the second team. It is the first time in their careers that either player has garnered national accolades. This season is the fourth time in the last five years that at least one Villanova player has earned preseason All-America recognition.

POSTSEASON SUCCESS

■ Villanova is tied for 10th in FCS history with 16 playoff appearances. In their FCS playoff history, the Wildcats have a record of 15-15 with one natonal championship (2009) and three semifinal berths (2002, 2009, 2010). Villanova has won at least one playoff game in 10 of its last 12 postseason appearances. The 15 playoff wins for the Wildcats are tied for the 12th most ever among current FCS programs.

ABOUT THE SCHOOL

VILLANOVA ATHLETICS

Villanova University has a long and storied athletics history defined by excellence both in competition and in the classroom. The Villanova Athletics Department is a community of studentathletes, coaches and staff whose primary focus is to achieve academic excellence, while striving to produce teams and individuals committed to athletic competition and outstanding performance. Villanova Athletics sponsors 24 varsity sports, which together include more than 550 student-athletes. In the classroom, these Villanova student-athletes have registered a grade-point average higher than a 3.0 for 44 consecutive semesters. Three Villanova student-athletes have been named Rhodes Scholars, with numerous others earning Academic All-America distinction. Villanova's athletics history includes 21 NCAA team national championships, as well as more than 100 conference championships. In addition, at least one Villanovan has participated in every Summer Olympics since 1948. Villanova is a member of the BIG EAST Conference, CAA Football, Coastal Athletic Association (Rowing) and Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (Water Polo).

ACADEMICS

The GPA for more than 550 student-athletes in the Spring 2025 semester was 3.495, making it 15 straight semesters that student-athletes have had a GPA of 3.3 or higher. Success in the classroom has been across-the-board for Villanova Athletics, with 87 percent of all student-athletes compiling a GPA of 3.0 or higher and 73 student-athletes from 18 sports maintaining a perfect 4.0 GPA.

The most recent NCAA data to be released was the Academic Progress Rate (APR) update in May 2025 in which Villanova Athletics had 14 earn public recognition for having a multiyear APR score which ranks in the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. That included 13 teams who had a perfect score of 1000, making it eight straight years that the Wildcats have had 10 or more teams achieve a multi-year score of 1000.

ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

NCAA ACADEMIC DATA

- Each year the NCAA recognizes programs that have a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranks within the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. Villanova has earned this award nine times in the 18-year history of the APR program.
- In the most recent APR data released in June 2025 the football program's multi-year APR score of 982 was 24 points above the national average for FCS programs.
- New data on the NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) was released in November 2024 and Villanova recorded its fourth straight year with a score of 95 percent or higher.

ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

■ One of the highest honors that a student-athlete can achieve is to be named an Academic All-American, an award which encompasses both academic achievement as well as contributions on the field. Villanova has had 12 football student-athletes earn a total of 14 Academic All-America honors over the years.

CAA TEAM ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

■ Villanova has been the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award five times in the last nine years. The award is presented at the end of each academic year to the conference school with the highest team GPA.

CAA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

■ Villanova has had five student-athletes be named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Nominees for the award must have attained senior standing academically and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

CAA ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

■ Student-athletes with a semester GPA of 3.0 or higher are named to the CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll. Villanova had 63 honorees for the Fall 2024 semester and 64 student-athletes achieve this distinction for the Spring 2025 term.

ACADEMIC ALL-AREA TEAMS

■ In conjunction with the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, the sports information directors at the colleges and universities in the Philadelphia area (PhillySIDA) name an Academic All-Area team and a football Performer of the Year each season. In the 19 years of the Academic All-Area program, which started with the 2005-06 academic year, the football team has had a total of 64 selections to the Academic All-Area Team. In addition, the Wildcats have had six Performers of the Year.

VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE



Mark Ferrante enters his ninth season as the Thomas and Diane Treacy Endowed Football Head Coach in 2025 and is in his 39th year overall with the Wildcats including his time as head coach and 30 years prior as an assistant coach from 1987-2016. He has been a part of 274 victories and all 16 of the program's FCS playoff appearances during his Villanova tenure. Entering the 2025 season Ferrante has a career head coaching record of 57-33 (.633) which includes 36 regular season CAA Football wins, two league titles and four playoff appearances.

Under Ferrante's watch, the Wildcats have consistently been one of the top teams in the country. Villanova begins the 2025 season as one of six FCS programs to have won 10+

games in at least three of the last four years. During that span (2021-24), the Wildcats have made three playoff appearances and won a share of two CAA Football titles as well as the league's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs in 2021 and 2023. Villanova's overall record over the past four seasons is 36-15 (.706) and that mark includes a 24-8 record versus CAA Football foes and a 22-3 mark at home.

Ferrante guided the Wildcats to its second straight 10-win season in 2024 and its third appearance in the playoffs in the past four seasons. Villanova finished the year ranked No. 12 in the final Stats Perform national poll and was a top 10 team at the end of the season in two of the previous three years. Ferrante ranks third in school history in head coaching wins, while his .633 career winning percentage trails only Harry Stuhldreher (1925-35) and Clipper Smith (1936-42) among Wildcats head coaches who held the position for three or more seasons.

Villanova has consistently earned national recognition for its success during Ferrante's head coaching tenure. Following the 2024 season, linebacker Brendan Bell and cornerback Isas Waxter were selected as All-American by both Stats Perform and the Associated Press. Freshman running back David Avit was the CAA Football Offensive Rookie of the Year and a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award presented to the top FCS freshman. Honors have already started to come in for the 2025 campaign with Avit on the watch list for the Walter Payton Award and linebacker Shane Hartzell on the Buck Buchanan Award preseason watch list. Their accolades make the Wildcats one of 10 schools to have at least one player on the watch lists for the top offensive and defensive honors in the FCS.

In his first eight seasons as head coach, Ferrante has seen the Wildcats win six CAA Football major awards and earn a total of 61 all-conference accolades. Five players under Ferrante's watch – Corbi, cornerback Christian Benford, linebacker Forrest Rhyne and the aforementioned duo of Bell and Waxter – have earned All-America honors from Stats Perform and/or the American Football Coaches Association. Benford and Rhyne were first team All-Americans in 2021. Ferrante is himself one of the CAA Football major award winners after earning his first Coach of the Year honor in 2021.

Villanova's recent teams have featured several players who had an opportunity to continue their football careers beyond the collegiate ranks. Most recent on the list is Isas Waxter who signed with the Seattle Seahawks as an undrafted free agent in 2025. Following the 2023 season, running back Jalen Jackson and offensive lineman Nick Torres signed free agent contracts with the Jacksonville Jaguars and the Kansas City Chiefs, respectively. Three other players – running back TD Ayo-Durojaiye (Chicago Bears/Kansas City Chiefs), linebacker Danny Abraham (Seattle Seahawks) and wide receiver Jaaron Hayek (Kansas City Chiefs) – were invited to attend NFL rookie mini camps.

Ferrante coached 11 players on the 2021 team who had professional opportunities, led by Christian Benford who was a sixth round draft pick of the Buffalo Bills and has since gone on to have a successful NFL career in Buffalo. In addition, 2021 CAA Football Defensive Player of the Year and first team All-American Forest Rhyne signed a free agent contract and played in the NFL with the Indianapolis Colts. Cornerback Denzel Williams signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Ravens.

One of the themes of Ferrante's head coaching tenure has been his ability to keep his teams largely intact throughout the COVID pandemic and the changing land-scape of college sports. Villanova began the 2021 season with 75 out of 85 players returning from the previous Spring, while the members of the 2023 team had

combined to play in more than 1,000 college football games even before the season started. Experience wins, and Nova Nation has taken notice. Villanova's average attendance for five regular season home games in 2021 was its highest mark since 2013 and represented a 23 percent increase from 2019 prior to the pandemic. The increased attendance included the Wildcats first home sellout crowd since 2015 during the 2021 Family Weekend game against Richmond.

Ferrante has continually stressed the importance of his student-athletes coming to Villanova for a complete collegiate experience which includes excellence in their academic pursuits. In his first eight years as head coach, the Wildcats have been the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award four times. The award is presented to the team with the highest GPA in the conference each academic year and Villanova has been a repeat winner of the honor in each of the last three years spanning the 2022-23 through 2024-25 academic years.

The football program set and tied its highest overall NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) with a mark of 96 percent in both 2022 and 2023, while the team has had a mark of at least 95 percent in four consecutive years. The most recent NCAA GSR data was released in November 2024 and the Wildcats were one of two CAA Football teams with a score of at least 95 percent.

During the 2024-25 academic year, the Wildcats had 63 student-athletes selected to the CAA Football Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll during the Fall semester and another 64 honorees for the Spring 2025 grading period. Two student-athletes each semester had perfect 4.0 GPAs: Gilbert Deglau and Chris Dobrydney in the Fall and the duo of Temi Ajirotutu and Ryan Kennedy in the Spring. Villanova had a total of 34 selections to the CAA High Honors List in 2024-25 for having a 3.7 or higher semester GPA.

Villanova has had nearly 800 selections to the CAA Football Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll during Ferrante's head coaching tenure and has had more than 650 selections to the Athletic Director's Honor Roll which is announced each semester for student-athletes who post a GPA of 3.2 or higher during the grading period.

Ferrante leads one of the nation's elite FCS programs after playing an instrumental role in the Wildcats rise to national prominence. He has been a part of the coaching staff for all 16 of Villanova's appearances in the FCS playoffs, including

the 2009 national championship season and a 2010 semifinal appearance while serving as the Assistant Head Coach on Andy Talley's staff. Ferrante has been a part of Villanova teams that have won eight CAA titles, three Lambert Meadowlands Cups and three ECAC Team of the Year awards.

Ferrante was involved in all aspects of the Villanova program during his time as an assistant on Andy Talley's staff. On the field he coached the offensive line for 27 seasons and developed a unit that was perennially one of the best in CAA Football. Over the years he coached three All-Americans, 11 All-East performers and 15 first team all-conference selections. The offensive line had 17 All-CAA selections in a nine-year span, including three-time first team honoree Ben Ijalana along with first team selections Brant Clouser (2010), Dan Shirey (2011) and Vince Kowalski (2014).

Two of Ferrante's players went on to be selected in the NFL Draft. Ijalana was a second round selection by the Indianapolis Colts in 2011 and Brad Seaton was picked in the seventh round by the Tennessee Titans in 2017. Ijalana was a two-time All-American (2009, 2010) and a three-time first team All-CAA selection during his collegiate career. Villanova reached the FCS playoffs in each of his last three seasons on the team, winning the 2009 national title and advancing to the semifinal round a year later. Seaton was a second team CAA Football All-Conference selection in 2016 when the offensive line enabled the Wildcats to average 206.3 rushing yards and 378.7 yards of total offense per game. Villanova ranked third in the CAA and 24th nationally in rushing offense in addition to ranking fourth in the league in total offense and fifth with a scoring average of 24.4 points per game.

The other All-Americans Ferrante mentored are Eamonn Allen (2001) and Bryan Russo (1989). Allen earned first team Associated Press All-America recognition in 2001 and was also a first team All-East and first team All-Atlantic 10 selection. Russo was chosen as an All-American by the Sports Network and the American Football Coaches Association as a senior in 1989 when he was also a first team all-conference and an All-ECAC selection. He was inducted to Villanova's Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2007.

Ferrante and his wife, Georgea, reside in Phoenixville, Pa. The couple has a son, Jimmy, who earned his undergraduate degree from Villanova in 2018.
