PATRIOT LEAGUE NOTEBOOK (WEEK ONE)

A NEW ERA OF PATRIOT LEAGUE FOOTBALL CONTINUES IN WEEK ONE

- Patriot League Play Continues** - Lehigh travels to Georgetown in search of its 19th straight regular-season victory, which would mark the third-longest streak in program history. Colgate hosts Holy Cross after a 2025 meeting that saw the Raiders erase an 18-point second-half deficit to earn a 29-28 win. Bucknell and Villanova meet for the 29th time, but the first time since 2021, with the Wildcats winning the last 11 matchups.
- Patriot League vs. FBS** - Lafayette heads to UConn (Noon) and Fordham flies to North Dakota State for the first two of nine games Patriot League teams will play against FBS opponents in 2026. The last League team to defeat an FBS opponent was the Rams, who downed Buffalo, 40-37, on Sept. 9, 2023.
- Patriot League vs. MEAC** - Richmond travels to Howard and William & Mary hosts Delaware State in two of the four games Patriot League teams will play against MEAC opponents in 2026. The PL went 2-0 against the MEAC in 2025.

A NEW ERA OF PATRIOT LEAGUE FOOTBALL: PATRIOT LEAGUE IN THE POLLS

- AFCA COACHES POLL**: Four Patriot League teams appeared in the AFCA Coaches Poll for the first time in League history when it was announced on Monday. Lehigh climbed one spot to No. 10 from its preseason ranking after a 35-10 win at Holy Cross. Villanova checked in at No. 17, and William & Mary entered the poll at No. 19 after its dramatic win against the Wildcats on Friday. Richmond also entered the poll at No. 23 after a 35-14 victory over Bucknell in its season opener.
- STATS PERFORM FCS TOP 25 POLL**: No. 10 Lehigh, No. 17 William & Mary and No. 18 Villanova all appeared in this week's Stats Perform FCS Top 25 Poll, with Richmond receiving votes. This marks the first week since the postseason poll of the 2009 season in which three Patriot League squads were ranked. In that final poll, conducted by The Sports Network, Patriot League champion Holy Cross was No. 14, Colgate was No. 21 and Lafayette was No. 24.

PATRIOT LEAGUE FOOTBALL OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Danny Shaban, Colgate, Jr., RB, Redding, Conn./Joel Barlow

*Shaban rushed for a career-high 214 yards and two touchdowns on 28 carries to lead Colgate to a 24-14 victory at Fordham. He also had three receptions for 26 yards.

*The junior running back scored the first touchdown of the game in the first quarter, then sealed the Raiders' victory with a 29-yard touchdown run with 1:53 remaining in the fourth quarter.

*He is Colgate's first 200-yard rusher since Nov. 3, 2012, when Gavin McCarney (288) and Jordan McCord (203) accomplished the feat in the same game.

PATRIOT LEAGUE FOOTBALL DEFENSIVE PLAYER AND ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Cade Ellis, William & Mary, Fr., S, Orange, Va./Woodberry Forest

*Ellis intercepted two passes in his collegiate debut, to help the Tribe to a 35-32 comeback victory over No. 7/8 Villanova.

*The freshman safety intercepted his second pass of the game with seconds remaining, returning it 24 yards to set up the game-winning field goal.

*He intercepted his first pass of the game in the second quarter after the Wildcats crossed into W&M territory.

PATRIOT LEAGUE FOOTBALL SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Max Lipinski, William & Mary, Jr., PK, King George, Va./King George

*Lipinski broke a William & Mary single-game record with five field goals, including the game-winning 45-yarder as time expired on a 35-32 victory over No. 7/8 Villanova.

*The junior placekicker also connected on a 40-yard field goal with 53 seconds left in the fourth quarter to cut the deficit to seven points.

*He made all five of his field-goal attempts (22, 39, 41, 40, 45), finishing with 17 points.

HONORABLE MENTIONS

Nick Peltekian, Lehigh, 5th-year, DB, Mahwah, N.J./Deerfield Academy

*Peltekian posted eight tackles and an interception in the Mountain Hawks' 35-10 win at Holy Cross. He returned his sixth career interception 28 yards to set up Luke Yoder's third rushing touchdown of the game.

Luke Yoder, Lehigh, Sr., RB, Palm Harbor, Fla./East Lake

*Yoder rushed for 130 yards and three touchdowns to lead Lehigh to a 35-10 victory at Holy Cross. The reigning Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year recorded his 12th 100-yard rushing game and moved into fifth place on Lehigh's career rushing touchdowns list (33).

Bryce Allen, Richmond, Fr., WR, Frisco, Texas/Rock Hill

*Allen finished with four receptions for 106 yards and two touchdowns in his collegiate debut to lead the Spiders to a 35-14 win over Bucknell. He became Richmond's first freshman since at least 1949 to record 100 or more receiving yards in a season opener.

Camden Byrd, Richmond, Gr., DE, Ashland, Va./Patrick Henry

*Byrd recorded a career-high three sacks while helping Richmond hold Bucknell to 187 yards of total offense in a 35-14 win. The Patriot League Preseason Defensive Player of the Year's three sacks were for a loss of 20 yards, helping the Spiders hold the Bison to just 32 rushing yards on 29 carries. He added a pass breakup and a quarterback hurry, while Richmond's defense held Bucknell scoreless until late in the third quarter.

Ned Gray, Richmond, So., P, Melbourne, Australia/St. Leonard's

*Gray averaged 44.9 yards per punt on eight attempts with a long of 57 yards in the Spiders' 35-14 win over Bucknell. The Melbourne, Australia, native placed three punts inside the Bucknell 20-yard line, including two inside the five.

Omari Bursey, Villanova, So., LB, Brookfield, Colo./Legacy

*Bursey posted Week Zero Patriot League-highs of 15 tackles and 4.0 tackles for loss (TFL) in the Wildcats' loss. He had one sack and eight solo tackles against the Tribe.

Winston Watkins, William & Mary, Jr., QB, Pasadena, Md./Mount Saint Josephs

*Watkins led the Tribe to a 35-32 comeback win over No. 7/8 Villanova, including a game-tying, 37-yard touchdown pass to Kai Austin with 22 seconds left in the game. He completed 19-of-33 passes for 254 yards and two touchdowns and rushed for 72 yards and another touchdown on 21 carries.

PATRIOT LEAGUE WINS VS. FBS OPPONENTS

Patriot League teams will face nine FBS opponents during the 2026 season, including two in Week One. Since 2000, the Patriot League has recorded eight victories against FBS (formerly I-A) opponents, with the last coming in Fordham's 40-37 victory at Buffalo in 2023. Fordham and Holy Cross have three FBS wins apiece, while Colgate and Lehigh each have one.

WILLIAM & MARY, VILLANOVA DEBUT IN INSTANT CLASSIC TRIBE COMEBACK RECEIVES NATIONAL ATTENTION

William & Mary and Villanova made their Patriot League debut Friday in an instant classic. The Tribe erased a 10-point deficit in the final 53 seconds in a dramatic comeback victory that has received more than 4.6 million views on the ESPN @ SportsCenter post on X and 43.5 million online impressions on various media outlets.

TRIBE'S LIPINSKI RECEIVES NATIONAL WEEKLY HONORS

Max Lipinski (Jr., PK) was named the Stats Perform FCS National Special Teams Player of the Week for his performance in the Tribe's win over Villanova on Friday. Lipinski booted a career-long 45-yard field goal as time expired to complete a 10-point comeback in the final minute of the game, which also included a 40-yard field goal. His five made field goals broke a single-game program record, as he connected from 22, 39, 41, 40 and 45 yards. Colgate's Danny Shaban (Jr., RB), Villanova's Omari Bursey (So., LB) and W&M's Cade Ellis earned honorable mentions for offensive, defensive and rookie of the week, respectively.

YODER SECOND AMONG FCS CAREER LEADERS

Lehigh RB Luke Yoder, the 2025 Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year, rushed for 130 yards and three touchdowns in the Mountain Hawks' season-opening win at Holy Cross. His performance gave him 3,197 career rushing yards to rank second among active FCS leaders, behind only Montana's Eli Gilman. Yoder is 18th among Patriot League career rushers entering Week One. Yoder is also third among active FCS rushers with 33 career touchdowns. He has rushed for more than 1,000 yards and at least 10 touchdowns in the last two seasons to lead Lehigh to consecutive Patriot League titles.

Colgate's Danny Shaban (Jr., RB) rushed for 214 yards and two touchdowns on 28 carries to lead the Raiders to a 24-14 season-opening victory at Fordham. Shaban marked the first Colgate rusher to top 200 yards in a single game since QB Gavin McCarney (288) and RB Jordan McCord (203) both eclipsed the mark in a 65-41 win over Lafayette on Nov. 3, 2012. After one week, Shaban leads the FCS in rushing yards (214) and all-purpose yards (240).

BUCKNELL TABS JEFF BEHRMAN AS HEAD COACH

Bucknell selected Jeff Behrman as the 28th head football coach in program history. Behrman, a 30-year veteran in the college football coaching ranks, comes to Lewisburg from his alma mater, John Carroll, where he guided the Blue Streaks to a 29-7 record in his three seasons. Behrman was named the Division III Region 4 Coach of the Year in 2025 after his top-10 team finished 12-2, won the North Coast Athletic Conference title, and made a run to the NCAA semifinals. J

LEHIGH'S POOLE NAMED TO FCS PUNTER OF THE YEAR LIST

Lehigh's Connor Poole (Jr., P) was one of 14 candidates selected to the Preseason Watch List for the 2026 FCS Punter of the Year Award, presented by The Augusta Sports Council. Poole earned First Team All-Patriot League honors in 2025 after averaging 42.1 yards per punt with a season-long punt of 57 yards and nine punts of 50 yards or more. He pinned 17 punts inside the opposing 20-yard line.

THREE MAKE FELDMAN'S "FREAKS" LIST IN THE ATHLETIC

Three Patriot League football players made Bruce Feldman's annual "Freaks" in college football list, published by *The Athletic*.

***No. 65 Stephon Hicks, William & Mary, LB** - He had a profound effect on William & Mary's special teams, where he led all of Division I with four blocked punts (one shy of tying the FCS record) and returned a punt for a touchdown. He made 23 tackles, had two sacks and two forced fumbles. The 6-2, 215-pound junior broad-jumped 10-11 and touched 11 feet on the Vertec. He's also clocked a 10-yard fly with a 10-yard build-up of 1.01 seconds and has topped out at 22.5 mph on the GPS.

***No. 83 JoJo Williams, Holy Cross, RB** - The 5-7, 181-pound sophomore ran for 121 yards last season to go with 17 receptions and 17 receiving yards. He's considered pound-for-pound the strongest player in the program, squatting 600 pounds and benching 320. This offseason, he did a force plate counter movement jump of 61 cm in addition to having a 10-9 broad jump and a 40.2-inch vertical.

***No. 99 Daniel Sellers, Richmond, DE** - Last year as a redshirt freshman, the 6-3, 253-pound Sellers emerged as a playmaker for the Spiders, making 4.5 TFLs and three sacks and forcing two fumbles. Sellers won the program's Gus Lee Winter Warrior Award, honoring the player who made the biggest strides during offseason workouts.

"He's a freak in the weight room because he can squat 600 pounds, he can bench 455-plus and can power clean around 365, and he moves so fast," said Richmond strength coach Scott Brincks. "You just don't see that in a normal human. He's that much of a freak when it comes to those things."

TWO NOMINATED FOR 2025 GOOD WORKS TEAM

Richmond's Carter Glassmyer and William & Mary's Davin Dzidzienyo are among the nominees for the 2026 AFCA All-state Good Works Team. Allstate and the AFCA announced 162 nominees for the honor, recognizing college football players and coaches for their commitment to community service and leadership beyond the gridiron. The 2026 All-state AFCA Good Works Team will be announced in September and will include 22 student-athletes and one honorary head coach. One student-athlete will also be selected as team captain and receive the Allstate Wuerffel Trophy.

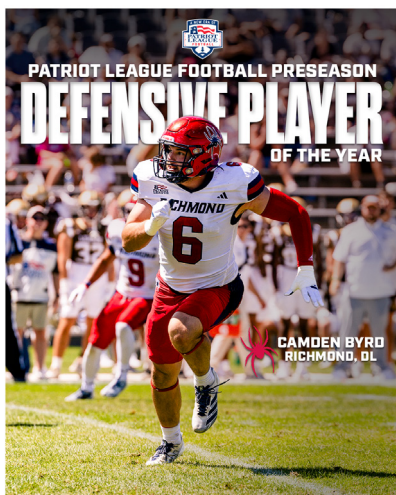

b. If a tie still exists, a comparison of League records will be made between the tied institutions starting at the highest seed and continuing through the lowest seed, if necessary.

c. If a tie still exists, a comparison of records against common out-of-league opponents will be made.

d. If a tie still exists, a comparison of rank according to the FCS Committee Metric will be made.

e. If a tie still exists, a committee consisting of the athletics directors of each of the institutions not involved in the tie will make a final decision. The committee should consider various factors, including, but not limited to, the following examples. Note: the criteria are listed in no particular order:

1. Strength of schedule
 2. Overall record
 3. Computer rankings
 4. Performance during the second half of the season
- The committee will meet immediately following the release of the FCS Committee Metric should a tie still exist. A majority vote of the committee is required to determine the champion.

Note: In the case of a multiple-team tiebreaker (more than two teams), the process will revert to the beginning of the tiebreaker formula once the tie has been reduced to two teams.

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2026-27 PATRIOT LEAGUE ATHLETICS & ACADEMIC SUCCESS

Now in its fourth decade as an all-sport conference combining academic and athletic excellence, the Patriot League sponsors championships in 24 men's and women's sports. Beginning as an NCAA Division I-AA football conference in 1986, the Patriot League became an all-sport conference in 1990 and now includes American, Army West Point, Boston University, Bucknell, Colgate, Holy Cross, Lafayette, Lehigh, Loyola Maryland and Navy as full members. Fordham, Georgetown, MIT, Richmond, Villanova and William & Mary are associate members. These institutions are among the oldest and most prestigious in the nation, while their alumni continue to play leadership roles in shaping our country.

The Patriot League's mission is simple: to provide successful competitive athletic experiences while maintaining high academic standards and preparing its student-athletes to be leaders in society. During the 2025-26 academic year, Patriot League student-athletes and teams accomplished the following:

*The League's 94 percent graduation success rate (GSR) is the third-best mark in the nation, finishing in the top three each year since the rating was released in 2013. All 10 member schools registered totals of 91 percent or higher, exceeding the record-high national GSR of 90 percent. In addition, the League's 83 percent Federal Graduation Rate (FGR) is the national leader for the 13th consecutive year.

*The Patriot League ranks among the leaders of the 32 NCAA Division I conferences in Academic Progress Rate (APR) (1994), eligibility (1996) and retention trends (1993) by conference. In the latest data release by the NCAA, the League stands second in APR, retention trends and eligibility trends by conference. The League had 165 of its 194 teams score at or above the national average multi-year APR of 986. Eighty-six squads earned a perfect score of 1,000.

*Seven student-athletes earned College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-America recognition, including first-team accolades for Navy's Andrew Schug (Men's Soccer) and Justin Mumford (Men's Track & Field/Cross Country). Second-team honorees include Army West Point's Jordan Follenweider (Women's Soccer) and Charlotte Richman (Women's Track and Field/Cross Country), Bucknell's David Krumov (Men's Soccer) and Navy's Zach Hayashi (At-Large, Men's Lacrosse). Bucknell's Wade Shomper (Men's Track & Field/Cross Country) received third-team accolades.

*A record 4,152 student-athletes named to the Patriot League Academic Honor Roll in 2025-26. The total marked the second year the League has topped 4,000 honorees and a 105-member improvement from the 2024-25 academic year.

*Navy's Justin Mumford (Men's Cross Country/Track and Field) and Boston University's Kasey Ricard (Softball) were named the Patriot League Men's and Women's Scholar-Athlete of the Year honorees, respectively.

*Bucknell's Freddie Lapworth (Men's Soccer) and Navy's Maren Louridas (Women's Basketball) received the 2025-26 Patriot League Award of Outstanding Leadership and Character, recognizing their shared excellence in leadership and service.

*Colgate's Hunter Drouin (Men's Lacrosse) and Holy Cross' Anna Brait (Softball) were named the League's 2025-26 Sportsmanship Award winners for demonstrating fairness, equality and excellence in academics and athletics.

*Navy captured the Patriot League Presidents' Cup following the 2025-26 academic year. The Midshipmen led the men's standings, while Army West Point finished atop the women's standings and second overall. It marked the 11th time in 12 seasons that Navy won the Presidents' Cup.

*Twenty-five Patriot League graduates have participated in the Victory Scholarship program, through the Sport Changes Life Foundation (SCLF), allowing them to attend graduate school in Ireland or Northern Ireland. A pair of League basketball student-athletes - Colgate's Zach Light and Lafayette's Naomi Ganpo - were the most recent recipients (2022-23 academic year).

*Ten Patriot League football student-athletes were named to the 2025 FCS ADA Academic All-Star Team: Bucknell's John Ohnegan, Colgate's

Treyvonn Saunders, Fordham's James Conway, Georgetown's Jimmy Kibble and Giancarlo Rufo, Holy Cross' Cam Nolan, Lafayette's Ethan Hosak and Phillip Peiffer, Richmond's Carter Glassmeyer and Scott Hummel. Ohnegan was selected as one of 12 finalists for the 2025 FCS ADA Postgraduate Scholarship.

*Patriot League men's basketball featured two national awards recipients, including Navy's Austin Benigni, who was named the Lou Henson Mid-Major National Player of the Year, and Navy head coach Jon Perry, who received the Hugh Durham National Mid-Major Coach of the Year award, both from CollegeInsider.com.

*The Patriot League featured 47 All-America selections during the 2025-26 athletic year with first-team status for Army West Point's Sean Byrne (Men's Lacrosse), Johnny Crush (Men's Swimming & Diving), Brigid Duffy (Women's Lacrosse), Evan Plunkett (Men's Lacrosse) and Allison Reilly (Women's Lacrosse), Bucknell's Evelyn Bliss (Women's Outdoor Track & Field), Fordham's James Conway (Football), Lehigh's Tyler Ochowski (Football), Loyola Maryland's Mae Murphy (Women's Lacrosse) and Navy's Alyssa Chung (Women's Lacrosse).

*One Patriot League men's lacrosse student-athlete was selected in the 2026 Premier Lacrosse League (PLL) College Draft, with Army West Point's Evan Plunkett being selected by the Denver Outlaws with the fourth pick in the first round. One Patriot League women's lacrosse student-athlete was selected in the 2026 Women's Lacrosse League (WLL) College Draft, with Army West Point's Brigid Duffy being selected by the Maryland Charm with the third pick in the first round.

*12 Patriot League men's lacrosse student-athletes were on PLL rosters during the 2026 season, including Army West Point's Sean Byrne (Philadelphia Waterdogs), Jackson Eicher (Carolina Chaos), Christian Mazur (Maryland Whipsnakes) and Evan Plunkett (Denver Outlaws), Colgate's Hunter Drouin (New York Atlas), Holy Cross' Chris Conlin (California Redwoods), Lafayette's Nolan Byrne (Denver Outlaws), Lehigh's Richard Checo (Carolina Chaos) and Mike Sisselberger (Utah Archers), Loyola Maryland's Adam Poitras (Maryland Whipsnakes), Payton Rezanka (Maryland Whipsnakes) and Remi Reynolds (Boston Cannons).

*Six Patriot League women's lacrosse student-athletes were on WLL rosters during the inaugural 2026 season, including Army West Point's Brigid Duffy (Maryland Charm) and Allison Reilly (New York Chargers), Loyola Maryland's Sydnie Black (Maryland Charm), Chase Boyle (Loyola Maryland), Katie Detwiler (California Palms) and Livy Rosenzweig (Loyola Maryland).

*Army West Point's Evan Plunkett (Men's Lacrosse) was honored with the Lt. J.G. Donald MacLaughlin Jr. Award, which is given annually to the nation's most outstanding midfielder. Plunkett is the first student-athlete in Patriot League history to receive the award.

*Army West Point's Sean Byrne (Men's Lacrosse) received the Ensign C. Markland Kelly Jr. Award, which is given annually to the nation's most outstanding goalie. Byrne is the second student-athlete in Patriot League history to receive the award, joining Navy's Matt Russell (2004).

*Army West Point's Brigid Duffy (Women's Lacrosse) was selected as the Midfielder of the Year by the Intercollegiate Women's Lacrosse Coaches Association (IWCA), marking the third time a Patriot League women's lacrosse student-athlete earned the award in the last four years, joining Loyola Maryland's Chase Boyle (2024) and Jillian Wilson (2023).

*Nine student-athletes from Patriot League football programs were on NFL rosters at the beginning of training camp season. Bucknell's Ethan Robinson (Miami Dolphins), Colgate's Max Hurlman (Pittsburgh Steelers) and Treyvonn Saunders (Houston Texans), Fordham's Nick Zakelj (San Francisco 49ers), Holy Cross' Liam Anderson (Cincinnati Bengals), Jalen Coker (Carolina Panthers), CJ Hanson (Kansas City Chiefs) and Kalif Raymond, and William & Mary's Charles Grant (Las Vegas Raiders).

*Five Patriot League baseball student-athletes have played on Major League Baseball (MLB) rosters during the 2026 season: Army West Point's Connely Early (Boston Red Sox/Washington Nationals), Lafayette's David Bednar (New York Yankees), who was selected as an MLB All-Star in 2022 and 2023, Bucknell's Sean Keys (Toronto Blue Jays), who made his

Big League debut in July, and Lehigh's Mason Black (Kansas City Royals) and Matt Svanson (St. Louis Cardinals).

*Three Patriot League men's basketball student-athletes played on NBA rosters during the 2025-26 season, including Lehigh's C.J. McCollum (Atlanta Hawks/Washington Wizards) and Loyola Maryland's Santi Aldama (Memphis Grizzlies) and Cam Spencer (Memphis Grizzlies). McCollum served as the President of the National Basketball Players Association (NBPA) from the 2021-22 season until July 2025. Aldama is a member of the NBPA Board of Directors. Former Bucknell men's basketball student-athlete Charles Lee enters his third season as the head coach of the Charlotte Hornets for the 2026-27 season.

*Five Patriot League soccer student-athletes are playing in the MLS or NWSL. American's Troy Elgersma (Los Angeles Galaxy), Army West Point's Zac McGraw (Portland Timbers) and Boston University's Francesco Montali (San Jose Earthquakes) are currently playing in the MLS. Boston University graduate Kylie Nadaner (Orlando Pride) and Loyola Maryland graduate Didi Haračić (San Diego Wave FC) are playing in the NWSL.

*Boston University women's rowing head coach Malcolm Doldron was honored as the Collegiate Rowing Coaches Association Mid-Atlantic Region Coach of the Year after leading the Terriers to their third straight Patriot League championship.

*Two Patriot League Men's Lacrosse programs finished the 2026 season ranked in Inside Lacrosse's KANE Men's Division I Top 20 Poll, including Army West Point at No. 13 and Loyola Maryland at No. 18.

*Two Patriot League men's lacrosse student-athletes, Army West Point's Jackson Eicher ('25) and Evan Plunkett ('26), were selected to the represent the United States at the inaugural Pan-American Men's Lacrosse Championship.

*Three Patriot League Women's Lacrosse programs, Army West Point, Loyola Maryland and League champion Navy received berths in the 2026 NCAA Women's Lacrosse Championship, marking the second straight season the League received three bids. All three were ranked in the final KANE DI Media Poll, with Navy (7th), Army West Point (13th) and Loyola Maryland (22nd) among the top 25.

*Patriot League women's lacrosse champion Navy earned the No. 6 seed in the 2026 NCAA Division I Women's Lacrosse Championship and advanced to the quarterfinal round. The Mids run marked the sixth time a Patriot League team has advanced to the quarterfinal round or further in the NCAA DI Women's Lacrosse Championship.

*Lehigh ranked No. 9 in the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll and No. 11 in the Stats Perform Top 25 after earning its second straight Patriot League crown. The Mountain Hawks fell to future League rival Villanova in the second round of the FCS Playoffs. Lafayette and Richmond both received votes in the FCS Coaches Poll.

*Bucknell's Amar Tahirovic peaked at No. 43 in the Intercollegiate Tennis Association's (ITA) men's singles rankings. Tahirovic and Brendan McDonald represented the Patriot League at the ITA Conference Masters in San Diego, Calif. and advanced to the semifinals before falling one win shy of an automatic berth in the NCAA Doubles Tournament. McDonald received the ITA Sportsmanship Award.

*Seven Patriot League individual student-athletes qualified for the NCAA Outdoor Track and Field Championships. Bucknell's Evelyn Bliss (Javelin) became the second Patriot League student-athlete to finish as the runner-up, earning First Team All-America honors. Army West Point's Nathan Davis (3,000-meter Steeplechase) was a Second Team All-American for the second straight year, while Bucknell's Wade Shomper (Shot Put) received Second Team All-American honors. Boston University's Owen Faulha (Javelin), Peace Omonzane (Long Jump) and Ellie Roan (Hammer Throw) as well as Navy's Brian Schloeder (Pole Vault) earned Honorable Mention All-America honors.

*Bucknell's Evelyn Bliss earned the silver medal at the 2026 Toyota USAITF Outdoor & Para National Championships.
